mayest add thereto 13_1CH_22_14 # Now, behold, in my trouble I have prepared for the house of the LORD an hundred thousand talents of gold, and a thousand thousand talents of silver; and of brass and iron without weight; for it is in abundance: timber also and stone have I prepared; and thou mayest add thereto.

mayest And he <u>44_ACT_08_37</u> # And Philip said, If thou believest with all thine heart, thou mayest. And he answered and said, I believe that Jesus Christ is the Son of God.

mayest be a <u>01_GEN_28_03</u> # And God Almighty bless thee, and make thee fruitful, and multiply thee, that thou mayest be a multitude of people;

mayest be an <u>05_DEU_26_19</u># And to make thee high above all nations which he hath made, in praise, and in name, and in honour; and that thou mayest be an holy people unto the LORD thy God, as he hath spoken.

mayest be bound <u>24_JER_30_13</u> # [There is] none to plead thy cause, that thou mayest be bound up: thou hast no healing medicines.

mayest be clothed <u>66_REV_03_18</u># I counsel thee to buy of me gold tried in the fire, that thou mayest be rich; and white raiment, that thou mayest be clothed, and [that] the shame of thy nakedness do not appear; and anoint thine eyes with eyesalve, that thou mayest see.

mayest be confounded <u>26_EZE_16_54</u> # That thou mayest bear thine own shame, and mayest be confounded in all that thou hast done, in that thou art a comfort unto them.

mayest be delivered 42_LUK_12_58 # When thou goest with thine adversary to the magistrate, [as thou art] in the way, give diligence that thou mayest be delivered from him; lest he hale thee to the judge, and the judge deliver thee to the officer, and the officer cast thee into prison.

mayest be feared 19 PSA 130 04 # But [there is] forgiveness with thee, that thou mayest be feared.

mayest be found 19_PSA_32_06 # For this shall every one that is godly pray unto thee in a time when thou mayest be found: surely in the floods of great waters they shall not come nigh unto him.

mayest be justified <u>23_ISA_43_26</u> # Put me in remembrance: let us plead together: declare thou, that thou mayest be justified.

mayest be made 46_1CO_07_21 # Art thou called [being] a servant? care not for it: but if thou mayest be made free, use [it] rather.

mayest be my <u>23_ISA_49_06</u># And he said, It is a light thing that thou shouldest be my servant to raise up the tribes of Jacob, and to restore the preserved of Israel: I will also give thee for a light to the Gentiles, that thou mayest be my salvation unto the end of the earth.

mayest be no <u>42_LUK_16_02</u> # And he called him, and said unto him, How is it that I hear this of thee? give an account of thy stewardship; for thou mayest be no longer steward.

mayest be remembered 23_ISA_23_16 # Take an harp, go about the city, thou harlot that hast been

mayest be rich <u>66_REV_03_18</u># I counsel thee to buy of me gold tried in the fire, that thou mayest be rich; and white raiment, that thou mayest be clothed, and [that] the shame of thy nakedness do not appear; and anoint thine eyes with eyesalve, that thou mayest see.

mayest be righteous <u>18_JOB_40_08</u> # Wilt thou also disannul my judgment? wilt thou condemn me, that thou mayest be righteous?

mayest be saved <u>24_JER_04_14</u> # O Jerusalem, wash thine heart from wickedness, that thou mayest be saved. How long shall thy vain thoughts lodge within thee?

mayest be their <u>16_NEH_06_06</u># Wherein [was] written, It is reported among the heathen, and Gashmu saith [it, that] thou and the Jews think to rebel: for which cause thou buildest the wall, that thou mayest be their king, according to these words.

mayest be to <u>04_NUM_10_31</u># And he said, Leave us not, I pray thee; forasmuch as thou knowest how we are to encamp in the wilderness, and thou mayest be to us instead of eyes.

mayest be wise 20_PRO_19_20# Hear counsel, and receive instruction, that thou mayest be wise in thy latter end.

