Manasseh according to 12_2KI_24_03 # Surely at the commandment of the LORD came [this] upon Judah, to remove [them] out of his sight, for the sins of Manasseh, according to all that he did;

Manasseh Adnah and 13_1CH_12_20# As he went to Ziklag, there fell to him of Manasseh, Adnah, and Jozabad, and Jediael, and Michael, and Jozabad, and Elihu, and Zilthai, captains of the thousands that [were] of Manasseh.

Manasseh all the <u>05_DEU_03_13</u># And the rest of Gilead, and all Bashan, [being] the kingdom of Og, gave I unto the half tribe of Manasseh; all the region of Argob, with all Bashan, which was called the land of giants.

Manasseh all the <u>06_JOS_16_09</u> # And the separate cities for the children of Ephraim [were] among the inheritance of the children of Manasseh, all the cities with their villages.

Manasseh and all <u>12_2KI_21_17</u> # Now the rest of the acts of Manasseh, and all that he did, and his sin that he sinned, [are] they not written in the book of the chronicles of the kings of Judah?

Manasseh and all <u>05_DEU_34_02</u># And all Naphtali, and the land of Ephraim, and Manasseh, and all the land of Judah, unto the utmost sea,

Manasseh and brought <u>13_1CH_05_26</u># And the God of Israel stirred up the spirit of Pul king of Assyria, and the spirit of Tilgathpilneser king of Assyria, and he carried them away, even the Reubenites, and the Gadites, and the half tribe of Manasseh, and brought them unto Halah, and Habor, and Hara, and to the river Gozan, unto this day.

Manasseh and Ephraim <u>01_GEN_48_01</u># And it came to pass after these things, that [one] told Joseph, Behold, thy father [is] sick: and he took with him his two sons, Manasseh and Ephraim.

Manasseh and Ephraim 06_JOS_14_04 # For the children of Joseph were two tribes, Manasseh and

Ephraim: therefore they gave no part unto the Levites in the land, save cities to dwell [in], with their suburbs for their cattle and for their substance.

Manasseh and Ephraim <u>06_JOS_16_04</u> # So the children of Joseph, Manasseh and Ephraim, took their inheritance.

Manasseh and Ephraim <u>04_NUM_26_28</u> # The sons of Joseph after their families [were] Manasseh and Ephraim.

Manasseh and he <u>01_GEN_48_20</u> # And he blessed them that day, saying, In thee shall Israel bless, saying, God make thee as Ephraim and as Manasseh: and he set Ephraim before Manasseh.

Manasseh and he <u>04_NUM_32_40</u># And Moses gave Gilead unto Machir the son of Manasseh; and he dwelt therein.

Manasseh and his 14_2CH_33_18# Now the rest of the acts of Manasseh, and his prayer unto his God, and the words of the seers that spake to him in the name of the LORD God of Israel, behold, they [are written] in the book of the kings of Israel.

Manasseh and I <u>07_JUD_06_15</u> # And he said unto him, Oh my Lord, wherewith shall I save Israel? behold, my family [is] poor in Manasseh, and I [am] the least in my father's house.

Manasseh and of <u>14_2CH_30_11</u># Nevertheless divers of Asher and Manasseh and of Zebulun humbled themselves, and came to Jerusalem.

Manasseh and they <u>23_ISA_09_21</u> # Manasseh, Ephraim; and Ephraim, Manasseh: [and] they together [shall be] against Judah. For all this his anger is not turned away, but his hand [is] stretched out still.

Manasseh and this <u>06_JOS_13_29</u> # And Moses gave [inheritance] unto the half tribe of Manasseh: and [this] was [the possession] of the half tribe of the children of Manasseh by their families.

