Abimelech and both <u>01_GEN_21_27</u> # And Abraham took sheep and oxen, and gave them unto Abimelech; and both of them made a covenant.

Abimelech and devour <u>07_JUD_09_20</u> # But if not, let fire come out from Abimelech, and devour the men of Shechem, and the house of Millo; and let fire come out from the men of Shechem, and from the house of Millo, and devour Abimelech.

Abimelech And he <u>07_JUD_09_29</u> # And would to God this people were under my hand! then would I remove Abimelech. And he said to Abimelech, Increase thine army, and come out.

Abimelech and his <u>01_GEN_20_17</u># So Abraham prayed unto God: and God healed Abimelech, and his wife, and his maidservants; and they bare [children].

Abimelech and let <u>07_JUD_09_19</u># If ye then have dealt truly and sincerely with Jerubbaal and with his house this day, [then] rejoice ye in Abimelech, and let him also rejoice in you:

Abimelech and Phichol <u>01_GEN_21_22</u> # And it came to pass at that time, that Abimelech and Phichol the chief captain of his host spake unto Abraham, saying, God [is] with thee in all that thou doest:

Abimelech and put <u>07_JUD_09_49</u> # And all the people likewise cut down every man his bough, and followed Abimelech, and put [them] to the hold, and set the hold on fire upon them; so that all the men of the tower of Shechem died also, about a thousand men and women.

Abimelech and the <u>07_JUD_09_23</u> # Then God sent an evil spirit between Abimelech and the men of Shechem; and the men of Shechem dealt treacherously with Abimelech:

Abimelech and the <u>07_JUD_09_44</u> # And Abimelech, and the company that [was] with him, rushed forward, and stood in the entering of the gate of the city: and the two [other] companies ran upon all [the people] that [were] in the fields, and slew them.

Abimelech and who <u>07_JUD_09_28</u> # And Gaal the son of Ebed said, Who [is] Abimelech, and who [is] Shechem, that we should serve him? [is] not [he] the son of Jerubbaal? and Zebul his officer? serve the men of Hamor the father of Shechem: for why should we serve him?

Abimelech because of <u>01_GEN_20_18</u># For the LORD had fast closed up all the wombs of the house of Abimelech, because of Sarah Abraham's wife.

Abimelech because of <u>01_GEN_21_25</u># And Abraham reproved Abimelech because of a well of water, which Abimelech's servants had violently taken away.

Abimelech called Abraham <u>01_GEN_20_09</u> # Then Abimelech called Abraham, and said unto him, What hast thou done unto us? and what have I offended thee, that thou hast brought on me and on my kingdom a great sin? thou hast done deeds unto me that ought not to be done.

Abimelech called Isaac <u>01_GEN_26_09</u> # And Abimelech called Isaac, and said, Behold, of a surety she [is] thy wife: and how saidst thou, She [is] my sister? And Isaac said unto him, Because I said, Lest I die for her.

Abimelech came unto <u>07_JUD_09_52</u> # And Abimelech came unto the tower, and fought against it, and went hard unto the door of the tower to burn it with fire.

Abimelech charged all <u>01_GEN_26_11</u># And Abimelech charged all [his] people, saying, He that toucheth this man or his wife shall surely be put to death.

Abimelech chased him <u>07_JUD_09_40</u># And Abimelech chased him, and he fled before him, and many were overthrown [and] wounded, [even] unto the entering of the gate.

Abimelech dwelt at <u>07_JUD_09_41</u> # And Abimelech dwelt at Arumah: and Zebul thrust out Gaal and his brethren, that they should not dwell in Shechem.

Abimelech for they <u>07_JUD_09_03</u># And his mother's brethren spake of him in the ears of all the men of Shechem all these words: and their hearts inclined to follow Abimelech; for they said, He [is] our brother.

Abimelech fought against <u>07_JUD_09_45</u> # And Abimelech fought against the city all that day; and he took the city, and slew the people that [was] therein, and beat down the city, and sowed it with salt.

Abimelech gat him <u>07_JUD_09_48</u> # And Abimelech gat him up to mount Zalmon, he and all the people that [were] with him; and Abimelech took an ax in his hand, and cut down a bough from the trees, and took it, and laid [it] on his shoulder, and said unto the people that [were] with him, What ye have seen me do, make haste, [and] do as I [have done].

