breastplate and an <u>02_EXO_28_04</u> # And these [are] the garments which they shall make; a breastplate, and an ephod, and a robe, and a broidered coat, a mitre, and a girdle: and they shall make holy garments for Aaron thy brother, and his sons, that he may minister unto me in the priest's office.

breastplate and an <u>23_ISA_59_17</u> # For he put on righteousness as a breastplate, and an helmet of salvation upon his head; and he put on the garments of vengeance [for] clothing, and was clad with zeal as a cloak.

breastplate and gird <u>02_EXO_29_05</u> # And thou shalt take the garments, and put upon Aaron the coat, and the robe of the ephod, and the ephod, and the breastplate, and gird him with the curious girdle of the ephod:

breastplate double a <u>02_EXO_39_09</u># It was foursquare; they made the breastplate double: a span [was] the length thereof, and a span the breadth thereof, [being] doubled.

breastplate in the <u>02_EXO_28_26</u> # And thou shalt make two rings of gold, and thou shalt put them upon the two ends of the breastplate in the border thereof, which [is] in the side of the ephod inward.

breastplate might not <u>02_EXO_39_21</u> # And they did bind the breastplate by his rings unto the rings of the ephod with a lace of blue, that it might be above the curious girdle of the ephod, and that the breastplate might not be loosed from the ephod; as the LORD commanded Moses.

breastplate of judgment <u>02_EXO_28_29</u># And Aaron shall bear the names of the children of Israel in the breastplate of judgment upon his heart, when he goeth in unto the holy [place], for a memorial before the LORD continually.

breastplate of judgment <u>02_EXO_28_30</u> # And thou shalt put in the breastplate of judgment the Urim and the Thummim; and they shall be upon Aaron's heart, when he goeth in before the LORD: and Aaron shall bear the judgment of the children of Israel upon his heart before the LORD continually.

breastplate of righteousness <u>49_EPH_06_14</u> # Stand therefore, having your loins girt about with truth, and having on the breastplate of righteousness;

breastplate <u>02_EXO_39_16</u> # And they made two ouches [of] gold, and two gold rings; and put the two rings in the two ends of the breastplate.

breastplate <u>02_EXO_39_17</u># And they put the two wreathen chains of gold in the two rings on the ends of the breastplate.

breastplates as it <u>66_REV_09_09</u># And they had breastplates, as it were breastplates of iron; and the sound of their wings [was] as the sound of chariots of many horses running to battle.

breastplates of fire <u>66_REV_09_17</u> # And thus I saw the horses in the vision, and them that sat on them, having breastplates of fire, and of jacinth, and brimstone: and the heads of the horses [were] as the heads of lions; and out of their mouths issued fire and smoke and brimstone.

desolate a captive <u>23_ISA_49_21</u> # Then shalt thou say in thine heart, Who hath begotten me these, seeing I have lost my children, and am desolate, a captive, and removing to and fro? and who hath brought up these? Behold, I was left alone; these, where [had] they [been]?

desolate a land <u>24_JER_06_08</u># Be thou instructed, O Jerusalem, lest my soul depart from thee; lest I make thee desolate, a land not inhabited.

desolate after them <u>38_ZEC_07_14</u># But I scattered them with a whirlwind among all the nations whom they knew not. Thus the land was desolate after them, that no man passed through nor returned: for they laid the pleasant land desolate.

Pilate and begged <u>42_LUK_23_52</u> # This [man] went unto Pilate, and begged the body of Jesus.

Pilate and begged <u>40_MAT_27_58</u># He went to Pilate, and begged the body of Jesus. Then Pilate commanded the body to be delivered.

Pilate and craved <u>41_MAR_15_43</u># Joseph of Arimathaea, an honourable counsellor, which also waited for the kingdom of God, came, and went in boldly unto Pilate, and craved the body of Jesus.

Pilate and Herod <u>42_LUK_23_12</u># And the same day Pilate and Herod were made friends together: for before they were at enmity between themselves.

Pilate answered Am <u>43_JOH_18_35</u> # Pilate answered, Am I a Jew? Thine own nation and the chief priests have delivered thee unto me: what hast thou done?

Pilate answered and <u>41_MAR_15_12</u># And Pilate answered and said again unto them, What will ye then that I shall do [unto him] whom ye call the King of the Jews?

Pilate answered them <u>41_MAR_15_09</u># But Pilate answered them, saying, Will ye that I release unto you the King of the Jews?

Pilate answered What <u>43_JOH_19_22</u> # Pilate answered, What I have written I have written.

