

## KJV Bible linked to Three Phrase Concordance

leavened because they <u>02\_EXO\_12\_39</u> # And they baked unleavened cakes of the dough which they brought forth out of Egypt, for it was not leavened; because they were thrust out of Egypt, and could not tarry, neither had they prepared for themselves any victual.

leavened bread be <u>02\_EXO\_13\_03</u># And Moses said unto the people, Remember this day, in which ye came out from Egypt, out of the house of bondage; for by strength of hand the LORD brought you out from this [place]: there shall no leavened bread be eaten.

leavened bread be <u>02\_EXO\_13\_07</u> # Unleavened bread shall be eaten seven days; and there shall no leavened bread be seen with thee, neither shall there be leaven seen with thee in all thy quarters.

leavened bread from <u>02\_EXO\_12\_15</u># Seven days shall ye eat unleavened bread; even the first day ye shall put away leaven out of your houses: for whosoever eateth leavened bread from the first day until the seventh day, that soul shall be cut off from Israel.

leavened bread neither <u>02\_EXO\_23\_18</u># Thou shalt not offer the blood of my sacrifice with leavened bread; neither shall the fat of my sacrifice remain until the morning.

leavened bread seen <u>05\_DEU\_16\_04</u># And there shall be no leavened bread seen with thee in all thy coast seven days; neither shall there [any thing] of the flesh, which thou sacrificedst the first day at even, remain all night until the morning.

leavened bread with <u>05\_DEU\_16\_03</u> # Thou shalt eat no leavened bread with it; seven days shalt thou eat unleavened bread therewith, [even] the bread of affliction: for thou camest forth out of the land of Egypt in haste: that thou mayest remember the day when thou camest forth out of the land of Egypt all the days of thy life.

leavened bread with <u>03\_LEV\_07\_13</u># Besides the cakes, he shall offer [for] his offering leavened bread with the sacrifice of thanksgiving of his peace offerings.

leavened even that <u>02\_EXO\_12\_19</u># Seven days shall there be no leaven found in your houses: for whosoever eateth that which is leavened, even that soul shall be cut off from the congregation of Israel, whether he be a stranger, or born in the land.

leavened in all <u>02\_EXO\_12\_20</u> # Ye shall eat nothing leavened; in all your habitations shall ye eat unleavened bread.

leavened their kneadingtroughs <u>02\_EXO\_12\_34</u># And the people took their dough before it was leavened, their kneadingtroughs being bound up in their clothes upon their shoulders.

leavened <u>28\_HOS\_07\_04</u> # They [are] all adulterers, as an oven heated by the baker, [who] ceaseth from raising after he hath kneaded the dough, until it be leavened.

leavened <u>42\_LUK\_13\_21</u> # It is like leaven, which a woman took and hid in three measures of meal, till the whole was leavened.

leavened <u>40\_MAT\_13\_33</u># Another parable spake he unto them; The kingdom of heaven is like unto leaven, which a woman took, and hid in three measures of meal, till the whole was leavened.

unleavened anointed with <u>02\_EXO\_29\_02</u> # And unleavened bread, and cakes unleavened tempered with oil, and wafers unleavened anointed with oil: [of] wheaten flour shalt thou make them.

unleavened bread among 12 2KI 23 09 # Nevertheless the priests of the high places came not up to the altar of the LORD in Jerusalem, but they did eat of the unleavened bread among their brethren.

unleavened bread and <u>14\_2CH\_08\_13</u> # Even after a certain rate every day, offering according to the commandment of Moses, on the sabbaths, and on the new moons, and on the solemn feasts, three times in the year, [even] in the feast of unleavened bread, and in the feast of weeks, and in the feast of tabernacles.

unleavened bread and <u>44\_ACT\_20\_06</u># And we sailed away from Philippi after the days of unleavened bread, and came unto them to Troas in five days; where we abode seven days.

unleavened bread and <u>05\_DEU\_16\_08</u># Six days thou shalt eat unleavened bread: and on the seventh day [shall be] a solemn assembly to the LORD thy God: thou shalt do no work [therein].

