Ghost according to <u>58\_HEB\_02\_04</u> # God also bearing [them] witness, both with signs and wonders, and with divers miracles, and gifts of the Holy Ghost, according to his own will?

Ghost also is <u>58\_HEB\_10\_15</u># [Whereof] the Holy Ghost also is a witness to us: for after that he had said before,

Ghost and began <u>44\_ACT\_02\_04</u> # And they were all filled with the Holy Ghost, and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance.

ghost and died <u>01\_GEN\_25\_08</u># Then Abraham gave up the ghost, and died in a good old age, an old man, and full [of years]; and was gathered to his people.

ghost and died <u>01\_GEN\_25\_17</u># And these [are] the years of the life of Ishmael, an hundred and thirty and seven years: and he gave up the ghost and died; and was gathered unto his people.

ghost and died <u>01\_GEN\_35\_29</u># And Isaac gave up the ghost, and died, and was gathered unto his people, [being] old and full of days: and his sons Esau and Jacob buried him.

ghost and great <u>44\_ACT\_05\_05</u> # And Ananias hearing these words fell down, and gave up the ghost: and great fear came on all them that heard these things.

Ghost and in <u>52\_1TH\_01\_05</u># For our gospel came not unto you in word only, but also in power, and in the Holy Ghost, and in much assurance; as ye know what manner of men we were among you for your sake.

ghost and no <u>18\_JOB\_10\_18</u> # Wherefore then hast thou brought me forth out of the womb? Oh that I had given up the ghost, and no eye had seen me!

Ghost and of <u>44\_ACT\_11\_24</u># For he was a good man, and full of the Holy Ghost and of faith: and much people was added unto the Lord.

Ghost and Philip <u>44\_ACT\_06\_05</u> # And the saying pleased the whole multitude: and they chose Stephen, a man full of faith and of the Holy Ghost, and Philip, and Prochorus, and Nicanor, and Timon, and Parmenas, and Nicolas a proselyte of Antioch:

Ghost and prophesied <u>42\_LUK\_01\_67</u> # And his father Zacharias was filled with the Holy Ghost, and prophesied, saying,

ghost and the <u>44\_ACT\_05\_10</u># Then fell she down straightway at his feet, and yielded up the ghost: and the young men came in, and found her dead, and, carrying [her] forth, buried [her] by her husband.

Ghost and these <u>62\_1JO\_05\_07</u># For there are three that bear record in heaven, the Father, the Word, and the Holy Ghost: and these three are one.

Ghost and they <u>44\_ACT\_04\_31</u> # And when they had prayed, the place was shaken where they were assembled together; and they were all filled with the Holy Ghost, and they spake the word of God with boldness.

Ghost and to <u>44\_ACT\_05\_03</u> # But Peter said, Ananias, why hath Satan filled thine heart to lie to the Holy

Ghost, and to keep back [part] of the price of the land?

Ghost and to <u>44\_ACT\_15\_28</u> # For it seemed good to the Holy Ghost, and to us, to lay upon you no greater burden than these necessary things;

ghost and was <u>01\_GEN\_49\_33</u> # And when Jacob had made an end of commanding his sons, he gathered up his feet into the bed, and yielded up the ghost, and was gathered unto his people.

ghost and where <u>18\_JOB\_14\_10</u># But man dieth, and wasteth away: yea, man giveth up the ghost, and where [is] he?

Ghost and wisdom <u>44\_ACT\_06\_03</u> # Wherefore, brethren, look ye out among you seven men of honest report, full of the Holy Ghost and wisdom, whom we may appoint over this business.

Ghost and with <u>44\_ACT\_10\_38</u> # How God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Ghost and with power: who went about doing good, and healing all that were oppressed of the devil; for God was with him.

Ghost and with <u>42\_LUK\_03\_16</u> # John answered, saying unto [them] all, I indeed baptize you with water; but one mightier than I cometh, the latchet of whose shoes I am not worthy to unloose: he shall baptize you with the Holy Ghost and with fire:

Ghost and with <u>40\_MAT\_03\_11</u># I indeed baptize you with water unto repentance: but he that cometh after me is mightier than I, whose shoes I am not worthy to bear: he shall baptize you with the Holy Ghost, and [with] fire:

Ghost as well <u>44\_ACT\_10\_47</u> # Can any man forbid water, that these should not be baptized, which have received the Holy Ghost as well as we?

Ghost as your <u>44\_ACT\_07\_51</u># Ye stiffnecked and uncircumcised in heart and ears, ye do always resist the Holy Ghost: as your fathers [did], so [do] ye.

Ghost be with <u>47\_2CO\_13\_14</u># The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ, and the love of God, and the communion of the Holy Ghost, [be] with you all. Amen.

Ghost by Esaias <u>44\_ACT\_28\_25</u> # And when they agreed not among themselves, they departed, after that Paul had spoken one word, Well spake the Holy Ghost by Esaias the prophet unto our fathers,

Ghost by love <u>47\_2CO\_06\_06</u> # By pureness, by knowledge, by longsuffering, by kindness, by the Holy Ghost, by love unfeigned,

Ghost by the <u>44\_ACT\_01\_16</u># Men [and] brethren, this scripture must needs have been fulfilled, which the Holy Ghost by the mouth of David spake before concerning Judas, which was guide to them that took Jesus.

Ghost came on <u>44\_ACT\_19\_06</u> # And when Paul had laid [his] hands upon them, the Holy Ghost came on them; and they spake with tongues, and prophesied.

Ghost departed unto <u>44\_ACT\_13\_04</u> # So they, being sent forth by the Holy Ghost, departed unto Seleucia; and from thence they sailed to Cyprus.

Ghost descended in <u>42\_LUK\_03\_22</u> # And the Holy Ghost descended in a bodily shape like a dove upon him, and a voice came from heaven, which said, Thou art my beloved Son; in thee I am well pleased.

Ghost even as <u>44\_ACT\_15\_08</u># And God, which knoweth the hearts, bare them witness, giving them the Holy Ghost, even as [he did] unto us;

Ghost even from <u>42\_LUK\_01\_15</u># For he shall be great in the sight of the Lord, and shall drink neither wine nor strong drink; and he shall be filled with the Holy Ghost, even from his mother's womb.

