beginnest to put <u>05\_DEU\_16\_09</u># Seven weeks shalt thou number unto thee: begin to number the seven weeks from [such time as] thou beginnest [to put] the sickle to the corn.

beginning afterward thou 23\_ISA\_01\_26 # And I will restore thy judges as at the first, and thy counsellors as at the beginning: afterward thou shalt be called, The city of righteousness, the faithful city.

beginning and abode <u>43\_JOH\_08\_44</u> # Ye are of [your] father the devil, and the lusts of your father ye will do. He was a murderer from the beginning, and abode not in the truth, because there is no truth in him. When he speaketh a lie, he speaketh of his own: for he is a liar, and the father of it.

beginning and every <u>19\_PSA\_119\_160</u> # Thy word [is] true [from] the beginning: and every one of thy righteous judgments [endureth] for ever.

beginning and expounded <u>44\_ACT\_11\_04</u> # But Peter rehearsed [the matter] from the beginning, and expounded [it] by order unto them, saying,

beginning and from <u>23\_ISA\_46\_10</u># Declaring the end from the beginning, and from ancient times [the things] that are not [yet] done, saying, My counsel shall stand, and I will do all my pleasure:

beginning and the <u>66\_REV\_01\_08</u># I am Alpha and Omega, the beginning and the ending, saith the Lord, which is, and which was, and which is to come, the Almighty.

beginning and the <u>66\_REV\_21\_06</u># And he said unto me, It is done. I am Alpha and Omega, the beginning and the end. I will give unto him that is athirst of the fountain of the water of life freely.

beginning and the <u>66\_REV\_22\_13</u># I am Alpha and Omega, the beginning and the end, the first and the last.

beginning and they <u>23\_ISA\_48\_03</u># I have declared the former things from the beginning; and they went forth out of my mouth, and I showed them; I did [them] suddenly, and they came to pass.

beginning at Jerusalem <u>42\_LUK\_24\_47</u> # And that repentance and remission of sins should be preached in his name among all nations, beginning at Jerusalem.

beginning at Moses <u>42\_LUK\_24\_27</u> # And beginning at Moses and all the prophets, he expounded unto them in all the scriptures the things concerning himself.

beginning at the <u>43\_JOH\_08\_09</u> # And they which heard [it], being convicted by [their own] conscience, went out one by one, beginning at the eldest, [even] unto the last: and Jesus was left alone, and the woman standing in the midst.

beginning because I <u>43\_JOH\_16\_04</u> # But these things have I told you, that when the time shall come, ye may remember that I told you of them. And these things I said not unto you at the beginning, because I was with you.

beginning being caused <u>27\_DAN\_09\_21</u> # Yea, whiles I [was] speaking in prayer, even the man Gabriel, whom I had seen in the vision at the beginning, being caused to fly swiftly, touched me about the time of the evening oblation.

beginning between Bethel <u>01\_GEN\_13\_03</u># And he went on his journeys from the south even to Bethel, unto the place where his tent had been at the beginning, between Bethel and Hai;

beginning but the <u>20\_PRO\_20\_21</u># An inheritance [may be] gotten hastily at the beginning; but the end thereof shall not be blessed.

beginning chosen you <u>53\_2TH\_02\_13</u># But we are bound to give thanks alway to God for you, brethren beloved of the Lord, because God hath from the beginning chosen you to salvation through sanctification of the Spirit and belief of the truth:

beginning declared it 23\_ISA\_48\_05 # I have even from the beginning declared [it] to thee; before it came to pass I showed [it] thee: lest thou shouldest say, Mine idol hath done them, and my graven image, and my molten image, hath commanded them.

beginning doth set <u>43\_JOH\_02\_10</u> # And saith unto him, Every man at the beginning doth set forth good wine; and when men have well drunk, then that which is worse: [but] thou hast kept the good wine until now.

beginning even before <u>23\_ISA\_48\_07</u> # They are created now, and not from the beginning; even before the day when thou heardest them not; lest thou shouldest say, Behold, I knew them.

beginning for he <u>18\_JOB\_42\_12</u># So the LORD blessed the latter end of Job more than his beginning: for he had fourteen thousand sheep, and six thousand camels, and a thousand yoke of oxen, and a thousand she asses.

beginning For this <u>62\_1JO\_03\_08</u># He that committeth sin is of the devil; for the devil sinneth from the beginning. For this purpose the Son of God was manifested, that he might destroy the works of the devil.

beginning from Galilee <u>42\_LUK\_23\_05</u> # And they were the more fierce, saying, He stirreth up the people, teaching throughout all Jewry, beginning from Galilee to this place.

Beginning from the <u>44\_ACT\_01\_22</u> # Beginning from the baptism of John, unto that same day that he was taken up from us, must one be ordained to be a witness with us of his resurrection.

beginning have ye <u>23\_ISA\_40\_21</u> # Have ye not known? have ye not heard? hath it not been told you from the beginning? have ye not understood from the foundations of the earth?

beginning hitherto a 23\_ISA\_18\_02 # That sendeth ambassadors by the sea, even in vessels of bulrushes upon the waters, [saying], Go, ye swift messengers, to a nation scattered and peeled, to a people terrible from their beginning hitherto; a nation meted out and trodden down, whose land the rivers have spoiled!

beginning hitherto a <u>23\_ISA\_18\_07</u> # In that time shall the present be brought unto the LORD of hosts of a people scattered and peeled, and from a people terrible from their beginning hitherto; a nation meted out

and trodden under foot, whose land the rivers have spoiled, to the place of the name of the LORD of hosts, the mount Zion.

beginning I have <u>62\_1JO\_02\_14</u># I have written unto you, fathers, because ye have known him [that is] from the beginning. I have written unto you, young men, because ye are strong, and the word of God abideth in you, and ye have overcome the wicked one.

beginning I the <u>23\_ISA\_41\_04</u> # Who hath wrought and done [it], calling the generations from the beginning? I the LORD, the first, and with the last; I [am] he.

beginning I write <u>62\_1JO\_02\_13</u> # I write unto you, fathers, because ye have known him [that is] from the beginning. I write unto you, young men, because ye have overcome the wicked one. I write unto you, little children, because ye have known the Father.

beginning If that <u>62\_1JO\_02\_24</u># Let that therefore abide in you, which ye have heard from the beginning. If that which ye have heard from the beginning shall remain in you, ye also shall continue in the Son, and in the Father.

beginning if they <u>44\_ACT\_26\_05</u># Which knew me from the beginning, if they would testify, that after the most straitest sect of our religion I lived a Pharisee.