mayest bear thine <u>26_EZE_16_54</u># That thou mayest bear thine own shame, and mayest be confounded in all that thou hast done, in that thou art a comfort unto them.

mayest bring forth <u>02_EXO_03_10</u> # Come now therefore, and I will send thee unto Pharaoh, that thou mayest bring forth my people the children of Israel out of Egypt.

mayest bring forth <u>02_EXO_03_10</u> # Come now therefore, and I will send thee unto Pharaoh, that thou mayest bring forth my people the children of Israel out of Egypt.

mayest buy speedily <u>15_EZR_07_17</u> # That thou mayest buy speedily with this money bullocks, rams, lambs, with their meat offerings and their drink offerings, and offer them upon the altar of the house of your God which [is] in Jerusalem.

mayest carry me <u>14_2CH_18_33</u> # And a [certain] man drew a bow at a venture, and smote the king of Israel between the joints of the harness: therefore he said to his chariot man, Turn thine hand, that thou mayest carry me out of the host; for I am wounded.

mayest certainly recover <u>12_2KI_08_10</u> # And Elisha said unto him, Go, say unto him, Thou mayest certainly recover: howbeit the LORD hath showed me that he shall surely die.

mayest cleave unto <u>05_DEU_30_20</u> # That thou mayest love the LORD thy God, [and] that thou mayest obey his voice, and that thou mayest cleave unto him: for he [is] thy life, and the length of thy days: that thou mayest dwell in the land which the LORD sware unto thy fathers, to Abraham, to Isaac, and to Jacob, to give them.

mayest come in <u>01_GEN_38_16</u># And he turned unto her by the way, and said, Go to, I pray thee, let me come in unto thee; [for he knew not that she [was] his daughter in law.] And she said, What wilt thou give me, that thou mayest come in unto me?

mayest curse me <u>04_NUM_23_27</u> # And Balak said unto Balaam, Come, I pray thee, I will bring thee unto another place; peradventure it will please God that thou mayest curse me them from thence.

mayest dig brass <u>05_DEU_08_09</u> # A land wherein thou shalt eat bread without scarceness, thou shalt not lack any [thing] in it; a land whose stones [are] iron, and out of whose hills thou mayest dig brass.

mayest do it <u>05_DEU_30_14</u># But the word [is] very nigh unto thee, in thy mouth, and in thy heart, that thou mayest do it.

mayest do to <u>09_1SA_24_04</u># And the men of David said unto him, Behold the day of which the LORD said unto thee, Behold, I will deliver thine enemy into thine hand, that thou mayest do to him as it shall seem good unto thee. Then David arose, and cut off the skirt of Saul's robe privily.

mayest dwell in <u>05_DEU_30_20</u> # That thou mayest love the LORD thy God, [and] that thou mayest obey his voice, and that thou mayest cleave unto him: for he [is] thy life, and the length of thy days: that thou mayest dwell in the land which the LORD sware unto thy fathers, to Abraham, to Isaac, and to Jacob, to give them.

mayest eat and <u>05_DEU_11_15</u># And I will send grass in thy fields for thy cattle, that thou mayest eat and be full.

mayest eat flesh <u>05_DEU_12_20</u># When the LORD thy God shall enlarge thy border, as he hath promised thee, and thou shalt say, I will eat flesh, because thy soul longeth to eat flesh; thou mayest eat flesh, whatsoever thy soul lusteth after.

mayest eat grapes <u>05_DEU_23_24</u># When thou comest into thy neighbour's vineyard, then thou mayest eat grapes thy fill at thine own pleasure; but thou shalt not put [any] in thy vessel.

mayest eat of <u>05_DEU_20_19</u> # When thou shalt besiege a city a long time, in making war against it to take it, thou shalt not destroy the trees thereof by forcing an ax against them: for thou mayest eat of them, and thou shalt not cut them down [for the tree of the field [is] man's [life]] to employ [them] in the siege:

mayest eat the <u>41_MAR_14_12</u> # And the first day of unleavened bread, when they killed the passover, his disciples said unto him, Where wilt thou that we go and prepare that thou mayest eat the passover?