unleavened bread and <u>05\_DEU\_16\_16</u># Three times in a year shall all thy males appear before the LORD thy God in the place which he shall choose; in the feast of unleavened bread, and in the feast of weeks, and in the feast of tabernacles: and they shall not appear before the LORD empty:

unleavened bread and <u>02\_EXO\_12\_08</u># And they shall eat the flesh in that night, roast with fire, and unleavened bread; [and] with bitter [herbs] they shall eat it.

unleavened bread and <u>02\_EXO\_13\_06</u># Seven days thou shalt eat unleavened bread, and in the seventh day [shall be] a feast to the LORD.

unleavened bread and <u>02\_EXO\_29\_02</u># And unleavened bread, and cakes unleavened tempered with oil, and wafers unleavened anointed with oil: [of] wheaten flour shalt thou make them.

unleavened bread and <u>01\_GEN\_19\_03</u># And he pressed upon them greatly; and they turned in unto him, and entered into his house; and he made them a feast, and did bake unleavened bread, and they did eat.

unleavened bread and <u>41\_MAR\_14\_01</u># After two days was [the feast of] the passover, and of unleavened bread: and the chief priests and the scribes sought how they might take him by craft, and put [him] to death.

unleavened bread and <u>04\_NUM\_09\_11</u># The fourteenth day of the second month at even they shall keep it, [and] eat it with unleavened bread and bitter [herbs].

unleavened bread anointed <u>04\_NUM\_06\_15</u># And a basket of unleavened bread, cakes of fine flour mingled with oil, and wafers of unleavened bread anointed with oil, and their meat offering, and their drink offerings.

unleavened bread as <u>02\_EXO\_34\_18</u># The feast of unleavened bread shalt thou keep. Seven days thou shalt eat unleavened bread, as I commanded thee, in the time of the month Abib: for in the month Abib thou camest out from Egypt.

unleavened bread be <u>04\_NUM\_28\_17</u> # And in the fifteenth day of this month [is] the feast: seven days shall unleavened bread be eaten.

unleavened bread cakes <u>04\_NUM\_06\_15</u># And a basket of unleavened bread, cakes of fine flour mingled with oil, and wafers of unleavened bread anointed with oil, and their meat offering, and their drink offerings.

unleavened bread drew <u>42\_LUK\_22\_01</u> # Now the feast of unleavened bread drew nigh, which is called the Passover.

unleavened bread even <u>02\_EXO\_12\_15</u># Seven days shall ye eat unleavened bread; even the first day ye shall put away leaven out of your houses: for whosoever eateth leavened bread from the first day until the seventh day, that soul shall be cut off from Israel.

unleavened bread for <u>02\_EXO\_12\_17</u> # And ye shall observe [the feast of] unleavened bread; for in this selfsame day have I brought your armies out of the land of Egypt: therefore shall ye observe this day in your generations by an ordinance for ever.

unleavened bread in 14\_2CH\_30\_13 # And there assembled at Jerusalem much people to keep the feast of unleavened bread in the second month, a very great congregation.

unleavened bread of <u>46\_1CO\_05\_08</u> # Therefore let us keep the feast, not with old leaven, neither with the leaven of malice and wickedness; but with the unleavened [bread] of sincerity and truth.

unleavened bread seven <u>14\_2CH\_30\_21</u> # And the children of Israel that were present at Jerusalem kept the feast of unleavened bread seven days with great gladness: and the Levites and the priests praised the LORD day by day, [singing] with loud instruments unto the LORD.

unleavened bread seven <u>14\_2CH\_35\_17</u># And the children of Israel that were present kept the passover at that time, and the feast of unleavened bread seven days.

unleavened bread seven <u>02\_EXO\_23\_15</u> # Thou shalt keep the feast of unleavened bread: [thou shalt eat unleavened bread seven days, as I commanded thee, in the time appointed of the month Abib; for in it thou camest out from Egypt: and none shall appear before me empty:]

unleavened bread seven <u>15\_EZR\_06\_22</u> # And kept the feast of unleavened bread seven days with joy: for the LORD had made them joyful, and turned the heart of the king of Assyria unto them, to strengthen their hands in the work of the house of God, the God of Israel.