beginning inasmuch as <u>08\_RUT\_03\_10</u> # And he said, Blessed [be] thou of the LORD, my daughter: [for] thou hast showed more kindness in the latter end than at the beginning, inasmuch as thou followedst not young men, whether poor or rich.

beginning is the <u>24\_JER\_17\_12</u> # A glorious high throne from the beginning [is] the place of our sanctuary.

beginning it was <u>40\_MAT\_19\_08</u># He saith unto them, Moses because of the hardness of your hearts suffered you to put away your wives: but from the beginning it was not so.

beginning made them <u>40\_MAT\_19\_04</u># And he answered and said unto them, Have ye not read, that he which made [them] at the beginning made them male and female,

beginning of barley <u>10\_2SA\_21\_09</u> # And he delivered them into the hands of the Gibeonites, and they hanged them in the hill before the LORD: and they fell [all] seven together, and were put to death in the days of harvest, in the first [days], in the beginning of barley harvest.

beginning of barley <u>08\_RUT\_01\_22</u> # So Naomi returned, and Ruth the Moabitess, her daughter in law, with her, which returned out of the country of Moab: and they came to Bethlehem in the beginning of barley harvest.

beginning of days <u>58\_HEB\_07\_03</u> # Without father, without mother, without descent, having neither beginning of days, nor end of life; but made like unto the Son of God; abideth a priest continually.

beginning of harvest <u>10\_2SA\_21\_10</u><sup>#</sup> And Rizpah the daughter of Aiah took sackcloth, and spread it for her upon the rock, from the beginning of harvest until water dropped upon them out of heaven, and suffered neither the birds of the air to rest on them by day, nor the beasts of the field by night.

beginning of his <u>05\_DEU\_21\_17</u># But he shall acknowledge the son of the hated [for] the firstborn, by giving him a double portion of all that he hath: for he [is] the beginning of his strength; the right of the firstborn [is] his.

beginning of his <u>15\_EZR\_04\_06</u># And in the reign of Ahasuerus, in the beginning of his reign, wrote they [unto him] an accusation against the inhabitants of Judah and Jerusalem.

beginning of his <u>01\_GEN\_10\_10</u># And the beginning of his kingdom was Babel, and Erech, and Accad, and Calneh, in the land of Shinar.

beginning of his <u>20\_PRO\_08\_22</u># The LORD possessed me in the beginning of his way, before his works of old.

beginning of knowledge <u>20\_PRO\_01\_07</u># The fear of the LORD [is] the beginning of knowledge: [but] fools despise wisdom and instruction.

beginning of miracles <u>43\_JOH\_02\_11</u># This beginning of miracles did Jesus in Cana of Galilee, and manifested forth his glory; and his disciples believed on him.

beginning of months <u>02\_EXO\_12\_02</u># This month [shall be] unto you the beginning of months: it [shall be] the first month of the year to you.

beginning of my <u>01\_GEN\_49\_03</u> # Reuben, thou [art] my firstborn, my might, and the beginning of my strength, the excellency of dignity, and the excellency of power:

beginning of our <u>58\_HEB\_03\_14</u> # For we are made partakers of Christ, if we hold the beginning of our confidence stedfast unto the end;

beginning of revengers <u>05\_DEU\_32\_42</u> # I will make mine arrows drunk with blood, and my sword shall devour flesh; [and that] with the blood of the slain and of the captives, from the beginning of revengers upon the enemy.

beginning of sorrows <u>40\_MAT\_24\_08</u># All these [are] the beginning of sorrows.

beginning of strife <u>20\_PRO\_17\_14</u># The beginning of strife [is as] when one letteth out water: therefore leave off contention, before it be meddled with.

beginning of the <u>61\_2PE\_03\_04</u> # And saying, Where is the promise of his coming? for since the fathers fell asleep, all things continue as [they were] from the beginning of the creation.

beginning of the <u>44\_ACT\_15\_18</u># Known unto God are all his works from the beginning of the world.

beginning of the <u>30\_AMO\_07\_01</u> # Thus hath the Lord GOD showed unto me; and, behold, he formed grasshoppers in the beginning of the shooting up of the latter growth; and, lo, [it was] the latter growth after the king's mowings.

beginning of the <u>05\_DEU\_11\_12</u># A land which the LORD thy God careth for: the eyes of the LORD thy God [are] always upon it, from the beginning of the year even unto the end of the year.

beginning So I <u>01\_GEN\_41\_21</u> # And when they had eaten them up, it could not be known that they had eaten them; but they [were] still ill favoured, as at the beginning. So I awoke.

beginning were eyewitnesses <u>42\_LUK\_01\_02</u> # Even as they delivered them unto us, which from the beginning were eyewitnesses, and ministers of the word;

beginning which we <u>62\_1JO\_01\_01</u># That which was from the beginning, which we have heard, which we have seen with our eyes, which we have looked upon, and our hands have handled, of the Word of life;

beginning who they <u>43\_JOH\_06\_64</u> # But there are some of you that believe not. For Jesus knew from the

beginning who they were that believed not, and who should betray him.

beginning with God <u>43\_JOH\_01\_02</u> # The same was in the beginning with God.

beginning ye should <u>63\_2JO\_01\_06</u># And this is love, that we walk after his commandments. This is the commandment, That, as ye have heard from the beginning, ye should walk in it.

beginning <u>13\_1CH\_17\_09</u># Also I will ordain a place for my people Israel, and will plant them, and they shall dwell in their place, and shall be moved no more; neither shall the children of wickedness waste them any more, as at the beginning,

beginning <u>62\_1JO\_02\_07</u> # Brethren, I write no new commandment unto you, but an old commandment which ye had from the beginning. The old commandment is the word which ye have heard from the beginning.

beginning <u>61\_2PE\_02\_20</u> # For if after they have escaped the pollutions of the world through the knowledge of the Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ, they are again entangled therein, and overcome, the latter end is worse with them than the beginning.

beginning <u>44\_ACT\_11\_15</u># And as I began to speak, the Holy Ghost fell on them, as on us at the beginning.

beginnings of sorrows <u>41\_MAR\_13\_08</u># For nation shall rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom: and there shall be earthquakes in divers places, and there shall be famines and troubles: these [are] the beginnings of sorrows.

beginnings of your <u>04\_NUM\_10\_10</u> # Also in the day of your gladness, and in your solemn days, and in the beginnings of your months, ye shall blow with the trumpets over your burnt offerings, and over the sacrifices of your peace offerings; that they may be to you for a memorial before your God: I [am] the LORD your God.

beginnings of your <u>04\_NUM\_28\_11</u># And in the beginnings of your months ye shall offer a burnt offering unto the LORD; two young bullocks, and one ram, seven lambs of the first year without spot;

Binnui and Manasseh <u>15\_EZR\_10\_30</u> # And of the sons of Pahathmoab; Adna, and Chelal, Benaiah, Maaseiah, Mattaniah, Bezaleel, and Binnui, and Manasseh.

