loose he giveth [01\\_GEN\\_49\\_21](#) # Naphtali [is] a hind let loose: he giveth goodly words.

Loose him and [43\\_JOH\\_11\\_44](#) # And he that was dead came forth, bound hand and foot with graveclothes: and his face was bound about with a napkin. Jesus saith unto them, Loose him, and let him go.

loose him and [42\\_LUK\\_19\\_30](#) # Saying, Go ye into the village over against [you]; in the which at your entering ye shall find a colt tied, whereon yet never man sat: loose him, and bring [him hither].

loose him and [41\\_MAR\\_11\\_02](#) # And saith unto them, Go your way into the village over against you: and as soon as ye be entered into it, ye shall find a colt tied, whereon never man sat; loose him, and bring [him].