Ghost fell on <u>44\_ACT\_10\_44</u> # While Peter yet spake these words, the Holy Ghost fell on all them which heard the word.

Ghost fell on <u>44\_ACT\_11\_15</u># And as I began to speak, the Holy Ghost fell on them, as on us at the beginning.

Ghost had given <u>44\_ACT\_01\_02</u> # Until the day in which he was taken up, after that he through the Holy Ghost had given commandments unto the apostles whom he had chosen:

Ghost hath made <u>44\_ACT\_20\_28</u># Take heed therefore unto yourselves, and to all the flock, over the which the Holy Ghost hath made you overseers, to feed the church of God, which he hath purchased with his own blood.

Ghost hath never <u>41\_MAR\_03\_29</u># But he that shall blaspheme against the Holy Ghost hath never forgiveness, but is in danger of eternal damnation:

Ghost he hath <u>44\_ACT\_02\_33</u> # Therefore being by the right hand of God exalted, and having received of the Father the promise of the Holy Ghost, he hath shed forth this, which ye now see and hear.

ghost he said <u>41\_MAR\_15\_39</u> # And when the centurion, which stood over against him, saw that he so cried out, and gave up the ghost, he said, Truly this man was the Son of God.

ghost her sun <u>24\_JER\_15\_09</u># She that hath borne seven languisheth: she hath given up the ghost; her sun is gone down while [it was] yet day: she hath been ashamed and confounded: and the residue of them will I deliver to the sword before their enemies, saith the LORD.

ghost in the <u>25\_LAM\_01\_19</u> # I called for my lovers, [but] they deceived me: my priests and mine elders gave up the ghost in the city, while they sought their meat to relieve their souls.

Ghost is come <u>44\_ACT\_01\_08</u># But ye shall receive power, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you: and ye shall be witnesses unto me both in Jerusalem, and in all Judaea, and in Samaria, and unto the uttermost part of the earth.

Ghost it shall <u>42\_LUK\_12\_10</u> # And whosoever shall speak a word against the Son of man, it shall be forgiven him: but unto him that blasphemeth against the Holy Ghost it shall not be forgiven.

Ghost it shall <u>40\_MAT\_12\_32</u># And whosoever speaketh a word against the Son of man, it shall be forgiven him: but whosoever speaketh against the Holy Ghost, it shall not be forgiven him, neither in this world, neither in the [world] to come.

Ghost looked up <u>44\_ACT\_07\_55</u> # But he, being full of the Holy Ghost, looked up stedfastly into heaven, and saw the glory of God, and Jesus standing on the right hand of God,

Ghost not many <u>44\_ACT\_01\_05</u># For John truly baptized with water; but ye shall be baptized with the Holy Ghost not many days hence.

Ghost returned from <u>42\_LUK\_04\_01</u> # And Jesus being full of the Holy Ghost returned from Jordan, and was led by the Spirit into the wilderness,

Ghost said Separate <u>44\_ACT\_13\_02</u> # As they ministered to the Lord, and fasted, the Holy Ghost said, Separate me Barnabas and Saul for the work whereunto I have called them.

Ghost said unto <u>44\_ACT\_04\_08</u># Then Peter, filled with the Holy Ghost, said unto them, Ye rulers of the people, and elders of Israel,

Ghost saith To 58\_HEB\_03\_07 # Wherefore [as the Holy Ghost saith, To day if ye will hear his voice,

Ghost sent down <u>60\_1PE\_01\_12</u><sup>#</sup> Unto whom it was revealed, that not unto themselves, but unto us they did minister the things, which are now reported unto you by them that have preached the gospel unto you with the Holy Ghost sent down from heaven; which things the angels desire to look into.

Ghost set his <u>44\_ACT\_13\_09</u> # Then Saul, [who also [is called] Paul,] filled with the Holy Ghost, set his eyes on him,

Ghost shall come <u>42\_LUK\_01\_35</u> # And the angel answered and said unto her, The Holy Ghost shall come upon thee, and the power of the Highest shall overshadow thee: therefore also that holy thing which shall be born of thee shall be called the Son of God.

Ghost shall not <u>40\_MAT\_12\_31</u># Wherefore I say unto you, All manner of sin and blasphemy shall be forgiven unto men: but the blasphemy [against] the [Holy] Ghost shall not be forgiven unto men.

Ghost shall teach <u>42\_LUK\_12\_12</u> # For the Holy Ghost shall teach you in the same hour what ye ought to say.

Ghost since ye <u>44\_ACT\_19\_02</u> # He said unto them, Have ye received the Holy Ghost since ye believed? And they said unto him, We have not so much as heard whether there be any Holy Ghost.

Ghost So shall <u>44\_ACT\_21\_11</u># And when he was come unto us, he took Paul's girdle, and bound his own hands and feet, and said, Thus saith the Holy Ghost, So shall the Jews at Jerusalem bind the man that owneth this girdle, and shall deliver [him] into the hands of the Gentiles.

Ghost teacheth comparing <u>46\_1CO\_02\_13</u> # Which things also we speak, not in the words which man's wisdom teacheth, but which the Holy Ghost teacheth; comparing spiritual things with spiritual.

Ghost that he <u>42\_LUK\_02\_26</u> # And it was revealed unto him by the Holy Ghost, that he should not see death, before he had seen the Lord's Christ.

Ghost The LORD <u>41\_MAR\_12\_36</u> # For David himself said by the Holy Ghost, The LORD said to my Lord, Sit thou on my right hand, till I make thine enemies thy footstool.

Ghost this signifying <u>58\_HEB\_09\_08</u># The Holy Ghost this signifying, that the way into the holiest of all was not yet made manifest, while as the first tabernacle was yet standing:

Ghost to preach <u>44\_ACT\_16\_06</u> # Now when they had gone throughout Phrygia and the region of Galatia, and were forbidden of the Holy Ghost to preach the word in Asia,

Ghost was given <u>44\_ACT\_08\_18</u> # And when Simon saw that through laying on of the apostles' hands the Holy Ghost was given, he offered them money,

Ghost was not <u>43\_JOH\_07\_39</u> # [But this spake he of the Spirit, which they that believe on him should receive: for the Holy Ghost was not yet [given]; because that Jesus was not yet glorified.]

