imagine a vain 19_PSA_02_01 # Why do the heathen rage, and the people imagine a vain thing?

imagine against me <u>18_JOB_21_27</u> # Behold, I know your thoughts, and the devices [which] ye wrongfully imagine against me.

imagine against the <u>34_NAH_01_09</u> # What do ye imagine against the LORD? he will make an utter end: affliction shall not rise up the second time.

imagine deceits all 19_PSA_38_12 # They also that seek after my life lay snares [for me]: and they that seek my hurt speak mischievous things, and imagine deceits all the day long.

imagine evil against 38_ZEC_07_10 # And oppress not the widow, nor the fatherless, the stranger, nor the poor; and let none of you imagine evil against his brother in your heart.

imagine evil but 20_PRO_12_20 # Deceit [is] in the heart of them that imagine evil: but to the counsellors of peace [is] joy.

imagine evil in <u>38_ZEC_08_17</u># And let none of you imagine evil in your hearts against his neighbour; and love no false oath: for all these [are things] that I hate, saith the LORD.

imagine mischief against <u>28_HOS_07_15</u> # Though I have bound [and] strengthened their arms, yet do they imagine mischief against me.

imagine mischief against 19_PSA_62_03 # How long will ye imagine mischief against a man? ye shall be slain all of you: as a bowing wall [shall ye be, and as] a tottering fence.

imagine mischiefs in 19_PSA_140_02 # Which imagine mischiefs in [their] heart; continually are they gathered together [for] war.

imagine to reprove <u>18_JOB_06_26</u> # Do ye imagine to reprove words, and the speeches of one that is desperate, [which are] as wind?

imagine vain things <u>44_ACT_04_25</u> # Who by the mouth of thy servant David hast said, Why did the heathen rage, and the people imagine vain things?

imagined a mischievous 19_PSA_21_11 # For they intended evil against thee: they imagined a mischievous device, [which] they are not able [to perform].

imagined to do <u>01_GEN_11_06</u># And the LORD said, Behold, the people [is] one, and they have all one language; and this they begin to do: and now nothing will be restrained from them, which they have imagined to do.

imagined 19_PSA_10_02 # The wicked in [his] pride doth persecute the poor: let them be taken in the devices that they have imagined.

imagineth evil against $34_NAH_01_11$ # There is [one] come out of thee, that imagineth evil against the LORD, a wicked counsellor.
