Jacob a second <u>01\_GEN\_30\_07</u> # And Bilhah Rachel's maid conceived again, and bare Jacob a second son.

Jacob a second <u>01\_GEN\_30\_12</u> # And Zilpah Leah's maid bare Jacob a second son.

Jacob a son <u>01\_GEN\_30\_05</u> # And Bilhah conceived, and bare Jacob a son.

Jacob a son <u>01\_GEN\_30\_10</u># And Zilpah Leah's maid bare Jacob a son.

Jacob according to <u>28\_HOS\_12\_02</u># The LORD hath also a controversy with Judah, and will punish Jacob according to his ways; according to his doings will he recompense him.

Jacob again to 23\_ISA\_49\_05 # And now, saith the LORD that formed me from the womb [to be] his servant, to bring Jacob again to him, Though Israel be not gathered, yet shall I be glorious in the eyes of the LORD, and my God shall be my strength.

Jacob again when <u>01\_GEN\_35\_09</u># And God appeared unto Jacob again, when he came out of Padanaram, and blessed him.

Jacob all of <u>33\_MIC\_02\_12</u> # I will surely assemble, O Jacob, all of thee; I will surely gather the remnant of Israel; I will put them together as the sheep of Bozrah, as the flock in the midst of their fold: they shall make great noise by reason of [the multitude of] men.

Jacob all the <u>01\_GEN\_35\_04</u># And they gave unto Jacob all the strange gods which [were] in their hand, and [all their] earrings which [were] in their ears; and Jacob hid them under the oak which [was] by Shechem.

Jacob all the <u>01\_GEN\_46\_22</u># These [are] the sons of Rachel, which were born to Jacob: all the souls [were] fourteen.

Jacob all the <u>01\_GEN\_46\_25</u> # These [are] the sons of Bilhah, which Laban gave unto Rachel his daughter, and she bare these unto Jacob: all the souls [were] seven.

Jacob and a <u>04\_NUM\_24\_17</u> # I shall see him, but not now: I shall behold him, but not nigh: there shall come a Star out of Jacob, and a Sceptre shall rise out of Israel, and shall smite the corners of Moab, and destroy all the children of Sheth.

Jacob and all <u>01\_GEN\_46\_06</u># And they took their cattle, and their goods, which they had gotten in the land of Canaan, and came into Egypt, Jacob, and all his seed with him:

Jacob and all <u>23\_ISA\_46\_03</u> # Hearken unto me, O house of Jacob, and all the remnant of the house of Israel, which are borne [by me] from the belly, which are carried from the womb:

Jacob and all <u>24\_JER\_02\_04</u> # Hear ye the word of the LORD, O house of Jacob, and all the families of the house of Israel:

Jacob and all <u>42\_LUK\_13\_28</u># There shall be weeping and gnashing of teeth, when ye shall see Abraham, and Isaac, and Jacob, and all the prophets, in the kingdom of God, and you [yourselves] thrust out.

Jacob and also <u>03\_LEV\_26\_42</u> # Then will I remember my covenant with Jacob, and also my covenant with Isaac, and also my covenant with Abraham will I remember; and I will remember the land.

Jacob and anger <u>19\_PSA\_78\_21</u># Therefore the LORD heard [this], and was wroth: so a fire was kindled against Jacob, and anger also came up against Israel;

Jacob and another <u>23\_ISA\_44\_05</u> # One shall say, I [am] the LORD's; and another shall call [himself] by the name of Jacob; and another shall subscribe [with] his hand unto the LORD, and surname [himself] by the name of Israel.

Jacob and appointed <u>19\_PSA\_78\_05</u># For he established a testimony in Jacob, and appointed a law in Israel, which he commanded our fathers, that they should make them known to their children:

Jacob and be <u>24\_JER\_46\_27</u> # But fear not thou, O my servant Jacob, and be not dismayed, O Israel: for, behold, I will save thee from afar off, and thy seed from the land of their captivity; and Jacob shall return, and be in rest and at ease, and none shall make [him] afraid.

Jacob and blessed <u>01\_GEN\_28\_01</u># And Isaac called Jacob, and blessed him, and charged him, and said unto him, Thou shalt not take a wife of the daughters of Canaan.

Jacob and come <u>04\_NUM\_23\_07</u> # And he took up his parable, and said, Balak the king of Moab hath brought me from Aram, out of the mountains of the east, [saying], Come, curse me Jacob, and come, defy Israel.