Binnui Kadmiel Sherebiah <u>16\_NEH\_12\_08</u># Moreover the Levites: Jeshua, Binnui, Kadmiel, Sherebiah, Judah, [and] Mattaniah, [which was] over the thanksgiving, he and his brethren.

Binnui Levites <u>15\_EZR\_08\_33</u> # Now on the fourth day was the silver and the gold and the vessels weighed in the house of our God by the hand of Meremoth the son of Uriah the priest; and with him [was] Eleazar the son of Phinehas; and with them [was] Jozabad the son of Jeshua, and Noadiah the son of Binnui, Levites;

Binnui of the <u>16\_NEH\_10\_09</u># And the Levites: both Jeshua the son of Azaniah, Binnui of the sons of

# Henadad, Kadmiel;

Binnui Shimei 15\_EZR\_10\_38 # And Bani, and Binnui, Shimei,

Binnui six hundred <u>16\_NEH\_07\_15</u># The children of Binnui, six hundred forty and eight.

Binnui the son <u>16\_NEH\_03\_24</u> # After him repaired Binnui the son of Henadad another piece, from the house of Azariah unto the turning [of the wall], even unto the corner.

Chinnereth eastward <u>04\_NUM\_34\_11</u># And the coast shall go down from Shepham to Riblah, on the east side of Ain; and the border shall descend, and shall reach unto the side of the sea of Chinnereth eastward:

Chinnereth even unto <u>05\_DEU\_03\_17</u># The plain also, and Jordan, and the coast [thereof], from Chinnereth even unto the sea of the plain, [even] the salt sea, under Ashdothpisgah eastward.

Chinnereth on the <u>06\_JOS\_13\_27</u> # And in the valley, Betharam, and Bethnimrah, and Succoth, and Zaphon, the rest of the kingdom of Sihon king of Heshbon, Jordan and [his] border, [even] unto the edge of the sea of Chinnereth on the other side Jordan eastward.

Chinnereth <u>06\_JOS\_19\_35</u># And the fenced cities [are] Ziddim, Zer, and Hammath, Rakkath, and Chinnereth,

Chinneroth and in <u>06\_JOS\_11\_02</u># And to the kings that [were] on the north of the mountains, and of the plains south of Chinneroth, and in the valley, and in the borders of Dor on the west,

Chinneroth on the <u>06\_JOS\_12\_03</u> # And from the plain to the sea of Chinneroth on the east, and unto the sea of the plain, [even] the salt sea on the east, the way to Bethjeshimoth; and from the south, under Ashdothpisgah:

cinnamon and odours <u>66\_REV\_18\_13</u># And cinnamon, and odours, and ointments, and frankincense, and wine, and oil, and fine flour, and wheat, and beasts, and sheep, and horses, and chariots, and slaves, and souls of men.

cinnamon half so <u>02\_EXO\_30\_23</u># Take thou also unto thee principal spices, of pure myrrh five hundred [shekels], and of sweet cinnamon half so much, [even] two hundred and fifty [shekels], and of sweet calamus two hundred and fifty [shekels],

cinnamon with all <u>22\_SON\_04\_14</u># Spikenard and saffron; calamus and cinnamon, with all trees of frankincense; myrrh and aloes, with all the chief spices:

cinnamon <u>20\_PRO\_07\_17</u># I have perfumed my bed with myrrh, aloes, and cinnamon.

Cinneroth with all <u>11\_1KI\_15\_20</u># So Benhadad hearkened unto king Asa, and sent the captains of the hosts which he had against the cities of Israel, and smote Ijon, and Dan, and Abelbethmaachah, and all Cinneroth, with all the land of Naphtali.

dinner my oxen <u>40\_MAT\_22\_04</u># Again, he sent forth other servants, saying, Tell them which are bidden, Behold, I have prepared my dinner: my oxen and [my] fatlings [are] killed, and all things [are] ready: come unto the marriage.

dinner of herbs <u>20\_PRO\_15\_17</u># Better [is] a dinner of herbs where love is, than a stalled ox and hatred therewith.

dinner or a <u>42\_LUK\_14\_12</u> # Then said he also to him that bade him, When thou makest a dinner or a supper, call not thy friends, nor thy brethren, neither thy kinsmen, nor [thy] rich neighbours; lest they also

bid thee again, and a recompense be made thee.

sinned against him <u>27\_DAN\_09\_11</u># Yea, all Israel have transgressed thy law, even by departing, that they might not obey thy voice; therefore the curse is poured upon us, and the oath that [is] written in the law of Moses the servant of God, because we have sinned against him.

sinned against him <u>18\_JOB\_08\_04</u># If thy children have sinned against him, and he have cast them away for their transgression;

sinned against him <u>33\_MIC\_07\_09</u> # I will bear the indignation of the LORD, because I have sinned against him, until he plead my cause, and execute judgment for me: he will bring me forth to the light, [and] I shall behold his righteousness.

sinned against it <u>03\_LEV\_04\_14</u># When the sin, which they have sinned against it, is known, then the congregation shall offer a young bullock for the sin, and bring him before the tabernacle of the congregation.

sinned against me <u>02\_EXO\_32\_33</u># And the LORD said unto Moses, Whosoever hath sinned against me, him will I blot out of my book.

sinned against me <u>28\_HOS\_04\_07</u> # As they were increased, so they sinned against me: [therefore] will I change their glory into shame.

sinned against me 24\_JER\_33\_08 # And I will cleanse them from all their iniquity, whereby they have sinned against me; and I will pardon all their iniquities, whereby they have sinned, and whereby they have transgressed against me.

sinned against the <u>09\_1SA\_07\_06</u># And they gathered together to Mizpeh, and drew water, and poured [it] out before the LORD, and fasted on that day, and said there, We have sinned against the LORD. And Samuel judged the children of Israel in Mizpeh.

