along and smote <u>07_JUD_20_37</u># And the liers in wait hasted, and rushed upon Gibeah; and the liers in wait drew [themselves] along, and smote all the city with the edge of the sword.

along as he <u>24_JER_41_06</u># And Ishmael the son of Nethaniah went forth from Mizpah to meet them, weeping all along as he went: and it came to pass, as he met them, he said unto them, Come to Gedaliah the son of Ahikam.

along by the <u>14_2CH_23_10</u># And he set all the people, every man having his weapon in his hand, from the right side of the temple to the left side of the temple, along by the altar and the temple, by the king round about.

along by the <u>12_2KI_11_11</u># And the guard stood, every man with his weapons in his hand, round about the king, from the right corner of the temple to the left corner of the temple, [along] by the altar and the temple.

along by the <u>05_DEU_02_27</u># Let me pass through thy land: I will go along by the high way, I will neither turn unto the right hand nor to the left.

along by the <u>02_EXO_02_05</u># And the daughter of Pharaoh came down to wash [herself] at the river; and her maidens walked along by the river's side; and when she saw the ark among the flags, she sent her maid to fetch it.

along by the <u>06_JOS_15_06</u># And the border went up to Bethhogla, and passed along by the north of Betharabah; and the border went up to the stone of Bohan the son of Reuben:

along by the <u>07_JUD_09_37</u> # And Gaal spake again and said, See there come people down by the middle of the land, and another company come along by the plain of Meonenim.

along by the <u>07_JUD_11_26</u># While Israel dwelt in Heshbon and her towns, and in Aroer and her towns, and in all the cities that [be] along by the coasts of Arnon, three hundred years? why therefore did ye not recover [them] within that time?

along by the <u>04_NUM_21_22</u># Let me pass through thy land: we will not turn into the fields, or into the vineyards; we will not drink [of] the waters of the well: [but] we will go along by the king's [high] way, until we be past thy borders.

along by the <u>04_NUM_34_03</u># Then your south quarter shall be from the wilderness of Zin along by the coast of Edom, and your south border shall be the outmost coast of the salt sea eastward:

along in the <u>07_JUD_07_12</u># And the Midianites and the Amalekites and all the children of the east lay along in the valley like grasshoppers for multitude; and their camels [were] without number, as the sand by the sea side for multitude.

along on the <u>09_1SA_28_20</u># Then Saul fell straightway all along on the earth, and was sore afraid, because of the words of Samuel: and there was no strength in him; for he had eaten no bread all the day, nor all the night.

along on the 10_2SA_16_13 # And as David and his men went by the way, Shimei went along on the hill's

side over against him, and cursed as he went, and threw stones at him, and cast dust.

along on the <u>06_JOS_17_07</u># And the coast of Manasseh was from Asher to Michmethah, that [lieth] before Shechem; and the border went along on the right hand unto the inhabitants of Entappuah.

along on the <u>06_JOS_19_13</u> # And from thence passeth on along on the east to Gittahhepher, to Ittahkazin, and goeth out to Remmonmethoar to Neah;

along that way <u>07_JUD_09_25</u> # And the men of Shechem set liers in wait for him in the top of the mountains, and they robbed all that came along that way by them: and it was told Abimelech.

along the highway <u>09_1SA_06_12</u> # And the kine took the straight way to the way of Bethshemesh, [and] went along the highway, lowing as they went, and turned not aside [to] the right hand or [to] the left; and the lords of the Philistines went after them unto the border of Bethshemesh.

along the way <u>06_JOS_10_10</u># And the LORD discomfited them before Israel, and slew them with a great slaughter at Gibeon, and chased them along the way that goeth up to Bethhoron, and smote them to Azekah, and unto Makkedah.

along through the <u>07_JUD_11_18</u># Then they went along through the wilderness, and compassed the land of Edom, and the land of Moab, and came by the east side of the land of Moab, and pitched on the other side of Arnon, but came not within the border of Moab: for Arnon [was] the border of Moab.

