measured a thousand <u>26_EZE_47_03</u># And when the man that had the line in his hand went forth eastward, he measured a thousand cubits, and he brought me through the waters; the waters [were] to the ankles.

measured a thousand <u>26_EZE_47_04</u># Again he measured a thousand, and brought me through the waters; the waters [were] to the knees. Again he measured a thousand, and brought me through; the waters [were] to the loins.

measured a thousand <u>26_EZE_47_04</u># Again he measured a thousand, and brought me through the waters; the waters [were] to the knees. Again he measured a thousand, and brought me through; the waters [were] to the loins.

measured a thousand <u>26_EZE_47_05</u># Afterward he measured a thousand; [and it was] a river that I could not pass over: for the waters were risen, waters to swim in, a river that could not be passed over.

measured also the 26_EZE_40_08 # He measured also the porch of the gate within, one reed.

measured and the <u>24_JER_31_37</u># Thus saith the LORD; If heaven above can be measured, and the foundations of the earth searched out beneath, I will also cast off all the seed of Israel for all that they have done, saith the LORD.

measured each post <u>26_EZE_40_48</u># And he brought me to the porch of the house, and measured [each] post of the porch, five cubits on this side, and five cubits on that side: and the breadth of the gate [was] three cubits on this side, and three cubits on that side.

measured five hundred <u>26_EZE_42_19</u> # He turned about to the west side, [and] measured five hundred reeds with the measuring reed.

measured from gate <u>26_EZE_40_23</u> # And the gate of the inner court [was] over against the gate toward the north, and toward the east; and he measured from gate to gate an hundred cubits.

measured from gate 26_EZE_40_27 # And [there was] a gate in the inner court toward the south: and he measured from gate to gate toward the south an hundred cubits.

measured he the <u>26_EZE_40_09</u> # Then measured he the porch of the gate, eight cubits; and the posts thereof, two cubits; and the porch of the gate [was] inward.

measured he to <u>10_2SA_08_02</u> # And he smote Moab, and measured them with a line, casting them down to the ground; even with two lines measured he to put to death, and with one full line to keep alive. And [so] the Moabites became David's servants, [and] brought gifts.

measured it according <u>26_EZE_40_35</u># And he brought me to the north gate, and measured [it] according to these measures:

measured it by <u>26_EZE_42_20</u># He measured it by the four sides: it had a wall round about, five hundred [reeds] long, and five hundred broad, to make a separation between the sanctuary and the profane place.

measured it round 26_EZE_42_15 # Now when he had made an end of measuring the inner house, he

brought me forth toward the gate whose prospect [is] toward the east, and measured it round about.

measured nor numbered <u>28_HOS_01_10</u> # Yet the number of the children of Israel shall be as the sand of the sea, which cannot be measured nor numbered; and it shall come to pass, [that] in the place where it was said unto them, Ye [are] not my people, [there] it shall be said unto them, [Ye are] the sons of the living God.

measured six measures <u>08_RUT_03_15</u># Also he said, Bring the veil that [thou hast] upon thee, and hold it. And when she held it, he measured six [measures] of barley, and laid [it] on her: and she went into the city.

measured so will 24_JER_33_22 # As the host of heaven cannot be numbered, neither the sand of the sea measured: so will I multiply the seed of David my servant, and the Levites that minister unto me.

measured the breadth <u>26_EZE_40_05</u># And behold a wall on the outside of the house round about, and in the man's hand a measuring reed of six cubits [long] by the cubit and an hand breadth: so he measured the breadth of the building, one reed; and the height, one reed.

measured the breadth <u>26_EZE_40_11</u># And he measured the breadth of the entry of the gate, ten cubits; [and] the length of the gate, thirteen cubits.

measured the breadth <u>26_EZE_40_19</u># Then he measured the breadth from the forefront of the lower gate unto the forefront of the inner court without, an hundred cubits eastward and northward.

measured the city <u>66_REV_21_16</u># And the city lieth foursquare, and the length is as large as the breadth: and he measured the city with the reed, twelve thousand furlongs. The length and the breadth and the height of it are equal.

