Almighty God walk <u>01\_GEN\_17\_01</u># And when Abram was ninety years old and nine, the LORD appeared to Abram, and said unto him, I [am] the Almighty God; walk before me, and be thou perfect.

Almighty God when 26 EZE 10 05 # And the sound of the cherubims' wings was heard [even] to the outer court, as the voice of the Almighty God when he speaketh.

Almighty pervert justice <u>18\_JOB\_08\_03</u> # Doth God pervert judgment? or doth the Almighty pervert justice?

Almighty regard it 18\_JOB\_35\_13 # Surely God will not hear vanity, neither will the Almighty regard it.

Almighty scattered kings 19\_PSA\_68\_14 # When the Almighty scattered kings in it, it was [white] as snow in Salmon.

Almighty shall be <u>18\_JOB\_22\_25</u># Yea, the Almighty shall be thy defence, and thou shalt have plenty of silver.

Almighty shall it 29\_JOE\_01\_15 # Alas for the day! for the day of the LORD [is] at hand, and as a destruction from the Almighty shall it come.

Almighty that he <u>18\_JOB\_34\_10</u> # Therefore hearken unto me, ye men of understanding: far be it from God, [that he should do] wickedness; and [from] the Almighty, [that he should commit] iniquity.

Almighty that thou <u>18\_JOB\_22\_03</u> # [Is it] any pleasure to the Almighty, that thou art righteous? or [is it] gain [to him], that thou makest thy ways perfect?

Almighty that we <u>18\_JOB\_21\_15</u> # What [is] the Almighty, that we should serve him? and what profit should we have, if we pray unto him?

Almighty was yet <u>18\_JOB\_29\_05</u># When the Almighty [was] yet with me, [when] my children [were] about me;

Almighty we cannot <u>18\_JOB\_37\_23</u> # [Touching] the Almighty, we cannot find him out: [he is] excellent in power, and in judgment, and in plenty of justice: he will not afflict.

Almighty which art <u>66\_REV\_11\_17</u> # Saying, We give thee thanks, O Lord God Almighty, which art, and wast, and art to come; because thou hast taken to thee thy great power, and hast reigned.

Almighty which was <u>66\_REV\_04\_08</u> # And the four beasts had each of them six wings about [him]; and [they were] full of eyes within: and they rest not day and night, saying, Holy, holy, Lord God Almighty, which was, and is, and is to come.

Almighty who hath <u>18\_JOB\_27\_02</u> # [As] God liveth, [who] hath taken away my judgment; and the Almighty, [who] hath vexed my soul;

Almighty <u>47\_2CO\_06\_18</u># And will be a Father unto you, and ye shall be my sons and daughters, saith the Lord Almighty.

Almighty 23\_ISA\_13\_06 # Howl ye; for the day of the LORD [is] at hand; it shall come as a destruction from the Almighty.

Almighty <u>18\_JOB\_05\_17</u># Behold, happy [is] the man whom God correcteth: therefore despise not thou the chastening of the Almighty:

Almighty <u>18\_JOB\_06\_14</u> # To him that is afflicted pity [should be showed] from his friend; but he forsaketh the fear of the Almighty.

Almighty <u>18\_JOB\_08\_05</u># If thou wouldest seek unto God betimes, and make thy supplication to the Almighty;

Almighty <u>18\_JOB\_15\_25</u># For he stretcheth out his hand against God, and strengtheneth himself against the Almighty.

Almighty <u>18\_JOB\_21\_20</u> # His eyes shall see his destruction, and he shall drink of the wrath of the Almighty.

Almighty <u>18\_JOB\_27\_13</u> # This [is] the portion of a wicked man with God, and the heritage of oppressors, [which] they shall receive of the Almighty.

Almighty 19\_PSA\_91\_01 # He that dwelleth in the secret place of the most High shall abide under the shadow of the Almighty.

Almighty <u>66\_REV\_01\_08</u> # I am Alpha and Omega, the beginning and the ending, saith the Lord, which is, and which was, and which is to come, the Almighty.

Almighty <u>66\_REV\_16\_14</u># For they are the spirits of devils, working miracles, [which] go forth unto the kings of the earth and of the whole world, to gather them to the battle of that great day of God Almighty.

might abound But <u>45\_ROM\_05\_20</u> # Moreover the law entered, that the offence might abound. But where sin abounded, grace did much more abound:

might according to 12 2KI 23 25 # And like unto him was there no king before him, that turned to the LORD with all his heart, and with all his soul, and with all his might, according to all the law of Moses; neither after him arose there [any] like him.

might according to <u>51\_COL\_01\_11</u># Strengthened with all might, according to his glorious power, unto all patience and longsuffering with joyfulness;

might accuse him <u>42\_LUK\_11\_54</u># Laying wait for him, and seeking to catch something out of his mouth, that they might accuse him.

