alleging that Christ <u>44\_ACT\_17\_03</u> # Opening and alleging, that Christ must needs have suffered, and risen again from the dead; and that this Jesus, whom I preach unto you, is Christ.

allegory for these <u>48\_GAL\_04\_24</u> # Which things are an allegory: for these are the two covenants; the one from the mount Sinai, which gendereth to bondage, which is Agar.

college and they <u>14\_2CH\_34\_22</u># And Hilkiah, and [they] that the king [had appointed], went to Huldah the prophetess, the wife of Shallum the son of Tikvath, the son of Hasrah, keeper of the wardrobe; [now she dwelt in Jerusalem in the college:] and they spake to her to that [effect].

college and they <u>12\_2KI\_22\_14</u># So Hilkiah the priest, and Ahikam, and Achbor, and Shaphan, and Asahiah, went unto Huldah the prophetess, the wife of Shallum the son of Tikvah, the son of Harhas, keeper of the wardrobe; [now she dwelt in Jerusalem in the college;] and they communed with her.

Legion because many <u>42\_LUK\_08\_30</u> # And Jesus asked him, saying, What is thy name? And he said, Legion: because many devils were entered into him.

Legion for we <u>41\_MAR\_05\_09</u> # And he asked him, What [is] thy name? And he answered, saying, My name [is] Legion: for we are many.

legion sitting and <u>41\_MAR\_05\_15</u># And they come to Jesus, and see him that was possessed with the devil, and had the legion, sitting, and clothed, and in his right mind: and they were afraid.

legions of angels <u>40\_MAT\_26\_53</u># Thinkest thou that I cannot now pray to my Father, and he shall presently give me more than twelve legions of angels?

legs above their <u>03\_LEV\_11\_21</u># Yet these may ye eat of every flying creeping thing that goeth upon [all] four, which have legs above their feet, to leap withal upon the earth;

legs and a <u>09\_1SA\_17\_06</u># And [he had] greaves of brass upon his legs, and a target of brass between his shoulders.

legs and burnt <u>03\_LEV\_09\_14</u> # And he did wash the inwards and the legs, and burnt [them] upon the burnt offering on the altar.

legs of the <u>20\_PRO\_26\_07</u> # The legs of the lame are not equal: so [is] a parable in the mouth of fools.

legs or a <u>30\_AMO\_03\_12</u> # Thus saith the LORD; As the shepherd taketh out of the mouth of the lion two legs, or a piece of an ear; so shall the children of Israel be taken out that dwell in Samaria in the corner of a bed, and in Damascus [in] a couch.

Peleg <u>01\_GEN\_11\_16</u># And Eber lived four and thirty years, and begat Peleg:

Phlegon Hermas Patrobas <u>45\_ROM\_16\_14</u> # Salute Asyncritus, Phlegon, Hermas, Patrobas, Hermes, and the brethren which are with them.

sacrilege <u>45 ROM\_02\_22</u> # Thou that sayest a man should not commit adultery, dost thou commit adultery? thou that abhorrest idols, dost thou commit sacrilege?