Jacob and David <u>24\_JER\_33\_26</u> # Then will I cast away the seed of Jacob, and David my servant, [so] that I will not take [any] of his seed [to be] rulers over the seed of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob: for I will cause their captivity to return, and have mercy on them.

Jacob and devoured 24\_JER\_10\_25 # Pour out thy fury upon the heathen that know thee not, and upon the families that call not on thy name: for they have eaten up Jacob, and devoured him, and consumed him, and have made his habitation desolate.

Jacob and Esau <u>58\_HEB\_11\_20</u># By faith Isaac blessed Jacob and Esau concerning things to come.

Jacob and Esau <u>06\_JOS\_24\_04</u> # And I gave unto Isaac Jacob and Esau: and I gave unto Esau mount Seir, to possess it; but Jacob and his children went down into Egypt.

Jacob and glorified <u>23\_ISA\_44\_23</u> # Sing, O ye heavens; for the LORD hath done [it]: shout, ye lower parts of the earth: break forth into singing, ye mountains, O forest, and every tree therein: for the LORD hath redeemed Jacob, and glorified himself in Israel.

Jacob and hate <u>30\_AMO\_06\_08</u># The Lord GOD hath sworn by himself, saith the LORD the God of hosts, I abhor the excellency of Jacob, and hate his palaces: therefore will I deliver up the city with all that is therein.

Jacob and hath <u>25\_LAM\_02\_02</u># The Lord hath swallowed up all the habitations of Jacob, and hath not pitied: he hath thrown down in his wrath the strong holds of the daughter of Judah; he hath brought [them] down to the ground: he hath polluted the kingdom and the princes thereof.

Jacob and have <u>26\_EZE\_39\_25</u> # Therefore thus saith the Lord GOD; Now will I bring again the captivity of Jacob, and have mercy upon the whole house of Israel, and will be jealous for my holy name;

Jacob and he <u>01\_GEN\_28\_05</u># And Isaac sent away Jacob: and he went to Padanaram unto Laban, son of Bethuel the Syrian, the brother of Rebekah, Jacob's and Esau's mother.

Jacob and he <u>01\_GEN\_34\_03</u> # And his soul clave unto Dinah the daughter of Jacob, and he loved the damsel, and spake kindly unto the damsel.

Jacob And he <u>01\_GEN\_46\_02</u># And God spake unto Israel in the visions of the night, and said, Jacob, Jacob. And he said, Here [am] I.

Jacob and he <u>23\_ISA\_02\_03</u> # And many people shall go and say, Come ye, and let us go up to the mountain of the LORD, to the house of the God of Jacob; and he will teach us of his ways, and we will walk in his paths: for out of Zion shall go forth the law, and the word of the LORD from Jerusalem.

Jacob and he <u>23 ISA 43 01</u> # But now thus saith the LORD that created thee, O Jacob, and he that formed thee, O Israel, Fear not: for I have redeemed thee, I have called [thee] by thy name; thou [art] mine.

Jacob and he <u>33\_MIC\_04\_02</u> # And many nations shall come, and say, Come, and let us go up to the mountain of the LORD, and to the house of the God of Jacob; and he will teach us of his ways, and we will walk in his paths: for the law shall go forth of Zion, and the word of the LORD from Jerusalem.

Jacob and hearken <u>01\_GEN\_49\_02</u># Gather yourselves together, and hear, ye sons of Jacob; and hearken unto Israel your father.

Jacob and him <u>39\_MAL\_02\_12</u> # The LORD will cut off the man that doeth this, the master and the scholar, out of the tabernacles of Jacob, and him that offereth an offering unto the LORD of hosts.

Jacob and his <u>01\_GEN\_46\_08</u># And these [are] the names of the children of Israel, which came into Egypt, Jacob and his sons: Reuben, Jacob's firstborn.

Jacob and his <u>06\_JOS\_24\_04</u> # And I gave unto Isaac Jacob and Esau: and I gave unto Esau mount Seir, to possess it; but Jacob and his children went down into Egypt.

Jacob and I <u>02\_EXO\_06\_08</u># And I will bring you in unto the land, concerning the which I did swear to give it to Abraham, to Isaac, and to Jacob; and I will give it you for an heritage: I [am] the LORD.

Jacob And I <u>01\_GEN\_31\_11</u># And the angel of God spake unto me in a dream, [saying], Jacob: And I said, Here [am] I.

Jacob and I <u>23\_ISA\_08\_17</u> # And I will wait upon the LORD, that hideth his face from the house of Jacob, and I will look for him.