might accuse him <u>41\_MAR\_03\_02</u># And they watched him, whether he would heal him on the sabbath day; that they might accuse him.

might accuse him <u>40\_MAT\_12\_10</u># And, behold, there was a man which had [his] hand withered. And they asked him, saying, Is it lawful to heal on the sabbath days? that they might accuse him.

might affect them <u>48\_GAL\_04\_17</u> # They zealously affect you, [but] not well; yea, they would exclude you, that ye might affect them.

might afflict ourselves <u>15\_EZR\_08\_21</u># Then I proclaimed a fast there, at the river of Ahava, that we might afflict ourselves before our God, to seek of him a right way for us, and for our little ones, and for all our substance.

might against this 14\_2CH\_20\_12 # O our God, wilt thou not judge them? for we have no might against this great company that cometh against us; neither know we what to do: but our eyes [are] upon thee.

might also have <u>50\_PHP\_03\_04</u> # Though I might also have confidence in the flesh. If any other man thinketh that he hath whereof he might trust in the flesh, I more:

might and all <u>11\_1KI\_15\_23</u># The rest of all the acts of Asa, and all his might, and all that he did, and the cities which he built, [are] they not written in the book of the chronicles of the kings of Judah? Nevertheless in the time of his old age he was diseased in his feet.

might and David <u>10\_2SA\_06\_14</u># And David danced before the LORD with all [his] might; and David [was] girded with a linen ephod.

might and dominion 49\_EPH\_01\_21 # Far above all principality, and power, and might, and dominion, and every name that is named, not only in this world, but also in that which is to come:

might and hast <u>27\_DAN\_02\_23</u> # I thank thee, and praise thee, O thou God of my fathers, who hast given me wisdom and might, and hast made known unto me now what we desired of thee: for thou hast [now] made known unto us the king's matter.

might and how 12 2KI 14 15 # Now the rest of the acts of Jehoash which he did, and his might, and how he fought with Amaziah king of Judah, [are] they not written in the book of the chronicles of the kings of Israel?

might and how 12\_2KI\_20\_20 # And the rest of the acts of Hezekiah, and all his might, and how he made a pool, and a conduit, and brought water into the city, [are] they not written in the book of the chronicles of the kings of Judah?

might and in 13\_1CH\_29\_12 # Both riches and honour [come] of thee, and thou reignest over all; and in thine hand [is] power and might; and in thine hand [it is] to make great, and to give strength unto all.

might and men <u>13\_1CH\_12\_08</u># And of the Gadites there separated themselves unto David into the hold to the wilderness men of might, [and] men of war [fit] for the battle, that could handle shield and buckler, whose faces [were like] the faces of lions, and [were] as swift as the roes upon the mountains;

might and the 13\_1CH\_29\_30# With all his reign and his might, and the times that went over him, and over Israel, and over all the kingdoms of the countries.

might and the <u>17\_EST\_10\_02</u># And all the acts of his power and of his might, and the declaration of the greatness of Mordecai, whereunto the king advanced him, [are] they not written in the book of the chronicles of the kings of Media and Persia?

might and the <u>01\_GEN\_49\_03</u># Reuben, thou [art] my firstborn, my might, and the beginning of my strength, the excellency of dignity, and the excellency of power:

might And the <u>07\_JUD\_05\_31</u># So let all thine enemies perish, O LORD: but [let] them that love him [be] as the sun when he goeth forth in his might. And the land had rest forty years.

might and the <u>07\_JUD\_16\_30</u># And Samson said, Let me die with the Philistines. And he bowed himself with [all his] might; and the house fell upon the lords, and upon all the people that [were] therein. So the dead which he slew at his death were more than [they] which he slew in his life.

might appear sin <u>45\_ROM\_07\_13</u> # Was then that which is good made death unto me? God forbid. But sin, that it might appear sin, working death in me by that which is good; that sin by the commandment might

might are they 12\_2KI\_10\_34 # Now the rest of the acts of Jehu, and all that he did, and all his might, [are] they not written in the book of the chronicles of the kings of Israel?

might are they <u>12\_2KI\_13\_08</u> # Now the rest of the acts of Jehoahaz, and all that he did, and his might, [are] they not written in the book of the chronicles of the kings of Israel?

might attain to <u>44\_ACT\_27\_12</u> # And because the haven was not commodious to winter in, the more part advised to depart thence also, if by any means they might attain to Phenice, [and there] to winter; [which is] an haven of Crete, and lieth toward the south west and north west.

might attain unto 50\_PHP\_03\_11 # If by any means I might attain unto the resurrection of the dead.

might be a <u>26\_EZE\_17\_08</u># It was planted in a good soil by great waters, that it might bring forth branches, and that it might bear fruit, that it might be a goodly vine.

