maidservants and camels <u>01\_GEN\_24\_35</u># And the LORD hath blessed my master greatly; and he is become great: and he hath given him flocks, and herds, and silver, and gold, and menservants, and maidservants, and camels, and asses.

maidservants and menservants <u>01\_GEN\_30\_43</u> # And the man increased exceedingly, and had much cattle, and maidservants, and menservants, and camels, and asses.

maidservants and she <u>01\_GEN\_12\_16</u># And he entreated Abram well for her sake: and he had sheep, and oxen, and he asses, and menservants, and maidservants, and she asses, and camels.

maidservants and the <u>05\_DEU\_12\_12\_#</u> And ye shall rejoice before the LORD your God, ye, and your sons, and your daughters, and your menservants, and your maidservants, and the Levite that [is] within your gates; forasmuch as he hath no part nor inheritance with you.

maidservants and they <u>01\_GEN\_20\_17</u># So Abraham prayed unto God: and God healed Abimelech, and his wife, and his maidservants; and they bare [children].

maidservants and your <u>09\_1SA\_08\_16</u># And he will take your menservants, and your maidservants, and your goodliest young men, and your asses, and put [them] to his work.

maidservants of whom <u>16\_NEH\_07\_67</u> # Beside their manservants and their maidservants, of whom [there were] seven thousand three hundred thirty and seven: and they had two hundred forty and five singing men and singing women.

maidservants tents but <u>01\_GEN\_31\_33</u># And Laban went into Jacob's tent, and into Leah's tent, and into the two maidservants' tents; but he found [them] not. Then went he out of Leah's tent, and entered into Rachel's tent.

maidservants which thou <u>10\_2SA\_06\_22</u> # And I will yet be more vile than thus, and will be base in mine own sight: and of the maidservants which thou hast spoken of, of them shall I be had in honour.

maidservants <u>12\_2KI\_05\_26</u> # And he said unto him, Went not mine heart [with thee], when the man turned again from his chariot to meet thee? [Is it] a time to receive money, and to receive garments, and oliveyards, and vineyards, and sheep, and oxen, and menservants, and maidservants?