Manasseh Aner with 13_1CH_06_70 # And out of the half tribe of Manasseh; Aner with her suburbs, and

Manasseh answered and <u>06_JOS_22_21</u> # Then the children of Reuben and the children of Gad and the half tribe of Manasseh answered, and said unto the heads of the thousands of Israel,

Manasseh Ashriel whom <u>13_1CH_07_14</u> # The sons of Manasseh; Ashriel, whom she bare: [[but] his concubine the Aramitess bare Machir the father of Gilead:

Manasseh belonged to <u>06_JOS_17_08</u> # [Now] Manasseh had the land of Tappuah: but Tappuah on the border of Manasseh [belonged] to the children of Ephraim;

Manasseh beside the <u>06_JOS_17_05</u># And there fell ten portions to Manasseh, beside the land of Gilead and Bashan, which [were] on the other side Jordan;

Manasseh Bethshean and 13_1CH_07_29 # And by the borders of the children of Manasseh, Bethshean and her towns, Taanach and her towns, Megiddo and her towns, Dor and her towns. In these dwelt the children of Joseph the son of Israel.

Manasseh built there <u>06_JOS_22_10</u># And when they came unto the borders of Jordan, that [are] in the land of Canaan, the children of Reuben and the children of Gad and the half tribe of Manasseh built there an altar by Jordan, a great altar to see to.

Manasseh by lot 13_1CH_06_61 # And unto the sons of Kohath, [which were] left of the family of that tribe, [were cities given] out of the half tribe, [namely, out of] the half [tribe] of Manasseh, by lot, ten cities.

Manasseh eighteen thousand 13_1CH_12_31 # And of the half tribe of Manasseh eighteen thousand, which were expressed by name, to come and make David king.

Manasseh Ephraim and 23_ISA_09_21_# Manasseh, Ephraim; and Ephraim, Manasseh: [and] they

together [shall be] against Judah. For all this his anger is not turned away, but his hand [is] stretched out still.

Manasseh even to <u>06_JOS_13_31</u># And half Gilead, and Ashtaroth, and Edrei, cities of the kingdom of Og in Bashan, [were pertaining] unto the children of Machir the son of Manasseh, [even] to the one half of the children of Machir by their families.

Manasseh even unto <u>14_2CH_30_10</u> # So the posts passed from city to city through the country of Ephraim and Manasseh even unto Zebulun: but they laughed them to scorn, and mocked them.

Manasseh for every 13_1CH_26_32 # And his brethren, men of valour, [were] two thousand and seven hundred chief fathers, whom king David made rulers over the Reubenites, the Gadites, and the half tribe of Manasseh, for every matter pertaining to God, and affairs of the king.

Manasseh Gaddi the <u>04_NUM_13_11</u># Of the tribe of Joseph, [namely], of the tribe of Manasseh, Gaddi the son of Susi.

Manasseh Gamaliel the <u>04_NUM_01_10</u># Of the children of Joseph: of Ephraim; Elishama the son of Ammihud: of Manasseh; Gamaliel the son of Pedahzur.

Manasseh Golan in <u>13_1CH_06_71</u> # Unto the sons of Gershom [were given] out of the family of the half tribe of Manasseh, Golan in Bashan with her suburbs, and Ashtaroth with her suburbs:

Manasseh have built <u>06_JOS_22_11</u># And the children of Israel heard say, Behold, the children of Reuben and the children of Gad and the half tribe of Manasseh have built an altar over against the land of Canaan, in the borders of Jordan, at the passage of the children of Israel.

Manasseh have received <u>06_JOS_18_07</u> # But the Levites have no part among you; for the priesthood of the LORD [is] their inheritance: and Gad, and Reuben, and half the tribe of Manasseh, have received their inheritance beyond Jordan on the east, which Moses the servant of the LORD gave them.

Manasseh in his <u>01_GEN_48_13</u># And Joseph took them both, Ephraim in his right hand toward Israel's left hand, and Manasseh in his left hand toward Israel's right hand, and brought [them] near unto him.