mayest exact it <u>05_DEU_15_03</u># Of a foreigner thou mayest exact [it again]: but [that] which is thine with thy brother thine hand shall release;

mayest fear this <u>05_DEU_28_58</u># If thou wilt not observe to do all the words of this law that are written in this book, that thou mayest fear this glorious and fearful name, THE LORD THY GOD;

mayest freely eat <u>01_GEN_02_16</u># And the LORD God commanded the man, saying, Of every tree of the garden thou mayest freely eat:

mayest gather in 05_DEU_11_14 # That I will give [you] the rain of your land in his due season, the first

rain and the latter rain, that thou mayest gather in thy corn, and thy wine, and thine oil.

mayest give him 19 PSA 94 13 # That thou mayest give him rest from the days of adversity, until the pit be digged for the wicked.

mayest give them 19_PSA_104_27 # These wait all upon thee; that thou mayest give [them] their meat in due season.

mayest go home <u>07_JUD_19_09</u># And when the man rose up to depart, he, and his concubine, and his servant, his father in law, the damsel's father, said unto him, Behold, now the day draweth toward evening, I pray you tarry all night: behold, the day groweth to an end, lodge here, that thine heart may be merry; and to morrow get you early on your way, that thou mayest go home.

mayest go in <u>09_1SA_20_13</u># The LORD do so and much more to Jonathan: but if it please my father [to do] thee evil, then I will show it thee, and send thee away, that thou mayest go in peace: and the LORD be with thee, as he hath been with my father.

mayest go in <u>05_DEU_06_18</u># And thou shalt do [that which is] right and good in the sight of the LORD: that it may be well with thee, and that thou mayest go in and possess the good land which the LORD sware unto thy fathers,

mayest go in <u>05_DEU_27_03</u># And thou shalt write upon them all the words of this law, when thou art passed over, that thou mayest go in unto the land which the LORD thy God giveth thee, a land that floweth with milk and honey; as the LORD God of thy fathers hath promised thee.

mayest go with <u>07_JUD_11_08</u># And the elders of Gilead said unto Jephthah, Therefore we turn again to thee now, that thou mayest go with us, and fight against the children of Ammon, and be our head over all the inhabitants of Gilead.

mayest have strength <u>09_1SA_28_22</u> # Now therefore, I pray thee, hearken thou also unto the voice of thine handmaid, and let me set a morsel of bread before thee; and eat, that thou mayest have strength, when thou goest on thy way.

mayest hear the <u>16_NEH_01_06</u># Let thine ear now be attentive, and thine eyes open, that thou mayest hear the prayer of thy servant, which I pray before thee now, day and night, for the children of Israel thy servants, and confess the sins of the children of Israel, which we have sinned against thee: both I and my father's house have sinned.

mayest hearken unto 11_1KI_08_29 # That thine eyes may be open toward this house night and day, [even] toward the place of which thou hast said, My name shall be there: that thou mayest hearken unto the prayer which thy servant shall make toward this place.

mayest inherit his <u>05_DEU_02_31</u># And the LORD said unto me, Behold, I have begun to give Sihon and his land before thee: begin to possess, that thou mayest inherit his land.

mayest inherit the <u>01_GEN_28_04</u> # And give thee the blessing of Abraham, to thee, and to thy seed with thee; that thou mayest inherit the land wherein thou art a stranger, which God gave unto Abraham.

mayest judge my 14_2CH_01_11 # And God said to Solomon, Because this was in thine heart, and thou hast not asked riches, wealth, or honour, nor the life of thine enemies, neither yet hast asked long life; but hast asked wisdom and knowledge for thyself, that thou mayest judge my people, over whom I have made thee king:

mayest keep the 13_1CH_22_12 # Only the LORD give thee wisdom and understanding, and give thee charge concerning Israel, that thou mayest keep the law of the LORD thy God.

