laughed and said <u>01\_GEN\_17\_17</u># Then Abraham fell upon his face, and laughed, and said in his heart, Shall [a child] be born unto him that is an hundred years old? and shall Sarah, that is ninety years old, bear?

laughed him to 42\_LUK\_08\_53 # And they laughed him to scorn, knowing that she was dead.

laughed him to 41 MAR 05 40 # And they laughed him to scorn. But when he had put them all out, he taketh the father and the mother of the damsel, and them that were with him, and entereth in where the damsel was lying.

laughed him to 40\_MAT\_09\_24# He said unto them, Give place: for the maid is not dead, but sleepeth. And they laughed him to scorn.

laughed not for <u>01\_GEN\_18\_15</u> # Then Sarah denied, saying, I laughed not; for she was afraid. And he said, Nay; but thou didst laugh.

laughed on them <u>18\_JOB\_29\_24</u> # [If] I laughed on them, they believed [it] not; and the light of my countenance they cast not down.

laughed thee to 12 2KI 19 21 # This [is] the word that the LORD hath spoken concerning him; The virgin the daughter of Zion hath despised thee, [and] laughed thee to scorn; the daughter of Jerusalem hath shaken her head at thee.

laughed thee to 23 ISA 37 22 # This [is] the word which the LORD hath spoken concerning him; The virgin, the daughter of Zion, hath despised thee, [and] laughed thee to scorn; the daughter of Jerusalem hath shaken her head at thee.

laughed them to 14\_2CH\_30\_10 # So the posts passed from city to city through the country of Ephraim and Manasseh even unto Zebulun: but they laughed them to scorn, and mocked them.

laughed to scorn 26\_EZE\_23\_32 # Thus saith the Lord GOD; Thou shalt drink of thy sister's cup deep and large: thou shalt be laughed to scorn and had in derision; it containeth much.

laughed to scorn 18\_JOB\_12\_04 # I am [as] one mocked of his neighbour, who calleth upon God, and he answereth him: the just upright [man is] laughed to scorn.

laughed us to <u>16\_NEH\_02\_19</u> # But when Sanballat the Horonite, and Tobiah the servant, the Ammonite, and Geshem the Arabian, heard [it], they laughed us to scorn, and despised us, and said, What [is] this thing that ye do? will ye rebel against the king?

laughed within herself <u>01\_GEN\_18\_12</u> # Therefore Sarah laughed within herself, saying, After I am waxed old shall I have pleasure, my lord being old also?
