Anathoth an hundred 15 EZR 02 23 # The men of Anathoth, an hundred twenty and eight.

Anathoth an hundred 16\_NEH\_07\_27 # The men of Anathoth, an hundred twenty and eight.

Anathoth and Alameth <u>13\_1CH\_07\_08</u># And the sons of Becher; Zemira, and Joash, and Eliezer, and Elioenai, and Omri, and Jerimoth, and Abiah, and Anathoth, and Alameth. All these [are] the sons of Becher.

Anathoth and weighed 24\_JER\_32\_09 # And I bought the field of Hanameel my uncle's son, that [was] in Anathoth, and weighed him the money, [even] seventeen shekels of silver.

Anathoth even the <u>24\_JER\_11\_23</u># And there shall be no remnant of them: for I will bring evil upon the men of Anathoth, [even] the year of their visitation.

Anathoth for the 24\_JER\_32\_07 # Behold, Hanameel the son of Shallum thine uncle shall come unto thee, saying, Buy thee my field that [is] in Anathoth: for the right of redemption [is] thine to buy [it].

Anathoth in the 24\_JER\_01\_01# The words of Jeremiah the son of Hilkiah, of the priests that [were] in Anathoth in the land of Benjamin:

Anathoth Nob Ananiah 16\_NEH\_11\_32 # [And] at Anathoth, Nob, Ananiah,

Anathoth that seek 24\_JER\_11\_21# Therefore thus saith the LORD of the men of Anathoth, that seek thy life, saying, Prophesy not in the name of the LORD, that thou die not by our hand:

Anathoth unto thine 11\_1KI\_02\_26# And unto Abiathar the priest said the king, Get thee to Anathoth, unto thine own fields; for thou [art] worthy of death: but I will not at this time put thee to death, because thou barest the ark of the Lord GOD before David my father, and because thou hast been afflicted in all wherein my father was afflicted.

Anathoth which is 24\_JER\_32\_08 # So Hanameel mine uncle's son came to me in the court of the prison according to the word of the LORD, and said unto me, Buy my field, I pray thee, that [is] in Anathoth, which [is] in the country of Benjamin: for the right of inheritance [is] thine, and the redemption [is] thine; buy [it] for thyself. Then I knew that this [was] the word of the LORD.

Anathoth which maketh <u>24\_JER\_29\_27</u> # Now therefore why hast thou not reproved Jeremiah of Anathoth, which maketh himself a prophet to you?

Anathoth with her <u>13\_1CH\_06\_60</u> # And out of the tribe of Benjamin; Geba with her suburbs, and Alemeth with her suburbs, and Anathoth with her suburbs. All their cities throughout their families [were] thirteen cities.

Anathoth with her 06\_JOS\_21\_18 # Anathoth with her suburbs, and Almon with her suburbs; four cities.

Anathoth <u>23\_ISA\_10\_30</u> # Lift up thy voice, O daughter of Gallim: cause it to be heard unto Laish, O poor Anathoth.

Anethothite Mebunnai the 10\_2SA\_23\_27 # Abiezer the Anethothite, Mebunnai the Hushathite,

bowshot for she <u>01\_GEN\_21\_16</u># And she went, and sat her down over against [him] a good way off, as it were a bowshot: for she said, Let me not see the death of the child. And she sat over against [him], and lift up her voice, and wept.

hot against Israel <u>07\_JUD\_02\_14</u> # And the anger of the LORD was hot against Israel, and he delivered them into the hands of spoilers that spoiled them, and he sold them into the hands of their enemies round about, so that they could not any longer stand before their enemies.

hot against Israel <u>07\_JUD\_02\_20</u> # And the anger of the LORD was hot against Israel; and he said, Because that this people hath transgressed my covenant which I commanded their fathers, and have not hearkened unto my voice;

hot against Israel <u>07\_JUD\_03\_08</u># Therefore the anger of the LORD was hot against Israel, and he sold them into the hand of Chushanrishathaim king of Mesopotamia: and the children of Israel served Chushanrishathaim eight years.

hot against Israel <u>07\_JUD\_10\_07</u># And the anger of the LORD was hot against Israel, and he sold them into the hands of the Philistines, and into the hands of the children of Ammon.

hot against me <u>07\_JUD\_06\_39</u> # And Gideon said unto God, Let not thine anger be hot against me, and I will speak but this once: let me prove, I pray thee, but this once with the fleece; let it now be dry only upon the fleece, and upon all the ground let there be dew.

hot against them <u>02\_EXO\_32\_10</u> # Now therefore let me alone, that my wrath may wax hot against them, and that I may consume them: and I will make of thee a great nation.

