Lystra and behold <u>44_ACT_16_01</u> # Then came he to Derbe and Lystra: and, behold, a certain disciple was there, named Timotheus, the son of a certain woman, which was a Jewess, and believed; but his father [was] a Greek:

Lystra and Derbe <u>44_ACT_14_06</u># They were ware of [it], and fled unto Lystra and Derbe, cities of Lycaonia, and unto the region that lieth round about:

Lystra and Iconium <u>44_ACT_16_02</u> # Which was well reported of by the brethren that were at Lystra and Iconium.

Lystra and to <u>44_ACT_14_21</u> # And when they had preached the gospel to that city, and had taught many, they returned again to Lystra, and [to] Iconium, and Antioch,

Lystra impotent in <u>44_ACT_14_08</u> # And there sat a certain man at Lystra, impotent in his feet, being a cripple from his mother's womb, who never had walked:

Lystra what persecutions <u>55_2TI_03_11</u># Persecutions, afflictions, which came unto me at Antioch, at Iconium, at Lystra; what persecutions I endured: but out of [them] all the Lord delivered me.
