Abelbethmaachah and all 11 1KI 15 20 # So Benhadad hearkened unto king Asa, and sent the captains of the hosts which he had against the cities of Israel, and smote Ijon, and Dan, and Abelbethmaachah, and all Cinneroth, with all the land of Naphtali.

Abelbethmaachah and Janoah 12 2KI 15 29 # In the days of Pekah king of Israel came Tiglathpileser king of Assyria, and took Ijon, and Abelbethmaachah, and Janoah, and Kedesh, and Hazor, and Gilead, and Galilee, all the land of Naphtali, and carried them captive to Assyria.

Bethmaachah and all 10 2SA 20 14 # And he went through all the tribes of Israel unto Abel, and to Bethmaachah, and all the Berites: and they were gathered together, and went also after him.

Bethmaachah and they 10 2SA 20 15 # And they came and besieged him in Abel of Bethmaachah, and they cast up a bank against the city, and it stood in the trench: and all the people that [were] with Joab battered the wall, to throw it down.

Maachah and his 13 1CH 19 07 # So they hired thirty and two thousand chariots, and the king of Maachah and his people; who came and pitched before Medeba. And the children of Ammon gathered themselves together from their cities, and came to battle.

Maachah and Joshaphat 13 1CH 11 43 # Hanan the son of Maachah, and Joshaphat the Mithnite,

Maachah and the 13 1CH 07 15 # And Machir took to wife [the sister] of Huppim and Shuppim, whose sister's name [was] Maachah;] and the name of the second [was] Zelophehad: and Zelophehad had daughters. Maachah Caleb's concubine 13 1CH 02 48 # Maachah, Caleb's concubine, bare Sheber, and Tirhanah.

Maachah his mother 11 1KI 15 13# And also Maachah his mother, even her he removed from [being] queen, because she had made an idol in a grove; and Asa destroyed her idol, and burnt [it] by the brook Kidron.

Maachah king of 11 1KI 02 39 # And it came to pass at the end of three years, that two of the servants of Shimei ran away unto Achish son of Maachah king of Gath. And they told Shimei, saying, Behold, thy servants [be] in Gath.

Maachah the chief 14 2CH 11 22 # And Rehoboam made Abijah the son of Maachah the chief, [to be] ruler among his brethren: for [he thought] to make him king.

Maachah the daughter 13 1CH 03 02# The third, Absalom the son of Maachah the daughter of Talmai king of Geshur: the fourth, Adonijah the son of Haggith:

Maachah the daughter 11 1KI 15 02# Three years reigned he in Jerusalem. And his mother's name [was] Maachah, the daughter of Abishalom.

Maachah the daughter 11 1KI 15 10# And forty and one years reigned he in Jerusalem. And his mother's name [was] Maachah, the daughter of Abishalom.

Maachah the daughter 14 2CH 11 20# And after her he took Maachah the daughter of Absalom; which bare him Abijah, and Attai, and Ziza, and Shelomith.

Maachah the daughter 14 2CH 11 21 # And Rehoboam loved Maachah the daughter of Absalom above all his wives and his concubines: [for he took eighteen wives, and threescore concubines; and begat twenty and eight sons, and threescore daughters.]

Maachah the mother 14 2CH 15 16 # And also [concerning] Maachah the mother of Asa the king, he removed her from [being] queen, because she had made an idol in a grove: and Asa cut down her idol, and stamped [it], and burnt [it] at the brook Kidron.

Maachah the wife 13 1CH 07 16 # And Maachah the wife of Machir bare a son, and she called his name Peresh; and the name of his brother [was] Sheresh; and his sons [were] Ulam and Rakem.

Maachah 13 1CH 08 29 # And at Gibeon dwelt the father of Gibeon; whose wife's name [was] Maachah:

Maachah 13 1CH 09 35 # And in Gibeon dwelt the father of Gibeon, Jehiel, whose wife's name [was] Maachah:

Maachah 13 1CH 27 16 # Furthermore over the tribes of Israel: the ruler of the Reubenites [was] Eliezer the son of Zichri: of the Simeonites, Shephatiah the son of Maachah:

Maachah 01 GEN 22 24 # And his concubine, whose name [was] Reumah, she bare also Tebah, and Gaham, and Thahash, and Maachah.

Syriamaachah and out 13 1CH 19 06 # And when the children of Ammon saw that they had made themselves odious to David, Hanun and the children of Ammon sent a thousand talents of silver to hire them chariots and horsemen out of Mesopotamia, and out of Syriamaachah, and out of Zobah.
