inhabit Dibon come <u>24\_JER\_48\_18</u> # Thou daughter that dost inhabit Dibon, come down from [thy] glory, and sit in thirst; for the spoiler of Moab shall come upon thee, [and] he shall destroy thy strong holds.

inhabit let the <u>23\_ISA\_42\_11</u># Let the wilderness and the cities thereof lift up [their voice], the villages [that] Kedar doth inhabit: let the inhabitants of the rock sing, let them shout from the top of the mountains.

inhabit the earth <u>20\_PRO\_10\_30</u># The righteous shall never be removed: but the wicked shall not inhabit the earth.

inhabit the parched 24\_JER\_17\_06 # For he shall be like the heath in the desert, and shall not see when good cometh; but shall inhabit the parched places in the wilderness, [in] a salt land and not inhabited.

inhabitant of this <u>23\_ISA\_20\_06</u># And the inhabitant of this isle shall say in that day, Behold, such [is] our expectation, whither we flee for help to be delivered from the king of Assyria: and how shall we escape?

inhabitant of Zaanan 33\_MIC\_01\_11# Pass ye away, thou inhabitant of Saphir, having thy shame naked: the inhabitant of Zaanan came not forth in the mourning of Bethezel; he shall receive of you his standing.

inhabitant of Zion <u>23\_ISA\_12\_06</u> # Cry out and shout, thou inhabitant of Zion: for great [is] the Holy One of Israel in the midst of thee.

inhabitant of Zion 24\_JER\_51\_35 # The violence done to me and to my flesh [be] upon Babylon, shall the

inhabitant of Zion say; and my blood upon the inhabitants of Chaldea, shall Jerusalem say.

inhabitant shall not 23\_ISA\_33\_24 # And the inhabitant shall not say, I am sick: the people that dwell therein [shall be] forgiven [their] iniquity.

inhabitant <u>23\_ISA\_05\_09</u># In mine ears [said] the LORD of hosts, Of a truth many houses shall be desolate, [even] great and fair, without inhabitant.

inhabitant <u>24\_JER\_02\_15</u># The young lions roared upon him, [and] yelled, and they made his land waste: his cities are burned without inhabitant.

inhabitant <u>24\_JER\_51\_37</u> # And Babylon shall become heaps, a dwellingplace for dragons, and astonishment, and an hissing, without an inhabitant.

inhabitant <u>36\_ZEP\_02\_05</u> # Woe unto the inhabitants of the sea coast, the nation of the Cherethites! the word of the LORD [is] against you; O Canaan, the land of the Philistines, I will even destroy thee, that there shall be no inhabitant.

inhabitant <u>36\_ZEP\_03\_06</u># I have cut off the nations: their towers are desolate; I made their streets waste, that none passeth by: their cities are destroyed, so that there is no man, that there is none inhabitant.

inhabitants and before <u>08\_RUT\_04\_04</u># And I thought to advertise thee, saying, Buy [it] before the inhabitants, and before the elders of my people. If thou wilt redeem [it], redeem [it]: but if thou wilt not redeem [it, then] tell me, that I may know: for [there is] none to redeem [it] beside thee; and I [am] after thee. And he said, I will redeem [it].

inhabitants in his <u>11\_1KI\_21\_11</u># And the men of his city, [even] the elders and the nobles who were the inhabitants in his city, did as Jezebel had sent unto them, [and] as it [was] written in the letters which she had sent unto them.

inhabitants like a 23\_ISA\_10\_13 # For he saith, By the strength of my hand I have done [it], and by my wisdom; for I am prudent: and I have removed the bounds of the people, and have robbed their treasures, and I have put down the inhabitants like a valiant [man]:

inhabitants of Accho <u>07\_JUD\_01\_31</u> # Neither did Asher drive out the inhabitants of Accho, nor the inhabitants of Zidon, nor of Ahlab, nor of Achzib, nor of Helbah, nor of Aphik, nor of Rehob:

inhabitants of Ai <u>06\_JOS\_08\_24</u> # And it came to pass, when Israel had made an end of slaying all the inhabitants of Ai in the field, in the wilderness wherein they chased them, and when they were all fallen on the edge of the sword, until they were consumed, that all the Israelites returned unto Ai, and smote it with the edge of the sword.