Unleavened bread shall <u>02\_EXO\_13\_07</u># Unleavened bread shall be eaten seven days; and there shall no leavened bread be seen with thee, neither shall there be leaven seen with thee in all thy quarters.

unleavened bread shall <u>26\_EZE\_45\_21</u># In the first [month], in the fourteenth day of the month, ye shall have the passover, a feast of seven days; unleavened bread shall be eaten.

unleavened bread shall <u>03\_LEV\_06\_16</u># And the remainder thereof shall Aaron and his sons eat: with unleavened bread shall it be eaten in the holy place; in the court of the tabernacle of the congregation they shall eat it.

unleavened bread shalt <u>02\_EXO\_34\_18</u># The feast of unleavened bread shalt thou keep. Seven days thou shalt eat unleavened bread, as I commanded thee, in the time of the month Abib: for in the month Abib thou camest out from Egypt.

unleavened bread that <u>02\_EXO\_29\_23</u> # And one loaf of bread, and one cake of oiled bread, and one wafer out of the basket of the unleavened bread that [is] before the LORD:

unleavened bread that <u>03\_LEV\_08\_26</u># And out of the basket of unleavened bread, that [was] before the LORD, he took one unleavened cake, and a cake of oiled bread, and one wafer, and put [them] on the fat, and upon the right shoulder:

unleavened bread the <u>40\_MAT\_26\_17</u># Now the first [day] of the [feast of] unleavened bread the disciples came to Jesus, saying unto him, Where wilt thou that we prepare for thee to eat the passover?

unleavened bread the <u>04\_NUM\_06\_17</u># And he shall offer the ram [for] a sacrifice of peace offerings unto the LORD, with the basket of unleavened bread: the priest shall offer also his meat offering, and his drink offering.

unleavened bread thereof <u>09\_1SA\_28\_24</u> # And the woman had a fat calf in the house; and she hasted, and killed it, and took flour, and kneaded [it], and did bake unleavened bread thereof:

unleavened bread therewith <u>05\_DEU\_16\_03</u># Thou shalt eat no leavened bread with it; seven days shalt thou eat unleavened bread therewith, [even] the bread of affliction: for thou camest forth out of the land of Egypt in haste: that thou mayest remember the day when thou camest forth out of the land of Egypt all the days of thy life.

unleavened bread thou <u>02\_EXO\_23\_15</u> # Thou shalt keep the feast of unleavened bread: [thou shalt eat unleavened bread seven days, as I commanded thee, in the time appointed of the month Abib; for in it thou camest out from Egypt: and none shall appear before me empty:]

unleavened bread until <u>02\_EXO\_12\_18</u> # In the first [month], on the fourteenth day of the month at even, ye shall eat unleavened bread, until the one and twentieth day of the month at even.

unleavened bread unto <u>03\_LEV\_23\_06</u># And on the fifteenth day of the same month [is] the feast of unleavened bread unto the LORD: seven days ye must eat unleavened bread.

unleavened bread when <u>42\_LUK\_22\_07</u># Then came the day of unleavened bread, when the passover must be killed.

unleavened bread when <u>41\_MAR\_14\_12</u># And the first day of unleavened bread, when they killed the passover, his disciples said unto him, Where wilt thou that we go and prepare that thou mayest eat the passover?

unleavened bread <u>44\_ACT\_12\_03</u># And because he saw it pleased the Jews, he proceeded further to take Peter also. [Then were the days of unleavened bread.]

unleavened bread <u>02\_EXO\_12\_20</u># Ye shall eat nothing leavened; in all your habitations shall ye eat unleavened bread.

unleavened bread <u>03\_LEV\_08\_02</u> # Take Aaron and his sons with him, and the garments, and the anointing oil, and a bullock for the sin offering, and two rams, and a basket of unleavened bread;

unleavened bread <u>03\_LEV\_23\_06</u> # And on the fifteenth day of the same month [is] the feast of unleavened bread unto the LORD: seven days ye must eat unleavened bread.