hot against thy <u>02\_EXO\_32\_11</u># And Moses besought the LORD his God, and said, LORD, why doth thy wrath wax hot against thy people, which thou hast brought forth out of the land of Egypt with great power, and with a mighty hand?

hot and he <u>02\_EXO\_32\_19</u># And it came to pass, as soon as he came nigh unto the camp, that he saw the calf, and the dancing: and Moses' anger waxed hot, and he cast the tables out of his hands, and brake them beneath the mount.

hot and I <u>02\_EXO\_22\_24</u> # And my wrath shall wax hot, and I will kill you with the sword; and your wives shall be widows, and your children fatherless.

hot and may 26\_EZE\_24\_11# Then set it empty upon the coals thereof, that the brass of it may be hot, and may burn, and [that] the filthiness of it may be molten in it, [that] the scum of it may be consumed.

hot and overtake <u>05\_DEU\_19\_06</u># Lest the avenger of the blood pursue the slayer, while his heart is hot, and overtake him, because the way is long, and slay him; whereas he [was] not worthy of death, inasmuch as he hated him not in time past.

hot and while 16 NEH 07 03 # And I said unto them, Let not the gates of Jerusalem be opened until the sun be hot; and while they stand by, let them shut the doors, and bar [them]: and appoint watches of the inhabitants of Jerusalem, every one in his watch, and every one [to be] over against his house.

hot as an <u>28\_HOS\_07\_07</u># They are all hot as an oven, and have devoured their judges; all their kings are fallen: [there is] none among them that calleth unto me.

hot bread in 09\_1SA\_21\_06 # So the priest gave him hallowed [bread]: for there was no bread there but the

showbread, that was taken from before the LORD, to put hot bread in the day when it was taken away.

hot burning and <u>03\_LEV\_13\_24</u> # Or if there be [any] flesh, in the skin whereof [there is] a hot burning, and the quick [flesh] that burneth have a white bright spot, somewhat reddish, or white;

hot coals and 20\_PRO\_06\_28 # Can one go upon hot coals, and his feet not be burned?

hot displeasure wherewith <u>05\_DEU\_09\_19</u># For I was afraid of the anger and hot displeasure, wherewith the LORD was wroth against you to destroy you. But the LORD hearkened unto me at that time also.

hot displeasure 19\_PSA\_06\_01 # To the chief Musician on Neginoth upon Sheminith, A Psalm of David. O LORD, rebuke me not in thine anger, neither chasten me in thy hot displeasure.

hot displeasure 19 PSA 38 01 # A Psalm of David, to bring to remembrance. O LORD, rebuke me not in thy wrath: neither chasten me in thy hot displeasure.

hot for our <u>06\_JOS\_09\_12</u> # This our bread we took hot [for] our provision out of our houses on the day we came forth to go unto you; but now, behold, it is dry, and it is mouldy:

hot I will <u>66\_REV\_03\_16</u># So then because thou art lukewarm, and neither cold nor hot, I will spue thee out of my mouth.

hot I would <u>66\_REV\_03\_15</u> # I know thy works, that thou art neither cold nor hot: I would thou wert cold or hot.

hot iron 54\_1TI\_04\_02 # Speaking lies in hypocrisy; having their conscience seared with a hot iron;

hot it melted <u>02\_EXO\_16\_21</u> # And they gathered it every morning, every man according to his eating: and when the sun waxed hot, it melted.

hot the flame <u>27\_DAN\_03\_22</u> # Therefore because the king's commandment was urgent, and the furnace exceeding hot, the flame of the fire slew those men that took up Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego.

hot they are <u>18\_JOB\_06\_17</u> # What time they wax warm, they vanish: when it is hot, they are consumed out of their place.

hot thou knowest <u>02\_EXO\_32\_22</u> # And Aaron said, Let not the anger of my lord wax hot: thou knowest the people, that they [are set] on mischief.

hot thunderbolts <u>19\_PSA\_78\_48</u># He gave up their cattle also to the hail, and their flocks to hot thunderbolts.

hot within me <u>19\_PSA\_39\_03</u># My heart was hot within me, while I was musing the fire burned: [then] spake I with my tongue,

hot ye shall <u>09\_1SA\_11\_09</u># And they said unto the messengers that came, Thus shall ye say unto the men of Jabeshgilead, To morrow, by [that time] the sun be hot, ye shall have help. And the messengers came and showed [it] to the men of Jabesh; and they were glad.

hot 66\_REV\_03\_15 # I know thy works, that thou art neither cold nor hot: I would thou wert cold or hot.

Hotham and Shua 13\_1CH\_07\_32 # And Heber begat Japhlet, and Shomer, and Hotham, and Shua their sister.