inhabitants of Ai <u>06\_JOS\_08\_26</u> # For Joshua drew not his hand back, wherewith he stretched out the spear, until he had utterly destroyed all the inhabitants of Ai.

inhabitants of Aijalon 13 1CH 08 13 # Beriah also, and Shema, who [were] heads of the fathers of the inhabitants of Aijalon, who drove away the inhabitants of Gath:

inhabitants of Babylon <u>24\_JER\_50\_34</u># Their Redeemer [is] strong; the LORD of hosts [is] his name: he shall thoroughly plead their cause, that he may give rest to the land, and disquiet the inhabitants of Babylon.

inhabitants of Babylon <u>24\_JER\_50\_35</u># A sword [is] upon the Chaldeans, saith the LORD, and upon the inhabitants of Babylon, and upon her princes, and upon her wise [men].

inhabitants of Babylon <u>24\_JER\_51\_12</u># Set up the standard upon the walls of Babylon, make the watch strong, set up the watchmen, prepare the ambushes: for the LORD hath both devised and done that which he spake against the inhabitants of Babylon.

inhabitants of Bethanath <u>07\_JUD\_01\_33</u> # Neither did Naphtali drive out the inhabitants of Bethshemesh, nor the inhabitants of Bethanath; but he dwelt among the Canaanites, the inhabitants of the land: nevertheless the inhabitants of Bethshemesh and of Bethanath became tributaries unto them.

inhabitants of Bethshean <u>07\_JUD\_01\_27</u> # Neither did Manasseh drive out [the inhabitants of] Bethshean and her towns, nor Taanach and her towns, nor the inhabitants of Dor and her towns, nor the inhabitants of Ibleam and her towns, nor the inhabitants of Megiddo and her towns: but the Canaanites would dwell in that land.

inhabitants of Bethshemesh <u>07\_JUD\_01\_33</u># Neither did Naphtali drive out the inhabitants of Bethshemesh, nor the inhabitants of Bethanath; but he dwelt among the Canaanites, the inhabitants of the land: nevertheless the inhabitants of Bethshemesh and of Bethanath became tributaries unto them.

inhabitants of Bethshemesh <u>07\_JUD\_01\_33</u># Neither did Naphtali drive out the inhabitants of Bethshemesh, nor the inhabitants of Bethanath; but he dwelt among the Canaanites, the inhabitants of the land: nevertheless the inhabitants of Bethshemesh and of Bethanath became tributaries unto them.

inhabitants of Canaan <u>02\_EXO\_15\_15</u># Then the dukes of Edom shall be amazed; the mighty men of Moab, trembling shall take hold upon them; all the inhabitants of Canaan shall melt away.

inhabitants of Chaldea 24\_JER\_51\_24 # And I will render unto Babylon and to all the inhabitants of Chaldea all their evil that they have done in Zion in your sight, saith the LORD.

inhabitants of Chaldea 24\_JER\_51\_35 # The violence done to me and to my flesh [be] upon Babylon, shall the inhabitant of Zion say; and my blood upon the inhabitants of Chaldea, shall Jerusalem say.

inhabitants of Debir <u>06\_JOS\_15\_15</u># And he went up thence to the inhabitants of Debir: and the name of Debir before [was] Kirjathsepher.

inhabitants of Debir 07\_JUD\_01\_11# And from thence he went against the inhabitants of Debir: and the

name of Debir before [was] Kirjathsepher:

inhabitants of Dedan 24\_JER\_49\_08 # Flee ye, turn back, dwell deep, O inhabitants of Dedan; for I will bring the calamity of Esau upon him, the time [that] I will visit him.

inhabitants of Dor <u>06\_JOS\_17\_11</u># And Manasseh had in Issachar and in Asher Bethshean and her towns, and Ibleam and her towns, and the inhabitants of Dor and her towns, and the inhabitants of Endor and her towns, and the inhabitants of Taanach and her towns, and the inhabitants of Megiddo and her towns, [even] three countries.

inhabitants of Dor <u>07\_JUD\_01\_27</u># Neither did Manasseh drive out [the inhabitants of] Bethshean and her towns, nor Taanach and her towns, nor the inhabitants of Dor and her towns, nor the inhabitants of Ibleam and her towns, nor the inhabitants of Megiddo and her towns: but the Canaanites would dwell in that land.