Pilate asked him <u>42_LUK_23_03</u># And Pilate asked him, saying, Art thou the King of the Jews? And he answered him and said, Thou sayest [it].

Pilate asked him <u>41_MAR_15_02</u> # And Pilate asked him, Art thou the King of the Jews? And he answering said unto him, Thou sayest [it].

Pilate asked him <u>41_MAR_15_04</u> # And Pilate asked him again, saying, Answerest thou nothing? behold how many things they witness against thee.

Pilate being governor <u>42_LUK_03_01</u> # Now in the fifteenth year of the reign of Tiberius Caesar, Pontius Pilate being governor of Judaea, and Herod being tetrarch of Galilee, and his brother Philip tetrarch of Ituraea and of the region of Trachonitis, and Lysanias the tetrarch of Abilene,

Pilate commanded the <u>40_MAT_27_58</u># He went to Pilate, and begged the body of Jesus. Then Pilate commanded the body to be delivered.

Pilate entered into <u>43_JOH_18_33</u># Then Pilate entered into the judgment hall again, and called Jesus, and said unto him, Art thou the King of the Jews?

Pilate gave him <u>43_JOH_19_38</u> # And after this Joseph of Arimathaea, being a disciple of Jesus, but secretly for fear of the Jews, besought Pilate that he might take away the body of Jesus: and Pilate gave [him] leave. He came therefore, and took the body of Jesus.

Pilate gave sentence <u>42_LUK_23_24</u> # And Pilate gave sentence that it should be as they required.

Pilate had mingled <u>42_LUK_13_01</u># There were present at that season some that told him of the Galilaeans, whose blood Pilate had mingled with their sacrifices.

Pilate heard of <u>42_LUK_23_06</u> # When Pilate heard of Galilee, he asked whether the man were a Galilaean.

Pilate marvelled if <u>41_MAR_15_44</u> # And Pilate marvelled if he were already dead: and calling [unto him] the centurion, he asked him whether he had been any while dead.

Pilate marvelled <u>41_MAR_15_05</u> # But Jesus yet answered nothing; so that Pilate marvelled.

Pilate said unto <u>41_MAR_15_14</u> # Then Pilate said unto them, Why, what evil hath he done? And they cried out the more exceedingly, Crucify him.

Pilate said unto <u>40_MAT_27_17</u># Therefore when they were gathered together, Pilate said unto them, Whom will ye that I release unto you? Barabbas, or Jesus which is called Christ?

Pilate said unto <u>40_MAT_27_65</u># Pilate said unto them, Ye have a watch: go your way, make [it] as sure as ye can.

Pilate saith unto <u>43_JOH_18_38</u> # Pilate saith unto him, What is truth? And when he had said this, he went out again unto the Jews, and saith unto them, I find in him no fault [at all].

Pilate saith unto <u>43_JOH_19_05</u> # Then came Jesus forth, wearing the crown of thorns, and the purple robe. And [Pilate] saith unto them, Behold the man!

Pilate saith unto <u>43_JOH_19_06</u> # When the chief priests therefore and officers saw him, they cried out, saying, Crucify [him], crucify [him]. Pilate saith unto them, Take ye him, and crucify [him]: for I find no fault in him.

Pilate saith unto <u>43_JOH_19_15</u># But they cried out, Away with [him], away with [him], crucify him. Pilate saith unto them, Shall I crucify your King? The chief priests answered, We have no king but Caesar.

Pilate saith unto <u>40_MAT_27_22</u># Pilate saith unto them, What shall I do then with Jesus which is called Christ? [They] all say unto him, Let him be crucified.

Pilate saw that <u>40_MAT_27_24</u># When Pilate saw that he could prevail nothing, but [that] rather a tumult was made, he took water, and washed [his] hands before the multitude, saying, I am innocent of the blood of this just person: see ye [to it].

Pilate sought to <u>43_JOH_19_12</u> # And from thenceforth Pilate sought to release him: but the Jews cried out, saying, If thou let this man go, thou art not Caesar's friend: whosoever maketh himself a king speaketh against Caesar.

Pilate that he <u>44_ACT_13_28</u> # And though they found no cause of death [in him], yet desired they Pilate that he should be slain.

Pilate that he <u>43_JOH_19_38</u> # And after this Joseph of Arimathaea, being a disciple of Jesus, but secretly for fear of the Jews, besought Pilate that he might take away the body of Jesus: and Pilate gave [him] leave. He came therefore, and took the body of Jesus.

Pilate that their <u>43_JOH_19_31</u> # The Jews therefore, because it was the preparation, that the bodies should not remain upon the cross on the sabbath day, [for that sabbath day was an high day,] besought Pilate that their legs might be broken, and [that] they might be taken away.