Ghost was upon <u>42\_LUK\_02\_25</u> # And, behold, there was a man in Jerusalem, whose name [was] Simeon; and the same man [was] just and devout, waiting for the consolation of Israel: and the Holy Ghost was upon him.

Ghost were multiplied <u>44\_ACT\_09\_31</u># Then had the churches rest throughout all Judaea and Galilee and Samaria, and were edified; and walking in the fear of the Lord, and in the comfort of the Holy Ghost, were multiplied.

ghost when I <u>18\_JOB\_03\_11</u># Why died I not from the womb? [why] did I [not] give up the ghost when I came out of the belly?

Ghost which dwelleth <u>55\_2TI\_01\_14</u> # That good thing which was committed unto thee keep by the Holy Ghost which dwelleth in us.

Ghost which is <u>46\_1CO\_06\_19</u> # What? know ye not that your body is the temple of the Holy Ghost [which is] in you, which ye have of God, and ye are not your own?

Ghost which is <u>45\_ROM\_05\_05</u> # And hope maketh not ashamed; because the love of God is shed abroad in our hearts by the Holy Ghost which is given unto us.

Ghost whom God <u>44\_ACT\_05\_32</u> # And we are his witnesses of these things; and [so is] also the Holy Ghost, whom God hath given to them that obey him.

Ghost whom the <u>43\_JOH\_14\_26</u> # But the Comforter, [which is] the Holy Ghost, whom the Father will send in my name, he shall teach you all things, and bring all things to your remembrance, whatsoever I have said unto you.

Ghost witnesseth in <u>44\_ACT\_20\_23</u># Save that the Holy Ghost witnesseth in every city, saying that bonds and afflictions abide me.

Ghost <u>46\_1CO\_12\_03</u> # Wherefore I give you to understand, that no man speaking by the Spirit of God calleth Jesus accursed: and [that] no man can say that Jesus is the Lord, but by the Holy Ghost.

Ghost <u>52\_1TH\_01\_06</u># And ye became followers of us, and of the Lord, having received the word in much affliction, with joy of the Holy Ghost:

Ghost <u>61\_2PE\_01\_21</u> # For the prophecy came not in old time by the will of man: but holy men of God spake [as they were] moved by the Holy Ghost.

Ghost <u>44\_ACT\_02\_38</u># Then Peter said unto them, Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost.

Ghost <u>44\_ACT\_08\_15</u> # Who, when they were come down, prayed for them, that they might receive the Holy Ghost:

Ghost <u>44\_ACT\_08\_17</u> # Then laid they [their] hands on them, and they received the Holy Ghost.

Ghost <u>44\_ACT\_08\_19</u># Saying, Give me also this power, that on whomsoever I lay hands, he may receive the Holy Ghost.

Ghost <u>44\_ACT\_09\_17</u> # And Ananias went his way, and entered into the house; and putting his hands on him said, Brother Saul, the Lord, [even] Jesus, that appeared unto thee in the way as thou camest, hath sent me, that thou mightest receive thy sight, and be filled with the Holy Ghost.

Ghost <u>44\_ACT\_10\_45</u> # And they of the circumcision which believed were astonished, as many as came with Peter, because that on the Gentiles also was poured out the gift of the Holy Ghost.

Ghost <u>44\_ACT\_11\_16</u># Then remembered I the word of the Lord, how that he said, John indeed baptized with water; but ye shall be baptized with the Holy Ghost.

ghost <u>44\_ACT\_12\_23</u> # And immediately the angel of the Lord smote him, because he gave not God the glory: and he was eaten of worms, and gave up the ghost.

Ghost <u>44\_ACT\_13\_52</u> # And the disciples were filled with joy, and with the Holy Ghost.

Ghost <u>44\_ACT\_19\_02</u> # He said unto them, Have ye received the Holy Ghost since ye believed? And they said unto him, We have not so much as heard whether there be any Holy Ghost.

Ghost <u>58\_HEB\_06\_04</u> # For [it is] impossible for those who were once enlightened, and have tasted of the heavenly gift, and were made partakers of the Holy Ghost,

Ghost <u>65\_JDE\_01\_20</u> # But ye, beloved, building up yourselves on your most holy faith, praying in the Holy Ghost,

ghost <u>18\_JOB\_11\_20</u># But the eyes of the wicked shall fail, and they shall not escape, and their hope [shall be as] the giving up of the ghost.

ghost <u>18\_JOB\_13\_19</u># Who [is] he [that] will plead with me? for now, if I hold my tongue, I shall give up the ghost.

Ghost <u>43\_JOH\_01\_33</u> # And I knew him not: but he that sent me to baptize with water, the same said unto me, Upon whom thou shalt see the Spirit descending, and remaining on him, the same is he which baptizeth with the Holy Ghost.

ghost <u>43\_JOH\_19\_30</u> # When Jesus therefore had received the vinegar, he said, It is finished: and he bowed his head, and gave up the ghost.

Ghost <u>43\_JOH\_20\_22</u># And when he had said this, he breathed on [them], and saith unto them, Receive ye the Holy Ghost:

Ghost <u>42\_LUK\_01\_41</u> # And it came to pass, that, when Elisabeth heard the salutation of Mary, the babe leaped in her womb; and Elisabeth was filled with the Holy Ghost:

ghost <u>42\_LUK\_23\_46</u> # And when Jesus had cried with a loud voice, he said, Father, into thy hands I commend my spirit: and having said thus, he gave up the ghost.

Ghost <u>41\_MAR\_01\_08</u># I indeed have baptized you with water: but he shall baptize you with the Holy Ghost.

Ghost <u>41\_MAR\_13\_11</u># But when they shall lead [you], and deliver you up, take no thought beforehand what ye shall speak, neither do ye premeditate: but whatsoever shall be given you in that hour, that speak ye: for it is not ye that speak, but the Holy Ghost.

ghost <u>41\_MAR\_15\_37</u># And Jesus cried with a loud voice, and gave up the ghost.

Ghost <u>40\_MAT\_01\_18</u># Now the birth of Jesus Christ was on this wise: When as his mother Mary was espoused to Joseph, before they came together, she was found with child of the Holy Ghost.