Hothan the Aroerite 13\_1CH\_11\_44 # Uzzia the Ashterathite, Shama and Jehiel the sons of Hothan the

Aroerite,

Hothir and Mahazioth <u>13\_1CH\_25\_04</u># Of Heman: the sons of Heman; Bukkiah, Mattaniah, Uzziel, Shebuel, and Jerimoth, Hananiah, Hanani, Eliathah, Giddalti, and Romamtiezer, Joshbekashah, Mallothi, Hothir, [and] Mahazioth:

Hothir he his <u>13\_1CH\_25\_28</u># The one and twentieth to Hothir, [he], his sons, and his brethren, [were] twelve:

hotly pursued after <u>01\_GEN\_31\_36</u># And Jacob was wroth, and chided with Laban: and Jacob answered and said to Laban, What [is] my trespass? what [is] my sin, that thou hast so hotly pursued after me?

hottest battle and 10\_28A\_11\_15# And he wrote in the letter, saying, Set ye Uriah in the forefront of the hottest battle, and retire ye from him, that he may be smitten, and die.

Misrephothmaim and all <u>06\_JOS\_13\_06</u># All the inhabitants of the hill country from Lebanon unto Misrephothmaim, [and] all the Sidonians, them will I drive out from before the children of Israel: only divide thou it by lot unto the Israelites for an inheritance, as I have commanded thee.

Misrephothmaim and unto <u>06\_JOS\_11\_08</u># And the LORD delivered them into the hand of Israel, who smote them, and chased them unto great Zidon, and unto Misrephothmaim, and unto the valley of Mizpeh eastward; and they smote them, until they left them none remaining.

shot an arrow <u>09\_1SA\_20\_36</u> # And he said unto his lad, Run, find out now the arrows which I shoot. [And] as the lad ran, he shot an arrow beyond him.

shot And he <u>12\_2KI\_13\_17</u># And he said, Open the window eastward. And he opened [it]. Then Elisha said, Shoot. And he shot. And he said, The arrow of the LORD'S deliverance, and the arrow of deliverance from Syria: for thou shalt smite the Syrians in Aphek, till thou have consumed [them].

shot at a 09\_1SA\_20\_20 # And I will shoot three arrows on the side [thereof], as though I shot at a mark.

shot at him <u>01\_GEN\_49\_23</u> # The archers have sorely grieved him, and shot [at him], and hated him:

shot at king 14\_2CH\_35\_23 # And the archers shot at king Josiah; and the king said to his servants, Have me away; for I am sore wounded.

shot at them <u>04\_NUM\_21\_30</u> # We have shot at them; Heshbon is perished even unto Dibon, and we have laid them waste even unto Nophah, which [reacheth] unto Medeba.

shot forth and <u>01\_GEN\_40\_10</u># And in the vine [were] three branches: and it [was] as though it budded, [and] her blossoms shot forth; and the clusters thereof brought forth ripe grapes:

shot forth her <u>26\_EZE\_17\_07</u># There was also another great eagle with great wings and many feathers: and, behold, this vine did bend her roots toward him, and shot forth her branches toward him, that he might water it by the furrows of her plantation.

shot forth sprigs <u>26\_EZE\_17\_06</u> # And it grew, and became a spreading vine of low stature, whose branches turned toward him, and the roots thereof were under him: so it became a vine, and brought forth branches, and shot forth sprigs.

shot forth **26\_EZE\_31\_05** # Therefore his height was exalted above all the trees of the field, and his boughs were multiplied, and his branches became long because of the multitude of waters, when he shot forth.

shot from off 10\_2SA\_11\_24# And the shooters shot from off the wall upon thy servants; and [some] of the

king's servants be dead, and thy servant Uriah the Hittite is dead also.

shot Jonathan cried <u>09\_1SA\_20\_37</u> # And when the lad was come to the place of the arrow which Jonathan had shot, Jonathan cried after the lad, and said, [Is] not the arrow beyond thee?

shot out it 24\_JER\_09\_08 # Their tongue [is as] an arrow shot out; it speaketh deceit: [one] speaketh peaceably to his neighbour with his mouth, but in heart he layeth his wait.

shot out lightnings 19\_PSA\_18\_14 # Yea, he sent out his arrows, and scattered them; and he shot out lightnings, and discomfitted them.

shot through whether <u>02\_EXO\_19\_13</u># There shall not an hand touch it, but he shall surely be stoned, or shot through; whether [it be] beast or man, it shall not live: when the trumpet soundeth long, they shall come up to the mount.

shot up his <u>26\_EZE\_31\_10</u># Therefore thus saith the Lord GOD; Because thou hast lifted up thyself in height, and he hath shot up his top among the thick boughs, and his heart is lifted up in his height;