unleavened cake and <u>03\_LEV\_08\_26</u># And out of the basket of unleavened bread, that [was] before the LORD, he took one unleavened cake, and a cake of oiled bread, and one wafer, and put [them] on the fat, and upon the right shoulder:

unleavened cake out <u>04\_NUM\_06\_19</u># And the priest shall take the sodden shoulder of the ram, and one unleavened cake out of the basket, and one unleavened wafer, and shall put [them] upon the hands of the Nazarite, after [the hair of] his separation is shaven:

unleavened cakes and <u>13\_1CH\_23\_29</u># Both for the showbread, and for the fine flour for meat offering, and for the unleavened cakes, and for [that which is baked in] the pan, and for that which is fried, and for all manner of measure and size;

unleavened cakes and 06\_JOS\_05\_11 # And they did eat of the old corn of the land on the morrow after the

passover, unleavened cakes, and parched [corn] in the selfsame day.

unleavened cakes and <u>07\_JUD\_06\_20</u># And the angel of God said unto him, Take the flesh and the unleavened cakes, and lay [them] upon this rock, and pour out the broth. And he did so.

unleavened cakes and <u>07\_JUD\_06\_21</u># Then the angel of the LORD put forth the end of the staff that [was] in his hand, and touched the flesh and the unleavened cakes; and there rose up fire out of the rock, and consumed the flesh and the unleavened cakes. unleavened cakes mingled <u>03\_LEV\_07\_12</u># If he offer it for a thanksgiving, then he shall offer with the sacrifice of thanksgiving unleavened cakes mingled with oil, and unleavened wafers anointed with oil, and cakes mingled with oil, of fine flour, fried.

unleavened cakes of <u>02\_EXO\_12\_39</u> # And they baked unleavened cakes of the dough which they brought forth out of Egypt, for it was not leavened; because they were thrust out of Egypt, and could not tarry, neither had they prepared for themselves any victual.

unleavened cakes of <u>07\_JUD\_06\_19</u># And Gideon went in, and made ready a kid, and unleavened cakes of an ephah of flour: the flesh he put in a basket, and he put the broth in a pot, and brought [it] out unto him under the oak, and presented [it].

unleavened cakes of <u>03\_LEV\_02\_04</u># And if thou bring an oblation of a meat offering baken in the oven, [it shall be] unleavened cakes of fine flour mingled with oil, or unleavened wafers anointed with oil.

unleavened cakes Then <u>07\_JUD\_06\_21</u># Then the angel of the LORD put forth the end of the staff that [was] in his hand, and touched the flesh and the unleavened cakes; and there rose up fire out of the rock, and consumed the flesh and the unleavened cakes. Then the angel of the LORD departed out of his sight.

unleavened For even <u>46\_1CO\_05\_07</u> # Purge out therefore the old leaven, that ye may be a new lump, as ye are unleavened. For even Christ our passover is sacrificed for us:

unleavened mingled with <u>03\_LEV\_02\_05</u># And if thy oblation [be] a meat offering [baken] in a pan, it shall be [of] fine flour unleavened, mingled with oil.

unleavened tempered with <u>02\_EXO\_29\_02</u># And unleavened bread, and cakes unleavened tempered with oil, and wafers unleavened anointed with oil: [of] wheaten flour shalt thou make them.

unleavened wafer and <u>04\_NUM\_06\_19</u># And the priest shall take the sodden shoulder of the ram, and one unleavened cake out of the basket, and one unleavened wafer, and shall put [them] upon the hands of the Nazarite, after [the hair of] his separation is shaven:

unleavened wafers anointed <u>03\_LEV\_02\_04</u># And if thou bring an oblation of a meat offering baken in the oven, [it shall be] unleavened cakes of fine flour mingled with oil, or unleavened wafers anointed with oil.

unleavened wafers anointed <u>03\_LEV\_07\_12</u># If he offer it for a thanksgiving, then he shall offer with the sacrifice of thanksgiving unleavened cakes mingled with oil, and unleavened wafers anointed with oil, and cakes mingled with oil, of fine flour, fried.