might be a <u>58\_HEB\_02\_17</u> # Wherefore in all things it behoved him to be made like unto [his] brethren, that he might be a merciful and faithful high priest in things [pertaining] to God, to make reconciliation for the sins of the people.

might be accomplished <u>14\_2CH\_36\_22</u># Now in the first year of Cyrus king of Persia, that the word of the LORD [spoken] by the mouth of Jeremiah might be accomplished, the LORD stirred up the spirit of Cyrus king of Persia, that he made a proclamation throughout all his kingdom, and [put it] also in writing, saying,

might be according 01\_GEN\_30\_34 # And Laban said, Behold, I would it might be according to thy word.

might be base <u>26\_EZE\_17\_14</u> # That the kingdom might be base, that it might not lift itself up, [but] that by keeping of his covenant it might stand.

might be broken 43\_JOH\_19\_31 # The Jews therefore, because it was the preparation, that the bodies should not remain upon the cross on the sabbath day, [for that sabbath day was an high day,] besought Pilate that their legs might be broken, and [that] they might be taken away.

might be built <u>38\_ZEC\_08\_09</u> # Thus saith the LORD of hosts; Let your hands be strong, ye that hear in these days these words by the mouth of the prophets, which [were] in the day [that] the foundation of the house of the LORD of hosts was laid, that the temple might be built.

might be by <u>45\_ROM\_04\_16</u># Therefore [it is] of faith, that [it might be] by grace; to the end the promise might be sure to all the seed; not to that only which is of the law, but to that also which is of the faith of Abraham; who is the father of us all,

might be called <u>23\_ISA\_61\_03</u> # To appoint unto them that mourn in Zion, to give unto them beauty for ashes, the oil of joy for mourning, the garment of praise for the spirit of heaviness; that they might be called trees of righteousness, the planting of the LORD, that he might be glorified.

might be careful <u>56\_TIT\_03\_08</u> # [This is] a faithful saying, and these things I will that thou affirm constantly, that they which have believed in God might be careful to maintain good works. These things are good and profitable unto men.

might be comforted <u>51\_COL\_02\_02</u># That their hearts might be comforted, being knit together in love, and unto all riches of the full assurance of understanding, to the acknowledgment of the mystery of God, and of the Father, and of Christ;

might be crucified <u>42\_LUK\_23\_23</u># And they were instant with loud voices, requiring that he might be crucified. And the voices of them and of the chief priests prevailed.

might be damned  $\underline{53\_2TH\_02\_12}$ # That they all might be damned who believed not the truth, but had pleasure in unrighteousness.

might be declared <u>45\_ROM\_09\_17</u># For the scripture saith unto Pharaoh, Even for this same purpose have I raised thee up, that I might show my power in thee, and that my name might be declared throughout all the earth.

might be destroyed <u>45\_ROM\_06\_06</u># Knowing this, that our old man is crucified with [him], that the body of sin might be destroyed, that henceforth we should not serve sin.

might be encouraged 14\_2CH\_31\_04 # Moreover he commanded the people that dwelt in Jerusalem to give the portion of the priests and the Levites, that they might be encouraged in the law of the LORD.

might be exalted <u>47\_2CO\_11\_07</u># Have I committed an offence in abasing myself that ye might be exalted, because I have preached to you the gospel of God freely?

might be fellowhelpers <u>64\_3JO\_01\_08</u># We therefore ought to receive such, that we might be fellowhelpers to the truth.

might be filled <u>51\_COL\_01\_09</u># For this cause we also, since the day we heard [it], do not cease to pray for you, and to desire that ye might be filled with the knowledge of his will in all wisdom and spiritual understanding;

might be filled 49\_EPH\_03\_19 # And to know the love of Christ, which passeth knowledge, that ye might be filled with all the fulness of God.

might perform his <u>11\_1KI\_12\_15</u># Wherefore the king hearkened not unto the people; for the cause was from the LORD, that he might perform his saying, which the LORD spake by Ahijah the Shilonite unto Jeroboam the son of Nebat.

might perform his 14\_2CH\_10\_15 # So the king hearkened not unto the people: for the cause was of God, that the LORD might perform his word, which he spake by the hand of Ahijah the Shilonite to Jeroboam the son of Nebat.

might perform the 12\_2KI\_23\_24 # Moreover the [workers with] familiar spirits, and the wizards, and the images, and the idols, and all the abominations that were spied in the land of Judah and in Jerusalem, did Josiah put away, that he might perform the words of the law which were written in the book that Hilkiah the priest found in the house of the LORD.

might perish ye 24\_JER\_27\_15 # For I have not sent them, saith the LORD, yet they prophesy a lie in my name; that I might drive you out, and that ye might perish, ye, and the prophets that prophesy unto you.

might plead for 18\_JOB\_16\_21 # O that one might plead for a man with God, as a man [pleadeth] for his neighbour!

