

KJV Bible linked to Three Phrase Concordance

Michaiah and Shaphan <u>12_2KI_22_12</u> # And the king commanded Hilkiah the priest, and Ahikam the son of Shaphan, and Achbor the son of Michaiah, and Shaphan the scribe, and Asahiah a servant of the king's, saying,

Michaiah declared unto <u>24_JER_36_13</u> # Then Michaiah declared unto them all the words that he had heard, when Baruch read the book in the ears of the people.

Michaiah Elioenai Zechariah <u>16_NEH_12_41</u> # And the priests; Eliakim, Maaseiah, Miniamin, Michaiah, Elioenai, Zechariah, [and] Hananiah, with trumpets;

Michaiah the daughter <u>14_2CH_13_02</u> # He reigned three years in Jerusalem. His mother's name also [was] Michaiah the daughter of Uriel of Gibeah. And there was war between Abijah and Jeroboam.

Michaiah the son <u>24_JER_36_11</u># When Michaiah the son of Gemariah, the son of Shaphan, had heard out of the book all the words of the LORD,

Michaiah the son <u>16_NEH_12_35</u> # And [certain] of the priests' sons with trumpets; [namely], Zechariah the son of Jonathan, the son of Shemaiah, the son of Mattaniah, the son of Michaiah, the son of Zaccur, the son of Asaph:

Michaiah to teach <u>14_2CH_17_07</u># Also in the third year of his reign he sent to his princes, [even] to Benhail, and to Obadiah, and to Zechariah, and to Nethaneel, and to Michaiah, to teach in the cities of Judah.