inhabitants of Egypt <u>26\_EZE\_29\_06</u># And all the inhabitants of Egypt shall know that I [am] the LORD, because they have been a staff of reed to the house of Israel.

inhabitants of Endor <u>06\_JOS\_17\_11</u># And Manasseh had in Issachar and in Asher Bethshean and her towns, and Ibleam and her towns, and the inhabitants of Dor and her towns, and the inhabitants of Endor and her towns, and the inhabitants of Taanach and her towns, and the inhabitants of Megiddo and her towns, [even] three countries.

inhabitants of Entappuah <u>06\_JOS\_17\_07</u># And the coast of Manasseh was from Asher to Michmethah, that [lieth] before Shechem; and the border went along on the right hand unto the inhabitants of Entappuah.

inhabitants of Gath <u>13\_1CH\_08\_13</u> # Beriah also, and Shema, who [were] heads of the fathers of the inhabitants of Aijalon, who drove away the inhabitants of Gath:

inhabitants of Geba <u>13\_1CH\_08\_06</u> # And these [are] the sons of Ehud: these are the heads of the fathers of the inhabitants of Geba, and they removed them to Manahath:

inhabitants of Gebim <u>23\_ISA\_10\_31</u> # Madmenah is removed; the inhabitants of Gebim gather themselves to flee.

inhabitants of Gibeah <u>07\_JUD\_20\_15</u># And the children of Benjamin were numbered at that time out of the cities twenty and six thousand men that drew sword, beside the inhabitants of Gibeah, which were numbered seven hundred chosen men.

inhabitants of Gibeon <u>06\_JOS\_09\_03</u># And when the inhabitants of Gibeon heard what Joshua had done unto Jericho and to Ai,

inhabitants of Gibeon <u>06\_JOS\_10\_01</u># Now it came to pass, when Adonizedek king of Jerusalem had heard how Joshua had taken Ai, and had utterly destroyed it; as he had done to Jericho and her king, so he had done to Ai and her king; and how the inhabitants of Gibeon had made peace with Israel, and were among them;

inhabitants of Gibeon <u>06\_JOS\_11\_19</u># There was not a city that made peace with the children of Israel, save the Hivites the inhabitants of Gibeon: all [other] they took in battle.

inhabitants of Gilead 11\_1KI\_17\_01 # And Elijah the Tishbite, [who was] of the inhabitants of Gilead, said unto Ahab, [As] the LORD God of Israel liveth, before whom I stand, there shall not be dew nor rain these years, but according to my word.

inhabitants of Gilead 07\_JUD\_10\_18 # And the people [and] princes of Gilead said one to another, What

man [is he] that will begin to fight against the children of Ammon? he shall be head over all the inhabitants of Gilead.

inhabitants of Gilead <u>07\_JUD\_11\_08</u># And the elders of Gilead said unto Jephthah, Therefore we turn again to thee now, that thou mayest go with us, and fight against the children of Ammon, and be our head over all the inhabitants of Gilead.

inhabitants of Hazor <u>24\_JER\_49\_30</u># Flee, get you far off, dwell deep, O ye inhabitants of Hazor, saith the LORD; for Nebuchadrezzar king of Babylon hath taken counsel against you, and hath conceived a purpose against you.

inhabitants of his <u>07\_JUD\_05\_11</u># [They that are delivered] from the noise of archers in the places of drawing water, there shall they rehearse the righteous acts of the LORD, [even] the righteous acts [toward the inhabitants] of his villages in Israel: then shall the people of the LORD go down to the gates.

inhabitants of Ibleam <u>07\_JUD\_01\_27</u># Neither did Manasseh drive out [the inhabitants of] Bethshean and her towns, nor Taanach and her towns, nor the inhabitants of Dor and her towns, nor the inhabitants of Ibleam and her towns, nor the inhabitants of Megiddo and her towns: but the Canaanites would dwell in that land.

inhabitants of Jabeshgilead <u>09\_1SA\_31\_11</u># And when the inhabitants of Jabeshgilead heard of that which the Philistines had done to Saul;

inhabitants of Jabeshgilead <u>07\_JUD\_21\_09</u># For the people were numbered, and, behold, [there were] none of the inhabitants of Jabeshgilead there.