might plow <u>09\_1SA\_14\_14</u> # And that first slaughter, which Jonathan and his armourbearer made, was about twenty men, within as it were an half acre of land, [which] a yoke [of oxen might plow].

might possess their <u>06\_JOS\_24\_08</u># And I brought you into the land of the Amorites, which dwelt on the other side Jordan; and they fought with you: and I gave them into your hand, that ye might possess their land; and I destroyed them from before you.

might preach him 48\_GAL\_01\_16 # To reveal his Son in me, that I might preach him among the heathen;

immediately I conferred not with flesh and blood:

might present it <u>49\_EPH\_05\_27</u># That he might present it to himself a glorious church, not having spot, or wrinkle, or any such thing; but that it should be holy and without blemish.

might preserve us <u>05\_DEU\_06\_24</u># And the LORD commanded us to do all these statutes, to fear the LORD our God, for our good always, that he might preserve us alive, as [it is] at this day.

might prove thee <u>05\_DEU\_08\_16</u># Who fed thee in the wilderness with manna, which thy fathers knew not, that he might humble thee, and that he might prove thee, to do thee good at thy latter end;

might provoke me <u>14\_2CH\_34\_25</u> # Because they have forsaken me, and have burned incense unto other gods, that they might provoke me to anger with all the works of their hands; therefore my wrath shall be poured out upon this place, and shall not be quenched.

might provoke me 12\_2KI\_22\_17 # Because they have forsaken me, and have burned incense unto other gods, that they might provoke me to anger with all the works of their hands; therefore my wrath shall be kindled against this place, and shall not be quenched.

might provoke me 24\_JER\_25\_07# Yet ye have not hearkened unto me, saith the LORD; that ye might provoke me to anger with the works of your hands to your own hurt.

might punish them 44\_ACT\_04\_21 # So when they had further threatened them, they let them go, finding nothing how they might punish them, because of the people: for all [men] glorified God for that which was done.

might put Lazarus 43\_JOH\_12\_10 # But the chief priests consulted that they might put Lazarus also to death;

might put them <u>10\_2SA\_10\_10</u># And the rest of the people he delivered into the hand of Abishai his brother, that he might put [them] in array against the children of Ammon.

might put them <u>07\_JUD\_18\_07</u># Then the five men departed, and came to Laish, and saw the people that [were] therein, how they dwelt careless, after the manner of the Zidonians, quiet and secure; and [there was] no magistrate in the land, that might put [them] to shame in [any] thing; and they [were] far from the Zidonians, and had no business with [any] man.

might put us <u>24\_JER\_43\_03</u># But Baruch the son of Neriah setteth thee on against us, for to deliver us into the hand of the Chaldeans, that they might put us to death, and carry us away captives into Babylon.

might rebel this <u>06\_JOS\_22\_16</u># Thus saith the whole congregation of the LORD, What trespass [is] this that ye have committed against the God of Israel, to turn away this day from following the LORD, in that ye have builded you an altar, that ye might rebel this day against the LORD?

might receive damage <u>47\_2CO\_07\_09</u> # Now I rejoice, not that ye were made sorry, but that ye sorrowed to repentance: for ye were made sorry after a godly manner, that ye might receive damage by us in nothing.

might receive from 41\_MAR\_12\_02 # And at the season he sent to the husbandmen a servant, that he might receive from the husbandmen of the fruit of the vineyard.

might receive his <u>44\_ACT\_09\_12</u> # And hath seen in a vision a man named Ananias coming in, and putting [his] hand on him, that he might receive his sight.

might receive my 41\_MAR\_10\_51 # And Jesus answered and said unto him, What wilt thou that I should do unto thee? The blind man said unto him, Lord, that I might receive my sight.

might receive the <u>44\_ACT\_08\_15</u># Who, when they were come down, prayed for them, that they might receive the Holy Ghost:

might receive the <u>48\_GAL\_03\_14</u># That the blessing of Abraham might come on the Gentiles through Jesus Christ; that we might receive the promise of the Spirit through faith.

might receive the <u>48\_GAL\_04\_05</u> # To redeem them that were under the law, that we might receive the adoption of sons.

might receive the <u>58\_HEB\_09\_15</u># And for this cause he is the mediator of the new testament, that by means of death, for the redemption of the transgressions [that were] under the first testament, they which are called might receive the promise of eternal inheritance.

might receive the <u>58\_HEB\_10\_36</u># For ye have need of patience, that, after ye have done the will of God, ye might receive the promise.

might receive the <u>40\_MAT\_21\_34</u># And when the time of the fruit drew near, he sent his servants to the husbandmen, that they might receive the fruits of it.

might reckoned in <u>13\_1CH\_07\_05</u># And their brethren among all the families of Issachar [were] valiant men of might, reckoned in all by their genealogies fourscore and seven thousand.