Manasseh into the <u>06_JOS_22_13</u># And the children of Israel sent unto the children of Reuben, and to the children of Gad, and to the half tribe of Manasseh, into the land of Gilead, Phinehas the son of Eleazar the priest,

Manasseh is mine 19_PSA_108_08 # Gilead [is] mine; Manasseh [is] mine; Ephraim also [is] the strength of mine head; Judah [is] my lawgiver;

Manasseh Joel the <u>13_1CH_27_20</u> # Of the children of Ephraim, Hoshea the son of Azaziah: of the half tribe of Manasseh, Joel the son of Pedaiah:

Manasseh king of 12_2KI_21_11# Because Manasseh king of Judah hath done these abominations, [and] hath done wickedly above all that the Amorites did, which [were] before him, and hath made Judah also to sin with his idols:

Manasseh knew that <u>14_2CH_33_13</u> # And prayed unto him: and he was entreated of him, and heard his supplication, and brought him again to Jerusalem into his kingdom. Then Manasseh knew that the LORD he [was] God.

Manasseh shall be <u>04_NUM_02_20</u> # And by him [shall be] the tribe of Manasseh: and the captain of the children of Manasseh [shall be] Gamaliel the son of Pedahzur.

Manasseh shed innocent 12_2KI_21_16 # Moreover Manasseh shed innocent blood very much, till he had filled Jerusalem from one end to another; beside his sin wherewith he made Judah to sin, in doing [that which was] evil in the sight of the LORD.

Manasseh slept with <u>14_2CH_33_20</u> # So Manasseh slept with his fathers, and they buried him in his own house: and Amon his son reigned in his stead.

Manasseh Tanach with <u>06_JOS_21_25</u># And out of the half tribe of Manasseh, Tanach with her suburbs, and Gathrimmon with her suburbs; two cities.

Manasseh ten cities <u>06_JOS_21_05</u># And the rest of the children of Kohath [had] by lot out of the families of the tribe of Ephraim, and out of the tribe of Dan, and out of the half tribe of Manasseh, ten cities.

Manasseh that they <u>14_2CH_30_01</u># And Hezekiah sent to all Israel and Judah, and wrote letters also to Ephraim and Manasseh, that they should come to the house of the LORD at Jerusalem, to keep the passover unto the LORD God of Israel.

Manasseh the coast <u>06_JOS_17_09</u> # And the coast descended unto the river Kanah, southward of the river: these cities of Ephraim [are] among the cities of Manasseh: the coast of Manasseh also [was] on the north side of the river, and the outgoings of it were at the sea:

Manasseh until they 14_2CH_31_01 # Now when all this was finished, all Israel that were present went out to the cities of Judah, and brake the images in pieces, and cut down the groves, and threw down the high places and the altars out of all Judah and Benjamin, in Ephraim also and Manasseh, until they had utterly destroyed them all. Then all the children of Israel returned, every man to his possession, into their own cities.

Manasseh unto the <u>06_JOS_22_15</u># And they came unto the children of Reuben, and to the children of Gad, and to the half tribe of Manasseh, unto the land of Gilead, and they spake with them, saying,

Manasseh was from <u>06_JOS_17_07</u># And the coast of Manasseh was from Asher to Michmethah, that [lieth] before Shechem; and the border went along on the right hand unto the inhabitants of Entappuah.

Manasseh was Gamaliel <u>04_NUM_10_23</u># And over the host of the tribe of the children of Manasseh [was] Gamaliel the son of Pedahzur.

Manasseh was the <u>01_GEN_48_14</u># And Israel stretched out his right hand, and laid [it] upon Ephraim's head, who [was] the younger, and his left hand upon Manasseh's head, guiding his hands wittingly; for Manasseh [was] the firstborn.

Manasseh was twelve <u>14_2CH_33_01</u># Manasseh [was] twelve years old when he began to reign, and he reigned fifty and five years in Jerusalem:

Manasseh was twelve <u>12_2KI_21_01</u> # Manasseh [was] twelve years old when he began to reign, and reigned fifty and five years in Jerusalem. And his mother's name [was] Hephzibah.

Manasseh went and <u>04_NUM_32_41</u># And Jair the son of Manasseh went and took the small towns thereof, and called them Havothjair.

Manasseh went to <u>04_NUM_32_39</u> # And the children of Machir the son of Manasseh went to Gilead, and took it, and dispossessed the Amorite which [was] in it.

Manasseh were brought <u>01_GEN_50_23</u> # And Joseph saw Ephraim's children of the third [generation]: the children also of Machir the son of Manasseh were brought up upon Joseph's knees.