inhabitants of Jabeshgilead <u>07\_JUD\_21\_10</u># And the congregation sent thither twelve thousand men of the valiantest, and commanded them, saying, Go and smite the inhabitants of Jabeshgilead with the edge of the sword, with the women and the children.

inhabitants of Jabeshgilead <u>07\_JUD\_21\_12</u># And they found among the inhabitants of Jabeshgilead four hundred young virgins, that had known no man by lying with any male: and they brought them unto the camp to Shiloh, which [is] in the land of Canaan.

inhabitants of Jebus <u>13\_1CH\_11\_05</u># And the inhabitants of Jebus said to David, Thou shalt not come hither. Nevertheless David took the castle of Zion, which [is] the city of David.

inhabitants of Jerusalem 14\_2CH\_20\_15 # And he said, Hearken ye, all Judah, and ye inhabitants of Jerusalem, and thou king Jehoshaphat, Thus saith the LORD unto you, Be not afraid nor dismayed by reason of this great multitude; for the battle [is] not yours, but God's.

inhabitants of Jerusalem 14\_2CH\_20\_18 # And Jehoshaphat bowed his head with [his] face to the ground: and all Judah and the inhabitants of Jerusalem fell before the LORD, worshipping the LORD.

inhabitants of Jerusalem <u>14\_2CH\_20\_20</u> # And they rose early in the morning, and went forth into the wilderness of Tekoa: and as they went forth, Jehoshaphat stood and said, Hear me, O Judah, and ye inhabitants of Jerusalem; Believe in the LORD your God, so shall ye be established; believe his prophets, so shall ye prosper.

inhabitants of Jerusalem <u>14\_2CH\_21\_11</u> # Moreover he made high places in the mountains of Judah, and caused the inhabitants of Jerusalem to commit fornication, and compelled Judah [thereto].

inhabitants of Jerusalem <u>14\_2CH\_21\_13</u># But hast walked in the way of the kings of Israel, and hast made Judah and the inhabitants of Jerusalem to go a whoring, like to the whoredoms of the house of Ahab, and also hast slain thy brethren of thy father's house, [which were] better than thyself:

inhabitants of Jerusalem <u>14\_2CH\_22\_01</u> # And the inhabitants of Jerusalem made Ahaziah his youngest son king in his stead: for the band of men that came with the Arabians to the camp had slain all the eldest. So Ahaziah the son of Jehoram king of Judah reigned.

inhabitants of Jerusalem <u>14\_2CH\_32\_22</u> # Thus the LORD saved Hezekiah and the inhabitants of Jerusalem from the hand of Sennacherib the king of Assyria, and from the hand of all [other], and guided them on every side.

inhabitants of Jerusalem <u>14\_2CH\_32\_26</u> # Notwithstanding Hezekiah humbled himself for the pride of his heart, [both] he and the inhabitants of Jerusalem, so that the wrath of the LORD came not upon them in the days of Hezekiah.

inhabitants of Jerusalem <u>14\_2CH\_32\_33</u># And Hezekiah slept with his fathers, and they buried him in the chiefest of the sepulchres of the sons of David: and all Judah and the inhabitants of Jerusalem did him honour at his death. And Manasseh his son reigned in his stead.

inhabitants of Jerusalem <u>14\_2CH\_33\_09</u> # So Manasseh made Judah and the inhabitants of Jerusalem to err, [and] to do worse than the heathen, whom the LORD had destroyed before the children of Israel.

inhabitants of Jerusalem 14\_2CH\_34\_30 # And the king went up into the house of the LORD, and all the men of Judah, and the inhabitants of Jerusalem, and the priests, and the Levites, and all the people, great and small: and he read in their ears all the words of the book of the covenant that was found in the house of the LORD.

inhabitants of Jerusalem <u>14\_2CH\_34\_32</u># And he caused all that were present in Jerusalem and Benjamin to stand [to it]. And the inhabitants of Jerusalem did according to the covenant of God, the God of their fathers.

