mayest be clothed <u>66\_REV\_03\_18</u># I counsel thee to buy of me gold tried in the fire, that thou mayest be rich; and white raiment, that thou mayest be clothed, and [that] the shame of thy nakedness do not appear; and anoint thine eyes with eyesalve, that thou mayest see.

mayest be confounded <u>26\_EZE\_16\_54</u># That thou mayest bear thine own shame, and mayest be confounded in all that thou hast done, in that thou art a comfort unto them.

mayest be delivered 42 <u>LUK 12 58 #</u> When thou goest with thine adversary to the magistrate, [as thou art] in the way, give diligence that thou mayest be delivered from him; lest he hale thee to the judge, and the judge deliver thee to the officer, and the officer cast thee into prison.

mayest be feared 19\_PSA\_130\_04 # But [there is] forgiveness with thee, that thou mayest be feared.

mayest be found 19 PSA 32 06 # For this shall every one that is godly pray unto thee in a time when thou mayest be found: surely in the floods of great waters they shall not come nigh unto him.

mayest be justified <u>23\_ISA\_43\_26</u> # Put me in remembrance: let us plead together: declare thou, that thou mayest be justified.

mayest be made 46\_1CO\_07\_21 # Art thou called [being] a servant? care not for it: but if thou mayest be made free, use [it] rather.

mayest be my <u>23\_ISA\_49\_06</u># And he said, It is a light thing that thou shouldest be my servant to raise up the tribes of Jacob, and to restore the preserved of Israel: I will also give thee for a light to the Gentiles, that thou mayest be my salvation unto the end of the earth.

mayest be no <u>42\_LUK\_16\_02</u> # And he called him, and said unto him, How is it that I hear this of thee? give an account of thy stewardship; for thou mayest be no longer steward.

mayest be to <u>04\_NUM\_10\_31</u> # And he said, Leave us not, I pray thee; forasmuch as thou knowest how we are to encamp in the wilderness, and thou mayest be to us instead of eyes.

mayest be wise 20\_PRO\_19\_20 # Hear counsel, and receive instruction, that thou mayest be wise in thy latter end.

mayest bear thine <u>26\_EZE\_16\_54</u> # That thou mayest bear thine own shame, and mayest be confounded in all that thou hast done, in that thou art a comfort unto them.

mayest fear this <u>05\_DEU\_28\_58</u># If thou wilt not observe to do all the words of this law that are written in this book, that thou mayest fear this glorious and fearful name, THE LORD THY GOD;

mayest freely eat <u>01\_GEN\_02\_16</u># And the LORD God commanded the man, saying, Of every tree of the garden thou mayest freely eat:

mayest know how <u>02\_EXO\_09\_29</u> # And Moses said unto him, As soon as I am gone out of the city, I will spread abroad my hands unto the LORD; [and] the thunder shall cease, neither shall there be any more hail; that thou mayest know how that the earth [is] the LORD's.

mayest obey his <u>05\_DEU\_30\_20</u> # That thou mayest love the LORD thy God, [and] that thou mayest obey his voice, and that thou mayest cleave unto him: for he [is] thy life, and the length of thy days: that thou mayest dwell in the land which the LORD sware unto thy fathers, to Abraham, to Isaac, and to Jacob, to give them.