Jacob and Isaac <u>01\_GEN\_25\_26</u> # And after that came his brother out, and his hand took hold on Esau's heel; and his name was called Jacob: and Isaac [was] threescore years old when she bare them.

Jacob and Israel <u>23\_ISA\_44\_21</u> # Remember these, O Jacob and Israel; for thou [art] my servant: I have formed thee; thou [art] my servant: O Israel, thou shalt not be forgotten of me.

Jacob and Israel <u>23\_ISA\_48\_12</u># Hearken unto me, O Jacob and Israel, my called; I [am] he; I [am] the first, I also [am] the last.

Jacob and it 23\_ISA\_09\_08 # The Lord sent a word into Jacob, and it hath lighted upon Israel.

Jacob and Jacob <u>44\_ACT\_07\_08</u> # And he gave him the covenant of circumcision: and so [Abraham] begat Isaac, and circumcised him the eighth day; and Isaac [begat] Jacob; and Jacob [begat] the twelve patriarchs.

Jacob and Jacob <u>01\_GEN\_27\_30</u># And it came to pass, as soon as Isaac had made an end of blessing Jacob, and Jacob was yet scarce gone out from the presence of Isaac his father, that Esau his brother came in from

his hunting.

Jacob and Jacob <u>01\_GEN\_30\_36</u># And he set three days' journey betwixt himself and Jacob: and Jacob fed the rest of Laban's flocks.

Jacob and Jacob <u>40\_MAT\_01\_02</u># Abraham begat Isaac; and Isaac begat Jacob; and Jacob begat Judas and his brethren;

Jacob and Joseph <u>19\_PSA\_77\_15</u># Thou hast with [thine] arm redeemed thy people, the sons of Jacob and Joseph. Selah.

Jacob and laid <u>19\_PSA\_79\_07</u># For they have devoured Jacob, and laid waste his dwelling place.

Jacob and made <u>26\_EZE\_20\_05</u># And say unto them, Thus saith the Lord GOD; In the day when I chose Israel, and lifted up mine hand unto the seed of the house of Jacob, and made myself known unto them in the land of Egypt, when I lifted up mine hand unto them, saying, I [am] the LORD your God;

Jacob And Moses <u>02\_EXO\_03\_06</u># Moreover he said, I [am] the God of thy father, the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob. And Moses hid his face; for he was afraid to look upon God.

Jacob and of <u>04\_NUM\_23\_23</u> # Surely [there is] no enchantment against Jacob, neither [is there] any divination against Israel: according to this time it shall be said of Jacob and of Israel, What hath God wrought!

Jacob and out <u>23\_ISA\_65\_09</u> # And I will bring forth a seed out of Jacob, and out of Judah an inheritor of my mountains: and mine elect shall inherit it, and my servants shall dwell there.

Jacob and princes <u>33\_MIC\_03\_09</u># Hear this, I pray you, ye heads of the house of Jacob, and princes of the house of Israel, that abhor judgment, and pervert all equity.

Jacob and publish <u>24\_JER\_05\_20</u># Declare this in the house of Jacob, and publish it in Judah, saying,

Jacob and ransomed <u>24\_JER\_31\_11</u># For the LORD hath redeemed Jacob, and ransomed him from the hand of [him that was] stronger than he.

Jacob and said <u>01\_GEN\_48\_02</u> # And [one] told Jacob, and said, Behold, thy son Joseph cometh unto thee: and Israel strengthened himself, and sat upon the bed.

Jacob and scatter <u>01\_GEN\_49\_07</u> # Cursed [be] their anger, for [it was] fierce; and their wrath, for it was cruel: I will divide them in Jacob, and scatter them in Israel.

Jacob and sent <u>01\_GEN\_28\_06</u># When Esau saw that Isaac had blessed Jacob, and sent him away to Padanaram, to take him a wife from thence; and that as he blessed him he gave him a charge, saying, Thou shalt not take a wife of the daughters of Canaan;

Jacob and shall <u>23\_ISA\_29\_23</u> # But when he seeth his children, the work of mine hands, in the midst of him, they shall sanctify my name, and sanctify the Holy One of Jacob, and shall fear the God of Israel.

Jacob and shout <u>24\_JER\_31\_07</u> # For thus saith the LORD; Sing with gladness for Jacob, and shout among the chief of the nations: publish ye, praise ye, and say, O LORD, save thy people, the remnant of Israel.

Jacob and speakest <u>23\_ISA\_40\_27</u> # Why sayest thou, O Jacob, and speakest, O Israel, My way is hid from the LORD, and my judgment is passed over from my God?