Abimelech had not <u>01_GEN_20_04</u># But Abimelech had not come near her: and he said, Lord, wilt thou slay also a righteous nation?

Abimelech had reigned <u>07_JUD_09_22</u> # When Abimelech had reigned three years over Israel,

Abimelech hired vain <u>07_JUD_09_04</u> # And they gave him threescore and ten [pieces] of silver out of the house of Baalberith, wherewith Abimelech hired vain and light persons, which followed him.

Abimelech his brother <u>07_JUD_09_21</u># And Jotham ran away, and fled, and went to Beer, and dwelt there, for fear of Abimelech his brother.

Abimelech in a <u>01_GEN_20_03</u># But God came to Abimelech in a dream by night, and said to him, Behold, thou [art but] a dead man, for the woman which thou hast taken; for she [is] a man's wife.

Abimelech Increase thine <u>07_JUD_09_29</u> # And would to God this people were under my hand! then would I remove Abimelech. And he said to Abimelech, Increase thine army, and come out.

Abimelech king and <u>07_JUD_09_16</u> # Now therefore, if ye have done truly and sincerely, in that ye have made Abimelech king, and if ye have dealt well with Jerubbaal and his house, and have done unto him according to the deserving of his hands;

Abimelech king by <u>07_JUD_09_06</u># And all the men of Shechem gathered together, and all the house of Millo, and went, and made Abimelech king, by the plain of the pillar that [was] in Shechem.

Abimelech king of <u>01_GEN_20_02</u> # And Abraham said of Sarah his wife, She [is] my sister: and Abimelech king of Gerar sent, and took Sarah.

Abimelech king of <u>01_GEN_26_01</u># And there was a famine in the land, beside the first famine that was in the days of Abraham. And Isaac went unto Abimelech king of the Philistines unto Gerar.

Abimelech king of <u>01_GEN_26_08</u> # And it came to pass, when he had been there a long time, that Abimelech king of the Philistines looked out at a window, and saw, and, behold, Isaac [was] sporting with

Rebekah his wife.

Abimelech privily saying <u>07_JUD_09_31</u> # And he sent messengers unto Abimelech privily, saying, Behold, Gaal the son of Ebed and his brethren be come to Shechem; and, behold, they fortify the city against thee.

Abimelech rose early <u>01_GEN_20_08</u> # Therefore Abimelech rose early in the morning, and called all his servants, and told all these things in their ears: and the men were sore afraid.

Abimelech rose up <u>01_GEN_21_32</u> # Thus they made a covenant at Beersheba: then Abimelech rose up, and Phichol the chief captain of his host, and they returned into the land of the Philistines.

Abimelech rose up <u>07_JUD_09_34</u> # And Abimelech rose up, and all the people that [were] with him, by night, and they laid wait against Shechem in four companies.

Abimelech rose up <u>07_JUD_09_35</u> # And Gaal the son of Ebed went out, and stood in the entering of the gate of the city: and Abimelech rose up, and the people that [were] with him, from lying in wait.

Abimelech said Behold <u>01_GEN_20_15</u># And Abimelech said, Behold, my land [is] before thee: dwell where it pleaseth thee.

Abimelech said I <u>01_GEN_21_26</u># And Abimelech said, I wot not who hath done this thing: neither didst thou tell me, neither yet heard I [of it], but to day.

Abimelech said unto <u>01_GEN_20_10</u># And Abimelech said unto Abraham, What sawest thou, that thou hast done this thing?

Abimelech said unto <u>01_GEN_21_29</u> # And Abimelech said unto Abraham, What [mean] these seven ewe lambs which thou hast set by themselves?

Abimelech said unto <u>01_GEN_26_16</u># And Abimelech said unto Isaac, Go from us; for thou art much mightier than we.

Abimelech said What <u>01_GEN_26_10</u> # And Abimelech said, What [is] this thou hast done unto us? one of the people might lightly have lien with thy wife, and thou shouldest have brought guiltiness upon us.

Abimelech that all <u>07_JUD_09_47</u># And it was told Abimelech, that all the men of the tower of Shechem were gathered together.

Abimelech that we <u>07_JUD_09_38</u># Then said Zebul unto him, Where [is] now thy mouth, wherewith thou saidst, Who [is] Abimelech, that we should serve him? [is] not this the people that thou hast despised? go out, I pray now, and fight with them.