sinned against the <u>12\_2KI\_17\_07</u># For [so] it was, that the children of Israel had sinned against the LORD their God, which had brought them up out of the land of Egypt, from under the hand of Pharaoh king of Egypt, and had feared other gods,

sinned against the <u>10\_2SA\_12\_13</u> # And David said unto Nathan, I have sinned against the LORD. And Nathan said unto David, The LORD also hath put away thy sin; thou shalt not die.

sinned against the <u>05\_DEU\_01\_41</u># Then ye answered and said unto me, We have sinned against the LORD, we will go up and fight, according to all that the LORD our God commanded us. And when ye had girded on every man his weapons of war, ye were ready to go up into the hill.

sinned against the <u>05\_DEU\_09\_16</u># And I looked, and, behold, ye had sinned against the LORD your God, [and] had made you a molten calf: ye had turned aside quickly out of the way which the LORD had commanded you.

sinned against the 24\_JER\_08\_14 # Why do we sit still? assemble yourselves, and let us enter into the defenced cities, and let us be silent there: for the LORD our God hath put us to silence, and given us water of gall to drink, because we have sinned against the LORD.

sinned against the <u>24\_JER\_40\_03</u> # Now the LORD hath brought [it], and done according as he hath said: because ye have sinned against the LORD, and have not obeyed his voice, therefore this thing is come upon you.

sinned against the 24\_JER\_44\_23 # Because ye have burned incense, and because ye have sinned against the LORD, and have not obeyed the voice of the LORD, nor walked in his law, nor in his statutes, nor in his testimonies; therefore this evil is happened unto you, as at this day.

sinned against the <u>24\_JER\_50\_07</u> # All that found them have devoured them: and their adversaries said, We offend not, because they have sinned against the LORD, the habitation of justice, even the LORD, the hope of their fathers.

sinned against the <u>24\_JER\_50\_14</u> # Put yourselves in array against Babylon round about: all ye that bend the bow, shoot at her, spare no arrows: for she hath sinned against the LORD.

sinned against the <u>06\_JOS\_07\_20</u> # And Achan answered Joshua, and said, Indeed I have sinned against the LORD God of Israel, and thus and thus have I done:

sinned against the <u>04\_NUM\_32\_23</u> # But if ye will not do so, behold, ye have sinned against the LORD: and be sure your sin will find you out.

sinned against the <u>36\_ZEP\_01\_17</u># And I will bring distress upon men, that they shall walk like blind men, because they have sinned against the LORD: and their blood shall be poured out as dust, and their flesh as the dung.

sinned against thee <u>11\_1KI\_08\_33</u># When thy people Israel be smitten down before the enemy, because they have sinned against thee, and shall turn again to thee, and confess thy name, and pray, and make supplication unto thee in this house:

sinned against thee <u>11\_1KI\_08\_35</u># When heaven is shut up, and there is no rain, because they have sinned against thee; if they pray toward this place, and confess thy name, and turn from their sin, when thou afflictest them:

sinned against thee <u>11\_1KI\_08\_50</u># And forgive thy people that have sinned against thee, and all their transgressions wherein they have transgressed against thee, and give them compassion before them who carried them captive, that they may have compassion on them:

sinned against thee <u>09\_1SA\_19\_04</u> # And Jonathan spake good of David unto Saul his father, and said unto him, Let not the king sin against his servant, against David; because he hath not sinned against thee, and because his works [have been] to thee ward very good:

sinned against thee <u>09\_1SA\_24\_11</u># Moreover, my father, see, yea, see the skirt of thy robe in my hand: for in that I cut off the skirt of thy robe, and killed thee not, know thou and see that [there is] neither evil nor transgression in mine hand, and I have not sinned against thee; yet thou huntest my soul to take it.

sinned against thee <u>14\_2CH\_06\_24</u># And if thy people Israel be put to the worse before the enemy, because they have sinned against thee; and shall return and confess thy name, and pray and make supplication before thee in this house;

sinned against thee <u>14\_2CH\_06\_26</u># When the heaven is shut up, and there is no rain, because they have sinned against thee; [yet] if they pray toward this place, and confess thy name, and turn from their sin, when thou dost afflict them;

sinned against thee <u>14\_2CH\_06\_39</u># Then hear thou from the heavens, [even] from thy dwelling place, their prayer and their supplications, and maintain their cause, and forgive thy people which have sinned against thee.

sinned against thee <u>27\_DAN\_09\_08</u> # O Lord, to us [belongeth] confusion of face, to our kings, to our princes, and to our fathers, because we have sinned against thee.

sinned against thee <u>24\_JER\_14\_07</u> # O LORD, though our iniquities testify against us, do thou [it] for thy name's sake: for our backslidings are many; we have sinned against thee.

sinned against thee <u>24\_JER\_14\_20</u># We acknowledge, O LORD, our wickedness, [and] the iniquity of our fathers: for we have sinned against thee.

sinned against thee <u>07\_JUD\_10\_10</u># And the children of Israel cried unto the LORD, saying, We have sinned against thee, both because we have forsaken our God, and also served Baalim.

sinned against thee <u>07\_JUD\_11\_27</u># Wherefore I have not sinned against thee, but thou doest me wrong to war against me: the LORD the Judge be judge this day between the children of Israel and the children of Ammon.

sinned against thee <u>16\_NEH\_01\_06</u># Let thine ear now be attentive, and thine eyes open, that thou mayest hear the prayer of thy servant, which I pray before thee now, day and night, for the children of Israel thy servants, and confess the sins of the children of Israel, which we have sinned against thee: both I and my father's house have sinned.

sinned against thee <u>19\_PSA\_41\_04</u># I said, LORD, be merciful unto me: heal my soul; for I have sinned against thee.

sinned against thy <u>35\_HAB\_02\_10</u># Thou hast consulted shame to thy house by cutting off many people, and hast sinned [against] thy soul.

sinned against thy <u>16\_NEH\_09\_29</u> # And testifiedst against them, that thou mightest bring them again unto thy law: yet they dealt proudly, and hearkened not unto thy commandments, but sinned against thy judgments, [which if a man do, he shall live in them;] and withdrew the shoulder, and hardened their neck, and would not hear.

sinned already and <u>47\_2CO\_12\_21</u># [And] lest, when I come again, my God will humble me among you, and [that] I shall bewail many which have sinned already, and have not repented of the uncleanness and fornication and lasciviousness which they have committed.

sinned and are <u>25\_LAM\_05\_07</u># Our fathers have sinned, [and are] not; and we have borne their iniquities.

