Dimnah with her 06\_JOS\_21\_35 # Dimnah with her suburbs, Nahalal with her suburbs; four cities.

Imnah and Isuah <u>13\_1CH\_07\_30</u> # The sons of Asher; Imnah, and Isuah, and Ishuai, and Beriah, and Serah their sister.

Imnah the Levite <u>14\_2CH\_31\_14</u> # And Kore the son of Imnah the Levite, the porter toward the east, [was] over the freewill offerings of God, to distribute the oblations of the LORD, and the most holy things.

Jimnah and Ishuah <u>01\_GEN\_46\_17</u># And the sons of Asher; Jimnah, and Ishuah, and Isui, and Beriah, and Serah their sister: and the sons of Beriah; Heber, and Malchiel.

Timnah duke Aliah <u>13\_1CH\_01\_51</u># Hadad died also. And the dukes of Edom were; duke Timnah, duke Aliah, duke Jetheth,

Timnah duke Alvah <u>01\_GEN\_36\_40</u># And these [are] the names of the dukes [that came] of Esau, according to their families, after their places, by their names; duke Timnah, duke Alvah, duke Jetheth,

Timnah ten cities <u>06\_JOS\_15\_57</u> # Cain, Gibeah, and Timnah; ten cities with their villages:

Timnah with the <a href="#">14\_2CH\_28\_18</a># The Philistines also had invaded the cities of the low country, and of the south of Judah, and had taken Bethshemesh, and Ajalon, and Gederoth, and Shocho with the villages thereof, and Timnah with the villages thereof, Gimzo also and the villages thereof: and they dwelt there.
