linen an hundred <u>02_EXO_38_09</u># And he made the court: on the south side southward the hangings of the court [were of] fine twined linen, an hundred cubits:

linen and all <u>13_1CH_15_27</u># And David [was] clothed with a robe of fine linen, and all the Levites that bare the ark, and the singers, and Chenaniah the master of the song with the singers: David also [had] upon him an ephod of linen.

linen and blue <u>02_EXO_26_01</u> # Moreover thou shalt make the tabernacle [with] ten curtains [of] fine twined linen, and blue, and purple, and scarlet: [with] cherubims of cunning work shalt thou make them.

linen and blue <u>02_EXO_36_08</u> # And every wise hearted man among them that wrought the work of the tabernacle made ten curtains [of] fine twined linen, and blue, and purple, and scarlet: [with] cherubims of cunning work made he them.

linen and blue <u>02_EXO_39_29</u> # And a girdle [of] fine twined linen, and blue, and purple, and scarlet, [of] needlework; as the LORD commanded Moses.

linen and coral <u>26_EZE_27_16</u># Syria [was] thy merchant by reason of the multitude of the wares of thy making: they occupied in thy fairs with emeralds, purple, and broidered work, and fine linen, and coral, and agate.

linen and fared <u>42_LUK_16_19</u># There was a certain rich man, which was clothed in purple and fine linen, and fared sumptuously every day:

linen and I <u>26_EZE_16_10</u> # I clothed thee also with broidered work, and shod thee with badgers' skin, and I girded thee about with fine linen, and I covered thee with silk.

linen and in <u>14_2CH_02_14</u> # The son of a woman of the daughters of Dan, and his father [was] a man of Tyre, skilful to work in gold, and in silver, in brass, in iron, in stone, and in timber, in purple, in blue, and in fine linen, and in crimson; also to grave any manner of graving, and to find out every device which shall be put to him, with thy cunning men, and with the cunning men of my lord David thy father.

linen and linen <u>02_EXO_39_28</u># And a mitre [of] fine linen, and goodly bonnets [of] fine linen, and linen breeches [of] fine twined linen,

linen and of <u>02_EXO_35_35</u># Them hath he filled with wisdom of heart, to work all manner of work, of the engraver, and of the cunning workman, and of the embroiderer, in blue, and in purple, in scarlet, and in fine linen, and of the weaver, [even] of them that do any work, and of those that devise cunning work.

linen and purple <u>17_EST_01_06</u># [Where were] white, green, and blue, [hangings], fastened with cords of fine linen and purple to silver rings and pillars of marble: the beds [were of] gold and silver, upon a pavement of red, and blue, and white, and black, marble.

linen and the <u>23_ISA_03_23</u> # The glasses, and the fine linen, and the hoods, and the veils.

linen and their <u>02_EXO_27_18</u># The length of the court [shall be] an hundred cubits, and the breadth fifty every where, and the height five cubits [of] fine twined linen, and their sockets [of] brass.

linen and thou <u>02_EXO_28_39</u> # And thou shalt embroider the coat of fine linen, and thou shalt make the mitre [of] fine linen, and thou shalt make the girdle [of] needlework.

linen bonnets upon <u>26_EZE_44_18</u> # They shall have linen bonnets upon their heads, and shall have linen breeches upon their loins; they shall not gird [themselves] with any thing that causeth sweat.

linen breeches of <u>02_EXO_39_28</u># And a mitre [of] fine linen, and goodly bonnets [of] fine linen, and linen breeches [of] fine twined linen,

linen breeches shall <u>03_LEV_06_10</u> # And the priest shall put on his linen garment, and his linen breeches shall he put upon his flesh, and take up the ashes which the fire hath consumed with the burnt offering on the altar, and he shall put them beside the altar.

linen breeches to <u>02_EXO_28_42</u> # And thou shalt make them linen breeches to cover their nakedness; from the loins even unto the thighs they shall reach:

linen breeches upon <u>26_EZE_44_18</u># They shall have linen bonnets upon their heads, and shall have linen breeches upon their loins; they shall not gird [themselves] with any thing that causeth sweat.

linen clean and <u>66_REV_19_08</u># And to her was granted that she should be arrayed in fine linen, clean and white: for the fine linen is the righteousness of saints.

linen cloth and <u>41_MAR_14_52</u> # And he left the linen cloth, and fled from them naked.

linen cloth cast <u>41_MAR_14_51</u> # And there followed him a certain young man, having a linen cloth cast about [his] naked [body]; and the young men laid hold on him:

linen cloth <u>40_MAT_27_59</u># And when Joseph had taken the body, he wrapped it in a clean linen cloth,

linen clothes but <u>43_JOH_20_07</u> # And the napkin, that was about his head, not lying with the linen clothes, but wrapped together in a place by itself.

linen clothes even <u>03_LEV_16_32</u> # And the priest, whom he shall anoint, and whom he shall consecrate to minister in the priest's office in his father's stead, shall make the atonement, and shall put on the linen clothes, [even] the holy garments:

linen clothes laid <u>42_LUK_24_12</u> # Then arose Peter, and ran unto the sepulchre; and stooping down, he beheld the linen clothes laid by themselves, and departed, wondering in himself at that which was come to pass.

linen clothes lie <u>43_JOH_20_06</u># Then cometh Simon Peter following him, and went into the sepulchre, and seeth the linen clothes lie,

linen clothes lying <u>43_JOH_20_05</u> # And he stooping down, [and looking in], saw the linen clothes lying; yet went he not in.