sinned and by <u>11\_1KI\_16\_13</u># For all the sins of Baasha, and the sins of Elah his son, by which they sinned, and by which they made Israel to sin, in provoking the LORD God of Israel to anger with their vanities.

sinned and come <u>45\_ROM\_03\_23</u> # For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God;

sinned and cursed <u>18\_JOB\_01\_05</u> # And it was so, when the days of [their] feasting were gone about, that Job sent and sanctified them, and rose up early in the morning, and offered burnt offerings [according] to the number of them all: for Job said, It may be that my sons have sinned, and cursed God in their hearts. Thus did Job continually.

sinned and done <u>13\_1CH\_21\_17</u># And David said unto God, [Is it] not I [that] commanded the people to be numbered? even I it is that have sinned and done evil indeed; but [as for] these sheep, what have they done? let thine hand, I pray thee, O LORD my God, be on me, and on my father's house; but not on thy people, that they should be plagued.

sinned and done <u>03\_LEV\_04\_22</u> # When a ruler hath sinned, and done [somewhat] through ignorance [against] any of the commandments of the LORD his God [concerning things] which should not be done, and is guilty;

sinned and done <u>19\_PSA\_51\_04</u># Against thee, thee only, have I sinned, and done [this] evil in thy sight: that thou mightest be justified when thou speakest, [and] be clear when thou judgest.

sinned and have <u>11\_1KI\_08\_47</u> # [Yet] if they shall bethink themselves in the land whither they were carried captives, and repent, and make supplication unto thee in the land of them that carried them captives, saying, We have sinned, and have done perversely, we have committed wickedness;

sinned and have <u>27\_DAN\_09\_05</u># We have sinned, and have committed iniquity, and have done wickedly, and have rebelled, even by departing from thy precepts and from thy judgments:

sinned and I <u>10\_2SA\_24\_17</u> # And David spake unto the LORD when he saw the angel that smote the people, and said, Lo, I have sinned, and I have done wickedly: but these sheep, what have they done? let thine hand, I pray thee, be against me, and against my father's house.

sinned and if <u>46\_1CO\_07\_28</u> # But and if thou marry, thou hast not sinned; and if a virgin marry, she hath not sinned. Nevertheless such shall have trouble in the flesh: but I spare you.

sinned and is <u>03\_LEV\_06\_04</u># Then it shall be, because he hath sinned, and is guilty, that he shall restore that which he took violently away, or the thing which he hath deceitfully gotten, or that which was delivered him to keep, or the lost thing which he found,

sinned and it <u>03\_LEV\_05\_10</u># And he shall offer the second [for] a burnt offering, according to the manner: and the priest shall make an atonement for him for his sin which he hath sinned, and it shall be forgiven him.

sinned and perverted <u>18\_JOB\_33\_27</u># He looketh upon men, and [if any] say, I have sinned, and perverted [that which was] right, and it profited me not;

sinned and they <u>06\_JOS\_07\_11</u># Israel hath sinned, and they have also transgressed my covenant which I commanded them: for they have even taken of the accursed thing, and have also stolen, and dissembled also, and they have put [it] even among their own stuff.

sinned and thy <u>23\_ISA\_43\_27</u># Thy first father hath sinned, and thy teachers have transgressed against me.

sinned and to <u>47\_2CO\_13\_02</u> # I told you before, and foretell you, as if I were present, the second time; and being absent now I write to them which heretofore have sinned, and to all other, that, if I come again, I will not spare:

sinned and whereby 24\_JER\_33\_08 # And I will cleanse them from all their iniquity, whereby they have sinned against me; and I will pardon all their iniquities, whereby they have sinned, and whereby they have transgressed against me.

sinned and which <u>11\_1KI\_15\_30</u># Because of the sins of Jeroboam which he sinned, and which he made Israel sin, by his provocation wherewith he provoked the LORD God of Israel to anger.

sinned and will <u>26\_EZE\_37\_23</u># Neither shall they defile themselves any more with their idols, nor with their detestable things, nor with any of their transgressions: but I will save them out of all their dwellingplaces, wherein they have sinned, and will cleanse them: so shall they be my people, and I will be their God.

sinned but cast <u>61\_2PE\_02\_04</u> # For if God spared not the angels that sinned, but cast [them] down to hell, and delivered [them] into chains of darkness, to be reserved unto judgment;

sinned by the <u>04\_NUM\_06\_11</u># And the priest shall offer the one for a sin offering, and the other for a burnt offering, and make an atonement for him, for that he sinned by the dead, and shall hallow his head that same day.

sinned come to <u>03\_LEV\_04\_23</u># Or if his sin, wherein he hath sinned, come to his knowledge; he shall bring his offering, a kid of the goats, a male without blemish:

sinned come to <u>03\_LEV\_04\_28</u> # Or if his sin, which he hath sinned, come to his knowledge: then he shall bring his offering, a kid of the goats, a female without blemish, for his sin which he hath sinned.

sinned do thou <u>07\_JUD\_10\_15</u> # And the children of Israel said unto the LORD, We have sinned: do thou unto us whatsoever seemeth good unto thee; deliver us only, we pray thee, this day.

sinned for I <u>09\_1SA\_15\_24</u> # And Saul said unto Samuel, I have sinned: for I have transgressed the commandment of the LORD, and thy words: because I feared the people, and obeyed their voice.

sinned for I <u>04\_NUM\_22\_34</u> # And Balaam said unto the angel of the LORD, I have sinned; for I knew not that thou stoodest in the way against me: now therefore, if it displease thee, I will get me back again.

sinned for they <u>23 ISA 42 24</u> # Who gave Jacob for a spoil, and Israel to the robbers? did not the LORD, he against whom we have sinned? for they would not walk in his ways, neither were they obedient unto his law.

sinned for we <u>04\_NUM\_21\_07</u># Therefore the people came to Moses, and said, We have sinned, for we have spoken against the LORD, and against thee; pray unto the LORD, that he take away the serpents from us. And Moses prayed for the people.

sinned from the <u>28\_HOS\_10\_09</u># O Israel, thou hast sinned from the days of Gibeah: there they stood: the battle in Gibeah against the children of iniquity did not overtake them.

sinned greatly because <u>13\_1CH\_21\_08</u> # And David said unto God, I have sinned greatly, because I have done this thing: but now, I beseech thee, do away the iniquity of thy servant; for I have done very foolishly.

sinned greatly in <u>10\_2SA\_24\_10</u># And David's heart smote him after that he had numbered the people. And David said unto the LORD, I have sinned greatly in that I have done: and now, I beseech thee, O LORD, take away the iniquity of thy servant; for I have done very foolishly.