Abimelech the son <u>13_1CH_18_16</u># And Zadok the son of Ahitub, and Abimelech the son of Abiathar, [were] the priests; and Shavsha was scribe;

Abimelech the son <u>10_2SA_11_21</u> # Who smote Abimelech the son of Jerubbesheth? did not a woman cast a piece of a millstone upon him from the wall, that he died in Thebez? why went ye nigh the wall? then say thou, Thy servant Uriah the Hittite is dead also.

Abimelech the son <u>07_JUD_09_01</u># And Abimelech the son of Jerubbaal went to Shechem unto his mother's brethren, and communed with them, and with all the family of the house of his mother's father, saying,

Abimelech the son <u>07_JUD_09_18</u># And ye are risen up against my father's house this day, and have slain his sons, threescore and ten persons, upon one stone, and have made Abimelech, the son of his maidservant,

king over the men of Shechem, because he [is] your brother;]

Abimelech their brother <u>07_JUD_09_24</u> # That the cruelty [done] to the threescore and ten sons of Jerubbaal might come, and their blood be laid upon Abimelech their brother, which slew them; and upon the men of Shechem, which aided him in the killing of his brethren.

Abimelech there arose <u>07_JUD_10_01</u># And after Abimelech there arose to defend Israel Tola the son of Puah the son of Dodo, a man of Issachar, and he dwelt in Shamir in mount Ephraim.

Abimelech to Thebez <u>07_JUD_09_50</u> # Then went Abimelech to Thebez, and encamped against Thebez, and took it.

Abimelech took an <u>07_JUD_09_48</u> # And Abimelech gat him up to mount Zalmon, he and all the people that [were] with him; and Abimelech took an ax in his hand, and cut down a bough from the trees, and took it, and laid [it] on his shoulder, and said unto the people that [were] with him, What ye have seen me do, make haste, [and] do as I [have done].

Abimelech took sheep <u>01_GEN_20_14</u># And Abimelech took sheep, and oxen, and menservants, and womenservants, and gave [them] unto Abraham, and restored him Sarah his wife.

Abimelech was dead <u>07_JUD_09_55</u># And when the men of Israel saw that Abimelech was dead, they departed every man unto his place.

Abimelech went to <u>01_GEN_26_26</u># Then Abimelech went to him from Gerar, and Ahuzzath one of his friends, and Phichol the chief captain of his army.

Abimelech which he <u>07_JUD_09_56</u># Thus God rendered the wickedness of Abimelech, which he did unto his father, in slaying his seventy brethren:

Abimelech who drove <u>19_PSA_34_01</u> # [A Psalm] of David, when he changed his behaviour before Abimelech; who drove him away, and he departed. I will bless the LORD at all times: his praise [shall] continually [be] in my mouth.

Abimelech <u>07_JUD_08_31</u># And his concubine that [was] in Shechem, she also bare him a son, whose name he called Abimelech.

Abimelech <u>07_JUD_09_20</u> # But if not, let fire come out from Abimelech, and devour the men of Shechem, and the house of Millo; and let fire come out from the men of Shechem, and from the house of Millo, and devour Abimelech.

Abimelech <u>07_JUD_09_23</u> # Then God sent an evil spirit between Abimelech and the men of Shechem; and the men of Shechem dealt treacherously with Abimelech:

Abimelech <u>07_JUD_09_25</u> # And the men of Shechem set liers in wait for him in the top of the mountains, and they robbed all that came along that way by them: and it was told Abimelech.

Abimelech <u>07_JUD_09_27</u> # And they went out into the fields, and gathered their vineyards, and trode [the grapes], and made merry, and went into the house of their god, and did eat and drink, and cursed Abimelech.

Abimelech <u>07_JUD_09_39</u> # And Gaal went out before the men of Shechem, and fought with Abimelech.

Abimelech <u>07_JUD_09_42</u> # And it came to pass on the morrow, that the people went out into the field; and they told Abimelech.

Abimelech's head and <u>07_JUD_09_53</u># And a certain woman cast a piece of a millstone upon Abimelech's head, and all to brake his skull.

Abimelech's servants had <u>01_GEN_21_25</u># And Abraham reproved Abimelech because of a well of water, which Abimelech's servants had violently taken away.

Adrammelech and Anammelech <u>12_2KI_17_31</u> # And the Avites made Nibhaz and Tartak, and the Sepharvites burnt their children in fire to Adrammelech and Anammelech, the gods of Sepharvaim.