along to Hezron <u>06_JOS_15_03</u># And it went out to the south side to Maalehacrabbim, and passed along to Zin, and ascended up on the south side unto Kadeshbarnea, and passed along to Hezron, and went up to Adar, and fetched a compass to Karkaa:

along to mount <u>06_JOS_15_11</u># And the border went out unto the side of Ekron northward: and the border was drawn to Shicron, and passed along to mount Baalah, and went out unto Jabneel; and the goings out of the border were at the sea.

along to the <u>06_JOS_18_19</u># And the border passed along to the side of Bethhoglah northward: and the outgoings of the border were at the north bay of the salt sea at the south end of Jordan: this [was] the south coast.

along to Zin <u>06_JOS_15_03</u># And it went out to the south side to Maalehacrabbim, and passed along to Zin, and ascended up on the south side unto Kadeshbarnea, and passed along to Hezron, and went up to Adar, and fetched a compass to Karkaa:

along toward the <u>06_JOS_18_18_#</u> And passed along toward the side over against Arabah northward, and went down unto Arabah:

along unto the <u>06_JOS_15_10</u># And the border compassed from Baalah westward unto mount Seir, and passed along unto the side of mount Jearim, which [is] Chesalon, on the north side, and went down to Bethshemesh, and passed on to Timnah:

along unto the <u>06_JOS_16_02</u># And goeth out from Bethel to Luz, and passeth along unto the borders of Archi to Ataroth,

along upon the <u>02_EXO_09_23</u># And Moses stretched forth his rod toward heaven: and the LORD sent thunder and hail, and the fire ran along upon the ground; and the LORD rained hail upon the land of Egypt.

along weeping behind <u>10_2SA_03_16</u> # And her husband went with her along weeping behind her to Bahurim. Then said Abner unto him, Go, return. And he returned.

along <u>07_JUD_07_13</u># And when Gideon was come, behold, [there was] a man that told a dream unto his fellow, and said, Behold, I dreamed a dream, and, lo, a cake of barley bread tumbled into the host of Midian, and came unto a tent, and smote it that it fell, and overturned it, that the tent lay along.

belong mercies and <u>27_DAN_09_09</u># To the Lord our God [belong] mercies and forgivenesses, though we have rebelled against him;

belong the issues 19_PSA_68_20_# [He that is] our God [is] the God of salvation; and unto GOD the Lord [belong] the issues from death.

belong to Christ <u>41_MAR_09_41</u> # For whosoever shall give you a cup of water to drink in my name, because ye belong to Christ, verily I say unto you, he shall not lose his reward.

belong to God <u>01 GEN_40_08</u># And they said unto him, We have dreamed a dream, and [there is] no interpreter of it. And Joseph said unto them, [Do] not interpretations [belong] to God? tell me [them], I pray you.

belong to it <u>04_NUM_01_50</u># But thou shalt appoint the Levites over the tabernacle of testimony, and over all the vessels thereof, and over all things that [belong] to it: they shall bear the tabernacle, and all the vessels thereof; and they shall minister unto it, and shall encamp round about the tabernacle.

belong to the <u>46_1CO_07_32</u> # But I would have you without carefulness. He that is unmarried careth for the things that belong to the Lord, how he may please the Lord:

belong to the <u>20_PRO_24_23</u># These [things] also [belong] to the wise. [It is] not good to have respect of persons in judgment.

belong unto God 19 PSA 47 09 # The princes of the people are gathered together, [even] the people of the God of Abraham: for the shields of the earth [belong] unto God: he is greatly exalted.

belong unto the <u>05_DEU_29_29</u># The secret [things belong] unto the LORD our God: but those [things which are] revealed [belong] unto us and to our children for ever, that [we] may do all the words of this law.

belong unto thy 42_LUK_19_42 # Saying, If thou hadst known, even thou, at least in this thy day, the things [which belong] unto thy peace! but now they are hid from thine eyes.

belong unto us <u>05_DEU_29_29</u> # The secret [things belong] unto the LORD our God: but those [things which are] revealed [belong] unto us and to our children for ever, that [we] may do all the words of this law.

belong <u>03_LEV_27_24</u> # In the year of the jubilee the field shall return unto him of whom it was bought, [even] to him to whom the possession of the land [did belong].

