impute any thing <u>09_1SA_22_15</u> # Did I then begin to inquire of God for him? be it far from me: let not the king impute [any] thing unto his servant, [nor] to all the house of my father: for thy servant knew nothing of all this, less or more.

impute iniquity unto <u>10_2SA_19_19</u> # And said unto the king, Let not my lord impute iniquity unto me, neither do thou remember that which thy servant did perversely the day that my lord the king went out of Jerusalem, that the king should take it to his heart.

impute sin <u>45_ROM_04_08</u> # Blessed [is] the man to whom the Lord will not impute sin.

imputed if we <u>45_ROM_04_24</u> # But for us also, to whom it shall be imputed, if we believe on him that raised up Jesus our Lord from the dead;

imputed to him <u>45_ROM_04_22</u> # And therefore it was imputed to him for righteousness.

imputed to him <u>45_ROM_04_23</u> # Now it was not written for his sake alone, that it was imputed to him;

imputed unto him <u>59_JAM_02_23</u> # And the scripture was fulfilled which saith, Abraham believed God, and it was imputed unto him for righteousness: and he was called the Friend of God.

imputed unto him <u>03_LEV_07_18</u># And if [any] of the flesh of the sacrifice of his peace offerings be eaten at all on the third day, it shall not be accepted, neither shall it be imputed unto him that offereth it: it shall be an abomination, and the soul that eateth of it shall bear his iniquity.

imputed unto that <u>03_LEV_17_04</u> # And bringeth it not unto the door of the tabernacle of the congregation, to offer an offering unto the LORD before the tabernacle of the LORD; blood shall be imputed unto that man; he hath shed blood; and that man shall be cut off from among his people:

imputed unto them <u>45_ROM_04_11</u> # And he received the sign of circumcision, a seal of the righteousness of the faith which [he had yet] being uncircumcised: that he might be the father of all them that believe, though they be not circumcised; that righteousness might be imputed unto them also:

imputed when there <u>45_ROM_05_13</u> # [For until the law sin was in the world: but sin is not imputed when there is no law.

imputeth not iniquity <u>19_PSA_32_02</u># Blessed [is] the man unto whom the LORD imputeth not iniquity, and in whose spirit [there is] no guile.

imputeth righteousness without <u>45_ROM_04_06</u> # Even as David also describeth the blessedness of the man, unto whom God imputeth righteousness without works,