might reconcile both 49\_EPH\_02\_16 # And that he might reconcile both unto God in one body by the cross, having slain the enmity thereby:

might redeem us <u>56\_TIT\_02\_14</u> # Who gave himself for us, that he might redeem us from all iniquity, and purify unto himself a peculiar people, zealous of good works.

might reign with 46\_1CO\_04\_08 # Now ye are full, now ye are rich, ye have reigned as kings without us: and I would to God ye did reign, that we also might reign with you.

might remain in 43\_JOH\_15\_11 # These things have I spoken unto you, that my joy might remain in you, and [that] your joy might be full.

might remove them <u>29\_JOE\_03\_06</u># The children also of Judah and the children of Jerusalem have ye sold unto the Grecians, that ye might remove them far from their border.

might reproach me <u>16\_NEH\_06\_13</u> # Therefore [was] he hired, that I should be afraid, and do so, and sin, and [that] they might have [matter] for an evil report, that they might reproach me.

might rest in <u>35\_HAB\_03\_16</u> # When I heard, my belly trembled; my lips quivered at the voice: rottenness entered into my bones, and I trembled in myself, that I might rest in the day of trouble: when he cometh up unto the people, he will invade them with his troops.

might return from <u>08\_RUT\_01\_06</u># Then she arose with her daughters in law, that she might return from the country of Moab: for she had heard in the country of Moab how that the Lord had visited his people in giving them bread.

might rid him <u>01\_GEN\_37\_22</u># And Reuben said unto them, Shed no blood, [but] cast him into this pit that [is] in the wilderness, and lay no hand upon him; that he might rid him out of their hands, to deliver him to his father again.

might run to <u>09\_1SA\_20\_06</u># If thy father at all miss me, then say, David earnestly asked [leave] of me that he might run to Bethlehem his city: for [there is] a yearly sacrifice there for all the family.

might salute him <u>09\_1SA\_13\_10</u> # And it came to pass, that as soon as he had made an end of offering the burnt offering, behold, Samuel came; and Saul went out to meet him, that he might salute him.

might sanctify and 49\_EPH\_05\_26# That he might sanctify and cleanse it with the washing of water by the word,

might sanctify the <u>58\_HEB\_13\_12</u># Wherefore Jesus also, that he might sanctify the people with his own blood, suffered without the gate.

might save some <u>45\_ROM\_11\_14</u># If by any means I may provoke to emulation [them which are] my flesh, and might save some of them.

might say unto 42 LUK 17 06 # And the Lord said, If ye had faith as a grain of mustard seed, ye might say unto this sycamine tree, Be thou plucked up by the root, and be thou planted in the sea; and it should obey you.

might see and 43\_JOH\_09\_39 # And Jesus said, For judgment I am come into this world, that they which see not might see; and that they which see might be made blind.

might see Lazarus 43\_JOH\_12\_09 # Much people of the Jews therefore knew that he was there: and they came not for Jesus' sake only, but that they might see Lazarus also, whom he had raised from the dead.

might see that <u>21\_ECC\_03\_18</u># I said in mine heart concerning the estate of the sons of men, that God might manifest them, and that they might see that they themselves are beasts.

might see the <u>04\_NUM\_22\_41</u> # And it came to pass on the morrow, that Balak took Balaam, and brought him up into the high places of Baal, that thence he might see the utmost [part] of the people.

might see what 21\_ECC\_02\_03 # I sought in mine heart to give myself unto wine, yet acquainting mine heart with wisdom; and to lay hold on folly, till I might see what [was] that good for the sons of men, which they should do under the heaven all the days of their life.

might see what 32\_JON\_04\_05 # So Jonah went out of the city, and sat on the east side of the city, and there made him a booth, and sat under it in the shadow, till he might see what would become of the city.

might see your <u>52\_1TH\_03\_10</u> # Night and day praying exceedingly that we might see your face, and might perfect that which is lacking in your faith?

might seek a <u>39\_MAL\_02\_15</u># And did not he make one? Yet had he the residue of the spirit. And wherefore one? That he might seek a godly seed. Therefore take heed to your spirit, and let none deal treacherously against the wife of his youth.

might seek after 44\_ACT\_15\_17 # That the residue of men might seek after the Lord, and all the Gentiles, upon whom my name is called, saith the Lord, who doeth all these things.

might send him 44\_ACT\_25\_21 # But when Paul had appealed to be reserved unto the hearing of Augustus, I commanded him to be kept till I might send him to Caesar.

might send them <u>02\_EXO\_12\_33</u> # And the Egyptians were urgent upon the people, that they might send them out of the land in haste; for they said, We [be] all dead [men].

