

## KJV Bible linked to Three Phrase Concordance

Josiah and all <u>14\_2CH\_35\_25</u> # And Jeremiah lamented for Josiah: and all the singing men and the singing women spake of Josiah in their lamentations to this day, and made them an ordinance in Israel: and, behold, they [are] written in the lamentations.

Josiah and all <u>12\_2KI\_23\_28</u> # Now the rest of the acts of Josiah, and all that he did, [are] they not written in the book of the chronicles of the kings of Judah?

Josiah and anointed <u>12\_2KI\_23\_30</u> # And his servants carried him in a chariot dead from Megiddo, and brought him to Jerusalem, and buried him in his own sepulchre. And the people of the land took Jehoahaz the son of Josiah, and anointed him, and made him king in his father's stead.

Josiah and his <u>14\_2CH\_35\_26</u># Now the rest of the acts of Josiah, and his goodness, according to [that which was] written in the law of the LORD,

Josiah and made <u>14\_2CH\_36\_01</u># Then the people of the land took Jehoahaz the son of Josiah, and made him king in his father's stead in Jerusalem.

Josiah and the <u>14\_2CH\_35\_23</u># And the archers shot at king Josiah; and the king said to his servants, Have me away; for I am sore wounded.

Josiah gave to <u>14\_2CH\_35\_07</u> # And Josiah gave to the people, of the flock, lambs and kids, all for the passover offerings, for all that were present, to the number of thirty thousand, and three thousand bullocks: these [were] of the king's substance.

Josiah had prepared <u>14\_2CH\_35\_20</u># After all this, when Josiah had prepared the temple, Necho king of Egypt came up to fight against Charchemish by Euphrates: and Josiah went out against him.

Josiah his father <u>12\_2KI\_23\_34</u> # And Pharaohnechoh made Eliakim the son of Josiah king in the room of Josiah his father, and turned his name to Jehoiakim, and took Jehoahaz away: and he came to Egypt, and died there.

Josiah his father <u>24\_JER\_22\_11</u># For thus saith the LORD touching Shallum the son of Josiah king of Judah, which reigned instead of Josiah his father, which went forth out of this place; He shall not return thither any more:

Josiah kept a <u>14\_2CH\_35\_01</u> # Moreover Josiah kept a passover unto the LORD in Jerusalem: and they killed the passover on the fourteenth [day] of the first month.

Josiah kept and <u>14\_2CH\_35\_18</u># And there was no passover like to that kept in Israel from the days of Samuel the prophet; neither did all the kings of Israel keep such a passover as Josiah kept, and the priests, and the Levites, and all Judah and Israel that were present, and the inhabitants of Jerusalem.

Josiah king in <u>12\_2KI\_23\_34</u># And Pharaohnechoh made Eliakim the son of Josiah king in the room of Josiah his father, and turned his name to Jehoiakim, and took Jehoahaz away: and he came to Egypt, and died there.

Josiah king of 24\_JER\_36\_09 # And it came to pass in the fifth year of Jehoiakim the son of Josiah king of

Judah, in the ninth month, [that] they proclaimed a fast before the LORD to all the people in Jerusalem, and to all the people that came from the cities of Judah unto Jerusalem.

Josiah king of <u>24\_JER\_45\_01</u> # The word that Jeremiah the prophet spake unto Baruch the son of Neriah, when he had written these words in a book at the mouth of Jeremiah, in the fourth year of Jehoiakim the son of Josiah king of Judah, saying,

Josiah king of 24\_JER\_46\_02 # Against Egypt, against the army of Pharaohnecho king of Egypt, which was by the river Euphrates in Carchemish, which Nebuchadrezzar king of Babylon smote in the fourth year of Jehoiakim the son of Josiah king of Judah.

Josiah put away <u>12\_2KI\_23\_24</u> # Moreover the [workers with] familiar spirits, and the wizards, and the images, and the idols, and all the abominations that were spied in the land of Judah and in Jerusalem, did Josiah put away, that he might perform the words of the law which were written in the book that Hilkiah the priest found in the house of the LORD.

Josiah reigned instead <u>24\_JER\_37\_01</u> # And king Zedekiah the son of Josiah reigned instead of Coniah the son of Jehoiakim, whom Nebuchadrezzar king of Babylon made king in the land of Judah.