sinned in doing <u>11\_1KI\_16\_19</u># For his sins which he sinned in doing evil in the sight of the LORD, in walking in the way of Jeroboam, and in his sin which he did, to make Israel to sin.

sinned in doing <u>05\_DEU\_09\_18</u> # And I fell down before the LORD, as at the first, forty days and forty nights: I did neither eat bread, nor drink water, because of all your sins which ye sinned, in doing wickedly in the sight of the LORD, to provoke him to anger.

sinned in one <u>03\_LEV\_05\_13</u> # And the priest shall make an atonement for him as touching his sin that he hath sinned in one of these, and it shall be forgiven him: and [the remnant] shall be the priest's, as a meat offering.

sinned shall bring <u>03\_LEV\_05\_11</u># But if he be not able to bring two turtledoves, or two young pigeons, then he that sinned shall bring for his offering the tenth part of an ephah of fine flour for a sin offering; he shall put no oil upon it, neither shall he put [any] frankincense thereon: for it [is] a sin offering.

sinned so is <u>45\_ROM\_05\_16</u> # And not as [it was] by one that sinned, [so is] the gift: for the judgment [was] by one to condemnation, but the free gift [is] of many offences unto justification.

sinned still and <u>19\_PSA\_78\_32</u># For all this they sinned still, and believed not for his wondrous works.

sinned that thou <u>11\_1KI\_18\_09</u># And he said, What have I sinned, that thou wouldest deliver thy servant into the hand of Ahab, to slay me?

sinned this time <u>02\_EXO\_09\_27</u># And Pharaoh sent, and called for Moses and Aaron, and said unto them, I have sinned this time: the LORD [is] righteous, and I and my people [are] wicked.

sinned we have <u>14\_2CH\_06\_37</u> # Yet [if] they bethink themselves in the land whither they are carried captive, and turn and pray unto thee in the land of their captivity, saying, We have sinned, we have done amiss, and have dealt wickedly;

sinned we have <u>27\_DAN\_09\_15</u># And now, O Lord our God, that hast brought thy people forth out of the land of Egypt with a mighty hand, and hast gotten thee renown, as at this day; we have sinned, we have done wickedly.

sinned we make <u>62\_1JO\_01\_10</u># If we say that we have not sinned, we make him a liar, and his word is not in us.

sinned what shall <u>18\_JOB\_07\_20</u> # I have sinned; what shall I do unto thee, O thou preserver of men? why hast thou set me as a mark against thee, so that I am a burden to myself?

sinned whose carcases <u>58\_HEB\_03\_17</u> # But with whom was he grieved forty years? [was it] not with them that had sinned, whose carcases fell in the wilderness?

sinned with our <u>19\_PSA\_106\_06</u># We have sinned with our fathers, we have committed iniquity, we have done wickedly.

sinned without law <u>45\_ROM\_02\_12</u> # For as many as have sinned without law shall also perish without law: and as many as have sinned in the law shall be judged by the law;

sinned yet honour <u>09\_1SA\_15\_30</u># Then he said, I have sinned: [yet] honour me now, I pray thee, before the elders of my people, and before Israel, and turn again with me, that I may worship the LORD thy God.

sinned yet more <u>02\_EXO\_09\_34</u> # And when Pharaoh saw that the rain and the hail and the thunders were ceased, he sinned yet more, and hardened his heart, he and his servants.

sinned yet more <u>19\_PSA\_78\_17</u> # And they sinned yet more against him by provoking the most High in the wilderness.

sinned <u>24\_JER\_02\_35</u> # Yet thou sayest, Because I am innocent, surely his anger shall turn from me. Behold, I will plead with thee, because thou sayest, I have not sinned.

sinner or no <u>43\_JOH\_09\_25</u># He answered and said, Whether he be a sinner [or no], I know not: one thing I know, that, whereas I was blind, now I see.

sinner shall be 21\_ECC\_07\_26 # And I find more bitter than death the woman, whose heart [is] snares and nets, [and] her hands [as] bands: whoso pleaseth God shall escape from her; but the sinner shall be taken by her.

sinner that repenteth <u>42\_LUK\_15\_07</u># I say unto you, that likewise joy shall be in heaven over one sinner that repenteth, more than over ninety and nine just persons, which need no repentance.

sinner that repenteth <u>42\_LUK\_15\_10</u> # Likewise, I say unto you, there is joy in the presence of the angels of God over one sinner that repenteth.

sinner when she <u>42\_LUK\_07\_37</u> # And, behold, a woman in the city, which was a sinner, when she knew that [Jesus] sat at meat in the Pharisee's house, brought an alabaster box of ointment,

sinner <u>43\_JOH\_09\_24</u> # Then again called they the man that was blind, and said unto him, Give God the praise: we know that this man is a sinner.

sinner <u>42\_LUK\_07\_39</u> # Now when the Pharisee which had bidden him saw [it], he spake within himself, saying, This man, if he were a prophet, would have known who and what manner of woman [this is] that toucheth him: for she is a sinner.

sinner <u>42\_LUK\_18\_13</u> # And the publican, standing afar off, would not lift up so much as [his] eyes unto

heaven, but smote upon his breast, saying, God be merciful to me a sinner.

sinner <u>42\_LUK\_19\_07</u> # And when they saw [it], they all murmured, saying, That he was gone to be guest with a man that is a sinner.

sinner **<u>20\_PRO\_11\_31</u>**# Behold, the righteous shall be recompensed in the earth: much more the wicked and the sinner.

sinner <u>20\_PRO\_13\_06</u> # Righteousness keepeth [him that is] upright in the way: but wickedness overthroweth the sinner.

sinner <u>45\_ROM\_03\_07</u> # For if the truth of God hath more abounded through my lie unto his glory; why yet am I also judged as a sinner?

sinners above all <u>42\_LUK\_13\_02</u> # And Jesus answering said unto them, Suppose ye that these Galilaeans were sinners above all the Galilaeans, because they suffered such things?

sinners above all <u>42\_LUK\_13\_04</u> # Or those eighteen, upon whom the tower in Siloam fell, and slew them, think ye that they were sinners above all men that dwelt in Jerusalem?

sinners against himself <u>58\_HEB\_12\_03</u># For consider him that endured such contradiction of sinners against himself, lest ye be wearied and faint in your minds.

sinners against their <u>04\_NUM\_16\_38</u> # The censers of these sinners against their own souls, let them make them broad plates [for] a covering of the altar: for they offered them before the LORD, therefore they are hallowed: and they shall be a sign unto the children of Israel.