linen clothes with <u>43_JOH_19_40</u> # Then took they the body of Jesus, and wound it in linen clothes with the spices, as the manner of the Jews is to bury.

linen coat and <u>03_LEV_16_04</u># He shall put on the holy linen coat, and he shall have the linen breeches upon his flesh, and shall be girded with a linen girdle, and with the linen mitre shall he be attired: these [are] holy garments; therefore shall he wash his flesh in water, and [so] put them on.

linen either in <u>03_LEV_13_59</u># This [is] the law of the plague of leprosy in a garment of woollen or linen, either in the warp, or woof, or any thing of skins, to pronounce it clean, or to pronounce it unclean.

linen ephod <u>09_1SA_02_18</u># But Samuel ministered before the LORD, [being] a child, girded with a linen ephod.

linen ephod <u>09_18A_22_18</u># And the king said to Doeg, Turn thou, and fall upon the priests. And Doeg the Edomite turned, and he fell upon the priests, and slew on that day fourscore and five persons that did wear a linen ephod.

linen ephod <u>10_2SA_06_14</u># And David danced before the LORD with all [his] might; and David [was] girded with a linen ephod.

linen garment and <u>03_LEV_06_10</u># And the priest shall put on his linen garment, and his linen breeches shall he put upon his flesh, and take up the ashes which the fire hath consumed with the burnt offering on the altar, and he shall put them beside the altar.

linen garment <u>03_LEV_13_47</u># The garment also that the plague of leprosy is in, [whether it be] a woollen garment, or a linen garment;

linen garments and <u>26_EZE_44_17</u> # And it shall come to pass, [that] when they enter in at the gates of the inner court, they shall be clothed with linen garments; and no wool shall come upon them, whiles they minister in the gates of the inner court, and within.

linen garments which <u>03_LEV_16_23</u> # And Aaron shall come into the tabernacle of the congregation, and shall put off the linen garments, which he put on when he went into the holy [place], and shall leave them there:

linen girdle and <u>24_JER_13_01</u># Thus saith the LORD unto me, Go and get thee a linen girdle, and put it upon thy loins, and put it not in water.

linen girdle and <u>03_LEV_16_04</u> # He shall put on the holy linen coat, and he shall have the linen breeches upon his flesh, and shall be girded with a linen girdle, and with the linen mitre shall he be attired: these [are] holy garments; therefore shall he wash his flesh in water, and [so] put them on.

linen having cymbals <u>14_2CH_05_12</u> # Also the Levites [which were] the singers, all of them of Asaph, of Heman, of Jeduthun, with their sons and their brethren, [being] arrayed in white linen, having cymbals and psalteries and harps, stood at the east end of the altar, and with them an hundred and twenty priests sounding with trumpets:]

linen of Egypt <u>20_PRO_07_16</u># I have decked my bed with coverings of tapestry, with carved [works], with fine linen of Egypt.

linen of needlework <u>02_EXO_36_37</u># And he made an hanging for the tabernacle door [of] blue, and purple, and scarlet, and fine twined linen, of needlework;

linen or any <u>03_LEV_13_52</u># He shall therefore burn that garment, whether warp or woof, in woollen or in linen, or any thing of skin, wherein the plague is: for it [is] a fretting leprosy; it shall be burnt in the fire.

linen or of <u>03_LEV_13_48</u> # Whether [it be] in the warp, or woof; of linen, or of woollen; whether in a skin, or in any thing made of skin;

linen saying Take <u>26_EZE_10_06</u> # And it came to pass, [that] when he had commanded the man clothed with linen, saying, Take fire from between the wheels, from between the cherubims; then he went in, and stood beside the wheels.

linen shalt thou <u>02_EXO_28_15</u># And thou shalt make the breastplate of judgment with cunning work; after the work of the ephod thou shalt make it; [of] gold, [of] blue, and [of] purple, and [of] scarlet, and [of] fine twined linen, shalt thou make it.

linen together <u>05_DEU_22_11</u># Thou shalt not wear a garment of divers sorts, [as] of woollen and linen together.

linen which had <u>26_EZE_09_03</u> # And the glory of the God of Israel was gone up from the cherub, whereupon he was, to the threshold of the house. And he called to the man clothed with linen, which [had] the writer's inkhorn by his side;

linen white and <u>66_REV_19_14</u> # And the armies [which were] in heaven followed him upon white horses, clothed in fine linen, white and clean.

linen who took <u>26_EZE_10_07</u> # And [one] cherub stretched forth his hand from between the cherubims unto the fire that [was] between the cherubims, and took [thereof], and put [it] into the hands of [him that was] clothed with linen: who took [it], and went out.

linen whose loins <u>27_DAN_10_05</u> # Then I lifted up mine eyes, and looked, and behold a certain man clothed in linen, whose loins [were] girded with fine gold of Uphaz:

linen with cunning <u>02_EXO_39_03</u> # And they did beat the gold into thin plates, and cut [it into] wires, to work [it] in the blue, and in the purple, and in the scarlet, and in the fine linen, [with] cunning work.

linen wrought with <u>02_EXO_26_36</u> # And thou shalt make an hanging for the door of the tent, [of] blue, and purple, and scarlet, and fine twined linen, wrought with needlework.

linen wrought with <u>02_EXO_27_16</u># And for the gate of the court [shall be] an hanging of twenty cubits, [of] blue, and purple, and scarlet, and fine twined linen, wrought with needlework: [and] their pillars [shall be] four, and their sockets four.