inhabitants of Jerusalem <u>14\_2CH\_35\_18</u># And there was no passover like to that kept in Israel from the days of Samuel the prophet; neither did all the kings of Israel keep such a passover as Josiah kept, and the priests, and the Levites, and all Judah and Israel that were present, and the inhabitants of Jerusalem.

inhabitants of Jerusalem 12 2KI 23 02 # And the king went up into the house of the LORD, and all the men of Judah and all the inhabitants of Jerusalem with him, and the priests, and the prophets, and all the people, both small and great: and he read in their ears all the words of the book of the covenant which was found in the house of the LORD.

inhabitants of Jerusalem <u>27\_DAN\_09\_07</u># O Lord, righteousness [belongeth] unto thee, but unto us confusion of faces, as at this day; to the men of Judah, and to the inhabitants of Jerusalem, and unto all Israel, [that are] near, and [that are] far off, through all the countries whither thou hast driven them, because of their trespass that they have trespassed against thee.

inhabitants of Jerusalem <u>26\_EZE\_11\_15</u># Son of man, thy brethren, [even] thy brethren, the men of thy kindred, and all the house of Israel wholly, [are] they unto whom the inhabitants of Jerusalem have said, Get you far from the LORD: unto us is this land given in possession.

inhabitants of Jerusalem <u>26\_EZE\_12\_19</u># And say unto the people of the land, Thus saith the Lord GOD of the inhabitants of Jerusalem, [and] of the land of Israel; They shall eat their bread with carefulness, and drink their water with astonishment, that her land may be desolate from all that is therein, because of the violence of all them that dwell therein.

inhabitants of Jerusalem <u>26\_EZE\_15\_06</u> # Therefore thus saith the Lord GOD; As the vine tree among the trees of the forest, which I have given to the fire for fuel, so will I give the inhabitants of Jerusalem.

inhabitants of Jerusalem <u>23\_ISA\_05\_03</u> # And now, O inhabitants of Jerusalem, and men of Judah, judge, I pray you, betwixt me and my vineyard.

inhabitants of Jerusalem <u>23\_ISA\_08\_14</u> # And he shall be for a sanctuary; but for a stone of stumbling and for a rock of offence to both the houses of Israel, for a gin and for a snare to the inhabitants of Jerusalem.

inhabitants of Jerusalem <u>23\_ISA\_22\_21</u># And I will clothe him with thy robe, and strengthen him with thy girdle, and I will commit thy government into his hand: and he shall be a father to the inhabitants of Jerusalem, and to the house of Judah.

inhabitants of Jerusalem <u>24\_JER\_08\_01</u> # At that time, saith the LORD, they shall bring out the bones of the kings of Judah, and the bones of his princes, and the bones of the priests, and the bones of the inhabitants of Jerusalem, out of their graves:

inhabitants of Jerusalem <u>24 JER\_36\_31</u># And I will punish him and his seed and his servants for their iniquity; and I will bring upon them, and upon the inhabitants of Jerusalem, and upon the men of Judah, all the evil that I have pronounced against them; but they hearkened not.

inhabitants of Zidon <u>26\_EZE\_27\_08</u># The inhabitants of Zidon and Arvad were thy mariners: thy wise [men], O Tyrus, [that] were in thee, were thy pilots.

inhabitants of Zidon <u>07\_JUD\_01\_31</u> # Neither did Asher drive out the inhabitants of Accho, nor the inhabitants of Zidon, nor of Ahlab, nor of Achzib, nor of Helbah, nor of Aphik, nor of Rehob:

inhabitants that dwelt <u>13\_1CH\_09\_02</u> # Now the first inhabitants that [dwelt] in their possessions in their cities [were], the Israelites, the priests, Levites, and the Nethinims.

inhabitants thereof an <u>33 MIC\_06\_16</u># For the statutes of Omri are kept, and all the works of the house of Ahab, and ye walk in their counsels; that I should make thee a desolation, and the inhabitants thereof an hissing: therefore ye shall bear the reproach of my people.

inhabiteth which are <u>18\_JOB\_15\_28</u> # And he dwelleth in desolate cities, [and] in houses which no man inhabiteth, which are ready to become heaps.

inhabiting the wilderness <u>19\_PSA\_74\_14</u># Thou brakest the heads of leviathan in pieces, [and] gavest him [to be] meat to the people inhabiting the wilderness.