belonged to David 11_1KI_01_08# But Zadok the priest, and Benaiah the son of Jehoiada, and Nathan the prophet, and Shimei, and Rei, and the mighty men which [belonged] to David, were not with Adonijah.

belonged to her <u>17_EST_02_09</u># And the maiden pleased him, and she obtained kindness of him; and he speedily gave her her things for purification, with such things as belonged to her, and seven maidens, [which were] meet to be given her, out of the king's house: and he preferred her and her maids unto the best [place] of the house of the women.

belonged to Judah <u>13_1CH_13_06</u># And David went up, and all Israel, to Baalah, [that is], to Kirjathjearim, which [belonged] to Judah, to bring up thence the ark of God the LORD, that dwelleth

[between] the cherubims, whose name is called [on it].

belonged to Judah <u>12 2KI 14 28</u> # Now the rest of the acts of Jeroboam, and all that he did, and his might, how he warred, and how he recovered Damascus, and Hamath, [which belonged] to Judah, for Israel, are they not written in the book of the chronicles of the kings of Israel?

belonged to king 17_EST_01_09 # Also Vashti the queen made a feast for the women [in] the royal house which [belonged] to king Ahasuerus.

belonged to Saul <u>09_1SA_21_07</u> # Now a certain man of the servants of Saul [was] there that day, detained before the LORD; and his name [was] Doeg, an Edomite, the chiefest of the herdmen that [belonged] to Saul.

belonged to the <u>13_1CH_02_23</u># And he took Geshur, and Aram, with the towns of Jair, from them, with Kenath, and the towns thereof, [even] threescore cities. All these [belonged to] the sons of Machir, the father of Gilead.

belonged to the <u>11_1KI_15_27</u># And Baasha the son of Ahijah, of the house of Issachar, conspired against him; and Baasha smote him at Gibbethon, which [belonged] to the Philistines; for Nadab and all Israel laid siege to Gibbethon.

belonged to the <u>11_1KI_16_15</u># In the twenty and seventh year of Asa king of Judah did Zimri reign seven days in Tirzah. And the people [were] encamped against Gibbethon, which [belonged] to the Philistines.

belonged to the 14_2CH_26_23 # So Uzziah slept with his fathers, and they buried him with his fathers in the field of the burial which [belonged] to the kings; for they said, He [is] a leper: and Jotham his son reigned in his stead.

belonged to the <u>06_JOS_17_08</u> # [Now] Manasseh had the land of Tappuah: but Tappuah on the border of Manasseh [belonged] to the children of Ephraim;

belonged unto Herod's <u>42_LUK_23_07</u> # And as soon as he knew that he belonged unto Herod's jurisdiction, he sent him to Herod, who himself also was at Jerusalem at that time.

belongest thou and <u>09_1SA_30_13</u># And David said unto him, To whom [belongest] thou? and whence [art] thou? And he said, I [am] a young man of Egypt, servant to an Amalekite; and my master left me, because three days ago I fell sick.

belongeth confusion of <u>27_DAN_09_08</u># O Lord, to us [belongeth] confusion of face, to our kings, to our princes, and to our fathers, because we have sinned against thee.

belongeth mercy for 19_PSA_62_12 # Also unto thee, O Lord, [belongeth] mercy: for thou renderest to every man according to his work.

belongeth O God 19_PSA_94_01 # O LORD God, to whom vengeance belongeth; O God, to whom vengeance belongeth, show thyself.

belongeth show thyself 19_PSA_94_01_# O LORD God, to whom vengeance belongeth; O God, to whom vengeance belongeth, show thyself.

belongeth to Benjamin <u>07_JUD_19_14</u># And they passed on and went their way; and the sun went down upon them [when they were] by Gibeah, which [belongeth] to Benjamin.

belongeth to Benjamin <u>07_JUD_20_04</u> # And the Levite, the husband of the woman that was slain, answered and said, I came into Gibeah that [belongeth] to Benjamin, I and my concubine, to lodge.

belongeth to Judah <u>11_1KI_19_03</u># And when he saw [that], he arose, and went for his life, and came to Beersheba, which [belongeth] to Judah, and left his servant there.

belongeth to Judah <u>09_1SA_17_01</u># Now the Philistines gathered together their armies to battle, and were gathered together at Shochoh, which [belongeth] to Judah, and pitched between Shochoh and Azekah, in Ephesdammin.

belongeth to Judah <u>09_1SA_30_14</u> # We made an invasion [upon] the south of the Cherethites, and upon [the coast] which [belongeth] to Judah, and upon the south of Caleb; and we burned Ziklag with fire.

belongeth to Judah 14_2CH_25_21 # So Joash the king of Israel went up; and they saw one another in the face, [both] he and Amaziah king of Judah, at Bethshemesh, which [belongeth] to Judah.

belongeth to Judah 12 2KI 14 11 # But Amaziah would not hear. Therefore Jehoash king of Israel went up; and he and Amaziah king of Judah looked one another in the face at Bethshemesh, which [belongeth] to Judah.

belongeth to them <u>58_HEB_05_14</u> # But strong meat belongeth to them that are of full age, [even] those who by reason of use have their senses exercised to discern both good and evil.

belongeth to Zidon 11_1KI_17_09# Arise, get thee to Zarephath, which [belongeth] to Zidon, and dwell there: behold, I have commanded a widow woman there to sustain thee.

belongeth unto God 19 PSA 62 11 # God hath spoken once; twice have I heard this; that power [belongeth] unto God.

belongeth unto me <u>58_HEB_10_30</u># For we know him that hath said, Vengeance [belongeth] unto me, I will recompense, saith the Lord. And again, The Lord shall judge his people.

belongeth unto the <u>04_NUM_08_24</u> # This [is it] that [belongeth] unto the Levites: from twenty and five years old and upward they shall go in to wait upon the service of the tabernacle of the congregation:

belongeth unto the 19_PSA_03_08 # Salvation [belongeth] unto the LORD: thy blessing [is] upon thy people. Selah.

belongeth unto thee <u>27_DAN_09_07</u># O Lord, righteousness [belongeth] unto thee, but unto us confusion of faces, as at this day; to the men of Judah, and to the inhabitants of Jerusalem, and unto all Israel, [that are] near, and [that are] far off, through all the countries whither thou hast driven them, because of their trespass that they have trespassed against thee.

belongeth unto thee <u>15_EZR_10_04</u> # Arise; for [this] matter [belongeth] unto thee: we also [will be] with thee: be of good courage, and do [it].

belongeth vengeance and <u>05_DEU_32_35</u># To me [belongeth] vengeance, and recompense; their foot shall slide in [due] time: for the day of their calamity [is] at hand, and the things that shall come upon them make haste.

belonging not to 20_PRO_26_17 # He that passeth by, [and] meddleth with strife [belonging] not to him, [is like] one that taketh a dog by the ears.

belonging to the <u>09_1SA_06_18</u># And the golden mice, [according to] the number of all the cities of the Philistines [belonging] to the five lords, [both] of fenced cities, and of country villages, even unto the great [stone of] Abel, whereon they set down the ark of the LORD: [which stone remaineth] unto this day in the field of Joshua, the Bethshemite.

belonging to the <u>42_LUK_09_10</u> # And the apostles, when they were returned, told him all that they had done. And he took them, and went aside privately into a desert place belonging to the city called Bethsaida.

belonging unto Boaz <u>08_RUT_02_03</u> # And she went, and came, and gleaned in the field after the reapers: and her hap was to light on a part of the field [belonging] unto Boaz, who [was] of the kindred of Elimelech.

belonging unto them <u>04_NUM_07_09</u># But unto the sons of Kohath he gave none: because the service of the sanctuary belonging unto them [was that] they should bear upon their shoulders.

furlongs off 43_JOH_11_18 # Now Bethany was nigh unto Jerusalem, about fifteen furlongs off:

furlongs The length <u>66_REV_21_16</u># And the city lieth foursquare, and the length is as large as the breadth: and he measured the city with the reed, twelve thousand furlongs. The length and the breadth and the height of it are equal.

furlongs they see 43_JOH_06_19 # So when they had rowed about five and twenty or thirty furlongs, they see Jesus walking on the sea, and drawing nigh unto the ship: and they were afraid.

furlongs <u>42_LUK_24_13</u> # And, behold, two of them went that same day to a village called Emmaus, which was from Jerusalem [about] threescore furlongs.

furlongs <u>66_REV_14_20</u># And the winepress was trodden without the city, and blood came out of the winepress, even unto the horse bridles, by the space of a thousand [and] six hundred furlongs.

headlong he burst 44_ACT_01_18 # Now this man purchased a field with the reward of iniquity; and falling headlong, he burst asunder in the midst, and all his bowels gushed out.

headlong <u>18_JOB_05_13</u># He taketh the wise in their own craftiness: and the counsel of the froward is carried headlong.

headlong <u>42_LUK_04_29</u># And rose up, and thrust him out of the city, and led him unto the brow of the hill whereon their city was built, that they might cast him down headlong.

long a time <u>58_HEB_04_07</u> # Again, he limiteth a certain day, saying in David, To day, after so long a time; as it is said, To day if ye will hear his voice, harden not your hearts.

long abstinence Paul <u>44_ACT_27_21</u># But after long abstinence Paul stood forth in the midst of them, and said, Sirs, ye should have hearkened unto me, and not have loosed from Crete, and to have gained this harm and loss.

long after there <u>44_ACT_27_14</u># But not long after there arose against it a tempestuous wind, called Euroclydon.

long after you <u>47_2CO_09_14</u># And by their prayer for you, which long after you for the exceeding grace of God in you.

long after you <u>50_PHP_01_08</u># For God is my record, how greatly I long after you all in the bowels of Jesus Christ.

long ago how 12_2KI_19_25 # Hast thou not heard long ago [how] I have done it, [and] of ancient times that I have formed it? now have I brought it to pass, that thou shouldest be to lay waste fenced cities [into] ruinous heaps.

long ago how 23_ISA_37_26 # Hast thou not heard long ago, [how] I have done it; [and] of ancient times,

that I have formed it? now have I brought it to pass, that thou shouldest be to lay waste defenced cities [into] ruinous heaps.

long ago in <u>40 MAT_11_21</u># Woe unto thee, Chorazin! woe unto thee, Bethsaida! for if the mighty works, which were done in you, had been done in Tyre and Sidon, they would have repented long ago in sackcloth and ashes.

long ago 23_ISA_22_11 # Ye made also a ditch between the two walls for the water of the old pool: but ye have not looked unto the maker thereof, neither had respect unto him that fashioned it long ago.

long and a <u>26_EZE_40_42</u># And the four tables [were] of hewn stone for the burnt offering, of a cubit and an half long, and a cubit and an half broad, and one cubit high: whereupon also they laid the instruments wherewith they slew the burnt offering and the sacrifice.

long and an <u>26_EZE_40_47</u># So he measured the court, an hundred cubits long, and an hundred cubits broad, foursquare; and the altar [that was] before the house.

long and five 14 2CH 06 13 # For Solomon had made a brazen scaffold, of five cubits long, and five cubits broad, and three cubits high, and had set it in the midst of the court: and upon it he stood, and kneeled down upon his knees before all the congregation of Israel, and spread forth his hands toward heaven,

long and five <u>02_EXO_27_01</u># And thou shalt make an altar [of] shittim wood, five cubits long, and five cubits broad; the altar shall be foursquare: and the height thereof [shall be] three cubits.

long and five <u>26_EZE_40_29</u># And the little chambers thereof, and the posts thereof, and the arches thereof, according to these measures: and [there were] windows in it and in the arches thereof round about: [it was] fifty cubits long, and five and twenty cubits broad.

long and five <u>26_EZE_40_30</u># And the arches round about [were] five and twenty cubits long, and five cubits broad.

long and five <u>26_EZE_40_33</u># And the little chambers thereof, and the posts thereof, and the arches thereof, [were] according to these measures: and [there were] windows therein and in the arches thereof round about: [it was] fifty cubits long, and five and twenty cubits broad.

long and five <u>26_EZE_42_20</u># He measured it by the four sides: it had a wall round about, five hundred [reeds] long, and five hundred broad, to make a separation between the sanctuary and the profane place.