Manasseh were thirty <u>04_NUM_01_35</u> # Those that were numbered of them, [even] of the tribe of Manasseh, [were] thirty and two thousand and two hundred.

Manasseh which are 11_1KI_04_13# The son of Geber, in Ramothgilead; to him [pertained] the towns of Jair the son of Manasseh, which [are] in Gilead; to him [also pertained] the region of Argob, which [is] in Bashan, threescore great cities with walls and brazen bars:

Manasseh which were <u>01_GEN_48_05</u> # And now thy two sons, Ephraim and Manasseh, which were born unto thee in the land of Egypt before I came unto thee into Egypt, [are] mine; as Reuben and Simeon, they shall be mine.

Manasseh who also <u>07_JUD_06_35</u># And he sent messengers throughout all Manasseh; who also was gathered after him: and he sent messengers unto Asher, and unto Zebulun, and unto Naphtali; and they came up to meet them.

Manasseh with all <u>13_1CH_12_37</u># And on the other side of Jordan, of the Reubenites, and the Gadites, and of the half tribe of Manasseh, with all manner of instruments of war for the battle, an hundred and twenty thousand.

Manasseh <u>13_1CH_07_17</u> # And the sons of Ulam; Bedan. These [were] the sons of Gilead, the son of Machir, the son of Manasseh.

Manasseh <u>13_1CH_09_03</u> # And in Jerusalem dwelt of the children of Judah, and of the children of Benjamin, and of the children of Ephraim, and Manasseh;

Manasseh <u>13 1CH 12 20 #</u> As he went to Ziklag, there fell to him of Manasseh, Adnah, and Jozabad, and Jediael, and Michael, and Jozabad, and Elihu, and Zilthai, captains of the thousands that [were] of Manasseh.

Manasseh <u>05_DEU_29_08</u># And we took their land, and gave it for an inheritance unto the Reubenites, and to the Gadites, and to the half tribe of Manasseh.

Manasseh <u>05_DEU_33_17</u> # His glory [is like] the firstling of his bullock, and his horns [are like] the horns of unicorns: with them he shall push the people together to the ends of the earth: and they [are] the ten thousands of Ephraim, and they [are] the thousands of Manasseh.

Manasseh <u>15_EZR_10_30</u> # And of the sons of Pahathmoab; Adna, and Chelal, Benaiah, Maaseiah, Mattaniah, Bezaleel, and Binnui, and Manasseh.

Manasseh 01_GEN_48_20 # And he blessed them that day, saying, In thee shall Israel bless, saying, God

make thee as Ephraim and as Manasseh: and he set Ephraim before Manasseh.

Manasseh <u>06_JOS_12_06</u># Them did Moses the servant of the LORD and the children of Israel smite: and Moses the servant of the LORD gave it [for] a possession unto the Reubenites, and the Gadites, and the half tribe of Manasseh.

Manasseh <u>06_JOS_13_07</u> # Now therefore divide this land for an inheritance unto the nine tribes, and the half tribe of Manasseh,

Manasseh <u>06_JOS_20_08</u># And on the other side Jordan by Jericho eastward, they assigned Bezer in the wilderness upon the plain out of the tribe of Reuben, and Ramoth in Gilead out of the tribe of Gad, and Golan in Bashan out of the tribe of Manasseh.

Manasseh <u>06_JOS_22_01</u> # Then Joshua called the Reubenites, and the Gadites, and the half tribe of Manasseh,

Manasseh <u>04_NUM_07_54</u># On the eighth day [offered] Gamaliel the son of Pedahzur, prince of the children of Manasseh:

Manasseh's head <u>01_GEN_48_17</u># And when Joseph saw that his father laid his right hand upon the head of Ephraim, it displeased him: and he held up his father's hand, to remove it from Ephraim's head unto Manasseh's head.

Manasseh's sons had <u>06_JOS_17_06</u> # Because the daughters of Manasseh had an inheritance among his sons: and the rest of Manasseh's sons had the land of Gilead.
