Spirits of God 66_REV_05_06 # And I beheld, and, lo, in the midst of the throne and of the four beasts, and in the midst of the elders, stood a Lamb as it had been slain, having seven horns and seven eyes, which are the seven Spirits of God sent forth into all the earth.

spirits of just <u>58_HEB_12_23</u> # To the general assembly and church of the firstborn, which are written in heaven, and to God the Judge of all, and to the spirits of just men made perfect,

spirits of the 46 1CO 14 32 # And the spirits of the prophets are subject to the prophets.

spirits of the <u>38_ZEC_06_05</u># And the angel answered and said unto me, These [are] the four spirits of the heavens, which go forth from standing before the Lord of all the earth.

spirits or a <u>05_DEU_18_11</u># Or a charmer, or a consulter with familiar spirits, or a wizard, or a necromancer.

spirits sent forth <u>58_HEB_01_14</u> # Are they not all ministering spirits, sent forth to minister for them who shall be heirs of salvation?

spirits the name <u>44_ACT_19_13</u># Then certain of the vagabond Jews, exorcists, took upon them to call over them which had evil spirits the name of the Lord Jesus, saying, We adjure you by Jesus whom Paul preacheth.

spirits to another 46_1CO_12_10 # To another the working of miracles; to another prophecy; to another discerning of spirits; to another [divers] kinds of tongues; to another the interpretation of tongues:

spirits to cast 40_MAT_10_01# And when he had called unto [him] his twelve disciples, he gave them power [against] unclean spirits, to cast them out, and to heal all manner of sickness and all manner of disease.

spirits went out 44_ACT_19_12 # So that from his body were brought unto the sick handkerchiefs or aprons, and the diseases departed from them, and the evil spirits went out of them.

spirits went out <u>41_MAR_05_13</u># And forthwith Jesus gave them leave. And the unclean spirits went out, and entered into the swine: and the herd ran violently down a steep place into the sea, [they were about two thousand;] and were choked in the sea.