Adrammelech and Sharezer <u>12_2KI_19_37</u> # And it came to pass, as he was worshipping in the house of Nisroch his god, that Adrammelech and Sharezer his sons smote him with the sword: and they escaped into the land of Armenia. And Esarhaddon his son reigned in his stead.

Adrammelech and Sharezer 23_ISA_37_38 # And it came to pass, as he was worshipping in the house of Nisroch his god, that Adrammelech and Sharezer his sons smote him with the sword; and they escaped into the land of Armenia: and Esarhaddon his son reigned in his stead.

Ahimelech And is <u>09_1SA_21_08</u># And David said unto Ahimelech, And is there not here under thine hand spear or sword? for I have neither brought my sword nor my weapons with me, because the king's business required haste.

Ahimelech and the <u>13_1CH_24_31</u> # These likewise cast lots over against their brethren the sons of Aaron in the presence of David the king, and Zadok, and Ahimelech, and the chief of the fathers of the priests and Levites, even the principal fathers over against their younger brethren.

Ahimelech answered the <u>09_1SA_22_14</u> # Then Ahimelech answered the king, and said, And who [is so] faithful among all thy servants as David, which is the king's son in law, and goeth at thy bidding, and is honourable in thine house?

Ahimelech fled to <u>09_1SA_23_06</u># And it came to pass, when Abiathar the son of Ahimelech fled to David to Keilah, [that] he came down [with] an ephod in his hand.

Ahimelech of the <u>13_1CH_24_03</u># And David distributed them, both Zadok of the sons of Eleazar, and Ahimelech of the sons of Ithamar, according to their offices in their service.

Ahimelech the Hittite <u>09_1SA_26_06</u># Then answered David and said to Ahimelech the Hittite, and to Abishai the son of Zeruiah, brother to Joab, saying, Who will go down with me to Saul to the camp? And Abishai said, I will go down with thee.

Ahimelech the priest <u>09_1SA_21_01</u> # Then came David to Nob to Ahimelech the priest: and Ahimelech was afraid at the meeting of David, and said unto him, Why [art] thou alone, and no man with thee?

Ahimelech the priest <u>09_1SA_21_02</u> # And David said unto Ahimelech the priest, The king hath commanded me a business, and hath said unto me, Let no man know any thing of the business whereabout I send thee, and what I have commanded thee: and I have appointed [my] servants to such and such a place.

Ahimelech the priest <u>09_1SA_22_11</u># Then the king sent to call Ahimelech the priest, the son of Ahitub, and all his father's house, the priests that [were] in Nob: and they came all of them to the king.

Ahimelech the son <u>13_1CH_24_06</u> # And Shemaiah the son of Nethaneel the scribe, [one] of the Levites, wrote them before the king, and the princes, and Zadok the priest, and Ahimelech the son of Abiathar, and [before] the chief of the fathers of the priests and Levites: one principal household being taken for Eleazar, and [one] taken for Ithamar.

Ahimelech the son <u>09_1SA_22_09</u># Then answered Doeg the Edomite, which was set over the servants of Saul, and said, I saw the son of Jesse coming to Nob, to Ahimelech the son of Ahitub.

Ahimelech the son <u>09 1SA 22 20</u> # And one of the sons of Ahimelech the son of Ahitub, named Abiathar, escaped, and fled after David.

Ahimelech the son <u>10_2SA_08_17</u># And Zadok the son of Ahitub, and Ahimelech the son of Abiathar, [were] the priests; and Seraiah [was] the scribe;

Ahimelech thou and <u>09_1SA_22_16</u># And the king said, Thou shalt surely die, Ahimelech, thou, and all thy father's house.

Ahimelech was afraid <u>09_1SA_21_01</u># Then came David to Nob to Ahimelech the priest: and Ahimelech was afraid at the meeting of David, and said unto him, Why [art] thou alone, and no man with thee?

Ahimelech Why boastest <u>19_PSA_52_01</u># To the chief Musician, Maschil, [A Psalm] of David, when Doeg the Edomite came and told Saul, and said unto him, David is come to the house of Ahimelech. Why boastest thou thyself in mischief, O mighty man? the goodness of God [endureth] continually.

Ahimelech's son I <u>09_1SA_30_07</u># And David said to Abiathar the priest, Ahimelech's son, I pray thee, bring me hither the ephod. And Abiathar brought thither the ephod to David.

