

## KJV Bible linked to Three Phrase Concordance

leprosy and scall 03\_LEV\_14\_54 # This [is] the law for all manner of plague of leprosy, and scall,

leprosy and shall <u>03\_LEV\_13\_49</u># And if the plague be greenish or reddish in the garment, or in the skin, either in the warp, or in the woof, or in any thing of skin; it [is] a plague of leprosy, and shall be showed unto the priest:

leprosy and the <u>03\_LEV\_13\_03</u># And the priest shall look on the plague in the skin of the flesh: and [when] the hair in the plague is turned white, and the plague in sight [be] deeper than the skin of his flesh, it [is] a plague of leprosy: and the priest shall look on him, and pronounce him unclean.

leprosy appeareth in <u>03\_LEV\_13\_43</u># Then the priest shall look upon it: and, behold, [if] the rising of the sore [be] white reddish in his bald head, or in his bald forehead, as the leprosy appeareth in the skin of the flesh;

leprosy be healed <u>03\_LEV\_14\_03</u> # And the priest shall go forth out of the camp; and the priest shall look, and, behold, [if] the plague of leprosy be healed in the leper;

leprosy break out <u>03\_LEV\_13\_12</u># And if a leprosy break out abroad in the skin, and the leprosy cover all the skin of [him that hath] the plague from his head even to his foot, wheresoever the priest looketh;

leprosy broken out <u>03\_LEV\_13\_20</u># And if, when the priest seeth it, behold, it [be] in sight lower than the skin, and the hair thereof be turned white; the priest shall pronounce him unclean: it [is] a plague of leprosy broken out of the boil.

leprosy broken out <u>03 LEV\_13\_25</u> # Then the priest shall look upon it: and, behold, [if] the hair in the bright spot be turned white, and it [be in] sight deeper than the skin; it [is] a leprosy broken out of the burning: wherefore the priest shall pronounce him unclean: it [is] the plague of leprosy.

leprosy cover all <u>03\_LEV\_13\_12</u> # And if a leprosy break out abroad in the skin, and the leprosy cover all the skin of [him that hath] the plague from his head even to his foot, wheresoever the priest looketh;

leprosy departed from 42\_LUK\_05\_13 # And he put forth [his] hand, and touched him, saying, I will: be thou clean. And immediately the leprosy departed from him.

leprosy departed from <u>41\_MAR\_01\_42</u># And as soon as he had spoken, immediately the leprosy departed from him, and he was cleansed.

leprosy even rose <u>14\_2CH\_26\_19</u> # Then Uzziah was wroth, and [had] a censer in his hand to burn incense: and while he was wroth with the priests, the leprosy even rose up in his forehead before the priests in the house of the LORD, from beside the incense altar.

leprosy have covered <u>03\_LEV\_13\_13</u># Then the priest shall consider: and, behold, [if] the leprosy have covered all his flesh, he shall pronounce [him] clean [that hath] the plague: it is all turned white: he [is] clean.

leprosy in a <u>03\_LEV\_13\_59</u> # This [is] the law of the plague of leprosy in a garment of woollen or linen, either in the warp, or woof, or any thing of skins, to pronounce it clean, or to pronounce it unclean.

leprosy in a <u>03\_LEV\_14\_34</u> # When ye be come into the land of Canaan, which I give to you for a possession, and I put the plague of leprosy in a house of the land of your possession;

leprosy in the <u>03\_LEV\_13\_11</u># It [is] an old leprosy in the skin of his flesh, and the priest shall pronounce him unclean, and shall not shut him up: for he [is] unclean.

leprosy in the <u>03\_LEV\_14\_44</u> # Then the priest shall come and look, and, behold, [if] the plague be spread in the house, it [is] a fretting leprosy in the house: it [is] unclean.

leprosy is in <u>03\_LEV\_13\_09</u># When the plague of leprosy is in a man, then he shall be brought unto the priest;

leprosy is in <u>03\_LEV\_13\_47</u> # The garment also that the plague of leprosy is in, [whether it be] a woollen garment, or a linen garment;

leprosy it is <u>03\_LEV\_13\_51</u># And he shall look on the plague on the seventh day: if the plague be spread in the garment, either in the warp, or in the woof, or in a skin, [or] in any work that is made of skin; the plague [is] a fretting leprosy; it [is] unclean.