Jacob and tell <u>02\_EXO\_19\_03</u> # And Moses went up unto God, and the LORD called unto him out of the

mountain, saying, Thus shalt thou say to the house of Jacob, and tell the children of Israel;

Jacob and the <u>10\_2SA\_23\_01</u> # Now these [be] the last words of David. David the son of Jesse said, and the man [who was] raised up on high, the anointed of the God of Jacob, and the sweet psalmist of Israel, said,

Jacob and the <u>33\_MIC\_07\_20</u># Thou wilt perform the truth to Jacob, [and] the mercy to Abraham, which thou hast sworn unto our fathers from the days of old.

Jacob and the <u>04\_NUM\_23\_10</u> # Who can count the dust of Jacob, and the number of the fourth [part] of Israel? Let me die the death of the righteous, and let my last end be like his!

Jacob and thy <u>04\_NUM\_24\_05</u># How goodly are thy tents, O Jacob, [and] thy tabernacles, O Israel!

Jacob and to 23\_ISA\_49\_06 # And he said, It is a light thing that thou shouldest be my servant to raise up the tribes of Jacob, and to restore the preserved of Israel: I will also give thee for a light to the Gentiles, that thou mayest be my salvation unto the end of the earth.

Jacob and will <u>23\_ISA\_14\_01</u> # For the LORD will have mercy on Jacob, and will yet choose Israel, and set them in their own land: and the strangers shall be joined with them, and they shall cleave to the house of Jacob.

Jacob and would <u>12\_2KI\_13\_23</u># And the LORD was gracious unto them, and had compassion on them, and had respect unto them, because of his covenant with Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob, and would not destroy them, neither cast he them from his presence as yet.

Jacob and ye <u>23\_ISA\_41\_14</u> # Fear not, thou worm Jacob, [and] ye men of Israel; I will help thee, saith the LORD, and thy redeemer, the Holy One of Israel.

Jacob and ye <u>33\_MIC\_03\_01</u># And I said, Hear, I pray you, O heads of Jacob, and ye princes of the house of Israel; [Is it] not for you to know judgment?

Jacob answered and <u>01\_GEN\_31\_31</u># And Jacob answered and said to Laban, Because I was afraid: for I said, Peradventure thou wouldest take by force thy daughters from me.

Jacob answered and <u>01\_GEN\_31\_36</u># And Jacob was wroth, and chided with Laban: and Jacob answered and said to Laban, What [is] my trespass? what [is] my sin, that thou hast so hotly pursued after me?

Jacob answered Shechem <u>01\_GEN\_34\_13</u># And the sons of Jacob answered Shechem and Hamor his father deceitfully, and said, because he had defiled Dinah their sister:

Jacob appeared unto <u>02\_EXO\_03\_16</u># Go, and gather the elders of Israel together, and say unto them, The LORD God of your fathers, the God of Abraham, of Isaac, and of Jacob, appeared unto me, saying, I have surely visited you, and [seen] that which is done to you in Egypt:

Jacob are not <u>39\_MAL\_03\_06</u># For I [am] the LORD, I change not; therefore ye sons of Jacob are not consumed.

Jacob arise for <u>30\_AMO\_07\_02</u> # And it came to pass, [that] when they had made an end of eating the grass of the land, then I said, O Lord GOD, forgive, I beseech thee: by whom shall Jacob arise? for he [is] small.

Jacob arise for <u>30\_AMO\_07\_05</u># Then said I, O Lord GOD, cease, I beseech thee: by whom shall Jacob arise? for he [is] small.

Jacob Arise go 01\_GEN\_35\_01 # And God said unto Jacob, Arise, go up to Bethel, and dwell there: and

make there an altar unto God, that appeared unto thee when thou fleddest from the face of Esau thy brother.

Jacob as the <u>34\_NAH\_02\_02</u> # For the LORD hath turned away the excellency of Jacob, as the excellency of Israel: for the emptiers have emptied them out, and marred their vine branches.

Jacob asked him <u>01\_GEN\_32\_29</u># And Jacob asked [him], and said, Tell [me], I pray thee, thy name. And he said, Wherefore [is] it [that] thou dost ask after my name? And he blessed him there.

Jacob awaked out <u>01\_GEN\_28\_16</u># And Jacob awaked out of his sleep, and he said, Surely the LORD is in this place; and I knew [it] not.

Jacob be purged <u>23\_ISA\_27\_09</u> # By this therefore shall the iniquity of Jacob be purged; and this [is] all the fruit to take away his sin; when he maketh all the stones of the altar as chalkstones that are beaten in sunder, the groves and images shall not stand up.

