mete it shall <u>41_MAR_04_24</u># And he said unto them, Take heed what ye hear: with what measure ye mete, it shall be measured to you: and unto you that hear shall more be given.

mete it shall 40_MAT_07_02 # For with what judgment ye judge, ye shall be judged: and with what measure ye mete, it shall be measured to you again.

mete it with <u>02_EXO_16_18</u># And when they did mete [it] with an omer, he that gathered much had nothing over, and he that gathered little had no lack; they gathered every man according to his eating.

mete out the 19_PSA_108_07 # God hath spoken in his holiness; I will rejoice, I will divide Shechem, and mete out the valley of Succoth.

meteyard in weight <u>03_LEV_19_35</u># Ye shall do no unrighteousness in judgment, in meteyard, in weight, or in measure.