leprosy it shall <u>03\_LEV\_13\_52</u> # He shall therefore burn that garment, whether warp or woof, in woollen or in linen, or any thing of skin, wherein the plague is: for it [is] a fretting leprosy; it shall be burnt in the fire.

leprosy of a <u>03\_LEV\_14\_55</u># And for the leprosy of a garment, and of a house,

leprosy seven times <u>03\_LEV\_14\_07</u> # And he shall sprinkle upon him that is to be cleansed from the leprosy seven times, and shall pronounce him clean, and shall let the living bird loose into the open field.

leprosy sprung up <u>03\_LEV\_13\_42</u> # And if there be in the bald head, or bald forehead, a white reddish sore; it [is] a leprosy sprung up in his bald head, or his bald forehead.

leprosy that thou <u>05\_DEU\_24\_08</u># Take heed in the plague of leprosy, that thou observe diligently, and do according to all that the priests the Levites shall teach you: as I commanded them, [so] ye shall observe to do.

leprosy then he <u>03\_LEV\_13\_02</u># When a man shall have in the skin of his flesh a rising, a scab, or bright spot, and it be in the skin of his flesh [like] the plague of leprosy; then he shall be brought unto Aaron the priest, or unto one of his sons the priests:

leprosy therefore of 12\_2KI\_05\_27 # The leprosy therefore of Naaman shall cleave unto thee, and unto thy seed for ever. And he went out from his presence a leper [as white] as snow.

leprosy upon the <u>03\_LEV\_13\_30</u> # Then the priest shall see the plague: and, behold, if it [be] in sight deeper than the skin; [and there be] in it a yellow thin hair; then the priest shall pronounce him unclean: it [is] a dry scall, [even] a leprosy upon the head or beard.

leprosy was cleansed <u>40\_MAT\_08\_03</u># And Jesus put forth [his] hand, and touched him, saying, I will; be thou clean. And immediately his leprosy was cleansed.

leprosy wherefore consider 12\_2KI\_05\_07 # And it came to pass, when the king of Israel had read the letter, that he rent his clothes, and said, [Am] I God, to kill and to make alive, that this man doth send unto me to recover a man of his leprosy? wherefore consider, I pray you, and see how he seeketh a quarrel against me.

leprosy who seeing 42\_LUK\_05\_12 # And it came to pass, when he was in a certain city, behold a man full of leprosy: who seeing Jesus fell on [his] face, and besought him, saying, Lord, if thou wilt, thou canst make me clean.

leprosy whose hand <u>03\_LEV\_14\_32</u> # This [is] the law [of him] in whom [is] the plague of leprosy, whose hand is not able to get [that which pertaineth] to his cleansing.

leprosy 12 2KI 05 03 # And she said unto her mistress, Would God my lord [were] with the prophet that [is] in Samaria! for he would recover him of his leprosy.

leprosy <u>12\_2KI\_05\_06</u># And he brought the letter to the king of Israel, saying, Now when this letter is come unto thee, behold, I have [therewith] sent Naaman my servant to thee, that thou mayest recover him of his leprosy.

leprosy <u>03\_LEV\_13\_08</u># And [if] the priest see that, behold, the scab spreadeth in the skin, then the priest shall pronounce him unclean: it [is] a leprosy.

leprosy <u>03\_LEV\_13\_15</u> # And the priest shall see the raw flesh, and pronounce him to be unclean: [for] the raw flesh [is] unclean: it [is] a leprosy.

leprosy <u>03\_LEV\_13\_25</u> # Then the priest shall look upon it: and, behold, [if] the hair in the bright spot be turned white, and it [be in] sight deeper than the skin; it [is] a leprosy broken out of the burning: wherefore the priest shall pronounce him unclean: it [is] the plague of leprosy.

leprosy <u>03\_LEV\_13\_27</u> # And the priest shall look upon him the seventh day: [and] if it be spread much abroad in the skin, then the priest shall pronounce him unclean: it [is] the plague of leprosy.

leprosy 03\_LEV\_14\_57 # To teach when [it is] unclean, and when [it is] clean: this [is] the law of leprosy.