Jacob because of <u>01\_GEN\_27\_41</u> # And Esau hated Jacob because of the blessing wherewith his father blessed him: and Esau said in his heart, The days of mourning for my father are at hand; then will I slay my brother Jacob.

Jacob because they <u>23\_ISA\_02\_06</u># Therefore thou hast forsaken thy people the house of Jacob, because they be replenished from the east, and [are] soothsayers like the Philistines, and they please themselves in the children of strangers.

Jacob because they <u>04\_NUM\_32\_11</u># Surely none of the men that came up out of Egypt, from twenty years old and upward, shall see the land which I sware unto Abraham, unto Isaac, and unto Jacob; because they have not wholly followed me:

Jacob Because thou <u>01\_GEN\_29\_15</u># And Laban said unto Jacob, Because thou [art] my brother, shouldest thou therefore serve me for nought? tell me, what [shall] thy wages [be]?

Jacob begat Joseph <u>40\_MAT\_01\_16</u># And Jacob begat Joseph the husband of Mary, of whom was born Jesus, who is called Christ.

Jacob begat Judas <u>40\_MAT\_01\_02</u># Abraham begat Isaac; and Isaac begat Jacob; and Jacob begat Judas and his brethren;

Jacob begat the <u>44\_ACT\_07\_08</u># And he gave him the covenant of circumcision: and so [Abraham] begat Isaac, and circumcised him the eighth day; and Isaac [begat] Jacob; and Jacob [begat] the twelve patriarchs.

Jacob beheld the <u>01\_GEN\_31\_02</u># And Jacob beheld the countenance of Laban, and, behold, it [was] not toward him as before.

Jacob Behold this <u>01\_GEN\_31\_51</u># And Laban said to Jacob, Behold this heap, and behold [this] pillar, which I have cast betwixt me and thee;

Jacob blessed Pharaoh <u>01\_GEN\_47\_07</u># And Joseph brought in Jacob his father, and set him before Pharaoh: and Jacob blessed Pharaoh.

Jacob blessed Pharaoh <u>01\_GEN\_47\_10</u> # And Jacob blessed Pharaoh, and went out from before Pharaoh.

Jacob both the <u>19\_PSA\_76\_06</u># At thy rebuke, O God of Jacob, both the chariot and horse are cast into a dead sleep.

Jacob bought of <u>06\_JOS\_24\_32</u> # And the bones of Joseph, which the children of Israel brought up out of Egypt, buried they in Shechem, in a parcel of ground which Jacob bought of the sons of Hamor the father of Shechem for an hundred pieces of silver: and it became the inheritance of the children of Joseph.

Jacob buried him <u>01\_GEN\_35\_29</u># And Isaac gave up the ghost, and died, and was gathered unto his people, [being] old and full of days: and his sons Esau and Jacob buried him.

Jacob but Israel <u>01\_GEN\_32\_28</u> # And he said, Thy name shall be called no more Jacob, but Israel: for as a prince hast thou power with God and with men, and hast prevailed.

Jacob but Israel <u>01\_GEN\_35\_10</u># And God said unto him, Thy name [is] Jacob: thy name shall not be called any more Jacob, but Israel shall be thy name: and he called his name Israel.

Jacob but thou <u>23\_ISA\_43\_22</u> # But thou hast not called upon me, O Jacob; but thou hast been weary of me, O Israel.

Jacob by the <u>02\_EXO\_06\_03</u># And I appeared unto Abraham, unto Isaac, and unto Jacob, by [the name of] God Almighty, but by my name JEHOVAH was I not known to them.

Jacob called it <u>01\_GEN\_31\_47</u> # And Laban called it Jegarsahadutha: but Jacob called it Galeed.

Jacob called the <u>01\_GEN\_32\_30</u># And Jacob called the name of the place Peniel: for I have seen God face to face, and my life is preserved.

Jacob called the <u>01\_GEN\_35\_15</u># And Jacob called the name of the place where God spake with him, Bethel.

Jacob called unto <u>01\_GEN\_49\_01</u># And Jacob called unto his sons, and said, Gather yourselves together, that I may tell you [that] which shall befall you in the last days.

Jacob came out <u>01\_GEN\_30\_16</u># And Jacob came out of the field in the evening, and Leah went out to meet him, and said, Thou must come in unto me; for surely I have hired thee with my son's mandrakes. And he lay with her that night.

Jacob came out <u>01\_GEN\_34\_07</u> # And the sons of Jacob came out of the field when they heard [it]: and the men were grieved, and they were very wroth, because he had wrought folly in Israel in lying with Jacob's daughter; which thing ought not to be done.

