beholding afar off [40 MAT 27 55](#) # And many women were there beholding afar off, which followed Jesus from Galilee, ministering unto him:

beholding And the [42 LUK 23 35](#) # And the people stood beholding. And the rulers also with them derided [him], saying, He saved others; let him save himself, if he be Christ, the chosen of God.

beholding as in [47 2CO 03 18](#) # But we all, with open face beholding as in a glass the glory of the Lord, are changed into the same image from glory to glory, [even] as by the Spirit of the Lord.

beholding him and [44 ACT 14 09](#) # The same heard Paul speak: who stedfastly beholding him, and perceiving that he had faith to be healed,

beholding him loved [41 MAR 10 21](#) # Then Jesus beholding him loved him, and said unto him, One thing thou lackest: go thy way, sell whatsoever thou hast, and give to the poor, and thou shalt have treasure in heaven: and come, take up the cross, and follow me.

beholding of them [21 ECC 05 11](#) # When goods increase, they are increased that eat them: and what good [is there] to the owners thereof, saving the beholding [of them] with their eyes?

beholding the council [44 ACT 23 01](#) # And Paul, earnestly beholding the council, said, Men [and] brethren, I have lived in all good conscience before God until this day.

beholding the evil [20 PRO 15 03](#) # The eyes of the LORD [are] in every place, beholding the evil and the good.

beholding the man [44 ACT 04 14](#) # And beholding the man which was healed standing with them, they could say nothing against it.

beholding the miracles [44 ACT 08 13](#) # Then Simon himself believed also: and when he was baptized, he continued with Philip, and wondered, beholding the miracles and signs which were done.

beholding the things [42 LUK 23 48](#) # And all the people that came together to that sight, beholding the things which were done, smote their breasts, and returned.

beholding these things [42 LUK 23 49](#) # And all his acquaintance, and the women that followed him from Galilee, stood afar off, beholding these things.

beholding vanity and [19 PSA 119 37](#) # Turn away mine eyes from beholding vanity; [and] quicken thou me in thy way.

beholding your order [51 COL 02 05](#) # For though I be absent in the flesh, yet am I with you in the spirit, joying and beholding your order, and the stedfastness of your faith in Christ.

Holding faith and [54 1TI 01 19](#) # Holding faith, and a good conscience; which some having put away concerning faith have made shipwreck:

Holding fast the [56 TIT 01 09](#) # Holding fast the faithful word as he hath been taught, that he may be able by sound doctrine both to exhort and to convince the gainsayers.

Holding forth the [50 PHP 02 16](#) # Holding forth the word of life; that I may rejoice in the day of Christ, that I have not run in vain, neither laboured in vain.

holding in I [24 JER 06 11](#) # Therefore I am full of the fury of the LORD; I am weary with holding in: I will pour it out upon the children abroad, and upon the assembly of young men together: for even the husband with the wife shall be taken, the aged with [him that is] full of days.

holding of bribes [23 ISA 33 15](#) # He that walketh righteously, and speaketh uprightly; he that despiseth the gain of oppressions, that shaketh his hands from holding of bribes, that stoppeth his ears from hearing of blood, and shutteth his eyes from seeing evil;

holding the four [66 REV 07 01](#) # And after these things I saw four angels standing on the four corners of the earth, holding the four winds of the earth, that the wind should not blow on the earth, nor on the sea, nor on any tree.

holding the Head [51 COL 02 19](#) # And not holding the Head, from which all the body by joints and bands having nourishment ministered, and knit together, increaseth with the increase of God.

Holding the mystery [54 1TI 03 09](#) # Holding the mystery of the faith in a pure conscience.

holding the tradition [41 MAR 07 03](#) # For the Pharisees, and all the Jews, except they wash [their] hands oft, eat not, holding the tradition of the elders.