Ghost <u>40\_MAT\_01\_20</u># But while he thought on these things, behold, the angel of the Lord appeared unto him in a dream, saying, Joseph, thou son of David, fear not to take unto thee Mary thy wife: for that which is conceived in her is of the Holy Ghost.

ghost <u>40\_MAT\_27\_50</u># Jesus, when he had cried again with a loud voice, yielded up the ghost.

Ghost <u>40 MAT\_28\_19</u># Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost:

Ghost <u>45\_ROM\_09\_01</u> # I say the truth in Christ, I lie not, my conscience also bearing me witness in the Holy Ghost,

Ghost <u>45\_ROM\_14\_17</u># For the kingdom of God is not meat and drink; but righteousness, and peace, and joy in the Holy Ghost.

Ghost <u>45\_ROM\_15\_13</u> # Now the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace in believing, that ye may abound in hope, through the power of the Holy Ghost.

Ghost <u>45\_ROM\_15\_16</u> # That I should be the minister of Jesus Christ to the Gentiles, ministering the gospel of God, that the offering up of the Gentiles might be acceptable, being sanctified by the Holy Ghost.

Ghost <u>56\_TIT\_03\_05</u> # Not by works of righteousness which we have done, but according to his mercy he saved us, by the washing of regeneration, and renewing of the Holy Ghost;

host a mighty <u>19\_PSA\_33\_16</u># There is no king saved by the multitude of an host: a mighty man is not delivered by much strength.

host Abner whose <u>09\_18A\_17\_55</u># And when Saul saw David go forth against the Philistine, he said unto Abner, the captain of the host, Abner, whose son [is] this youth? And Abner said, [As] thy soul liveth, O king, I cannot tell.

host about the <u>11\_1KI\_22\_36</u># And there went a proclamation throughout the host about the going down of the sun, saying, Every man to his city, and every man to his own country.

host against Jerusalem <u>12\_2KI\_18\_17</u> # And the king of Assyria sent Tartan and Rabsaris and Rabshakeh from Lachish to king Hezekiah with a great host against Jerusalem. And they went up and came to Jerusalem. And when they were come up, they came and stood by the conduit of the upper pool, which [is] in the highway of the fuller's field.

host against Jerusalem <u>12\_2KI\_25\_01</u> # And it came to pass in the ninth year of his reign, in the tenth month, in the tenth [day] of the month, [that] Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon came, he, and all his host, against Jerusalem, and pitched against it: and they built forts against it round about.

host and Abiathar <u>11\_1KI\_01\_25</u># For he is gone down this day, and hath slain oxen and fat cattle and sheep in abundance, and hath called all the king's sons, and the captains of the host, and Abiathar the priest; and, behold, they eat and drink before him, and say, God save king Adonijah.

host and by <u>27\_DAN\_08\_11</u> # Yea, he magnified [himself] even to the prince of the host, and by him the daily [sacrifice] was taken away, and the place of his sanctuary was cast down.

host and command <u>06\_JOS\_01\_11</u># Pass through the host, and command the people, saying, Prepare you victuals; for within three days ye shall pass over this Jordan, to go in to possess the land, which the LORD your God giveth you to possess it.

host and for <u>12\_2KI\_03\_09</u> # So the king of Israel went, and the king of Judah, and the king of Edom: and they fetched a compass of seven days' journey: and there was no water for the host, and for the cattle that followed them.

host and he <u>01\_GEN\_32\_02</u># And when Jacob saw them, he said, This [is] God's host: and he called the name of that place Mahanaim.

host and Jehoshaphat <u>13\_1CH\_18\_15</u># And Joab the son of Zeruiah [was] over the host; and Jehoshaphat the son of Ahilud, recorder.

host and Jehoshaphat <u>10\_2SA\_08\_16</u> # And Joab the son of Zeruiah [was] over the host; and Jehoshaphat the son of Ahilud [was] recorder;

host And Joab <u>10\_2SA\_24\_04</u> # Notwithstanding the king's word prevailed against Joab, and against the captains of the host. And Joab and the captains of the host went out from the presence of the king, to number the people of Israel.

host and of <u>27\_DAN\_08\_10</u> # And it waxed great, [even] to the host of heaven; and it cast down [some] of the host and of the stars to the ground, and stamped upon them.

host and of <u>45\_ROM\_16\_23</u> # Gaius mine host, and of the whole church, saluteth you. Erastus the chamberlain of the city saluteth you, and Quartus a brother.

host and said <u>14\_2CH\_23\_14</u># Then Jehoiada the priest brought out the captains of hundreds that were set over the host, and said unto them, Have her forth of the ranges: and whoso followeth her, let him be slain with the sword. For the priest said, Slay her not in the house of the LORD.

host and said <u>12\_2KI\_11\_15</u># But Jehoiada the priest commanded the captains of the hundreds, the officers of the host, and said unto them, Have her forth without the ranges: and him that followeth her kill with the sword. For the priest had said, Let her not be slain in the house of the LORD.

host and said <u>42\_LUK\_10\_35</u># And on the morrow when he departed, he took out two pence, and gave [them] to the host, and said unto him, Take care of him; and whatsoever thou spendest more, when I come again, I will repay thee.

host and Saul <u>09\_1SA\_26\_05</u># And David arose, and came to the place where Saul had pitched: and David beheld the place where Saul lay, and Abner the son of Ner, the captain of his host: and Saul lay in the trench, and the people pitched round about him.

host And she <u>12\_2KI\_04\_13</u> # And he said unto him, Say now unto her, Behold, thou hast been careful for us with all this care; what [is] to be done for thee? wouldest thou be spoken for to the king, or to the captain of the host? And she answered, I dwell among mine own people.

host and smote <u>09\_1SA\_14\_48</u># And he gathered an host, and smote the Amalekites, and delivered Israel out of the hands of them that spoiled them.

host and the <u>07\_JUD\_07\_22</u># And the three hundred blew the trumpets, and the LORD set every man's sword against his fellow, even throughout all the host: and the host fled to Bethshittah in Zererath, [and] to the border of Abelmeholah, unto Tabbath.

host and they <u>14\_2CH\_14\_13</u> # And Asa and the people that [were] with him pursued them unto Gerar: and the Ethiopians were overthrown, that they could not recover themselves; for they were destroyed before the LORD, and before his host; and they carried away very much spoil.

host and they <u>12\_2KI\_06\_14</u> # Therefore sent he thither horses, and chariots, and a great host: and they came by night, and compassed the city about.

