lend him sufficient [05 DEU 15 08](#) # But thou shalt open thine hand wide unto him, and shalt surely lend him sufficient for his need, [in that] which he wanteth.

lend him thy [03 LEV 25 37](#) # Thou shalt not give him thy money upon usury, nor lend him thy victuals for increase.

lend hoping for [42 LUK 06 35](#) # But love ye your enemies, and do good, and lend, hoping for nothing again; and your reward shall be great, and ye shall be the children of the Highest: for he is kind unto the unthankful and [to] the evil.

lend me three [42 LUK 11 05](#) # And he said unto them, Which of you shall have a friend, and shall go unto him at midnight, and say unto him, Friend, lend me three loaves;

lend money to [02 EXO 22 25](#) # If thou lend money to [any of] my people [that is] poor by thee, thou shalt not be to him as an usurer, neither shalt thou lay upon him usury.

lend to them [42 LUK 06 34](#) # And if ye lend [to them] of whom ye hope to receive, what thank have ye? for sinners also lend to sinners, to receive as much again.

lend unto many [05 DEU 15 06](#) # For the LORD thy God blesseth thee, as he promised thee: and thou shalt lend unto many nations, but thou shalt not borrow; and thou shalt reign over many nations, but they shall not reign over thee.

lend unto many [05 DEU 28 12](#) # The LORD shall open unto thee his good treasure, the heaven to give the rain unto thy land in his season, and to bless all the work of thine hand: and thou shalt lend unto many nations, and thou shalt not borrow.

lend upon usury [05 DEU 23 19](#) # Thou shalt not lend upon usury to thy brother; usury of money, usury of victuals, usury of any thing that is lent upon usury:

lender so with [23 ISA 24 02](#) # And it shall be, as with the people, so with the priest; as with the servant, so with his master; as with the maid, so with her mistress; as with the buyer, so with the seller; as with the lender, so with the borrower; as with the taker of usury, so with the giver of usury to him.

lender [20 PRO 22 07](#) # The rich ruleth over the poor, and the borrower [is] servant to the lender.
