lacked for as <u>44_ACT_04_34</u> # Neither was there any among them that lacked: for as many as were possessors of lands or houses sold them, and brought the prices of the things that were sold,

lacked moisture <u>42_LUK_08_06</u> # And some fell upon a rock; and as soon as it was sprung up, it withered away, because it lacked moisture.

lacked not one <u>10_2SA_17_22</u> # Then David arose, and all the people that [were] with him, and they passed over Jordan: by the morning light there lacked not one of them that was not gone over Jordan.

lacked nothing their <u>16_NEH_09_21</u># Yea, forty years didst thou sustain them in the wilderness, [so that] they lacked nothing; their clothes waxed not old, and their feet swelled not.

lacked nothing <u>11_1KI_04_27</u># And those officers provided victual for king Solomon, and for all that came unto king Solomon's table, every man in his month: they lacked nothing.

lacked nothing <u>05_DEU_02_07</u># For the LORD thy God hath blessed thee in all the works of thy hand: he knoweth thy walking through this great wilderness: these forty years the LORD thy God [hath been] with thee; thou hast lacked nothing.

lacked of David's <u>10_2SA_02_30</u> # And Joab returned from following Abner: and when he had gathered all the people together, there lacked of David's servants nineteen men and Asahel.

lacked opportunity <u>50_PHP_04_10</u># But I rejoiced in the Lord greatly, that now at the last your care of me hath flourished again; wherein ye were also careful, but ye lacked opportunity.

lacked with me <u>11_1KI_11_22</u># Then Pharaoh said unto him, But what hast thou lacked with me, that, behold, thou seekest to go to thine own country? And he answered, Nothing: howbeit let me go in any wise.

lacked ye any <u>42_LUK_22_35</u># And he said unto them, When I sent you without purse, and scrip, and shoes, lacked ye any thing? And they said, Nothing.

lacked <u>46_1CO_12_24</u> # For our comely [parts] have no need: but God hath tempered the body together, having given more abundant honour to that [part] which lacked:
