flower and as 23\_ISA\_28\_04 # And the glorious beauty, which [is] on the head of the fat valley, shall be a fading flower, [and] as the hasty fruit before the summer; which [when] he that looketh upon it seeth, while it is yet in his hand he eateth it up.

flower and is <u>18\_JOB\_14\_02</u># He cometh forth like a flower, and is cut down: he fleeth also as a shadow, and continueth not.

flower and three <u>02\_EXO\_37\_19</u># Three bowls made after the fashion of almonds in one branch, a knop and a flower; and three bowls made like almonds in another branch, a knop and a flower: so throughout the six branches going out of the candlestick.

flower as the <u>18\_JOB\_15\_33</u># He shall shake off his unripe grape as the vine, and shall cast off his flower as the olive.

flower fadeth because 23\_ISA\_40\_07 # The grass withereth, the flower fadeth: because the spirit of the LORD bloweth upon it: surely the people [is] grass.

flower fadeth but 23\_ISA\_40\_08 # The grass withereth, the flower fadeth: but the word of our God shall stand for ever.

flower he shall <u>23\_ISA\_18\_05</u># For afore the harvest, when the bud is perfect, and the sour grape is ripening in the flower, he shall both cut off the sprigs with pruning hooks, and take away [and] cut down the branches.

flower in one <u>02\_EXO\_25\_33</u># Three bowls made like unto almonds, [with] a knop and a flower in one branch; and three bowls made like almonds in the other branch, [with] a knop and a flower: so in the six branches that come out of the candlestick.

flower of grass <u>60\_1PE\_01\_24</u> # For all flesh [is] as grass, and all the glory of man as the flower of grass. The grass withereth, and the flower thereof falleth away:

flower of her <u>46\_1CO\_07\_36</u># But if any man think that he behaveth himself uncomely toward his virgin, if she pass the flower of [her] age, and need so require, let him do what he will, he sinneth not: let them marry.

flower of Lebanon 34\_NAH\_01\_04 # He rebuketh the sea, and maketh it dry, and drieth up all the rivers: Bashan languisheth, and Carmel, and the flower of Lebanon languisheth.

flower of the <u>23\_ISA\_40\_06</u> # The voice said, Cry. And he said, What shall I cry? All flesh [is] grass, and all the goodliness thereof [is] as the flower of the field:

flower of the <u>59\_JAM\_01\_10</u># But the rich, in that he is made low: because as the flower of the grass he shall pass away.

flower of the 19\_PSA\_103\_15 # [As for] man, his days [are] as grass: as a flower of the field, so he flourisheth.

flower so throughout <u>02\_EXO\_37\_19</u># Three bowls made after the fashion of almonds in one branch, a knop and a flower; and three bowls made like almonds in another branch, a knop and a flower: so throughout the six branches going out of the candlestick.

flower thereof falleth <u>60\_1PE\_01\_24</u> # For all flesh [is] as grass, and all the glory of man as the flower of grass. The grass withereth, and the flower thereof falleth away:

flower thereof falleth <u>59\_JAM\_01\_11</u># For the sun is no sooner risen with a burning heat, but it withereth the grass, and the flower thereof falleth, and the grace of the fashion of it perisheth: so also shall the rich man fade away in his ways.

flower which are 23 ISA 28 01 # Woe to the crown of pride, to the drunkards of Ephraim, whose glorious beauty [is] a fading flower, which [are] on the head of the fat valleys of them that are overcome with wine!

flowers all was 11\_1KI\_06\_18# And the cedar of the house within [was] carved with knops and open flowers: all [was] cedar; there was no stone seen.

flowers and covered 11 1KI 06 35 # And he carved [thereon] cherubims and palm trees and open flowers: and covered [them] with gold fitted upon the carved work.

flowers and of <u>03\_LEV\_15\_33</u> # And of her that is sick of her flowers, and of him that hath an issue, of the man, and of the woman, and of him that lieth with her that is unclean.

flowers and overlaid <u>11\_1KI\_06\_32</u># The two doors also [were of] olive tree; and he carved upon them carvings of cherubims and palm trees and open flowers, and overlaid [them] with gold, and spread gold upon the cherubims, and upon the palm trees.

flowers and the <u>11\_1KI\_07\_49</u># And the candlesticks of pure gold, five on the right [side], and five on the left, before the oracle, with the flowers, and the lamps, and the tongs [of] gold,

flowers and the <u>14\_2CH\_04\_21</u> # And the flowers, and the lamps, and the tongs, [made he of] gold, [and] that perfect gold;

flowers appear on  $22_{SON_02_12}$ # The flowers appear on the earth; the time of the singing [of birds] is come, and the voice of the turtle is heard in our land;

flowers be upon <u>03\_LEV\_15\_24</u> # And if any man lie with her at all, and her flowers be upon him, he shall be unclean seven days; and all the bed whereon he lieth shall be unclean.

flowers his lips <u>22\_SON\_05\_13</u> # His cheeks [are] as a bed of spices, [as] sweet flowers: his lips [like] lilies, dropping sweet smelling myrrh.

flowers of lilies <u>11\_1KI\_07\_26</u># And it [was] an hand breadth thick, and the brim thereof was wrought like the brim of a cup, with flowers of lilies: it contained two thousand baths.

flowers of lilies <u>14\_2CH\_04\_05</u> # And the thickness of it [was] an handbreadth, and the brim of it like the work of the brim of a cup, with flowers of lilies; [and] it received and held three thousand baths.

flowers shall be <u>02\_EXO\_25\_31</u># And thou shalt make a candlestick [of] pure gold: [of] beaten work shall the candlestick be made: his shaft, and his branches, his bowls, his knops, and his flowers, shall be of the same.

flowers thereof was <u>04\_NUM\_08\_04</u> # And this work of the candlestick [was of] beaten gold, unto the shaft thereof, unto the flowers thereof, [was] beaten work: according unto the pattern which the LORD had showed Moses, so he made the candlestick.

flowers were of <u>02\_EXO\_37\_17</u> # And he made the candlestick [of] pure gold: [of] beaten work made he the candlestick; his shaft, and his branch, his bowls, his knops, and his flowers, were of the same:

flowers within and 11\_1KI\_06\_29 # And he carved all the walls of the house round about with carved figures of cherubims and palm trees and open flowers, within and without.

flowers <u>02\_EXO\_25\_34</u> # And in the candlestick [shall be] four bowls made like unto almonds, [with] their knops and their flowers.

flowers <u>02\_EXO\_37\_20</u> # And in the candlestick [were] four bowls made like almonds, his knops, and his flowers:

followers of God 49\_EPH\_05\_01 # Be ye therefore followers of God, as dear children;

followers of me 46\_1CO\_04\_16 # Wherefore I beseech you, be ye followers of me.

followers together of <u>50\_PHP\_03\_17</u># Brethren, be followers together of me, and mark them which walk so as ye have us for an ensample.

lower and than <u>26\_EZE\_42\_05</u># Now the upper chambers [were] shorter: for the galleries were higher than these, than the lower, and than the middlemost of the building.

lower gate unto <u>26\_EZE\_40\_19</u># Then he measured the breadth from the forefront of the lower gate unto the forefront of the inner court without, an hundred cubits eastward and northward.

lower parts of 23\_ISA\_44\_23 # Sing, O ye heavens; for the LORD hath done [it]: shout, ye lower parts of

the earth: break forth into singing, ye mountains, O forest, and every tree therein: for the LORD hath redeemed Jacob, and glorified himself in Israel.

lower parts of <u>19\_PSA\_63\_09</u># But those [that] seek my soul, to destroy [it], shall go into the lower parts of the earth.

lower pavement <u>26\_EZE\_40\_18</u># And the pavement by the side of the gates over against the length of the gates [was] the lower pavement.

lower places behind 16 NEH 04 13 # Therefore set I in the lower places behind the wall, [and] on the higher places, I even set the people after their families with their swords, their spears, and their bows.

lower pool <u>23\_ISA\_22\_09</u> # Ye have seen also the breaches of the city of David, that they are many: and ye gathered together the waters of the lower pool.

lower second and <u>01\_GEN\_06\_16</u># A window shalt thou make to the ark, and in a cubit shalt thou finish it above; and the door of the ark shalt thou set in the side thereof; [with] lower, second, and third [stories] shalt thou make it.

lower settle shall <u>26\_EZE\_43\_14</u> # And from the bottom [upon] the ground [even] to the lower settle [shall be] two cubits, and the breadth one cubit; and from the lesser settle [even] to the greater settle [shall be] four cubits, and the breadth [one] cubit.

lower than the <u>58\_HEB\_02\_07</u># Thou madest him a little lower than the angels; thou crownedst him with glory and honour, and didst set him over the works of thy hands:

lower than the <u>58\_HEB\_02\_09</u># But we see Jesus, who was made a little lower than the angels for the suffering of death, crowned with glory and honour; that he by the grace of God should taste death for every man.

lower than the <u>03\_LEV\_13\_20</u># And if, when the priest seeth it, behold, it [be] in sight lower than the skin, and the hair thereof be turned white; the priest shall pronounce him unclean: it [is] a plague of leprosy broken out of the boil.