mayest kill and <u>05_DEU_12_15</u># Notwithstanding thou mayest kill and eat flesh in all thy gates, whatsoever thy soul lusteth after, according to the blessing of the LORD thy God which he hath given thee: the unclean and the clean may eat thereof, as of the roebuck, and as of the hart.

mayest know and 24_JER_06_27_# I have set thee [for] a tower [and] a fortress among my people, that thou mayest know and try their way.

mayest know how <u>54_1TI_03_15</u># But if I tarry long, that thou mayest know how thou oughtest to behave thyself in the house of God, which is the church of the living God, the pillar and ground of the truth.

mayest know how <u>02 EXO 09 29 #</u> And Moses said unto him, As soon as I am gone out of the city, I will spread abroad my hands unto the LORD; [and] the thunder shall cease, neither shall there be any more hail; that thou mayest know how that the earth [is] the LORD's.

mayest know that <u>02_EXO_08_10</u> # And he said, To morrow. And he said, [Be it] according to thy word: that thou mayest know that [there is] none like unto the LORD our God.

mayest know that <u>02_EXO_08_22</u> # And I will sever in that day the land of Goshen, in which my people dwell, that no swarms [of flies] shall be there; to the end thou mayest know that I [am] the LORD in the midst of the earth.

mayest know that <u>02_EXO_09_14</u> # For I will at this time send all my plagues upon thine heart, and upon thy servants, and upon thy people; that thou mayest know that [there is] none like me in all the earth.

mayest know that <u>23_ISA_45_03</u># And I will give thee the treasures of darkness, and hidden riches of secret places, that thou mayest know that I, the LORD, which call [thee] by thy name, [am] the God of Israel.

mayest learn to <u>05_DEU_14_23</u># And thou shalt eat before the LORD thy God, in the place which he shall choose to place his name there, the tithe of thy corn, of thy wine, and of thine oil, and the firstlings of thy herds and of thy flocks; that thou mayest learn to fear the LORD thy God always.

mayest lend upon <u>05_DEU_23_20</u># Unto a stranger thou mayest lend upon usury; but unto thy brother thou shalt not lend upon usury: that the LORD thy God may bless thee in all that thou settest thine hand to in the land whither thou goest to possess it.

mayest live and <u>05_DEU_16_20</u> # That which is altogether just shalt thou follow, that thou mayest live, and inherit the land which the LORD thy God giveth thee.

mayest live and <u>05_DEU_30_16</u># In that I command thee this day to love the LORD thy God, to walk in his ways, and to keep his commandments and his statutes and his judgments, that thou mayest live and multiply: and the LORD thy God shall bless thee in the land whither thou goest to possess it.

mayest live long 49_EPH_06_03 # That it may be well with thee, and thou mayest live long on the earth.

mayest live <u>05_DEU_30_06</u># And the LORD thy God will circumcise thine heart, and the heart of thy seed, to love the LORD thy God with all thine heart, and with all thy soul, that thou mayest live.

mayest look on <u>35_HAB_02_15</u># Woe unto him that giveth his neighbour drink, that puttest thy bottle to [him], and makest [him] drunken also, that thou mayest look on their nakedness!

mayest love the <u>05_DEU_30_20</u># That thou mayest love the LORD thy God, [and] that thou mayest obey his voice, and that thou mayest cleave unto him: for he [is] thy life, and the length of thy days: that thou mayest dwell in the land which the LORD sware unto thy fathers, to Abraham, to Isaac, and to Jacob, to

give them.

mayest make known <u>09_1SA_28_15</u># And Samuel said to Saul, Why hast thou disquieted me, to bring me up? And Saul answered, I am sore distressed; for the Philistines make war against me, and God is departed from me, and answereth me no more, neither by prophets, nor by dreams: therefore I have called thee, that thou mayest make known unto me what I shall do.

mayest make princes 19 PSA 45 16 # Instead of thy fathers shall be thy children, whom thou mayest make princes in all the earth.

mayest not consume <u>05_DEU_07_22</u># And the LORD thy God will put out those nations before thee by little and little: thou mayest not consume them at once, lest the beasts of the field increase upon thee.