long and fourteen <u>26_EZE_43_17</u># And the settle [shall be] fourteen [cubits] long and fourteen broad in the four squares thereof; and the border about it [shall be] half a cubit; and the bottom thereof [shall be] a cubit about; and his stairs shall look toward the east.

long and he <u>27_DAN_10_01</u># In the third year of Cyrus king of Persia a thing was revealed unto Daniel, whose name was called Belteshazzar; and the thing [was] true, but the time appointed [was] long: and he understood the thing, and had understanding of the vision.

long and he <u>05_DEU_33_12</u> # [And] of Benjamin he said, The beloved of the LORD shall dwell in safety by him; [and the LORD] shall cover him all the day long, and he shall dwell between his shoulders.

long And he <u>23_ISA_06_11</u># Then said I, Lord, how long? And he answered, Until the cities be wasted without inhabitant, and the houses without man, and the land be utterly desolate,

long and his <u>02_EXO_27_11</u># And likewise for the north side in length [there shall be] hangings of an hundred [cubits] long, and his twenty pillars and their twenty sockets [of] brass; the hooks of the pillars and their fillets [of] silver.

long and is <u>46_1CO_13_04</u># Charity suffereth long, [and] is kind; charity envieth not; charity vaunteth not itself, is not puffed up,

long and let 19_PSA_90_13 # Return, O LORD, how long? and let it repent thee concerning thy servants.

long and one <u>26_EZE_40_07</u># And [every] little chamber [was] one reed long, and one reed broad; and between the little chambers [were] five cubits; and the threshold of the gate by the porch of the gate within [was] one reed.

long and praise 19_PSA_44_08 # In God we boast all the day long, and praise thy name for ever. Selah.

long and slay <u>05_DEU_19_06</u># Lest the avenger of the blood pursue the slayer, while his heart is hot, and overtake him, because the way is long, and slay him; whereas he [was] not worthy of death, inasmuch as he hated him not in time past.

long and the <u>26_EZE_41_13</u># So he measured the house, an hundred cubits long; and the separate place, and the building, with the walls thereof, an hundred cubits long;

long and there <u>05_DEU_28_32</u> # Thy sons and thy daughters [shall be] given unto another people, and thine eves shall look, and fail [with longing] for them all the day long: and [there shall be] no might in thine hand.

long and thirty <u>26_EZE_46_22</u># In the four corners of the court [there were] courts joined of forty [cubits] long and thirty broad: these four corners [were] of one measure.

long and to <u>35_HAB_02_06</u># Shall not all these take up a parable against him, and a taunting proverb against him, and say, Woe to him that increaseth [that which is] not his! how long? and to him that ladeth himself with thick clay!

long and waxed <u>02_EXO_19_19</u># And when the voice of the trumpet sounded long, and waxed louder and louder, Moses spake, and God answered him by a voice.

long are ye <u>06_JOS_18_03</u># And Joshua said unto the children of Israel, How long [are] ye slack to go to possess the land, which the LORD God of your fathers hath given you?

long as he $09_{18A_01_28}$ # Therefore also I have lent him to the LORD; as long as he liveth he shall be lent to the LORD. And he worshipped the LORD there.

long as he <u>14_2CH_26_05</u># And he sought God in the days of Zechariah, who had understanding in the visions of God: and as long as he sought the LORD, God made him to prosper.

long as he <u>48_GAL_04_01</u> # Now I say, [That] the heir, as long as he is a child, differeth nothing from a servant, though he be lord of all;

long as he <u>45_ROM_07_01</u> # Know ye not, brethren, [for I speak to them that know the law,] how that the law hath dominion over a man as long as he liveth?

long as he <u>45_ROM_07_02</u># For the woman which hath an husband is bound by the law to [her] husband so long as he liveth; but if the husband be dead, she is loosed from the law of [her] husband.

long as her <u>46_1CO_07_39</u># The wife is bound by the law as long as her husband liveth; but if her husband be dead, she is at liberty to be married to whom she will; only in the Lord.

long as I <u>09_1SA_29_08</u># And David said unto Achish, But what have I done? and what hast thou found in thy servant so long as I have been with thee unto this day, that I may not go fight against the enemies of my

lord the king?

