mightest answer the [20 PRO 22 21](#) # That I might make thee know the certainty of the words of truth; that thou mightest answer the words of truth to them that send unto thee?

mightest be bound [07 JUD 16 06](#) # And Delilah said to Samson, Tell me, I pray thee, wherein thy great strength [lieth], and wherewith thou mightest be bound to afflict thee.

mightest be bound [07 JUD 16 10](#) # And Delilah said unto Samson, Behold, thou hast mocked me, and told me lies: now tell me, I pray thee, wherewith thou mightest be bound.

mightest be bound [07 JUD 16 13](#) # And Delilah said unto Samson, Hitherto thou hast mocked me, and told me lies: tell me wherewith thou mightest be bound. And he said unto her, If thou weavest the seven locks of my head with the web.

mightest be justified [19 PSA 51 04](#) # Against thee, thee only, have I sinned, and done [this] evil in thy sight: that thou mightest be justified when thou speakest, [and] be clear when thou judgest.

mightest be justified [45 ROM 03 04](#) # God forbid: yea, let God be true, but every man a liar; as it is written, That thou mightest be justified in thy sayings, and mightest overcome when thou art judged.

mightest be profited [41 MAR 07 11](#) # But ye say, If a man shall say to his father or mother, [It is] Corban, that is to say, a gift, by whatsoever thou mightest be profited by me; [he shall be free].

mightest be profited [40 MAT 15 05](#) # But ye say, Whosoever shall say to [his] father or [his] mother, [It is] a gift, by whatsoever thou mightest be profited by me;

mightest bring them [16 NEH 09 29](#) # And testifiedst against them, that thou mightest bring them again unto thy law: yet they dealt proudly, and hearkened not unto thy commandments, but sinned against thy judgments, [which if a man do, he shall live in them:] and withdrew the shoulder, and hardened their neck, and would not hear.