sinners also do <u>42\_LUK\_06\_33</u># And if ye do good to them which do good to you, what thank have ye? for sinners also do even the same.

sinners also lend <u>42\_LUK\_06\_34</u> # And if ye lend [to them] of whom ye hope to receive, what thank have ye? for sinners also lend to sinners, to receive as much again.

sinners also love <u>42\_LUK\_06\_32</u> # For if ye love them which love you, what thank have ye? for sinners also love those that love them.

sinners and eateth <u>42\_LUK\_15\_02</u> # And the Pharisees and scribes murmured, saying, This man receiveth sinners, and eateth with them.

sinners and made <u>58\_HEB\_07\_26</u># For such an high priest became us, [who is] holy, harmless, undefiled, separate from sinners, and made higher than the heavens;

sinners and purify <u>59\_JAM\_04\_08</u> # Draw nigh to God, and he will draw nigh to you. Cleanse [your] hands, [ye] sinners; and purify [your] hearts, [ye] double minded.

sinners be consumed <u>19\_PSA\_104\_35</u> # Let the sinners be consumed out of the earth, and let the wicked be no more. Bless thou the LORD, O my soul. Praise ye the LORD.

sinners before the <u>01\_GEN\_13\_13</u># But the men of Sodom [were] wicked and sinners before the LORD exceedingly.

sinners but be <u>20\_PRO\_23\_17</u> # Let not thine heart envy sinners: but [be thou] in the fear of the LORD all the day long.

sinners but if <u>43\_JOH\_09\_31</u># Now we know that God heareth not sinners: but if any man be a worshipper

of God, and doeth his will, him he heareth.

sinners but to <u>20\_PRO\_13\_21</u> # Evil pursueth sinners: but to the righteous good shall be repayed.

sinners But wisdom <u>40\_MAT\_11\_19</u># The Son of man came eating and drinking, and they say, Behold a man gluttonous, and a winebibber, a friend of publicans and sinners. But wisdom is justified of her children.

sinners came and <u>40\_MAT\_09\_10</u># And it came to pass, as Jesus sat at meat in the house, behold, many publicans and sinners came and sat down with him and his disciples.

sinners Christ died <u>45\_ROM\_05\_08</u># But God commendeth his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us.

sinners entice thee 20\_PRO\_01\_10 # My son, if sinners entice thee, consent thou not.

sinners for to <u>42\_LUK\_15\_01</u> # Then drew near unto him all the publicans and sinners for to hear him.

sinners for unholy <u>54\_1TI\_01\_09</u> # Knowing this, that the law is not made for a righteous man, but for the lawless and disobedient, for the ungodly and for sinners, for unholy and profane, for murderers of fathers and murderers of mothers, for manslayers,

sinners have spoken <u>65\_JDE\_01\_15</u># To execute judgment upon all, and to convince all that are ungodly among them of all their ungodly deeds which they have ungodly committed, and of all their hard [speeches] which ungodly sinners have spoken against him.

sinners in the <u>19\_PSA\_01\_05</u> # Therefore the ungodly shall not stand in the judgment, nor sinners in the congregation of the righteous.

sinners in the <u>19\_PSA\_25\_08</u># Good and upright [is] the LORD: therefore will he teach sinners in the way.

sinners in Zion <u>23\_ISA\_33\_14</u># The sinners in Zion are afraid; fearfulness hath surprised the hypocrites. Who among us shall dwell with the devouring fire? who among us shall dwell with everlasting burnings?

sinners is therefore <u>48\_GAL\_02\_17</u> # But if, while we seek to be justified by Christ, we ourselves also are found sinners, [is] therefore Christ the minister of sin? God forbid.

sinners nor my <u>19\_PSA\_26\_09</u># Gather not my soul with sinners, nor my life with bloody men:

sinners nor sitteth <u>19\_PSA\_01\_01</u> # Blessed [is] the man that walketh not in the counsel of the ungodly, nor standeth in the way of sinners, nor sitteth in the seat of the scornful.

sinners of my <u>30\_AMO\_09\_10</u># All the sinners of my people shall die by the sword, which say, The evil shall not overtake nor prevent us.

sinners of the <u>48\_GAL\_02\_15</u># We [who are] Jews by nature, and not sinners of the Gentiles,

sinners of whom <u>54\_1TI\_01\_15</u> # This [is] a faithful saying, and worthy of all acceptation, that Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners; of whom I am chief.

sinners sat also <u>41\_MAR\_02\_15</u># And it came to pass, that, as Jesus sat at meat in his house, many publicans and sinners sat also together with Jesus and his disciples: for there were many, and they followed him.

sinners shall be <u>23\_ISA\_01\_28</u> # And the destruction of the transgressors and of the sinners [shall be]

together, and they that forsake the LORD shall be consumed.

sinners shall be <u>19\_PSA\_51\_13</u># [Then] will I teach transgressors thy ways; and sinners shall be converted unto thee.

sinners so by <u>45\_ROM\_05\_19</u> # For as by one man's disobedience many were made sinners, so by the obedience of one shall many be made righteous.

sinners thereof out <u>23\_ISA\_13\_09</u> # Behold, the day of the LORD cometh, cruel both with wrath and fierce anger, to lay the land desolate: and he shall destroy the sinners thereof out of it.

sinners they said <u>41\_MAR\_02\_16</u># And when the scribes and Pharisees saw him eat with publicans and sinners, they said unto his disciples, How is it that he eateth and drinketh with publicans and sinners?

sinners to receive <u>42\_LUK\_06\_34</u> # And if ye lend [to them] of whom ye hope to receive, what thank have ye? for sinners also lend to sinners, to receive as much again.

sinners to repentance <u>42\_LUK\_05\_32</u> # I came not to call the righteous, but sinners to repentance.

sinners to repentance <u>41\_MAR\_02\_17</u> # When Jesus heard [it], he saith unto them, They that are whole have no need of the physician, but they that are sick: I came not to call the righteous, but sinners to repentance.

sinners to repentance <u>40\_MAT\_09\_13</u># But go ye and learn what [that] meaneth, I will have mercy, and not sacrifice: for I am not come to call the righteous, but sinners to repentance.

sinners <u>42\_LUK\_05\_30</u> # But their scribes and Pharisees murmured against his disciples, saying, Why do ye eat and drink with publicans and sinners?

