kindle the fire <u>26\_EZE\_24\_10</u># Heap on wood, kindle the fire, consume the flesh, and spice it well, and let the bones be burned.

kindle the fire <u>24\_JER\_07\_18</u># The children gather wood, and the fathers kindle the fire, and the women knead [their] dough, to make cakes to the queen of heaven, and to pour out drink offerings unto other gods, that they may provoke me to anger.

kindled against Moses <u>02\_EXO\_04\_14</u> # And the anger of the LORD was kindled against Moses, and he said, [Is] not Aaron the Levite thy brother? I know that he can speak well. And also, behold, he cometh forth to meet thee: and when he seeth thee, he will be glad in his heart.