Jacob came to <u>01\_GEN\_33\_18</u># And Jacob came to Shalem, a city of Shechem, which [is] in the land of Canaan, when he came from Padanaram; and pitched his tent before the city.

Jacob came to <u>01\_GEN\_35\_06</u># So Jacob came to Luz, which [is] in the land of Canaan, that [is], Bethel, he and all the people that [were] with him.

Jacob came unto <u>01\_GEN\_35\_27</u># And Jacob came unto Isaac his father unto Mamre, unto the city of Arbah, which [is] Hebron, where Abraham and Isaac sojourned.

Jacob came upon <u>01\_GEN\_34\_27</u># The sons of Jacob came upon the slain, and spoiled the city, because they had defiled their sister.

Jacob Come near <u>01\_GEN\_27\_21</u> # And Isaac said unto Jacob, Come near, I pray thee, that I may feel thee, my son, whether thou [be] my very son Esau or not.

Jacob come ye <u>23\_ISA\_02\_05</u> # O house of Jacob, come ye, and let us walk in the light of the LORD.

Jacob defend thee <u>19\_PSA\_20\_01</u> # To the chief Musician, A Psalm of David. The LORD hear thee in the day of trouble; the name of the God of Jacob defend thee;

Jacob did separate <u>01\_GEN\_30\_40</u># And Jacob did separate the lambs, and set the faces of the flocks toward the ringstreaked, and all the brown in the flock of Laban; and he put his own flocks by themselves, and put them not unto Laban's cattle.

Jacob did so <u>01\_GEN\_29\_28</u># And Jacob did so, and fulfilled her week: and he gave him Rachel his daughter to wife also.

Jacob dwelt in <u>01\_GEN\_37\_01</u> # And Jacob dwelt in the land wherein his father was a stranger, in the land of Canaan.

Jacob either good <u>01\_GEN\_31\_24</u> # And God came to Laban the Syrian in a dream by night, and said unto him, Take heed that thou speak not to Jacob either good or bad.

Jacob either good <u>01\_GEN\_31\_29</u># It is in the power of my hand to do you hurt: but the God of your father spake unto me yesternight, saying, Take thou heed that thou speak not to Jacob either good or bad.

Jacob even sixteen <u>01\_GEN\_46\_18</u># These [are] the sons of Zilpah, whom Laban gave to Leah his daughter, and these she bare unto Jacob, [even] sixteen souls.

Jacob fed the <u>01\_GEN\_30\_36</u># And he set three days' journey betwixt himself and Jacob: and Jacob fed the rest of Laban's flocks.

Jacob Feed me <u>01\_GEN\_25\_30</u># And Esau said to Jacob, Feed me, I pray thee, with that same red [pottage]; for I [am] faint: therefore was his name called Edom.

Jacob for a <u>23\_ISA\_42\_24</u> # Who gave Jacob for a spoil, and Israel to the robbers? did not the LORD, he against whom we have sinned? for they would not walk in his ways, neither were they obedient unto his law.

Jacob for a <u>19\_PSA\_105\_10</u># And confirmed the same unto Jacob for a law, [and] to Israel [for] an everlasting covenant:

Jacob for ever <u>42\_LUK\_01\_33</u> # And he shall reign over the house of Jacob for ever; and of his kingdom there shall be no end.

Jacob for he <u>01\_GEN\_27\_36</u> # And he said, Is not he rightly named Jacob? for he hath supplanted me these two times: he took away my birthright; and, behold, now he hath taken away my blessing. And he said, Hast thou not reserved a blessing for me?

Jacob glorify him <u>19\_PSA\_22\_23</u># Ye that fear the LORD, praise him; all ye the seed of Jacob, glorify him; and fear him, all ye the seed of Israel.

Jacob his chosen <u>19\_PSA\_105\_06</u> # O ye seed of Abraham his servant, ye children of Jacob his chosen.

Jacob his father <u>01\_GEN\_47\_07</u># And Joseph brought in Jacob his father, and set him before Pharaoh: and Jacob blessed Pharaoh.

Jacob his people <u>19\_PSA\_78\_71</u># From following the ewes great with young he brought him to feed Jacob his people, and Israel his inheritance.

Jacob set up <u>01\_GEN\_35\_14</u> # And Jacob set up a pillar in the place where he talked with him, [even] a pillar of stone: and he poured a drink offering thereon, and he poured oil thereon.