might send them <u>41\_MAR\_03\_14</u> # And he ordained twelve, that they should be with him, and that he might send them forth to preach,

might serve him <u>42\_LUK\_01\_74</u> # That he would grant unto us, that we being delivered out of the hand of our enemies might serve him without fear,

might set their <u>19\_PSA\_78\_07</u># That they might set their hope in God, and not forget the works of God, but keep his commandments:

might show forth <u>54\_1TI\_01\_16</u> # Howbeit for this cause I obtained mercy, that in me first Jesus Christ might show forth all longsuffering, for a pattern to them which should hereafter believe on him to life everlasting.

might show my 45\_ROM\_09\_17 # For the scripture saith unto Pharaoh, Even for this same purpose have I raised thee up, that I might show my power in thee, and that my name might be declared throughout all the earth.

might show the <u>49\_EPH\_02\_07</u> # That in the ages to come he might show the exceeding riches of his grace in [his] kindness toward us through Christ Jesus.

might show them <u>26\_EZE\_40\_04</u># And the man said unto me, Son of man, behold with thine eyes, and hear with thine ears, and set thine heart upon all that I shall show thee; for to the intent that I might show [them] unto thee [art] thou brought hither: declare all that thou seest to the house of Israel.

might show these <u>02\_EXO\_10\_01</u># And the LORD said unto Moses, Go in unto Pharaoh: for I have hardened his heart, and the heart of his servants, that I might show these my signs before him:

might so that 14\_2CH\_20\_06 # And said, O LORD God of our fathers, [art] not thou God in heaven? and rulest [not] thou over all the kingdoms of the heathen? and in thine hand [is there not] power and might, so that none is able to withstand thee?

might speak unto <u>06\_JOS\_22\_24</u># And if we have not [rather] done it for fear of [this] thing, saying, In time to come your children might speak unto our children, saying, What have ye to do with the LORD God of Israel?

might stand before <u>27\_DAN\_01\_05</u># And the king appointed them a daily provision of the king's meat, and of the wine which he drank: so nourishing them three years, that at the end thereof they might stand before the king.

might take away 43\_JOH\_19\_38 # And after this Joseph of Arimathaea, being a disciple of Jesus, but secretly for fear of the Jews, besought Pilate that he might take away the body of Jesus: and Pilate gave [him] leave. He came therefore, and took the body of Jesus.

might take him 43\_JOH\_11\_57 # Now both the chief priests and the Pharisees had given a commandment,

that, if any man knew where he were, he should show [it], that they might take him.

might take him 41\_MAR\_14\_01 # After two days was [the feast of] the passover, and of unleavened bread: and the chief priests and the scribes sought how they might take him by craft, and put [him] to death.

might take hold <u>18\_JOB\_38\_13</u># That it might take hold of the earth, that the wicked might be shaken out of it?

might take hold <u>42\_LUK\_20\_20</u># And they watched [him], and sent forth spies, which should feign themselves just men, that they might take hold of his words, that so they might deliver him unto the power and authority of the governor.

might take it 43\_JOH\_10\_17 # Therefore doth my Father love me, because I lay down my life, that I might take it again.

might take Jesus 40\_MAT\_26\_04# And consulted that they might take Jesus by subtlety, and kill [him].

might take the 14\_2CH\_32\_18 # Then they cried with a loud voice in the Jews' speech unto the people of Jerusalem that [were] on the wall, to affright them, and to trouble them; that they might take the city.

might teach others <u>46\_1CO\_14\_19</u># Yet in the church I had rather speak five words with my understanding, that [by my voice] I might teach others also, than ten thousand words in an [unknown] tongue.

might teach the <u>27\_DAN\_01\_04</u># Children in whom [was] no blemish, but well favoured, and skilful in all wisdom, and cunning in knowledge, and understanding science, and such as [had] ability in them to stand in the king's palace, and whom they might teach the learning and the tongue of the Chaldeans.

might that he <u>11\_1KI\_16\_27</u># Now the rest of the acts of Omri which he did, and his might that he showed, [are] they not written in the book of the chronicles of the kings of Israel?

might that he <u>11\_1KI\_22\_45</u># Now the rest of the acts of Jehoshaphat, and his might that he showed, and how he warred, [are] they not written in the book of the chronicles of the kings of Judah?

might the spirit <u>23\_ISA\_11\_02</u># And the spirit of the LORD shall rest upon him, the spirit of wisdom and understanding, the spirit of counsel and might, the spirit of knowledge and of the fear of the LORD;

might the strength <u>18\_JOB\_30\_02</u> # Yea, whereto [might] the strength of their hands [profit] me, in whom old age was perished?

might they shall <u>33\_MIC\_07\_16</u> # The nations shall see and be confounded at all their might: they shall lay [their] hand upon [their] mouth, their ears shall be deaf.

might this parable 42\_LUK\_08\_09 # And his disciples asked him, saying, What might this parable be?