host was Abner <u>09\_1SA\_14\_50</u> # And the name of Saul's wife [was] Ahinoam, the daughter of Ahimaaz: and the name of the captain of his host [was] Abner, the son of Ner, Saul's uncle.

host was dead <u>11\_1KI\_11\_21</u># And when Hadad heard in Egypt that David slept with his fathers, and that Joab the captain of the host was dead, Hadad said to Pharaoh, Let me depart, that I may go to mine own country.

host was Elishama <u>04\_NUM\_10\_22</u> # And the standard of the camp of the children of Ephraim set forward according to their armies: and over his host [was] Elishama the son of Ammihud.

hosts Hearken not 24\_JER\_23\_16 # Thus saith the LORD of hosts, Hearken not unto the words of the prophets that prophesy unto you: they make you vain: they speak a vision of their own heart, [and] not out of the mouth of the LORD.

hosts himself and <u>23\_ISA\_08\_13</u># Sanctify the LORD of hosts himself; and [let] him [be] your fear, and [let] him [be] your dread.

hosts how long <u>19\_PSA\_80\_04</u># O LORD God of hosts, how long wilt thou be angry against the prayer of thy people?

hosts how long <u>38\_ZEC\_01\_12</u># Then the angel of the LORD answered and said, O LORD of hosts, how long wilt thou not have mercy on Jerusalem and on the cities of Judah, against which thou hast had indignation these threescore and ten years?

hosts I abhor <u>30\_AMO\_06\_08</u># The Lord GOD hath sworn by himself, saith the LORD the God of hosts, I abhor the excellency of Jacob, and hate his palaces: therefore will I deliver up the city with all that is therein.

hosts I am <u>23\_ISA\_44\_06</u> # Thus saith the LORD the King of Israel, and his redeemer the LORD of hosts; I [am] the first, and I [am] the last; and beside me [there is] no God.

have cursed them already, because ye do not lay [it] to heart.

hosts the God <u>24\_JER\_35\_13</u> # Thus saith the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel; Go and tell the men of Judah and the inhabitants of Jerusalem, Will ye not receive instruction to hearken to my words? saith the LORD.

hosts the God <u>24\_JER\_35\_17</u> # Therefore thus saith the LORD God of hosts, the God of Israel; Behold, I will bring upon Judah and upon all the inhabitants of Jerusalem all the evil that I have pronounced against them: because I have spoken unto them, but they have not heard; and I have called unto them, but they have not answered.

hosts the God <u>24\_JER\_35\_18</u> # And Jeremiah said unto the house of the Rechabites, Thus saith the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel; Because ye have obeyed the commandment of Jonadab your father, and kept all his precepts, and done according unto all that he hath commanded you:

hosts the God <u>24\_JER\_35\_19</u> # Therefore thus saith the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel; Jonadab the son of Rechab shall not want a man to stand before me for ever.

hosts the God 24\_JER\_38\_17 # Then said Jeremiah unto Zedekiah, Thus saith the LORD, the God of hosts, the God of Israel; If thou wilt assuredly go forth unto the king of Babylon's princes, then thy soul shall live, and this city shall not be burned with fire; and thou shalt live, and thine house:

hosts the God 24\_JER\_39\_16 # Go and speak to Ebedmelech the Ethiopian, saying, Thus saith the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel; Behold, I will bring my words upon this city for evil, and not for good; and they shall be [accomplished] in that day before thee.

hosts the God <u>24\_JER\_42\_15</u> # And now therefore hear the word of the LORD, ye remnant of Judah; Thus saith the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel; If ye wholly set your faces to enter into Egypt, and go to sojourn there;

hosts the God 24\_JER\_42\_18 # For thus saith the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel; As mine anger and my fury hath been poured forth upon the inhabitants of Jerusalem; so shall my fury be poured forth upon you, when ye shall enter into Egypt: and ye shall be an execration, and an astonishment, and a curse, and a reproach; and ye shall see this place no more.

hosts the God 24\_JER\_43\_10 # And say unto them, Thus saith the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel; Behold, I will send and take Nebuchadrezzar the king of Babylon, my servant, and will set his throne upon these stones that I have hid; and he shall spread his royal pavilion over them.

hosts the God 24\_JER\_44\_02 # Thus saith the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel; Ye have seen all the evil that I have brought upon Jerusalem, and upon all the cities of Judah; and, behold, this day they [are] a desolation, and no man dwelleth therein,

hosts the God <u>24\_JER\_44\_07</u># Therefore now thus saith the LORD, the God of hosts, the God of Israel; Wherefore commit ye [this] great evil against your souls, to cut off from you man and woman, child and suckling, out of Judah, to leave you none to remain;

hosts the God <u>24\_JER\_44\_11</u># Therefore thus saith the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel; Behold, I will set my face against you for evil, and to cut off all Judah.

hosts the God 24\_JER\_44\_25 # Thus saith the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel, saying; Ye and your wives have both spoken with your mouths, and fulfilled with your hand, saying, We will surely perform our vows that we have vowed, to burn incense to the queen of heaven, and to pour out drink offerings unto her: ye will surely accomplish your vows, and surely perform your vows.

hosts the God 24\_JER\_46\_25 # The LORD of hosts, the God of Israel, saith; Behold, I will punish the multitude of No, and Pharaoh, and Egypt, with their gods, and their kings; even Pharaoh, and [all] them that trust in him:

hosts the God 24\_JER\_48\_01 # Against Moab thus saith the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel; Woe unto Nebo! for it is spoiled: Kiriathaim is confounded [and] taken: Misgab is confounded and dismayed.

hosts the God <u>24\_JER\_50\_18</u> # Therefore thus saith the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel; Behold, I will punish the king of Babylon and his land, as I have punished the king of Assyria.

hosts the God <u>24\_JER\_51\_33</u> # For thus saith the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel; The daughter of Babylon [is] like a threshingfloor, [it is] time to thresh her: yet a little while, and the time of her harvest shall come.

hosts the God <u>19\_PSA\_59\_05</u># Thou therefore, O LORD God of hosts, the God of Israel, awake to visit all the heathen: be not merciful to any wicked transgressors. Selah.