long as I <u>61_2PE_01_13</u> # Yea, I think it meet, as long as I am in this tabernacle, to stir you up by putting [you] in remembrance;

long as I <u>17_EST_05_13</u> # Yet all this availeth me nothing, so long as I see Mordecai the Jew sitting at the king's gate.

long as I <u>18_JOB_27_06</u> # My righteousness I hold fast, and will not let it go: my heart shall not reproach [me] so long as I live.

long as I 43_JOH_09_05 # As long as I am in the world, I am the light of the world.

long as I <u>19_PSA_104_33</u># I will sing unto the LORD as long as I live: I will sing praise to my God while I have my being.

long as I <u>19_PSA_116_02</u># Because he hath inclined his ear unto me, therefore will I call upon [him] as long as I live.

long wilt thou 19_PSA_35_17 # Lord, how long wilt thou look on? rescue my soul from their destructions,

my darling from the lions.

long wilt thou <u>19_PSA_80_04</u> # O LORD God of hosts, how long wilt thou be angry against the prayer of thy people?

long wilt thou <u>38_ZEC_01_12</u># Then the angel of the LORD answered and said, O LORD of hosts, how long wilt thou not have mercy on Jerusalem and on the cities of Judah, against which thou hast had indignation these threescore and ten years?

long with them <u>42_LUK_18_07</u># And shall not God avenge his own elect, which cry day and night unto him, though he bear long with them?

long ye simple 20_PRO_01_22 # How long, ye simple ones, will ye love simplicity? and the scorners delight in their scorning, and fools hate knowledge?

long 11_1KI_06_17 # And the house, that [is], the temple before it, was forty cubits [long].

long <u>26_EZE_41_13</u># So he measured the house, an hundred cubits long; and the separate place, and the building, with the walls thereof, an hundred cubits long;

long 20_PRO_23_17 # Let not thine heart envy sinners: but [be thou] in the fear of the LORD all the day long.

long 19_PSA_06_03 # My soul is also sore vexed: but thou, O LORD, how long?

long 19_PSA_32_03 # When I kept silence, my bones waxed old through my roaring all the day long.

long 19_PSA_35_28 # And my tongue shall speak of thy righteousness [and] of thy praise all the day long.

long 19_PSA_38_06 # I am troubled; I am bowed down greatly; I go mourning all the day long.

long <u>19_PSA_74_09</u> # We see not our signs: [there is] no more any prophet: neither [is there] among us any that knoweth how long.

longed after thy <u>19_PSA_119_40</u># Behold, I have longed after thy precepts: quicken me in thy righteousness.

longed after you <u>50_PHP_02_26</u> # For he longed after you all, and was full of heaviness, because that ye had heard that he had been sick.

longed and said <u>13_1CH_11_17</u># And David longed, and said, Oh that one would give me drink of the water of the well of Bethlehem, that [is] at the gate!

longed and said 10_28A_23_15 # And David longed, and said, Oh that one would give me drink of the water of the well of Bethlehem, which [is] by the gate!

longed for my <u>50_PHP_04_01</u> # Therefore, my brethren, dearly beloved and longed for, my joy and crown, so stand fast in the Lord, [my] dearly beloved.

longed for thy 19_PSA_119_131 # I opened my mouth, and panted: for I longed for thy commandments.

longed for thy 19_PSA_119_174 # I have longed for thy salvation, O LORD; and thy law [is] my delight.

longed to go <u>10_2SA_13_39</u> # And [the soul of] king David longed to go forth unto Absalom: for he was comforted concerning Amnon, seeing he was dead.

longedst after thy <u>01_GEN_31_30</u> # And now, [though] thou wouldest needs be gone, because thou sore longedst after thy father's house, [yet] wherefore hast thou stolen my gods?

longer bear because 24 JER_44 22 # So that the LORD could no longer bear, because of the evil of your doings, [and] because of the abominations which ye have committed; therefore is your land a desolation, and an astonishment, and a curse, without an inhabitant, as at this day.

longer forbear I <u>52_1TH_03_05</u> # For this cause, when I could no longer forbear, I sent to know your faith, lest by some means the tempter have tempted you, and our labour be in vain.