might this thing 12 2KI 07 02 # Then a lord on whose hand the king leaned answered the man of God, and said, Behold, [if] the LORD would make windows in heaven, might this thing be? And he said, Behold, thou shalt see [it] with thine eyes, but shalt not eat thereof.

might through the <u>47\_2CO\_04\_15</u> # For all things [are] for your sakes, that the abundant grace might through the thanksgiving of many redound to the glory of God.

might to declare 33\_MIC\_03\_08 # But truly I am full of power by the spirit of the LORD, and of judgment, and of might, to declare unto Jacob his transgression, and to Israel his sin.

might touch if <u>41 MAR\_06\_56</u># And whithersoever he entered, into villages, or cities, or country, they laid the sick in the streets, and besought him that they might touch if it were but the border of his garment: and as many as touched him were made whole.

might trust in <u>50\_PHP\_03\_04</u># Though I might also have confidence in the flesh. If any other man thinketh that he hath whereof he might trust in the flesh, I more:

might turn from <u>27\_DAN\_09\_13</u> # As [it is] written in the law of Moses, all this evil is come upon us: yet made we not our prayer before the LORD our God, that we might turn from our iniquities, and understand thy truth.

might understand the <u>42\_LUK\_24\_45</u># Then opened he their understanding, that they might understand the scriptures,

mightest answer the <u>20\_PRO\_22\_21</u># That I might make thee know the certainty of the words of truth; that thou mightest answer the words of truth to them that send unto thee?

mightest be bound <u>07\_JUD\_16\_06</u># And Delilah said to Samson, Tell me, I pray thee, wherein thy great strength [lieth], and wherewith thou mightest be bound to afflict thee.

mightest be bound <u>07\_JUD\_16\_10</u># And Delilah said unto Samson, Behold, thou hast mocked me, and told me lies: now tell me, I pray thee, wherewith thou mightest be bound.

mightest be bound <u>07\_JUD\_16\_13</u># And Delilah said unto Samson, Hitherto thou hast mocked me, and told me lies: tell me wherewith thou mightest be bound. And he said unto her, If thou weavest the seven locks of my head with the web.

mightest be justified 19 PSA 51 04 # Against thee, thee only, have I sinned, and done [this] evil in thy sight: that thou mightest be justified when thou speakest, [and] be clear when thou judgest.

mightest be justified 45\_ROM\_03\_04 # God forbid: yea, let God be true, but every man a liar; as it is written, That thou mightest be justified in thy sayings, and mightest overcome when thou art judged.

mightest be profited 41\_MAR\_07\_11 # But ye say, If a man shall say to his father or mother, [It is] Corban, that is to say, a gift, by whatsoever thou mightest be profited by me; [he shall be free].

mighty man shall <u>36\_ZEP\_01\_14</u># The great day of the LORD [is] near, [it is] near, and hasteth greatly, [even] the voice of the day of the LORD: the mighty man shall cry there bitterly.

mighty man so 19\_PSA\_127\_04 # As arrows [are] in the hand of a mighty man; so [are] children of the youth.

mighty man that 24\_JER\_14\_09 # Why shouldest thou be as a man astonied, as a mighty man [that] cannot save? yet thou, O LORD, [art] in the midst of us, and we are called by thy name; leave us not.

mighty man that 19\_PSA\_78\_65 # Then the Lord awaked as one out of sleep, [and] like a mighty man that shouteth by reason of wine.

mighty man the 19 PSA 52 01 # To the chief Musician, Maschil, [A Psalm] of David, when Doeg the Edomite came and told Saul, and said unto him, David is come to the house of Ahimelech. Why boastest thou thyself in mischief, O mighty man? the goodness of God [endureth] continually.

mighty man 38\_ZEC\_09\_13 # When I have bent Judah for me, filled the bow with Ephraim, and raised up thy sons, O Zion, against thy sons, O Greece, and made thee as the sword of a mighty man.

mighty men and 13\_1CH\_28\_01 # And David assembled all the princes of Israel, the princes of the tribes, and the captains of the companies that ministered to the king by course, and the captains over the thousands, and captains over the hundreds, and the stewards over all the substance and possession of the king, and of his sons, with the officers, and with the mighty men, and with all the valiant men, unto Jerusalem.

mighty men and 13\_1CH\_29\_24 # And all the princes, and the mighty men, and all the sons likewise of king David, submitted themselves unto Solomon the king.

mighty men and 11\_1KI\_01\_10# But Nathan the prophet, and Benaiah, and the mighty men, and Solomon his brother, he called not.

mighty men and 10\_2SA\_17\_08 # For, said Hushai, thou knowest thy father and his men, that they [be] mighty men, and they [be] chafed in their minds, as a bear robbed of her whelps in the field: and thy father [is] a man of war, and will not lodge with the people.