Jacob shall be <u>05\_DEU\_33\_28</u># Israel then shall dwell in safety alone: the fountain of Jacob [shall be] upon a land of corn and wine; also his heavens shall drop down dew.

Jacob shall be 23\_ISA\_17\_04 # And in that day it shall come to pass, [that] the glory of Jacob shall be made

thin, and the fatness of his flesh shall wax lean.

Jacob Simeon and <u>01\_GEN\_34\_25</u> # And it came to pass on the third day, when they were sore, that two of the sons of Jacob, Simeon and Levi, Dinah's brethren, took each man his sword, and came upon the city boldly, and slew all the males.

Jacob sod pottage <u>01\_GEN\_25\_29</u> # And Jacob sod pottage: and Esau came from the field, and he [was] faint:

Jacob sojourned in <u>19\_PSA\_105\_23</u> # Israel also came into Egypt; and Jacob sojourned in the land of Ham.

Jacob stole away <u>01\_GEN\_31\_20</u># And Jacob stole away unawares to Laban the Syrian, in that he told him not that he fled.

Jacob Surely I <u>30\_AMO\_08\_07</u># The LORD hath sworn by the excellency of Jacob, Surely I will never forget any of their works.

Jacob sware by <u>01\_GEN\_31\_53</u># The God of Abraham, and the God of Nahor, the God of their father, judge betwixt us. And Jacob sware by the fear of his father Isaac.

Jacob take a <u>01\_GEN\_27\_46</u> # And Rebekah said to Isaac, I am weary of my life because of the daughters of Heth: if Jacob take a wife of the daughters of Heth, such as these [which are] of the daughters of the land, what good shall my life do me?

Jacob that his <u>25\_LAM\_01\_17</u> # Zion spreadeth forth her hands, [and there is] none to comfort her: the LORD hath commanded concerning Jacob, [that] his adversaries [should be] round about him: Jerusalem is as a menstruous woman among them.

Jacob the fifth <u>01\_GEN\_30\_17</u># And God hearkened unto Leah, and she conceived, and bare Jacob the fifth son.

Jacob the God <u>44\_ACT\_03\_13</u> # The God of Abraham, and of Isaac, and of Jacob, the God of our fathers, hath glorified his Son Jesus; whom ye delivered up, and denied him in the presence of Pilate, when he was determined to let [him] go.

Jacob the heirs <u>58\_HEB\_11\_09</u># By faith he sojourned in the land of promise, as [in] a strange country, dwelling in tabernacles with Isaac and Jacob, the heirs with him of the same promise:

Jacob the sixth <u>01\_GEN\_30\_19</u># And Leah conceived again, and bare Jacob the sixth son.

Jacob their sins <u>23\_ISA\_58\_01</u> # Cry aloud, spare not, lift up thy voice like a trumpet, and show my people their transgression, and the house of Jacob their sins.

Jacob Then Moses <u>44\_ACT\_07\_32</u> # [Saying], I [am] the God of thy fathers, the God of Abraham, and the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob. Then Moses trembled, and durst not behold.

Jacob These daughters <u>01\_GEN\_31\_43</u># And Laban answered and said unto Jacob, [These] daughters

[are] my daughters, and [these] children [are] my children, and [these] cattle [are] my cattle, and all that thou seest [is] mine: and what can I do this day unto these my daughters, or unto their children which they have born?

Jacob thy father <u>23\_ISA\_58\_14</u> # Then shalt thou delight thyself in the LORD; and I will cause thee to ride upon the high places of the earth, and feed thee with the heritage of Jacob thy father: for the mouth of the LORD hath spoken [it].

Jacob thy judgments <u>05\_DEU\_33\_10</u> # They shall teach Jacob thy judgments, and Israel thy law: they shall put incense before thee, and whole burnt sacrifice upon thine altar.

Jacob took a <u>01\_GEN\_31\_45</u> # And Jacob took a stone, and set it up [for] a pillar.

Jacob took him <u>01\_GEN\_30\_37</u># And Jacob took him rods of green poplar, and of the hazel and chestnut tree; and pilled white streaks in them, and made the white appear which [was] in the rods.

Jacob unto himself <u>19\_PSA\_135\_04</u> # For the LORD hath chosen Jacob unto himself, [and] Israel for his peculiar treasure.

Jacob unto the <u>23\_ISA\_10\_21</u># The remnant shall return, [even] the remnant of Jacob, unto the mighty God.

Jacob unto the <u>19\_PSA\_59\_13</u># Consume [them] in wrath, consume [them], that they [may] not [be]: and

let them know that God ruleth in Jacob unto the ends of the earth. Selah.