Alammelech and Amad <u>06_JOS_19_26</u># And Alammelech, and Amad, and Misheal; and reacheth to Carmel westward, and to Shihorlibnath;

Anammelech the gods <u>12_2KI_17_31</u> # And the Avites made Nibhaz and Tartak, and the Sepharvites burnt their children in fire to Adrammelech and Anammelech, the gods of Sepharvaim.

Ebedmelech the Ethiopian 24_JER_38_07 # Now when Ebedmelech the Ethiopian, one of the eunuchs which was in the king's house, heard that they had put Jeremiah in the dungeon; the king then sitting in the gate of Benjamin;

Ebedmelech the Ethiopian <u>24_JER_38_10</u># Then the king commanded Ebedmelech the Ethiopian, saying, Take from hence thirty men with thee, and take up Jeremiah the prophet out of the dungeon, before he die.

Ebedmelech the Ethiopian <u>24_JER_38_12</u> # And Ebedmelech the Ethiopian said unto Jeremiah, Put now [these] old cast clouts and rotten rags under thine armholes under the cords. And Jeremiah did so.

Ebedmelech the Ethiopian 24_JER_39_16 # Go and speak to Ebedmelech the Ethiopian, saying, Thus saith the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel; Behold, I will bring my words upon this city for evil, and not for good; and they shall be [accomplished] in that day before thee.

Ebedmelech took the <u>24_JER_38_11</u> # So Ebedmelech took the men with him, and went into the house of the king under the treasury, and took thence old cast clouts and old rotten rags, and let them down by cords into the dungeon to Jeremiah.

Ebedmelech went forth <u>24_JER_38_08</u># Ebedmelech went forth out of the king's house, and spake to the king, saying,

Elimelech and his <u>08_RUT_02_01</u> # And Naomi had a kinsman of her husband's, a mighty man of wealth, of the family of Elimelech; and his name [was] Boaz.

Elimelech and the <u>08_RUT_01_02</u> # And the name of the man [was] Elimelech, and the name of his wife Naomi, and the name of his two sons Mahlon and Chilion, Ephrathites of Bethlehemjudah. And they came into the country of Moab, and continued there.

Elimelech Naomi's husband <u>08_RUT_01_03</u># And Elimelech Naomi's husband died; and she was left, and her two sons.

Elimelech <u>08_RUT_02_03</u># And she went, and came, and gleaned in the field after the reapers: and her hap was to light on a part of the field [belonging] unto Boaz, who [was] of the kindred of Elimelech.

Elimelech's and all <u>08_RUT_04_09</u># And Boaz said unto the elders, and [unto] all the people, Ye [are] witnesses this day, that I have bought all that [was] Elimelech's, and all that [was] Chilion's and Mahlon's, of the hand of Naomi.

Elimelech's <u>08_RUT_04_03</u># And he said unto the kinsman, Naomi, that is come again out of the country of Moab, selleth a parcel of land, which [was] our brother Elimelech's:

Hammelech and Seraiah <u>24_JER_36_26</u> # But the king commanded Jerahmeel the son of Hammelech, and Seraiah the son of Azriel, and Shelemiah the son of Abdeel, to take Baruch the scribe and Jeremiah the prophet: but the LORD hid them.

Hammelech that was <u>24_JER_38_06</u> # Then took they Jeremiah, and cast him into the dungeon of Malchiah the son of Hammelech, that [was] in the court of the prison: and they let down Jeremiah with cords. And in the dungeon [there was] no water, but mire: so Jeremiah sunk in the mire.

Melech and Tahrea <u>13_1CH_09_41</u> # And the sons of Micah [were], Pithon, and Melech, and Tahrea, [and Ahaz].

Melech and Tarea <u>13_1CH_08_35</u> # And the sons of Micah [were], Pithon, and Melech, and Tarea, and Ahaz.

Nathanmelech the chamberlain <u>12_2KI_23_11</u># And he took away the horses that the kings of Judah had given to the sun, at the entering in of the house of the LORD, by the chamber of Nathanmelech the chamberlain, which [was] in the suburbs, and burned the chariots of the sun with fire.

Regemmelech and their <u>38_ZEC_07_02</u> # When they had sent unto the house of God Sherezer and Regemmelech, and their men, to pray before the LORD,
