honey and as <u>66\_REV\_10\_10</u># And I took the little book out of the angel's hand, and ate it up; and it was in my mouth sweet as honey: and as soon as I had eaten it, my belly was bitter.

honey and butter <u>10\_2SA\_17\_29</u> # And honey, and butter, and sheep, and cheese of kine, for David, and for the people that [were] with him, to eat: for they said, The people [is] hungry, and weary, and thirsty, in the wilderness.

honey and butter <u>18\_JOB\_20\_17</u># He shall not see the rivers, the floods, the brooks of honey and butter.

honey and go <u>11\_1KI\_14\_03</u># And take with thee ten loaves, and cracknels, and a cruse of honey, and go to him: he shall tell thee what shall become of the child.

honey and milk <u>22\_SON\_04\_11</u># Thy lips, O [my] spouse, drop [as] the honeycomb: honey and milk [are] under thy tongue; and the smell of thy garments [is] like the smell of Lebanon.

honey and of <u>14\_2CH\_31\_05</u> # And as soon as the commandment came abroad, the children of Israel brought in abundance the firstfruits of corn, wine, and oil, and honey, and of all the increase of the field; and the tithe of all [things] brought they in abundantly.