hosts the God <u>36\_ZEP\_02\_09</u># Therefore [as] I live, saith the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel, Surely Moab shall be as Sodom, and the children of Ammon as Gomorrah, [even] the breeding of nettles, and saltpits, and a perpetual desolation: the residue of my people shall spoil them, and the remnant of my people shall possess them.

hosts the holy <u>38\_ZEC\_08\_03</u> # Thus saith the LORD; I am returned unto Zion, and will dwell in the midst of Jerusalem: and Jerusalem shall be called a city of truth; and the mountain of the LORD of hosts the holy mountain.

hosts the Lord <u>30\_AMO\_05\_16</u> # Therefore the LORD, the God of hosts, the Lord, saith thus; Wailing [shall be] in all streets; and they shall say in all the highways, Alas! alas! and they shall call the husbandman to mourning, and such as are skilful of lamentation to wailing.

hosts the LORD **<u>28\_HOS\_12\_05</u>** # Even the LORD God of hosts; the LORD [is] his memorial.

hosts the mighty <u>23\_ISA\_01\_24</u> # Therefore saith the Lord, the LORD of hosts, the mighty One of Israel, Ah, I will ease me of mine adversaries, and avenge me of mine enemies:

hosts the mount <u>23\_ISA\_18\_07</u> # In that time shall the present be brought unto the LORD of hosts of a people scattered and peeled, and from a people terrible from their beginning hitherto; a nation meted out and trodden under foot, whose land the rivers have spoiled, to the place of the name of the LORD of hosts, the mount Zion.

hosts the whole <u>23\_ISA\_06\_03</u> # And one cried unto another, and said, Holy, holy, holy, [is] the LORD of hosts: the whole earth [is] full of his glory.

hosts their God <u>37\_HAG\_01\_14</u># And the LORD stirred up the spirit of Zerubbabel the son of Shealtiel, governor of Judah, and the spirit of Joshua the son of Josedech, the high priest, and the spirit of all the remnant of the people; and they came and did work in the house of the LORD of hosts, their God,

hosts their God <u>38\_ZEC\_12\_05</u> # And the governors of Judah shall say in their heart, The inhabitants of Jerusalem [shall be] my strength in the LORD of hosts their God.

hosts There shall <u>38\_ZEC\_08\_04</u> # Thus saith the LORD of hosts; There shall yet old men and old women dwell in the streets of Jerusalem, and every man with his staff in his hand for very age.

hosts therefore take <u>39\_MAL\_02\_16</u> # For the LORD, the God of Israel, saith that he hateth putting away: for [one] covereth violence with his garment, saith the LORD of hosts: therefore take heed to your spirit, that ye deal not treacherously.

hosts They shall <u>24\_JER\_06\_09</u> # Thus saith the LORD of hosts, They shall thoroughly glean the remnant of Israel as a vine: turn back thine hand as a grapegatherer into the baskets.

hosts They shall <u>39\_MAL\_01\_04</u> # Whereas Edom saith, We are impoverished, but we will return and build the desolate places; thus saith the LORD of hosts, They shall build, but I will throw down; and they shall call them, The border of wickedness, and, The people against whom the LORD hath indignation for ever.

hosts though their <u>24\_JER\_51\_05</u> # For Israel [hath] not [been] forsaken, nor Judah of his God, of the LORD of hosts; though their land was filled with sin against the Holy One of Israel.

hosts thought to <u>38\_ZEC\_01\_06</u> # But my words and my statutes, which I commanded my servants the prophets, did they not take hold of your fathers? and they returned and said, Like as the LORD of hosts thought to do unto us, according to our ways, and according to our doings, so hath he dealt with us.

hosts Turn ye <u>38\_ZEC\_01\_03</u> # Therefore say thou unto them, Thus saith the LORD of hosts; Turn ye unto me, saith the LORD of hosts, and I will turn unto you, saith the LORD of hosts.

hosts Turn ye <u>38\_ZEC\_01\_04</u> # Be ye not as your fathers, unto whom the former prophets have cried, saying, Thus saith the LORD of hosts; Turn ye now from your evil ways, and [from] your evil doings: but they did not hear, nor hearken unto me, saith the LORD.

hosts unto me <u>38\_ZEC\_07\_04</u> # Then came the word of the LORD of hosts unto me, saying,

hosts unto you <u>39\_MAL\_01\_06</u> # A son honoureth [his] father, and a servant his master: if then I [be] a father, where [is] mine honour? and if I [be] a master, where [is] my fear? saith the LORD of hosts unto you, O priests, that despise my name. And ye say, Wherein have we despised thy name?

hosts was laid <u>38\_ZEC\_08\_09</u># Thus saith the LORD of hosts; Let your hands be strong, ye that hear in these days these words by the mouth of the prophets, which [were] in the day [that] the foundation of the house of the LORD of hosts was laid, that the temple might be built.

hosts was with <u>13\_1CH\_11\_09</u># So David waxed greater and greater: for the LORD of hosts [was] with him.

hosts was with <u>10\_2SA\_05\_10</u># And David went on, and grew great, and the LORD God of hosts [was] with him.

hosts were six <u>04\_NUM\_02\_32</u> # These [are] those which were numbered of the children of Israel by the house of their fathers: all those that were numbered of the camps throughout their hosts [were] six hundred thousand and three thousand and five hundred and fifty.

hosts which dwelleth <u>09\_1SA\_04\_04</u># So the people sent to Shiloh, that they might bring from thence the ark of the covenant of the LORD of hosts, which dwelleth [between] the cherubims: and the two sons of Eli, Hophni and Phinehas, [were] there with the ark of the covenant of God.

hosts which dwelleth <u>23\_ISA\_08\_18</u> # Behold, I and the children whom the LORD hath given me [are] for signs and for wonders in Israel from the LORD of hosts, which dwelleth in mount Zion.

hosts which he <u>11\_1KI\_15\_20</u># So Benhadad hearkened unto king Asa, and sent the captains of the hosts which he had against the cities of Israel, and smote Ijon, and Dan, and Abelbethmaachah, and all Cinneroth, with all the land of Naphtali.

hosts which he <u>23\_ISA\_19\_16</u># In that day shall Egypt be like unto women: and it shall be afraid and fear because of the shaking of the hand of the LORD of hosts, which he shaketh over it.

