Mary a pound <u>43\_JOH\_12\_03</u># Then took Mary a pound of ointment of spikenard, very costly, and anointed the feet of Jesus, and wiped his feet with her hair: and the house was filled with the odour of the ointment.

Mary abode with <u>42\_LUK\_01\_56</u># And Mary abode with her about three months, and returned to her own house.
