blame before him <u>49_EPH_01_04</u> # According as he hath chosen us in him before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and without blame before him in love:

blame for ever <u>01_GEN_43_09</u> # I will be surety for him; of my hand shalt thou require him: if I bring him not unto thee, and set him before thee, then let me bear the blame for ever:

blame to my <u>01_GEN_44_32</u># For thy servant became surety for the lad unto my father, saying, If I bring him not unto thee, then I shall bear the blame to my father for ever.

blame us in <u>47_2CO_08_20</u> # Avoiding this, that no man should blame us in this abundance which is administered by us:

blamed <u>47_2CO_06_03</u># Giving no offence in any thing, that the ministry be not blamed:

blamed <u>48_GAL_02_11</u># But when Peter was come to Antioch, I withstood him to the face, because he was to be blamed.

blameless and harmless <u>50_PHP_02_15</u> # That ye may be blameless and harmless, the sons of God, without rebuke, in the midst of a crooked and perverse nation, among whom ye shine as lights in the world;

blameless as the <u>56_TIT_01_07</u> # For a bishop must be blameless, as the steward of God; not selfwilled, not soon angry, not given to wine, no striker, not given to filthy lucre;

blameless in the <u>46_1CO_01_08</u># Who shall also confirm you unto the end, [that ye may be] blameless in the day of our Lord Jesus Christ.

blameless of this <u>06_JOS_02_17</u># And the men said unto her, We [will be] blameless of this thine oath which thou hast made us swear.

blameless than the <u>07_JUD_15_03</u> # And Samson said concerning them, Now shall I be more blameless than the Philistines, though I do them a displeasure.

blameless the husband <u>54_1TI_03_02</u> # A bishop then must be blameless, the husband of one wife, vigilant, sober, of good behaviour, given to hospitality, apt to teach;

blameless the husband <u>56_TIT_01_06</u># If any be blameless, the husband of one wife, having faithful children not accused of riot or unruly.

blameless unto the <u>52_1TH_05_23</u># And the very God of peace sanctify you wholly; and [I pray God] your whole spirit and soul and body be preserved blameless unto the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ.

blameless <u>54_1TI_03_10</u> # And let these also first be proved; then let them use the office of a deacon, being [found] blameless.

blameless <u>54_1TI_05_07</u> # And these things give in charge, that they may be blameless.

blameless <u>50_PHP_03_06</u># Concerning zeal, persecuting the church; touching the righteousness which is in the law, blameless.

flame and his <u>27_DAN_07_09</u># I beheld till the thrones were cast down, and the Ancient of days did sit, whose garment [was] white as snow, and the hair of his head like the pure wool: his throne [was like] the fiery flame, [and] his wheels [as] burning fire.

flame and it <u>23_ISA_10_17</u> # And the light of Israel shall be for a fire, and his Holy One for a flame: and it shall burn and devour his thorns and his briers in one day;

flame and the <u>31_OBA_01_18</u># And the house of Jacob shall be a fire, and the house of Joseph a flame, and the house of Esau for stubble, and they shall kindle in them, and devour them; and there shall not be [any] remaining of the house of Esau; for the LORD hath spoken [it].

flame of fire <u>66_REV_01_14</u> # His head and [his] hairs [were] white like wool, as white as snow; and his eyes [were] as a flame of fire;

flame of fire <u>66_REV_02_18</u> # And unto the angel of the church in Thyatira write; These things saith the Son of God, who hath his eyes like unto a flame of fire, and his feet [are] like fine brass;

flame of fire <u>66_REV_19_12</u> # His eyes [were] as a flame of fire, and on his head [were] many crowns; and he had a name written, that no man knew, but he himself.

flame of the <u>27_DAN_03_22</u># Therefore because the king's commandment was urgent, and the furnace exceeding hot, the flame of the fire slew those men that took up Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego.

flame <u>22_SON_08_06</u># Set me as a seal upon thine heart, as a seal upon thine arm: for love [is] strong as death; jealousy [is] cruel as the grave: the coals thereof [are] coals of fire, [which hath a] most vehement flame.

flames of fire <u>23_ISA_66_15</u># For, behold, the LORD will come with fire, and with his chariots like a whirlwind, to render his anger with fury, and his rebuke with flames of fire.

flames of fire <u>19_PSA_29_07</u> # The voice of the LORD divideth the flames of fire.

flames <u>23_ISA_13_08</u> # And they shall be afraid: pangs and sorrows shall take hold of them; they shall be in pain as a woman that travaileth: they shall be amazed one at another; their faces [shall be as] flames.

inflame them <u>23_ISA_05_11</u> # Woe unto them that rise up early in the morning, [that] they may follow strong drink; that continue until night, [till] wine inflame them!

lament and howl 24_JER_04_08 # For this gird you with sackcloth, lament and howl: for the fierce anger of the LORD is not turned back from us.

lament and mourn 23_ISA_03_26 # And her gates shall lament and mourn; and she [being] desolate shall sit upon the ground.

lament and run 24_JER_49_03 # Howl, O Heshbon, for Ai is spoiled: cry, ye daughters of Rabbah, gird you with sackcloth; lament, and run to and fro by the hedges; for their king shall go into captivity, [and] his priests and his princes together.

lament and they <u>23_ISA_19_08</u># The fishers also shall mourn, and all they that cast angle into the brooks shall lament, and they that spread nets upon the waters shall languish.

lament over thee <u>26_EZE_27_32</u> # And in their wailing they shall take up a lamentation for thee, and lament over thee, [saying], What [city is] like Tyrus, like the destroyed in the midst of the sea?

lament the daughter <u>07_JUD_11_40</u># [That] the daughters of Israel went yearly to lament the daughter of Jephthah the Gileadite four days in a year.