hosts which he <u>23\_ISA\_19\_17</u># And the land of Judah shall be a terror unto Egypt, every one that maketh mention thereof shall be afraid in himself, because of the counsel of the LORD of hosts, which he hath determined against it.

hosts which is <u>23\_ISA\_28\_29</u># This also cometh forth from the LORD of hosts, [which] is wonderful in counsel, [and] excellent in working.

hosts who is <u>19\_PSA\_89\_08</u># O LORD God of hosts, who [is] a strong LORD like unto thee? or to thy faithfulness round about thee?

hosts will be <u>30\_AMO\_05\_15</u># Hate the evil, and love the good, and establish judgment in the gate: it may be that the LORD God of hosts will be gracious unto the remnant of Joseph.

hosts will I <u>37\_HAG\_02\_23</u> # In that day, saith the LORD of hosts, will I take thee, O Zerubbabel, my servant, the son of Shealtiel, saith the LORD, and will make thee as a signet: for I have chosen thee, saith the LORD of hosts.

hosts will perform <u>23\_ISA\_09\_07</u> # Of the increase of [his] government and peace [there shall be] no end, upon the throne of David, and upon his kingdom, to order it, and to establish it with judgment and with justice from henceforth even for ever. The zeal of the LORD of hosts will perform this.

hosts with them <u>06\_JOS\_11\_04</u># And they went out, they and all their hosts with them, much people, even as the sand that [is] upon the sea shore in multitude, with horses and chariots very many.

hosts with them <u>07\_JUD\_08\_10</u> # Now Zebah and Zalmunna [were] in Karkor, and their hosts with them, about fifteen thousand [men], all that were left of all the hosts of the children of the east: for there fell an hundred and twenty thousand men that drew sword.

hosts with thunder <u>23\_ISA\_29\_06</u># Thou shalt be visited of the LORD of hosts with thunder, and with earthquake, and great noise, with storm and tempest, and the flame of devouring fire.

hosts ye ministers <u>19\_PSA\_103\_21</u># Bless ye the LORD, all [ye] his hosts; [ye] ministers of his, that do his pleasure.

hosts Ye shall <u>24\_JER\_25\_28</u> # And it shall be, if they refuse to take the cup at thine hand to drink, then shalt thou say unto them, Thus saith the LORD of hosts; Ye shall certainly drink.

hosts Yet once <u>37\_HAG\_02\_06</u># For thus saith the LORD of hosts; Yet once, it [is] a little while, and I will shake the heavens, and the earth, and the sea, and the dry [land];

hosts Zion shall 24\_JER\_26\_18 # Micah the Morasthite prophesied in the days of Hezekiah king of Judah, and spake to all the people of Judah, saying, Thus saith the LORD of hosts; Zion shall be plowed [like] a field, and Jerusalem shall become heaps, and the mountain of the house as the high places of a forest.

hosts <u>10\_2SA\_06\_18</u> # And as soon as David had made an end of offering burnt offerings and peace offerings, he blessed the people in the name of the LORD of hosts.

hosts <u>30\_AMO\_03\_13</u># Hear ye, and testify in the house of Jacob, saith the Lord GOD, the God of hosts,

hosts <u>30\_AMO\_05\_27</u># Therefore will I cause you to go into captivity beyond Damascus, saith the LORD, whose name [is] The God of hosts.

hosts <u>37\_HAG\_02\_04</u> # Yet now be strong, O Zerubbabel, saith the LORD; and be strong, O Joshua, son of Josedech, the high priest; and be strong, all ye people of the land, saith the LORD, and work: for I [am] with you, saith the LORD of hosts:

hosts <u>37\_HAG\_02\_07</u> # And I will shake all nations, and the desire of all nations shall come: and I will fill this house with glory, saith the LORD of hosts.

hosts <u>37\_HAG\_02\_08</u># The silver [is] mine, and the gold [is] mine, saith the LORD of hosts.

hosts <u>37\_HAG\_02\_09</u># The glory of this latter house shall be greater than of the former, saith the LORD of hosts: and in this place will I give peace, saith the LORD of hosts.

hosts <u>37\_HAG\_02\_23</u> # In that day, saith the LORD of hosts, will I take thee, O Zerubbabel, my servant, the son of Shealtiel, saith the LORD, and will make thee as a signet: for I have chosen thee, saith the LORD of hosts.

hosts <u>23\_ISA\_03\_15</u> # What mean ye [that] ye beat my people to pieces, and grind the faces of the poor? saith the Lord GOD of hosts.

hosts <u>23\_ISA\_06\_05</u> # Then said I, Woe [is] me! for I am undone; because I [am] a man of unclean lips, and I dwell in the midst of a people of unclean lips: for mine eyes have seen the King, the LORD of hosts.

hosts <u>23\_ISA\_09\_13</u> # For the people turneth not unto him that smitch them, neither do they seek the LORD of hosts.

hosts <u>23\_ISA\_14\_23</u> # I will also make it a possession for the bittern, and pools of water: and I will sweep it with the besom of destruction, saith the LORD of hosts.

hosts <u>23\_ISA\_17\_03</u># The fortress also shall cease from Ephraim, and the kingdom from Damascus, and the remnant of Syria: they shall be as the glory of the children of Israel, saith the LORD of hosts.

hosts <u>23\_ISA\_19\_04</u> # And the Egyptians will I give over into the hand of a cruel lord; and a fierce king shall rule over them, saith the Lord, the LORD of hosts.

hosts <u>23\_ISA\_22\_14</u> # And it was revealed in mine ears by the LORD of hosts, Surely this iniquity shall not be purged from you till ye die, saith the Lord GOD of hosts.

hosts 23\_ISA\_39\_05 # Then said Isaiah to Hezekiah, Hear the word of the LORD of hosts:

hosts <u>23\_ISA\_45\_13</u> # I have raised him up in righteousness, and I will direct all his ways: he shall build my city, and he shall let go my captives, not for price nor reward, saith the LORD of hosts.

hosts <u>24\_JER\_02\_19</u># Thine own wickedness shall correct thee, and thy backslidings shall reprove thee: know therefore and see that [it is] an evil [thing] and bitter, that thou hast forsaken the LORD thy God, and that my fear [is] not in thee, saith the Lord GOD of hosts.