sinners <u>42\_LUK\_07\_34</u> # The Son of man is come eating and drinking; and ye say, Behold a gluttonous man, and a winebibber, a friend of publicans and sinners!

sinners <u>41\_MAR\_02\_16</u> # And when the scribes and Pharisees saw him eat with publicans and sinners, they said unto his disciples, How is it that he eateth and drinketh with publicans and sinners?

sinners <u>41\_MAR\_14\_41</u> # And he cometh the third time, and saith unto them, Sleep on now, and take [your] rest: it is enough, the hour is come; behold, the Son of man is betrayed into the hands of sinners.

sinners <u>40\_MAT\_09\_11</u># And when the Pharisees saw [it], they said unto his disciples, Why eateth your Master with publicans and sinners?

sinners <u>40\_MAT\_26\_45</u># Then cometh he to his disciples, and saith unto them, Sleep on now, and take [your] rest: behold, the hour is at hand, and the Son of man is betrayed into the hands of sinners.

sinnest what doest <u>18\_JOB\_35\_06</u># If thou sinnest, what doest thou against him? or [if] thy transgressions be multiplied, what doest thou unto him?

sinneth against his <u>46\_1CO\_06\_18</u># Flee fornication. Every sin that a man doeth is without the body; but he that committeth fornication sinneth against his own body.

sinneth against his 20\_PRO\_20\_02 # The fear of a king [is] as the roaring of a lion: [whoso] provoketh him to anger sinneth [against] his own soul.

sinneth against me <u>26\_EZE\_14\_13</u># Son of man, when the land sinneth against me by trespassing grievously, then will I stretch out mine hand upon it, and will break the staff of the bread thereof, and will send famine upon it, and will cut off man and beast from it:

sinneth against me <u>20\_PRO\_08\_36</u> # But he that sinneth against me wrongeth his own soul: all they that hate me love death.

sinneth at the <u>05\_DEU\_19\_15</u># One witness shall not rise up against a man for any iniquity, or for any sin, in any sin that he sinneth: at the mouth of two witnesses, or at the mouth of three witnesses, shall the matter be established.

sinneth being condemned <u>56\_TIT\_03\_11</u># Knowing that he that is such is subverted, and sinneth, being condemned of himself.

sinneth but he <u>20\_PRO\_14\_21</u># He that despiseth his neighbour sinneth: but he that hath mercy on the poor, happy [is] he.

sinneth by ignorance <u>04\_NUM\_15\_28</u># And the priest shall make an atonement for the soul that sinneth ignorantly, when he sinneth by ignorance before the LORD, to make an atonement for him; and it shall be forgiven him.

sinneth from the <u>62\_1JO\_03\_08</u># He that committeth sin is of the devil; for the devil sinneth from the beginning. For this purpose the Son of God was manifested, that he might destroy the works of the devil.

sinneth hath not <u>62\_1JO\_03\_06</u> # Whosoever abideth in him sinneth not: whosoever sinneth hath not seen him, neither known him.

sinneth ignorantly when <u>04\_NUM\_15\_28</u> # And the priest shall make an atonement for the soul that sinneth ignorantly, when he sinneth by ignorance before the LORD, to make an atonement for him; and it shall be forgiven him.

sinneth it shall <u>26\_EZE\_18\_04</u> # Behold, all souls are mine; as the soul of the father, so also the soul of the son is mine: the soul that sinneth, it shall die.

sinneth it shall <u>26\_EZE\_18\_20</u> # The soul that sinneth, it shall die. The son shall not bear the iniquity of the father, neither shall the father bear the iniquity of the son: the righteousness of the righteous shall be upon him, and the wickedness of the wicked shall be upon him.

sinneth not and <u>11\_1KI\_08\_46</u># If they sin against thee, [for [there is] no man that sinneth not,] and thou be angry with them, and deliver them to the enemy, so that they carry them away captives unto the land of the enemy, far or near;

sinneth not and <u>14\_2CH\_06\_36</u># If they sin against thee, [for [there is] no man which sinneth not,] and thou be angry with them, and deliver them over before [their] enemies, and they carry them away captives unto a land far off or near;

sinneth not but <u>62\_1JO\_05\_18</u> # We know that whosoever is born of God sinneth not; but he that is begotten of God keepeth himself, and that wicked one toucheth him not.

sinneth not let <u>46\_1CO\_07\_36</u> # But if any man think that he behaveth himself uncomely toward his virgin, if she pass the flower of [her] age, and need so require, let him do what he will, he sinneth not: let them marry.

sinneth not whosoever 62\_1JO\_03\_06 # Whosoever abideth in him sinneth not: whosoever sinneth hath not

# seen him, neither known him.

sinneth not 21\_ECC\_07\_20 # For [there is] not a just man upon earth, that doeth good, and sinneth not.

sinneth through ignorance <u>04\_NUM\_15\_29</u># Ye shall have one law for him that sinneth through ignorance, [both for] him that is born among the children of Israel, and for the stranger that sojourneth among them.

sinneth <u>26\_EZE\_33\_12</u> # Therefore, thou son of man, say unto the children of thy people, The righteousness of the righteous shall not deliver him in the day of his transgression: as for the wickedness of the wicked, he shall not fall thereby in the day that he turneth from his wickedness; neither shall the righteous be able to live for his [righteousness] in the day that he sinneth.

sinneth <u>20\_PRO\_19\_02</u> # Also, [that] the soul [be] without knowledge, [it is] not good; and he that hasteth with [his] feet sinneth.

sinning against me <u>01\_GEN\_20\_06</u># And God said unto him in a dream, Yea, I know that thou didst this in the integrity of thy heart; for I also withheld thee from sinning against me: therefore suffered I thee not to touch her.

sinning therein <u>03\_LEV\_06\_03</u># Or have found that which was lost, and lieth concerning it, and sweareth falsely; in any of all these that a man doeth, sinning therein:

Tehinnah the father <u>13\_1CH\_04\_12</u> # And Eshton begat Bethrapha, and Paseah, and Tehinnah the father of Irnahash. These [are] the men of Recah.

winneth souls is <u>20\_PRO\_11\_30</u># The fruit of the righteous [is] a tree of life; and he that winneth souls [is] wise.

winnowed with the <u>23\_ISA\_30\_24</u> # The oxen likewise and the young asses that ear the ground shall eat clean provender, which hath been winnowed with the shovel and with the fan.

winnoweth barley to <u>08\_RUT\_03\_02</u> # And now [is] not Boaz of our kindred, with whose maidens thou wast? Behold, he winnoweth barley to night in the threshingfloor.
