lions Now the <u>27\_DAN\_06\_16</u># Then the king commanded, and they brought Daniel, and cast [him] into the den of lions. [Now] the king spake and said unto Daniel, Thy God whom thou servest continually, he will deliver thee.

lions O LORD 19\_PSA\_58\_06 # Break their teeth, O God, in their mouth: break out the great teeth of the young lions, O LORD.

lions oxen and <u>11\_1KI\_07\_29</u># And on the borders that [were] between the ledges [were] lions, oxen, and cherubims: and upon the ledges [there was] a base above: and beneath the lions and oxen [were] certain additions made of thin work.

lions roar after 19\_PSA\_104\_21 # The young lions roar after their prey, and seek their meat from God.

lions roared upon <u>24\_JER\_02\_15</u># The young lions roared upon him, [and] yelled, and they made his land waste: his cities are burned without inhabitant.

lions she nourished 26\_EZE\_19\_02 # And say, What [is] thy mother? A lioness: she lay down among lions, she nourished her whelps among young lions.

lions standing by 14\_2CH\_09\_18 # And [there were] six steps to the throne, with a footstool of gold, [which were] fastened to the throne, and stays on each side of the sitting place, and two lions standing by the stays:

lions stood beside <u>11\_1KI\_10\_19</u># The throne had six steps, and the top of the throne [was] round behind: and [there were] stays on either side on the place of the seat, and two lions stood beside the stays.

lions stood there <u>11\_1KI\_10\_20</u># And twelve lions stood there on the one side and on the other upon the six steps: there was not the like made in any kingdom.

lions stood there 14\_2CH\_09\_19 # And twelve lions stood there on the one side and on the other upon the six steps. There was not the like made in any kingdom.

lions The king <u>27\_DAN\_06\_12</u># Then they came near, and spake before the king concerning the king's decree; Hast thou not signed a decree, that every man that shall ask [a petition] of any God or man within thirty days, save of thee, O king, shall be cast into the den of lions? The king answered and said, The thing [is] true, according to the law of the Medes and Persians, which altereth not.

lions them their <u>27\_DAN\_06\_24</u> # And the king commanded, and they brought those men which had accused Daniel, and they cast [them] into the den of lions, them, their children, and their wives; and the lions had the mastery of them, and brake all their bones in pieces or ever they came at the bottom of the den.

lions thereof shall <u>26\_EZE\_38\_13</u># Sheba, and Dedan, and the merchants of Tarshish, with all the young lions thereof, shall say unto thee, Art thou come to take a spoil? hast thou gathered thy company to take a prey? to carry away silver and gold, to take away cattle and goods, to take a great spoil?

lions they shall 24\_JER\_51\_38 # They shall roar together like lions: they shall yell as lions' whelps.

lions whelps 24\_JER\_51\_38 # They shall roar together like lions: they shall yell as lions' whelps.

lions where the <u>34\_NAH\_02\_11</u># Where [is] the dwelling of the lions, and the feedingplace of the young lions, where the lion, [even] the old lion, walked, [and] the lion's whelp, and none made [them] afraid?

lions yea they <u>23\_ISA\_05\_29</u> # Their roaring [shall be] like a lion, they shall roar like young lions: yea, they shall roar, and lay hold of the prey, and shall carry [it] away safe, and none shall deliver [it].

lions <u>10\_2SA\_01\_23</u> # Saul and Jonathan [were] lovely and pleasant in their lives, and in their death they were not divided: they were swifter than eagles, they were stronger than lions.

lions 19 PSA 35 17 # Lord, how long wilt thou look on? rescue my soul from their destructions, my darling from the lions.

lions 66\_REV\_09\_08 # And they had hair as the hair of women, and their teeth were as [the teeth] of lions.

millions and let <u>01\_GEN\_24\_60</u> # And they blessed Rebekah, and said unto her, Thou [art] our sister, be thou [the mother] of thousands of millions, and let thy seed possess the gate of those which hate them.

pavilion from the <u>19\_PSA\_31\_20</u> # Thou shalt hide them in the secret of thy presence from the pride of man: thou shalt keep them secretly in a pavilion from the strife of tongues.

pavilion in the <u>19\_PSA\_27\_05</u># For in the time of trouble he shall hide me in his pavilion: in the secret of his tabernacle shall he hide me; he shall set me up upon a rock.

pavilion over them <u>24\_JER\_43\_10</u># And say unto them, Thus saith the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel; Behold, I will send and take Nebuchadrezzar the king of Babylon, my servant, and will set his throne upon these stones that I have hid; and he shall spread his royal pavilion over them.

pavilion round about 19\_PSA\_18\_11# He made darkness his secret place; his pavilion round about him [were] dark waters [and] thick clouds of the skies.

pavilions he and <u>11\_1KI\_20\_16</u># And they went out at noon. But Benhadad [was] drinking himself drunk in the pavilions, he and the kings, the thirty and two kings that helped him.

pavilions round about 10\_2SA\_22\_12 # And he made darkness pavilions round about him, dark waters, [and] thick clouds of the skies.

pavilions that he <u>11\_1KI\_20\_12</u># And it came to pass, when [Benhadad] heard this message, as he [was] drinking, he and the kings in the pavilions, that he said unto his servants, Set [yourselves in array]. And they set [themselves in array] against the city.

rebellion unto his <u>18\_JOB\_34\_37</u> # For he addeth rebellion unto his sin, he clappeth [his hands] among us, and multiplieth his words against God.

vermilion <u>26\_EZE\_23\_14</u> # And [that] she increased her whoredoms: for when she saw men portrayed upon the wall, the images of the Chaldeans portrayed with vermilion,

vermilion <u>24\_JER\_22\_14</u># That saith, I will build me a wide house and large chambers, and cutteth him out windows; and [it is] ceiled with cedar, and painted with vermilion.