mayest not eat <u>05_DEU_12_17</u># Thou mayest not eat within thy gates the tithe of thy corn, or of thy wine, or of thy oil, or the firstlings of thy herds or of thy flock, nor any of thy vows which thou vowest, nor thy freewill offerings, or heave offering of thine hand:

mayest not eat <u>05_DEU_12_23</u># Only be sure that thou eat not the blood: for the blood [is] the life; and thou mayest not eat the life with the flesh.

mayest not hide <u>05_DEU_22_03</u> # In like manner shalt thou do with his ass; and so shalt thou do with his raiment; and with all lost thing of thy brother's, which he hath lost, and thou hast found, shalt thou do likewise: thou mayest not hide thyself.

mayest not sacrifice <u>05_DEU_16_05</u># Thou mayest not sacrifice the passover within any of thy gates, which the LORD thy God giveth thee:

mayest not set <u>05_DEU_17_15</u># Thou shalt in any wise set [him] king over thee, whom the LORD thy God shall choose: [one] from among thy brethren shalt thou set king over thee: thou mayest not set a stranger over thee, which [is] not thy brother.

mayest obey his <u>05_DEU_30_20</u># That thou mayest love the LORD thy God, [and] that thou mayest obey his voice, and that thou mayest cleave unto him: for he [is] thy life, and the length of thy days: that thou mayest dwell in the land which the LORD sware unto thy fathers, to Abraham, to Isaac, and to Jacob, to give them.

mayest observe to <u>06_JOS_01_07</u># Only be thou strong and very courageous, that thou mayest observe to do according to all the law, which Moses my servant commanded thee: turn not from it [to] the right hand or [to] the left, that thou mayest prosper whithersoever thou goest.

mayest observe to <u>06_JOS_01_08</u># This book of the law shall not depart out of thy mouth; but thou shalt meditate therein day and night, that thou mayest observe to do according to all that is written therein: for then thou shalt make thy way prosperous, and then thou shalt have good success.

mayest pluck the <u>05_DEU_23_25</u># When thou comest into the standing corn of thy neighbour, then thou mayest pluck the ears with thine hand; but thou shalt not move a sickle unto thy neighbour's standing corn.

mayest prevail <u>23_ISA_47_12</u># Stand now with thine enchantments, and with the multitude of thy sorceries, wherein thou hast laboured from thy youth; if so be thou shalt be able to profit, if so be thou mayest prevail.

mayest prolong thy <u>05_DEU_04_40</u># Thou shalt keep therefore his statutes, and his commandments, which I command thee this day, that it may go well with thee, and with thy children after thee, and that thou mayest prolong [thy] days upon the earth, which the LORD thy God giveth thee, for ever.

mayest prolong thy <u>05_DEU_22_07</u># [But] thou shalt in any wise let the dam go, and take the young to thee; that it may be well with thee, and [that] thou mayest prolong [thy] days.

mayest prosper and <u>64_3JO_01_02</u> # Beloved, I wish above all things that thou mayest prosper and be in health, even as thy soul prospereth.

mayest prosper in 11_1KI_02_03 # And keep the charge of the LORD thy God, to walk in his ways, to keep his statutes, and his commandments, and his judgments, and his testimonies, as it is written in the law of Moses, that thou mayest prosper in all that thou doest, and whithersoever thou turnest thyself:

mayest prosper whithersoever <u>06_JOS_01_07</u> # Only be thou strong and very courageous, that thou mayest observe to do according to all the law, which Moses my servant commanded thee: turn not from it [to] the right hand or [to] the left, that thou mayest prosper whithersoever thou goest.

mayest recover him 12 2KI 05 06 # And he brought the letter to the king of Israel, saying, Now when this letter is come unto thee, behold, I have [therewith] sent Naaman my servant to thee, that thou mayest recover him of his leprosy.

mayest regard discretion <u>20_PRO_05_02</u># That thou mayest regard discretion, and [that] thy lips may keep knowledge.