Pilate the governor <u>40_MAT_27_02</u># And when they had bound him, they led [him] away, and delivered him to Pontius Pilate the governor.

Pilate then went <u>43_JOH_18_29</u> # Pilate then went out unto them, and said, What accusation bring ye against this man?

Pilate therefore heard <u>43_JOH_19_08</u> # When Pilate therefore heard that saying, he was the more afraid;

Pilate therefore heard <u>43_JOH_19_13</u> # When Pilate therefore heard that saying, he brought Jesus forth, and sat down in the judgment seat in a place that is called the Pavement, but in the Hebrew, Gabbatha.

Pilate therefore said <u>43_JOH_18_37</u> # Pilate therefore said unto him, Art thou a king then? Jesus answered, Thou sayest that I am a king. To this end was I born, and for this cause came I into the world, that I should bear witness unto the truth. Every one that is of the truth heareth my voice.

Pilate therefore took <u>43_JOH_19_01</u> # Then Pilate therefore took Jesus, and scourged [him].

Pilate therefore went <u>43_JOH_19_04</u> # Pilate therefore went forth again, and saith unto them, Behold, I bring him forth to you, that ye may know that I find no fault in him.

Pilate therefore willing <u>42_LUK_23_20</u> # Pilate therefore, willing to release Jesus, spake again to them.

Pilate to the <u>42_LUK_23_04</u> # Then said Pilate to the chief priests and [to] the people, I find no fault in this man.

Pilate unto him <u>43_JOH_19_10</u> # Then saith Pilate unto him, Speakest thou not unto me? knowest thou not that I have power to crucify thee, and have power to release thee?

Pilate unto him <u>40_MAT_27_13</u># Then said Pilate unto him, Hearest thou not how many things they witness against thee?

Pilate unto them <u>43_JOH_18_31</u> # Then said Pilate unto them, Take ye him, and judge him according to your law. The Jews therefore said unto him, It is not lawful for us to put any man to death:

Pilate when he <u>44_ACT_03_13</u> # The God of Abraham, and of Isaac, and of Jacob, the God of our fathers, hath glorified his Son Jesus; whom ye delivered up, and denied him in the presence of Pilate, when he was determined to let [him] go.

Pilate when he <u>42_LUK_23_13</u> # And Pilate, when he had called together the chief priests and the rulers and the people,

Pilate willing to <u>41_MAR_15_15</u> # And [so] Pilate, willing to content the people, released Barabbas unto them, and delivered Jesus, when he had scourged [him], to be crucified.

Pilate with the <u>44_ACT_04_27</u> # For of a truth against thy holy child Jesus, whom thou hast anointed, both Herod, and Pontius Pilate, with the Gentiles, and the people of Israel, were gathered together,

Pilate witnessed a <u>54_1TI_06_13</u> # I give thee charge in the sight of God, who quickeneth all things, and [before] Christ Jesus, who before Pontius Pilate witnessed a good confession;

Pilate Write not <u>43_JOH_19_21</u># Then said the chief priests of the Jews to Pilate, Write not, The King of the Jews; but that he said, I am King of the Jews.

Pilate wrote a <u>43_JOH_19_19</u># And Pilate wrote a title, and put [it] on the cross. And the writing was, JESUS OF NAZARETH THE KING OF THE JEWS.

Pilate <u>42_LUK_23_01</u> # And the whole multitude of them arose, and led him unto Pilate.

Pilate <u>42_LUK_23_11</u># And Herod with his men of war set him at nought, and mocked [him], and arrayed him in a gorgeous robe, and sent him again to Pilate.

Pilate <u>41_MAR_15_01</u> # And straightway in the morning the chief priests held a consultation with the elders and scribes and the whole council, and bound Jesus, and carried [him] away, and delivered [him] to Pilate.

Pilate <u>40_MAT_27_62</u># Now the next day, that followed the day of the preparation, the chief priests and Pharisees came together unto Pilate,

plate of pure <u>02_EXO_28_36</u># And thou shalt make a plate [of] pure gold, and grave upon it, [like] the engravings of a signet, HOLINESS TO THE LORD.

plate of the <u>02_EXO_39_30</u># And they made the plate of the holy crown [of] pure gold, and wrote upon it a writing, [like to] the engravings of a signet, HOLINESS TO THE LORD.

plate the holy <u>03_LEV_08_09</u># And he put the mitre upon his head; also upon the mitre, [even] upon his forefront, did he put the golden plate, the holy crown; as the LORD commanded Moses.