measured the court <u>26_EZE_40_47</u># So he measured the court, an hundred cubits long, and an hundred cubits broad, foursquare; and the altar [that was] before the house.

measured the earth <u>35_HAB_03_06</u># He stood, and measured the earth: he beheld, and drove asunder the nations; and the everlasting mountains were scattered, the perpetual hills did bow: his ways [are] everlasting.

measured the east <u>26_EZE_42_16</u># He measured the east side with the measuring reed, five hundred reeds, with the measuring reed round about.

measured the gate <u>26_EZE_40_32</u> # And he brought me into the inner court toward the east: and he measured the gate according to these measures.

measured the house <u>26_EZE_41_13</u> # So he measured the house, an hundred cubits long; and the separate place, and the building, with the walls thereof, an hundred cubits long;

measured the length <u>26_EZE_40_20</u># And the gate of the outward court that looked toward the north, he measured the length thereof, and the breadth thereof.

measured the length <u>26_EZE_41_02</u> # And the breadth of the door [was] ten cubits: and the sides of the door [were] five cubits on the one side, and five cubits on the other side: and he measured the length thereof, forty cubits: and the breadth, twenty cubits.

measured the length <u>26_EZE_41_04</u> # So he measured the length thereof, twenty cubits; and the breadth, twenty cubits, before the temple: and he said unto me, This [is] the most holy [place].

measured the length <u>26_EZE_41_15</u># And he measured the length of the building over against the separate place which [was] behind it, and the galleries thereof on the one side and on the other side, an hundred cubits, with the inner temple, and the porches of the court;

measured the north <u>26_EZE_42_17</u># He measured the north side, five hundred reeds, with the measuring reed round about.

measured the post <u>26_EZE_41_03</u> # Then went he inward, and measured the post of the door, two cubits; and the door, six cubits; and the breadth of the door, seven cubits.

measured the posts <u>26_EZE_40_24</u> # After that he brought me toward the south, and behold a gate toward the south: and he measured the posts thereof and the arches thereof according to these measures.

measured the posts <u>26_EZE_41_01</u># Afterward he brought me to the temple, and measured the posts, six cubits broad on the one side, and six cubits broad on the other side, [which was] the breadth of the tabernacle.

measured the south <u>26_EZE_40_28</u># And he brought me to the inner court by the south gate: and he measured the south gate according to these measures;

measured the south <u>26_EZE_42_18</u># He measured the south side, five hundred reeds, with the measuring reed.

measured the threshold <u>26_EZE_40_06</u># Then came he unto the gate which looketh toward the east, and went up the stairs thereof, and measured the threshold of the gate, [which was] one reed broad; and the other threshold [of the gate, which was] one reed broad.

measured the wall <u>26_EZE_41_05</u> # After he measured the wall of the house, six cubits; and the breadth of [every] side chamber, four cubits, round about the house on every side.

measured the wall <u>66_REV_21_17</u> # And he measured the wall thereof, an hundred [and] forty [and] four cubits, [according to] the measure of a man, that is, of the angel.

measured the waters <u>23_ISA_40_12</u> # Who hath measured the waters in the hollow of his hand, and meted out heaven with the span, and comprehended the dust of the earth in a measure, and weighed the mountains in scales, and the hills in a balance?

measured them with 10_2SA_08_02 # And he smote Moab, and measured them with a line, casting them down to the ground; even with two lines measured he to put to death, and with one full line to keep alive. And [so] the Moabites became David's servants, [and] brought gifts.

measured then the <u>26_EZE_40_13</u># He measured then the gate from the roof of [one] little chamber to the roof of another: the breadth [was] five and twenty cubits, door against door.

measured to you <u>42_LUK_06_38</u> # Give, and it shall be given unto you; good measure, pressed down, and shaken together, and running over, shall men give into your bosom. For with the same measure that ye mete withal it shall be measured to you again.

measured to you 41_MAR_04_24 # And he said unto them, Take heed what ye hear: with what measure ye mete, it shall be measured to you: and unto you that hear shall more be given.

measured to you <u>40_MAT_07_02</u># For with what judgment ye judge, ye shall be judged: and with what measure ye mete, it shall be measured to you again.
