beholdest mischief and <u>19\_PSA\_10\_14</u># Thou hast seen [it]: for thou beholdest mischief and spite, to requite [it] with thy hand: the poor committeth himself unto thee; thou art the helper of the fatherless.

beholdest not the <u>42\_LUK\_06\_42</u> # Either how canst thou say to thy brother, Brother, let me pull out the mote that is in thine eye, when thou thyself beholdest not the beam that is in thine own eye? Thou hypocrite, cast out first the beam out of thine own eye, and then shalt thou see clearly to pull out the mote that is in thy brother's eye.

beholdest thou the <u>42\_LUK\_06\_41</u> # And why beholdest thou the mote that is in thy brother's eye, but perceivest not the beam that is in thine own eye?

beholdest thou the <u>40\_MAT\_07\_03</u># And why beholdest thou the mote that is in thy brother's eye, but considerest not the beam that is in thine own eye?

holdest fast my <u>66\_REV\_02\_13</u> # I know thy works and where thou dwellest, [even] where Satan's seat [is]: and thou holdest fast my name, and hast not denied my faith, even in those days wherein Antipas [was] my faithful martyr, who was slain among you, where Satan dwelleth.

holdest me for <a><u>18\_JOB\_13\_24</u></a># Wherefore hidest thou thy face, and holdest me for thine enemy?

holdest mine eyes 19\_PSA\_77\_04 # Thou holdest mine eyes waking: I am so troubled that I cannot speak.

holdest the height <u>24\_JER\_49\_16</u> # Thy terribleness hath deceived thee, [and] the pride of thine heart, O thou that dwellest in the clefts of the rock, that holdest the height of the hill: though thou shouldest make thy nest as high as the eagle, I will bring thee down from thence, saith the LORD.

holdest thy peace <u>17\_EST\_04\_14</u> # For if thou altogether holdest thy peace at this time, [then] shall there enlargement and deliverance arise to the Jews from another place; but thou and thy father's house shall be destroyed: and who knoweth whether thou art come to the kingdom for [such] a time as this?

holdest thy tongue <u>35\_HAB\_01\_13</u># [Thou art] of purer eyes than to behold evil, and canst not look on iniquity: wherefore lookest thou upon them that deal treacherously, [and] holdest thy tongue when the wicked devoureth [the man that is] more righteous than he?

upholdest me in <u>19\_PSA\_41\_12</u> # And as for me, thou upholdest me in mine integrity, and settest me before thy face for ever.
