married a wife 42_LUK_14_20 # And another said, I have married a wife, and therefore I cannot come.

married a wife <u>40_MAT_22_25</u># Now there were with us seven brethren: and the first, when he had married a wife, deceased, and, having no issue, left his wife unto his brother:

married an Ethiopian <u>04_NUM_12_01</u> # And Miriam and Aaron spake against Moses because of the Ethiopian woman whom he had married: for he had married an Ethiopian woman.

married and an <u>20_PRO_30_23</u> # For an odious [woman] when she is married; and an handmaid that is heir to her mistress.

married fourteen wives 14_2CH_13_21 # But Abijah waxed mighty, and married fourteen wives, and begat twenty and two sons, and sixteen daughters.
