humbled and the [23 ISA 02 11](#) # The lofty looks of man shall be humbled, and the haughtiness of men shall be bowed down, and the LORD alone shall be exalted in that day.

humbled and the [23 ISA 05 15](#) # And the mean man shall be brought down, and the mighty man shall be humbled, and the eyes of the lofty shall be humbled:

humbled and they [03 LEV 26 41](#) # And [that] I also have walked contrary unto them, and have brought them into the land of their enemies; if then their uncircumcised hearts be humbled, and they then accept of the punishment of their iniquity:

humbled behold they [14 2CH 33 19](#) # His prayer also, and [how God] was entreated of him, and all his sins, and his trespass, and the places wherein he built high places, and set up groves and graven images, before he was humbled: behold, they [are] written among the sayings of the seers.

humbled even unto [24 JER 44 10](#) # They are not humbled [even] unto this day, neither have they feared, nor walked in my law, nor in my statutes, that I set before you and before your fathers.

humbled her he [05 DEU 22 29](#) # Then the man that lay with her shall give unto the damsel's father fifty [shekels] of silver, and she shall be his wife; because he hath humbled her, he may not put her away all his days.

humbled her that [26 EZE 22 10](#) # In thee have they discovered their fathers' nakedness: in thee have they humbled her that was set apart for pollution.

humbled her [05 DEU 21 14](#) # And it shall be, if thou have no delight in her, then thou shalt let her go whither she will; but thou shalt not sell her at all for money, thou shalt not make merchandise of her, because thou hast humbled her.

humbled himself and [50 PHP 02 08](#) # And being found in fashion as a man, he humbled himself, and became obedient unto death, even the death of the cross.

humbled himself but [14 2CH 33 23](#) # And humbled not himself before the LORD, as Manasseh his father had humbled himself; but Amon trespassed more and more.

humbled himself for [14 2CH 32 26](#) # Notwithstanding Hezekiah humbled himself for the pride of his heart, [both] he and the inhabitants of Jerusalem, so that the wrath of the LORD came not upon them in the days of Hezekiah.

humbled himself greatly [14 2CH 33 12](#) # And when he was in affliction, he besought the LORD his God, and humbled himself greatly before the God of his fathers,

humbled himself the [14 2CH 12 12](#) # And when he humbled himself, the wrath of the LORD turned from him, that he would not destroy [him] altogether: and also in Judah things went well.

humbled his neighbour's [05 DEU 22 24](#) # Then ye shall bring them both out unto the gate of that city, and ye shall stone them with stones that they die; the damsel, because she cried not, [being] in the city; and the man, because he hath humbled his neighbour's wife: so thou shalt put away evil from among you.

humbled his sister [26 EZE 22 11](#) # And one hath committed abomination with his neighbour's wife; and another hath lewdly defiled his daughter in law; and another in thee hath humbled his sister, his father's daughter.

humbled in me [25 LAM 03 20](#) # My soul hath [them] still in remembrance, and is humbled in me.

humbled my soul [19 PSA 35 13](#) # But as for me, when they were sick, my clothing [was] sackcloth: I humbled my soul with fasting; and my prayer returned into mine own bosom.

humbled not himself [14 2CH 33 23](#) # And humbled not himself before the LORD, as Manasseh his father had humbled himself; but Amon trespassed more and more.

humbled not himself [14 2CH 36 12](#) # And he did [that which was] evil in the sight of the LORD his God, [and] humbled not himself before Jeremiah the prophet [speaking] from the mouth of the LORD.

humbled thee and [05 DEU 08 03](#) # And he humbled thee, and suffered thee to hunger, and fed thee with manna, which thou knewest not, neither did thy fathers know; that he might make thee know that man doth not live by bread only, but by every [word] that proceedeth out of the mouth of the LORD doth man live.

humbled themselves and [14 2CH 12 06](#) # Whereupon the princes of Israel and the king humbled themselves; and they said, The LORD [is] righteous.

humbled themselves and [14 2CH 30 11](#) # Nevertheless divers of Asher and Manasseh and of Zebulun humbled themselves, and came to Jerusalem.

humbled themselves the [14 2CH 12 07](#) # And when the LORD saw that they humbled themselves, the word of the LORD came to Shemaiah, saying, They have humbled themselves; [therefore] I will not destroy them, but I will grant them some deliverance; and my wrath shall not be poured out upon Jerusalem by the hand of Shishak.

humbled themselves therefore [14 2CH 12 07](#) # And when the LORD saw that they humbled themselves, the word of the LORD came to Shemaiah, saying, They have humbled themselves; [therefore] I will not destroy them, but I will grant them some deliverance; and my wrath shall not be poured out upon Jerusalem by the hand of Shishak.

humbled thine heart [27 DAN 05 22](#) # And thou his son, O Belshazzar, hast not humbled thine heart, though thou knewest all this;

humbled thyself before [12 2KI 22 19](#) # Because thine heart was tender, and thou hast humbled thyself before the LORD, when thou heardest what I spake against this place, and against the inhabitants thereof, that they should become a desolation and a curse, and hast rent thy clothes, and wept before me; I also have heard [thee], saith the LORD.

humbled [23 ISA 05 15](#) # And the mean man shall be brought down, and the mighty man shall be humbled, and the eyes of the lofty shall be humbled:

humbled [23 ISA 10 33](#) # Behold, the Lord, the LORD of hosts, shall lop the bough with terror: and the high ones of stature [shall be] hewn down, and the haughty shall be humbled.

humbledst thyself before [14 2CH 34 27](#) # Because thine heart was tender, and thou didst humble thyself before God, when thou heardest his words against this place, and against the inhabitants thereof, and humbledst thyself before me, and didst rend thy clothes, and weep before me; I have even heard [thee] also, saith the LORD.