mayest reign over <u>10_2SA_03_21</u># And Abner said unto David, I will arise and go, and will gather all Israel unto my lord the king, that they may make a league with thee, and that thou mayest reign over all that thine heart desireth. And David sent Abner away; and he went in peace.

mayest remember and <u>26_EZE_16_63</u># That thou mayest remember, and be confounded, and never open thy mouth any more because of thy shame, when I am pacified toward thee for all that thou hast done, saith the Lord GOD.

mayest remember the <u>05_DEU_16_03</u># Thou shalt eat no leavened bread with it; seven days shalt thou eat unleavened bread therewith, [even] the bread of affliction: for thou camest forth out of the land of Egypt in haste: that thou mayest remember the day when thou camest forth out of the land of Egypt all the days of thy life.

mayest save thine 11_1KI_01_12 # Now therefore come, let me, I pray thee, give thee counsel, that thou mayest save thine own life, and the life of thy son Solomon.

mayest say to <u>23_ISA_49_09</u> # That thou mayest say to the prisoners, Go forth; to them that [are] in darkness, Show yourselves. They shall feed in the ways, and their pastures [shall be] in all high places.

mayest see them <u>04_NUM_23_13</u># And Balak said unto him, Come, I pray thee, with me unto another place, from whence thou mayest see them: thou shalt see but the utmost part of them, and shalt not see them all: and curse me them from thence.

mayest see <u>66_REV_03_18</u># I counsel thee to buy of me gold tried in the fire, that thou mayest be rich; and white raiment, that thou mayest be clothed, and [that] the shame of thy nakedness do not appear; and anoint thine eyes with eyesalve, that thou mayest see.

mayest sell it <u>05_DEU_14_21</u> # Ye shall not eat [of] any thing that dieth of itself: thou shalt give it unto the stranger that [is] in thy gates, that he may eat it; or thou mayest sell it unto an alien: for thou [art] an holy people unto the LORD thy God. Thou shalt not seethe a kid in his mother's milk.

mayest take away 11_1KI_02_31 # And the king said unto him, Do as he hath said, and fall upon him, and bury him; that thou mayest take away the innocent blood, which Joab shed, from me, and from the house of my father.

mayest take knowledge 44_ACT_24_08 # Commanding his accusers to come unto thee: by examining of whom thyself mayest take knowledge of all these things, whereof we accuse him.

mayest teach them <u>02_EXO_24_12</u># And the LORD said unto Moses, Come up to me into the mount, and be there: and I will give thee tables of stone, and a law, and commandments which I have written; that thou mayest teach them.

mayest tell in <u>02_EXO_10_02</u> # And that thou mayest tell in the ears of thy son, and of thy son's son, what things I have wrought in Egypt, and my signs which I have done among them; that ye may know how that I [am] the LORD.

mayest thou do <u>07_JUD_09_33</u># And it shall be, [that] in the morning, as soon as the sun is up, thou shalt rise early, and set upon the city: and, behold, [when] he and the people that [is] with him come out against thee, then mayest thou do to them as thou shalt find occasion.

mayest thou for 10 2SA 15 34 # But if thou return to the city, and say unto Absalom, I will be thy servant, O king; [as] I [have been] thy father's servant hitherto, so [will] I now also [be] thy servant: then mayest thou for me defeat the counsel of Ahithophel.

mayest thou offer <u>03_LEV_22_23</u># Either a bullock or a lamb that hath any thing superfluous or lacking in his parts, that mayest thou offer [for] a freewill offering; but for a vow it shall not be accepted.

mayest understand that <u>44_ACT_24_11</u># Because that thou mayest understand, that there are yet but twelve days since I went up to Jerusalem for to worship.

mayest use them <u>04_NUM_10_02</u># Make thee two trumpets of silver; of a whole piece shalt thou make them: that thou mayest use them for the calling of the assembly, and for the journeying of the camps.

mayest walk in 20_PRO_02_20# That thou mayest walk in the way of good [men], and keep the paths of the righteous.
