loose he giveth 01_GEN_49_21 # Naphtali [is] a hind let loose: he giveth goodly words.

Loose him and 43_JOH_11_44# And he that was dead came forth, bound hand and foot with graveclothes: and his face was bound about with a napkin. Jesus saith unto them, Loose him, and let him go.

loose him and <u>42_LUK_19_30</u> # Saying, Go ye into the village over against [you]; in the which at your entering ye shall find a colt tied, whereon yet never man sat: loose him, and bring [him hither].

loose him and 41_MAR_11_02 # And saith unto them, Go your way into the village over against you: and as soon as ye be entered into it, ye shall find a colt tied, whereon never man sat; loose him, and bring [him].

loose him thus <u>42_LUK_19_31</u> # And if any man ask you, Why do ye loose [him]? thus shall ye say unto him, Because the Lord hath need of him.

loose him wherefore 44_ACT_24_26 # He hoped also that money should have been given him of Paul, that he might loose him: wherefore he sent for him the oftener, and communed with him.

loose him <u>41_MAR_11_04</u># And they went their way, and found the colt tied by the door without in a place where two ways met; and they loose him.

loose his hand <u>18_JOB_06_09</u># Even that it would please God to destroy me; that he would let loose his hand, and cut me off!

loose his ox <u>42_LUK_13_15</u> # The Lord then answered him, and said, [Thou] hypocrite, doth not each one of you on the sabbath loose his ox or [his] ass from the stall, and lead [him] away to watering?

loose the bridle <u>18_JOB_30_11</u># Because he hath loosed my cord, and afflicted me, they have also let loose the bridle before me.

Loose the four <u>66_REV_09_14</u> # Saying to the sixth angel which had the trumpet, Loose the four angels which are bound in the great river Euphrates.

loose the loins 23 ISA 45 01 # Thus saith the LORD to his anointed, to Cyrus, whose right hand I have holden, to subdue nations before him; and I will loose the loins of kings, to open before him the two leaved gates; and the gates shall not be shut;

loose the sackcloth <u>23_ISA_20_02</u> # At the same time spake the LORD by Isaiah the son of Amoz, saying, Go and loose the sackcloth from off thy loins, and put off thy shoe from thy foot. And he did so, walking naked and barefoot.

loosed nor the <u>23_ISA_05_27</u> # None shall be weary nor stumble among them; none shall slumber nor sleep; neither shall the girdle of their loins be loosed, nor the latchet of their shoes be broken:

loosed or the <u>21_ECC_12_06</u># Or ever the silver cord be loosed, or the golden bowl be broken, or the pitcher be broken at the fountain, or the wheel broken at the cistern.