Jacob unto whom <u>11\_1KI\_18\_31</u># And Elijah took twelve stones, according to the number of the tribes of the sons of Jacob, unto whom the word of the LORD came, saying, Israel shall be thy name:

Jacob vowed a <u>01\_GEN\_28\_20</u># And Jacob vowed a vow, saying, If God will be with me, and will keep me in this way that I go, and will give me bread to eat, and raiment to put on,

Jacob was a <u>01\_GEN\_25\_27</u># And the boys grew: and Esau was a cunning hunter, a man of the field; and Jacob [was] a plain man, dwelling in tents.

Jacob was an <u>01\_GEN\_47\_28</u># And Jacob lived in the land of Egypt seventeen years: so the whole age of Jacob was an hundred forty and seven years.

Jacob was come <u>09\_1SA\_12\_08</u> # When Jacob was come into Egypt, and your fathers cried unto the LORD, then the LORD sent Moses and Aaron, which brought forth your fathers out of Egypt, and made them dwell in this place.

Jacob was fled <u>01\_GEN\_31\_22</u># And it was told Laban on the third day that Jacob was fled.

Jacob was greatly <u>01\_GEN\_32\_07</u># Then Jacob was greatly afraid and distressed: and he divided the people that [was] with him, and the flocks, and herds, and the camels, into two bands;

Jacob was left <u>01\_GEN\_32\_24</u># And Jacob was left alone; and there wrestled a man with him until the breaking of the day.

Jacob was wroth <u>01\_GEN\_31\_36</u># And Jacob was wroth, and chided with Laban: and Jacob answered and said to Laban, What [is] my trespass? what [is] my sin, that thou hast so hotly pursued after me?

Jacob was yet <u>01\_GEN\_27\_30</u># And it came to pass, as soon as Isaac had made an end of blessing Jacob, and Jacob was yet scarce gone out from the presence of Isaac his father, that Esau his brother came in from his hunting.

Jacob went out <u>01\_GEN\_34\_01</u> # And Dinah the daughter of Leah, which she bare unto Jacob, went out to see the daughters of the land.

Jacob were seventy <u>02\_EXO\_01\_05</u># And all the souls that came out of the loins of Jacob were seventy souls: for Joseph was in Egypt [already].

Jacob were twelve <u>01\_GEN\_35\_22</u> # And it came to pass, when Israel dwelt in that land, that Reuben went and lay with Bilhah his father's concubine: and Israel heard [it]. Now the sons of Jacob were twelve:

Jacob What hast <u>01\_GEN\_31\_26</u># And Laban said to Jacob, What hast thou done, that thou hast stolen away unawares to me, and carried away my daughters, as captives [taken] with the sword?

Jacob when he <u>58\_HEB\_11\_21</u># By faith Jacob, when he was a dying, blessed both the sons of Joseph; and worshipped, [leaning] upon the top of his staff.

Jacob which are 23\_ISA\_48\_01 # Hear ye this, O house of Jacob, which are called by the name of Israel, and are come forth out of the waters of Judah, which swear by the name of the LORD, and make mention of the God of Israel, [but] not in truth, nor in righteousness.

Jacob which came <u>01\_GEN\_46\_27</u> # And the sons of Joseph, which were born him in Egypt, [were] two souls: all the souls of the house of Jacob, which came into Egypt, [were] threescore and ten.

Jacob which gave <u>43\_JOH\_04\_12</u> # Art thou greater than our father Jacob, which gave us the well, and drank thereof himself, and his children, and his cattle?

Jacob which was <u>42\_LUK\_03\_34</u> # Which was [the son] of Jacob, which was [the son] of Isaac, which was [the son] of Abraham, which was [the son] of Thara, which was [the son] of Nachor,

Jacob which were <u>01\_GEN\_35\_26</u># And the sons of Zilpah, Leah's handmaid; Gad, and Asher: these [are] the sons of Jacob, which were born to him in Padanaram.

Jacob whom he <u>12\_2KI\_17\_34</u> # Unto this day they do after the former manners: they fear not the LORD, neither do they after their statutes, or after their ordinances, or after the law and commandment which the LORD commanded the children of Jacob, whom he named Israel;

Jacob whom he <u>19\_PSA\_47\_04</u> # He shall choose our inheritance for us, the excellency of Jacob whom he loved. Selah.

Jacob whom I <u>23\_ISA\_41\_08</u># But thou, Israel, [art] my servant, Jacob whom I have chosen, the seed of Abraham my friend.
