means as the [47 2CO 11 03](#) # But I fear, lest by any means, as the serpent beguiled Eve through his subtlety, so your minds should be corrupted from the simplicity that is in Christ.

means clear the [02 EXO 34 07](#) # Keeping mercy for thousands, forgiving iniquity and transgression and sin, and that will by no means clear [the guilty]; visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children, and upon the children's children, unto the third and to the fourth [generation].

means clearing the [04 NUM 14 18](#) # The LORD [is] longsuffering, and of great mercy, forgiving iniquity and transgression, and by no means clearing [the guilty], visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children unto the third and fourth [generation].

means come out [40 MAT 05 26](#) # Verily I say unto thee, Thou shalt by no means come out thence, till thou hast paid the uttermost farthing.

means for that [53 2TH 02 03](#) # Let no man deceive you by any means: for [that day shall not come], except there come a falling away first, and that man of sin be revealed, the son of perdition;

means hurt you [42 LUK 10 19](#) # Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.

means I may [45 ROM 11 14](#) # If by any means I may provoke to emulation [them which are] my flesh, and might save some of them.

means I might [50 PHP 03 11](#) # If by any means I might attain unto the resurrection of the dead.

means I should [48 GAL 02 02](#) # And I went up by revelation, and communicated unto them that gospel which I preach among the Gentiles, but privately to them which were of reputation, lest by any means I should run, or had run, in vain.