hosts <u>24\_JER\_08\_03</u># And death shall be chosen rather than life by all the residue of them that remain of this evil family, which remain in all the places whither I have driven them, saith the LORD of hosts.

hosts <u>24\_JER\_15\_16</u># Thy words were found, and I did eat them; and thy word was unto me the joy and rejoicing of mine heart: for I am called by thy name, O LORD God of hosts.

hosts <u>24\_JER\_25\_29</u> # For, lo, I begin to bring evil on the city which is called by my name, and should ye be utterly unpunished? Ye shall not be unpunished: for I will call for a sword upon all the inhabitants of the earth, saith the LORD of hosts.

hosts <u>24\_JER\_48\_15</u> # Moab is spoiled, and gone up [out of] her cities, and his chosen young men are gone down to the slaughter, saith the King, whose name [is] the LORD of hosts.

hosts <u>24\_JER\_49\_26</u># Therefore her young men shall fall in her streets, and all the men of war shall be cut off in that day, saith the LORD of hosts.

hosts <u>24\_JER\_51\_57</u> # And I will make drunk her princes, and her wise [men], her captains, and her rulers, and her mighty men: and they shall sleep a perpetual sleep, and not wake, saith the King, whose name [is] the LORD of hosts.

hosts <u>39\_MAL\_01\_08</u># And if ye offer the blind for sacrifice, [is it] not evil? and if ye offer the lame and sick, [is it] not evil? offer it now unto thy governor; will he be pleased with thee, or accept thy person? saith the LORD of hosts.

hosts <u>39\_MAL\_01\_09</u># And now, I pray you, beseech God that he will be gracious unto us: this hath been by your means: will he regard your persons? saith the LORD of hosts.

hosts <u>39\_MAL\_01\_11</u># For from the rising of the sun even unto the going down of the same my name [shall be] great among the Gentiles; and in every place incense [shall be] offered unto my name, and a pure offering: for my name [shall be] great among the heathen, saith the LORD of hosts.

hosts <u>39\_MAL\_02\_04</u> # And ye shall know that I have sent this commandment unto you, that my covenant might be with Levi, saith the LORD of hosts.

hosts <u>39\_MAL\_02\_07</u># For the priest's lips should keep knowledge, and they should seek the law at his mouth: for he [is] the messenger of the LORD of hosts.

hosts <u>39\_MAL\_02\_08</u># But ye are departed out of the way; ye have caused many to stumble at the law; ye have corrupted the covenant of Levi, saith the LORD of hosts.

hosts <u>39\_MAL\_02\_12</u># The LORD will cut off the man that doeth this, the master and the scholar, out of the tabernacles of Jacob, and him that offereth an offering unto the LORD of hosts.

hosts <u>39\_MAL\_03\_01</u># Behold, I will send my messenger, and he shall prepare the way before me: and the Lord, whom ye seek, shall suddenly come to his temple, even the messenger of the covenant, whom ye delight in: behold, he shall come, saith the LORD of hosts.

hosts <u>39\_MAL\_03\_05</u># And I will come near to you to judgment; and I will be a swift witness against the sorcerers, and against the adulterers, and against false swearers, and against those that oppress the hireling in [his] wages, the widow, and the fatherless, and that turn aside the stranger [from his right], and fear not me, saith the LORD of hosts.

hosts <u>39\_MAL\_03\_11</u># And I will rebuke the devourer for your sakes, and he shall not destroy the fruits of your ground; neither shall your vine cast her fruit before the time in the field, saith the LORD of hosts.

hosts <u>39\_MAL\_03\_12</u># And all nations shall call you blessed: for ye shall be a delightsome land, saith the LORD of hosts.

hosts <u>39\_MAL\_03\_14</u> # Ye have said, It [is] vain to serve God: and what profit [is it] that we have kept his ordinance, and that we have walked mournfully before the LORD of hosts?

hosts <u>39\_MAL\_04\_03</u> # And ye shall tread down the wicked; for they shall be ashes under the soles of your feet in the day that I shall do [this], saith the LORD of hosts.

hosts <u>04\_NUM\_01\_52</u># And the children of Israel shall pitch their tents, every man by his own camp, and every man by his own standard, throughout their hosts.

hosts <u>19\_PSA\_108\_11</u># [Wilt] not [thou], O God, [who] hast cast us off? and wilt not thou, O God, go forth with our hosts?

hosts <u>19\_PSA\_148\_02</u> # Praise ye him, all his angels: praise ye him, all his hosts.

hosts <u>19\_PSA\_84\_01</u> # To the chief Musician upon Gittith, A Psalm for the sons of Korah. How amiable [are] thy tabernacles, O LORD of hosts!

hosts <u>38\_ZEC\_01\_03</u> # Therefore say thou unto them, Thus saith the LORD of hosts; Turn ye unto me, saith the LORD of hosts, and I will turn unto you, saith the LORD of hosts.

hosts <u>38\_ZEC\_04\_06</u> # Then he answered and spake unto me, saying, This [is] the word of the LORD unto Zerubbabel, saying, Not by might, nor by power, but by my spirit, saith the LORD of hosts.

hosts <u>38\_ZEC\_07\_12</u> # Yea, they made their hearts [as] an adamant stone, lest they should hear the law, and the words which the LORD of hosts hath sent in his spirit by the former prophets: therefore came a great wrath from the LORD of hosts.

hosts <u>38\_ZEC\_07\_13</u> # Therefore it is come to pass, [that] as he cried, and they would not hear; so they cried, and I would not hear, saith the LORD of hosts:

hosts <u>38\_ZEC\_08\_06</u> # Thus saith the LORD of hosts; If it be marvellous in the eyes of the remnant of this people in these days, should it also be marvellous in mine eyes? saith the LORD of hosts.

hosts <u>38\_ZEC\_08\_11</u> # But now I [will] not [be] unto the residue of this people as in the former days, saith the LORD of hosts.

hosts <u>38\_ZEC\_14\_21</u> # Yea, every pot in Jerusalem and in Judah shall be holiness unto the LORD of hosts: and all they that sacrifice shall come and take of them, and see the therein: and in that day there shall be no more the Canaanite in the house of the LORD of hosts.

hosts <u>36\_ZEP\_02\_10</u> # This shall they have for their pride, because they have reproached and magnified [themselves] against the people of the LORD of hosts.