longer forbear we <u>52_1TH_03_01</u> # Wherefore when we could no longer forbear, we thought it good to be left at Athens alone;

longer hide him <u>02_EXO_02_03</u> # And when she could not longer hide him, she took for him an ark of bulrushes, and daubed it with slime and with pitch, and put the child therein; and she laid [it] in the flags by the river's brink.

longer should live <u>60_1PE_04_02</u> # That he no longer should live the rest of [his] time in the flesh to the lusts of men, but to the will of God.

longer therein 45_ROM_06_02 # God forbid. How shall we, that are dead to sin, live any longer therein?

longer time with <u>44_ACT_18_20</u># When they desired [him] to tarry longer time with them, he consented not;

longer under a 48_GAL_03_25 # But after that faith is come, we are no longer under a schoolmaster.

longer water but <u>54_1TI_05_23</u> # Drink no longer water, but use a little wine for thy stomach's sake and thine often infirmities.

longer 12_2KI_06_33 # And while he yet talked with them, behold, the messenger came down unto him: and he said, Behold, this evil [is] of the LORD; what should I wait for the LORD any longer?

longer <u>44_ACT_25_24</u> # And Festus said, King Agrippa, and all men which are here present with us, ye see this man, about whom all the multitude of the Jews have dealt with me, both at Jerusalem, and [also] here, crying that he ought not to live any longer.

longer <u>02_EXO_09_28</u> # Entreat the LORD [for [it is] enough] that there be no [more] mighty thunderings and hail; and I will let you go, and ye shall stay no longer.

longeth for thee 19 PSA 63 01 # A Psalm of David, when he was in the wilderness of Judah. O God, thou [art] my God; early will I seek thee: my soul thirsteth for thee, my flesh longeth for thee in a dry and thirsty land, where no water is;

longeth for your <u>01_GEN_34_08</u> # And Hamor communed with them, saying, The soul of my son Shechem longeth for your daughter: I pray you give her him to wife.

longeth to eat <u>05_DEU_12_20</u> # When the LORD thy God shall enlarge thy border, as he hath promised thee, and thou shalt say, I will eat flesh, because thy soul longeth to eat flesh; thou mayest eat flesh, whatsoever thy soul lusteth after.

longeth yea even 19_PSA_84_02 # My soul longeth, yea, even fainteth for the courts of the LORD: my heart and my flesh crieth out for the living God.

longing for them <u>05_DEU_28_32</u> # Thy sons and thy daughters [shall be] given unto another people, and thine eyes shall look, and fail [with longing] for them all the day long: and [there shall be] no might in thine hand.

longing soul and 19_PSA_107_09 # For he satisfieth the longing soul, and filleth the hungry soul with goodness.

longing that it 19_PSA_119_20# My soul breaketh for the longing [that it hath] unto thy judgments at all times.

longsuffering gentleness goodness <u>48_GAL_05_22</u> # But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, gentleness, goodness, faith,

longsuffering know that <u>24_JER_15_15</u> # O LORD, thou knowest: remember me, and visit me, and revenge me of my persecutors; take me not away in thy longsuffering: know that for thy sake I have suffered rebuke.

longsuffering not knowing <u>45_ROM_02_04</u> # Or despisest thou the riches of his goodness and forbearance and longsuffering; not knowing that the goodness of God leadeth thee to repentance?

longsuffering of God 60_1PE_03_20 # Which sometime were disobedient, when once the longsuffering of God waited in the days of Noah, while the ark was a preparing, wherein few, that is, eight souls were saved by water.

longsuffering of our 61_2PE_03_15 # And account [that] the longsuffering of our Lord [is] salvation; even as our beloved brother Paul also according to the wisdom given unto him hath written unto you;

longsuffering the vessels <u>45_ROM_09_22</u> # [What] if God, willing to show [his] wrath, and to make his power known, endured with much longsuffering the vessels of wrath fitted to destruction:

longsuffering to us <u>61_2PE_03_09</u># The Lord is not slack concerning his promise, as some men count slackness; but is longsuffering to us ward, not willing that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance.