Josiah that the <u>12\_2KI\_22\_03</u># And it came to pass in the eighteenth year of king Josiah, [that] the king sent Shaphan the son of Azaliah, the son of Meshullam, the scribe, to the house of the LORD, saying,

Josiah the king <u>24\_JER\_03\_06</u> # The LORD said also unto me in the days of Josiah the king, Hast thou seen [that] which backsliding Israel hath done? she is gone up upon every high mountain and under every green tree, and there hath played the harlot.

Josiah the son 24\_JER\_01\_02 # To whom the word of the LORD came in the days of Josiah the son of Amon king of Judah, in the thirteenth year of his reign.

Josiah the son 24\_JER\_25\_03 # From the thirteenth year of Josiah the son of Amon king of Judah, even unto this day, that [is] the three and twentieth year, the word of the LORD hath come unto me, and I have spoken unto you, rising early and speaking; but ye have not hearkened.

Josiah the son <u>38\_ZEC\_06\_10</u># Take of [them of] the captivity, [even] of Heldai, of Tobijah, and of Jedaiah, which are come from Babylon, and come thou the same day, and go into the house of Josiah the son of Zephaniah;

Josiah the son <u>36\_ZEP\_01\_01</u> # The word of the LORD which came unto Zephaniah the son of Cushi, the son of Gedaliah, the son of Amariah, the son of Hizkiah, in the days of Josiah the son of Amon, king of Judah.

Josiah took away <u>14\_2CH\_34\_33</u> # And Josiah took away all the abominations out of all the countries that [pertained] to the children of Israel, and made all that were present in Israel to serve, [even] to serve the LORD their God. [And] all his days they departed not from following the LORD, the God of their fathers.

Josiah took away <u>12\_2KI\_23\_19</u># And all the houses also of the high places that [were] in the cities of Samaria, which the kings of Israel had made to provoke [the LORD] to anger, Josiah took away, and did to them according to all the acts that he had done in Bethel.

Josiah turned himself <u>12\_2KI\_23\_16</u> # And as Josiah turned himself, he spied the sepulchres that [were] there in the mount, and sent, and took the bones out of the sepulchres, and burned [them] upon the altar, and polluted it, according to the word of the LORD which the man of God proclaimed, who proclaimed these words.

Josiah was eight <u>14\_2CH\_34\_01</u> # Josiah [was] eight years old when he began to reign, and he reigned in

Jerusalem one and thirty years.

Josiah was eight <u>12\_2KI\_22\_01</u> # Josiah [was] eight years old when he began to reign, and he reigned thirty and one years in Jerusalem. And his mother's name [was] Jedidah, the daughter of Adaiah of Boscath.

Josiah was this <u>14\_2CH\_35\_19</u> # In the eighteenth year of the reign of Josiah was this passover kept.

Josiah went against <u>12\_2KI\_23\_29</u># In his days Pharaohnechoh king of Egypt went up against the king of Assyria to the river Euphrates: and king Josiah went against him; and he slew him at Megiddo, when he had seen him.

Josiah went out <u>14\_2CH\_35\_20</u> # After all this, when Josiah had prepared the temple, Necho king of Egypt came up to fight against Charchemish by Euphrates: and Josiah went out against him.

Josiah were the <u>13\_1CH\_03\_15</u># And the sons of Josiah [were], the firstborn Johanan, the second Jehoiakim, the third Zedekiah, the fourth Shallum.

Josiah wherein this <u>12\_2KI\_23\_23</u># But in the eighteenth year of king Josiah, [wherein] this passover was holden to the LORD in Jerusalem.

Josiah would not <u>14\_2CH\_35\_22</u> # Nevertheless Josiah would not turn his face from him, but disguised himself, that he might fight with him, and hearkened not unto the words of Necho from the mouth of God, and came to fight in the valley of Megiddo.

Josiah <u>14\_2CH\_35\_16</u># So all the service of the LORD was prepared the same day, to keep the passover, and to offer burnt offerings upon the altar of the LORD, according to the commandment of king Josiah.

Josiah <u>14\_2CH\_35\_24</u> # His servants therefore took him out of that chariot, and put him in the second chariot that he had; and they brought him to Jerusalem, and he died, and was buried in [one of] the sepulchres of his fathers. And all Judah and Jerusalem mourned for Josiah.
