**Mamre and he [01\\_GEN\\_18\\_01](#) # And the LORD appeared unto him in the plains of Mamre: and he sat in the tent door in the heat of the day;**

**Mamre in the [01\\_GEN\\_49\\_30](#) # In the cave that [is] in the field of Machpelah, which [is] before Mamre, in the land of Canaan, which Abraham bought with the field of Ephron the Hittite for a possession of a buryingplace.**

**Mamre let them [01\\_GEN\\_14\\_24](#) # Save only that which the young men have eaten, and the portion of the men which went with me, Aner, Eshcol, and Mamre; let them take their portion.**

**Mamre the Amorite [01\\_GEN\\_14\\_13](#) # And there came one that had escaped, and told Abram the Hebrew; for he dwelt in the plain of Mamre the Amorite, brother of Eshcol, and brother of Aner: and these [were] confederate with Abram.**

**Mamre the field [01\\_GEN\\_23\\_17](#) # And the field of Ephron, which [was] in Machpelah, which [was] before Mamre, the field, and the cave which [was] therein, and all the trees that [were] in the field, that [were] in all the borders round about, were made sure**

**Mamre the same [01\\_GEN\\_23\\_19](#) # And after this, Abraham buried Sarah his wife in the cave of the field of Machpelah before Mamre: the same [is] Hebron in the land of Canaan.**

**Mamre unto the [01\\_GEN\\_35\\_27](#) # And Jacob came unto Isaac his father unto Mamre, unto the city of Arbah, which [is] Hebron, where Abraham and Isaac sojourned.**

**Mamre which is [01\\_GEN\\_13\\_18](#) # Then Abram removed [his] tent, and came and dwelt in the plain of Mamre, which [is] in Hebron, and built there an altar unto the LORD.**

**Mamre [01\\_GEN\\_25\\_09](#) # And his sons Isaac and Ishmael buried him in the cave of Machpelah, in the field of Ephron the son of Zohar the Hittite, which [is] before Mamre;**

**Mamre [01\\_GEN\\_50\\_13](#) # For his sons carried him into the land of Canaan, and buried him in the cave of the field of Machpelah, which Abraham bought with the field for a possession of a buryingplace of Ephron the Hittite, before Mamre.**