mighty men and 10\_2SA\_20\_07 # And there went out after him Joab's men, and the Cherethites, and the Pelethites, and all the mighty men: and they went out of Jerusalem, to pursue after Sheba the son of Bichri.

mighty men and <u>26\_EZE\_39\_20</u> # Thus ye shall be filled at my table with horses and chariots, with mighty men, and with all men of war, saith the Lord GOD.

mighty men and <u>24\_JER\_26\_21</u> # And when Jehoiakim the king, with all his mighty men, and all the princes, heard his words, the king sought to put him to death: but when Urijah heard it, he was afraid, and fled, and went into Egypt;

mighty men in <u>25\_LAM\_01\_15</u># The Lord hath trodden under foot all my mighty [men] in the midst of me: he hath called an assembly against me to crush my young men: the Lord hath trodden the virgin, the daughter of Judah, [as] in a winepress.

mighty men is <u>34\_NAH\_02\_03</u># The shield of his mighty men is made red, the valiant men [are] in scarlet: the chariots [shall be] with flaming torches in the day of his preparation, and the fir trees shall be terribly shaken.

mighty men which <u>01\_GEN\_06\_04</u># There were giants in the earth in those days; and also after that, when the sons of God came in unto the daughters of men, and they bare [children] to them, the same [became] mighty men which [were] of old, men of renown.

mighty men which <u>38\_ZEC\_10\_05</u> # And they shall be as mighty [men], which tread down [their enemies] in the mire of the streets in the battle: and they shall fight, because the LORD [is] with them, and the riders on horses shall be confounded.

mighty men whom 13\_1CH\_11\_10# These also [are] the chief of the mighty men whom David had, who strengthened themselves with him in his kingdom, [and] with all Israel, to make him king, according to the

mighty men 13\_1CH\_19\_08# And when David heard [of it], he sent Joab, and all the host of the mighty men.

mighty nation and <u>01\_GEN\_18\_18</u># Seeing that Abraham shall surely become a great and mighty nation, and all the nations of the earth shall be blessed in him?

mighty nation it <u>24\_JER\_05\_15</u> # Lo, I will bring a nation upon you from far, O house of Israel, saith the LORD: it [is] a mighty nation, it [is] an ancient nation, a nation whose language thou knowest not, neither understandest what they say.

mighty valiant man <u>09\_1SA\_16\_18</u> # Then answered one of the servants, and said, Behold, I have seen a son of Jesse the Bethlehemite, [that is] cunning in playing, and a mighty valiant man, and a man of war, and prudent in matters, and a comely person, and the LORD [is] with him.

mighty waters <u>02\_EXO\_15\_10</u># Thou didst blow with thy wind, the sea covered them: they sank as lead in the mighty waters.

mighty waters 23\_ISA\_17\_12# Woe to the multitude of many people, [which] make a noise like the noise of the seas; and to the rushing of nations, [that] make a rushing like the rushing of mighty waters!

mighty waters 23\_ISA\_43\_16 # Thus saith the LORD, which maketh a way in the sea, and a path in the mighty waters;

mighty waters 16\_NEH\_09\_11 # And thou didst divide the sea before them, so that they went through the midst of the sea on the dry land; and their persecutors thou threwest into the deeps, as a stone into the mighty waters.

mighty waves of 19\_PSA\_93\_04 # The LORD on high [is] mightier than the noise of many waters, [yea, than] the mighty waves of the sea.

mighty wind and 44\_ACT\_02\_02 # And suddenly there came a sound from heaven as of a rushing mighty wind, and it filled all the house where they were sitting.

mighty work save <u>41\_MAR\_06\_05</u># And he could there do no mighty work, save that he laid his hands upon a few sick folk, and healed [them].

mighty works that <u>42\_LUK\_19\_37</u># And when he was come nigh, even now at the descent of the mount of Olives, the whole multitude of the disciples began to rejoice and praise God with a loud voice for all the mighty works that they had seen;

mighty works there 40\_MAT\_13\_58# And he did not many mighty works there because of their unbelief.

mighty works were 40 MAT\_11 20 # Then began he to upbraid the cities wherein most of his mighty works were done, because they repented not:

mighty works which 40\_MAT\_11\_21# Woe unto thee, Chorazin! woe unto thee, Bethsaida! for if the mighty works, which were done in you, had been done in Tyre and Sidon, they would have repented long ago in sackcloth and ashes.

mighty works which <u>40\_MAT\_11\_23</u># And thou, Capernaum, which art exalted unto heaven, shalt be brought down to hell: for if the mighty works, which have been done in thee, had been done in Sodom, it would have remained until this day.

mighty works 40 MAT\_13\_54# And when he was come into his own country, he taught them in their synagogue, insomuch that they were astonished, and said, Whence hath this [man] this wisdom, and [these] mighty works?
