intermeddle with his 20_PRO_14_10\# The heart knoweth his own bitterness; and a stranger doth not intermeddle with his joy.
intermeddleth with all 20_PRO_18_01 \# Through desire a man, having separated himself, seeketh [and] intermeddleth with all wisdom.

Meddle not with 05_DEU_02_05 \# Meddle not with them; for I will not give you of their land, no, not so much as a foot breadth; because $I$ have given mount Seir unto Esau [for] a possession.
meddle not with 20_PRO_20_19\# He that goeth about [as] a talebearer revealeth secrets: therefore meddle not with him that flattereth with his lips.
meddle not with 20_PRO_24_21 \# My son, fear thou the LORD and the king: [and] meddle not with them that are given to change:
meddle to thine 14 _2CH_25_19 \# Thou sayest, Lo, thou hast smitten the Edomites; and thine heart lifteth thee up to boast: abide now at home; why shouldest thou meddle to [thine] hurt, that thou shouldest fall, [even] thou, and Judah with thee?
