determine <u>02\_EXO\_21\_22</u># If men strive, and hurt a woman with child, so that her fruit depart [from her], and yet no mischief follow: he shall be surely punished, according as the woman's husband will lay upon him; and he shall pay as the judges [determine].

determined against him <u>17\_EST\_07\_07</u># And the king arising from the banquet of wine in his wrath [went] into the palace garden: and Haman stood up to make request for his life to Esther the queen; for he saw that there was evil determined against him by the king.

determined against it <u>23\_ISA\_19\_17</u> # And the land of Judah shall be a terror unto Egypt, every one that maketh mention thereof shall be afraid in himself, because of the counsel of the LORD of hosts, which he hath determined against it.

determined against our <u>09\_1SA\_25\_17</u># Now therefore know and consider what thou wilt do; for evil is determined against our master, and against all his household: for he [is such] a son of Belial, that [a man] cannot speak to him.

determined before to <u>44\_ACT\_04\_28</u> # For to do whatsoever thy hand and thy counsel determined before to be done.

determined but woe <u>42\_LUK\_22\_22</u># And truly the Son of man goeth, as it was determined: but woe unto that man by whom he is betrayed!

determined by him <u>09\_18A\_20\_07</u># If he say thus, [It is] well; thy servant shall have peace: but if he be very wroth, [then] be sure that evil is determined by him.

determined by my <u>09\_1SA\_20\_09</u> # And Jonathan said, Far be it from thee: for if I knew certainly that evil were determined by my father to come upon thee, then would not I tell it thee?

determined from the <u>10\_2SA\_13\_32</u> # And Jonadab, the son of Shimeah David's brother, answered and said, Let not my lord suppose [that] they have slain all the young men the king's sons; for Amnon only is dead: for by the appointment of Absalom this hath been determined from the day that he forced his sister Tamar.

determined in a <u>44\_ACT\_19\_39</u> # But if ye inquire any thing concerning other matters, it shall be determined in a lawful assembly.

determined in the <u>23\_ISA\_10\_23</u> # For the Lord GOD of hosts shall make a consumption, even determined, in the midst of all the land.

determined not to <u>46\_1CO\_02\_02</u> # For I determined not to know any thing among you, save Jesus Christ, and him crucified.

determined of his <u>09\_1SA\_20\_33</u># And Saul cast a javelin at him to smite him: whereby Jonathan knew that it was determined of his father to slay David.

determined shall be <u>27\_DAN\_09\_27</u> # And he shall confirm the covenant with many for one week: and in the midst of the week he shall cause the sacrifice and the oblation to cease, and for the overspreading of abominations he shall make [it] desolate, even until the consummation, and that determined shall be poured

upon the desolate.

determined shall be <u>27\_DAN\_11\_36</u># And the king shall do according to his will; and he shall exalt himself, and magnify himself above every god, and shall speak marvellous things against the God of gods, and shall prosper till the indignation be accomplished: for that that is determined shall be done.

determined that Paul <u>44\_ACT\_15\_02</u> # When therefore Paul and Barnabas had no small dissension and disputation with them, they determined that Paul and Barnabas, and certain other of them, should go up to Jerusalem unto the apostles and elders about this question.

determined that we <u>44\_ACT\_27\_01</u> # And when it was determined that we should sail into Italy, they delivered Paul and certain other prisoners unto [one] named Julius, a centurion of Augustus' band.

determined the number <u>18\_JOB\_14\_05</u> # Seeing his days [are] determined, the number of his months [are] with thee, thou hast appointed his bounds that he cannot pass;

determined the times <u>44\_ACT\_17\_26</u> # And hath made of one blood all nations of men for to dwell on all the face of the earth, and hath determined the times before appointed, and the bounds of their habitation;

determined there to <u>56\_TIT\_03\_12</u> # When I shall send Artemas unto thee, or Tychicus, be diligent to come unto me to Nicopolis: for I have determined there to winter.

determined this with <u>47\_2CO\_02\_01</u> # But I determined this with myself, that I would not come again to you in heaviness.

determined to build <u>14\_2CH\_02\_01</u> # And Solomon determined to build an house for the name of the LORD, and an house for his kingdom.

determined to destroy <u>14\_2CH\_25\_16</u> # And it came to pass, as he talked with him, that [the king] said unto him, Art thou made of the king's counsel? forbear; why shouldest thou be smitten? Then the prophet forbare, and said, I know that God hath determined to destroy thee, because thou hast done this, and hast not hearkened unto my counsel.

determined to let <u>44\_ACT\_03\_13</u> # The God of Abraham, and of Isaac, and of Jacob, the God of our fathers, hath glorified his Son Jesus; whom ye delivered up, and denied him in the presence of Pilate, when he was determined to let [him] go.

determined to sail <u>44\_ACT\_20\_16</u># For Paul had determined to sail by Ephesus, because he would not spend the time in Asia: for he hasted, if it were possible for him, to be at Jerusalem the day of Pentecost.

determined to send <u>44\_ACT\_11\_29</u># Then the disciples, every man according to his ability, determined to send relief unto the brethren which dwelt in Judaea:

determined to send <u>44\_ACT\_25\_25</u># But when I found that he had committed nothing worthy of death, and that he himself hath appealed to Augustus, I have determined to send him.

determined to take <u>44\_ACT\_15\_37</u># And Barnabas determined to take with them John, whose surname was Mark.

determined upon the <u>23\_ISA\_28\_22</u> # Now therefore be ye not mockers, lest your bands be made strong: for I have heard from the Lord GOD of hosts a consumption, even determined upon the whole earth.

determined upon thy <u>27\_DAN\_09\_24</u> # Seventy weeks are determined upon thy people and upon thy holy city, to finish the transgression, and to make an end of sins, and to make reconciliation for iniquity, and to bring in everlasting righteousness, and to seal up the vision and prophecy, and to anoint the most Holy.

determined <u>27\_DAN\_09\_26</u> # And after threescore and two weeks shall Messiah be cut off, but not for himself: and the people of the prince that shall come shall destroy the city and the sanctuary; and the end thereof [shall be] with a flood, and unto the end of the war desolations are determined.

eminent place and <u>26\_EZE\_16\_24</u># [That] thou hast also built unto thee an eminent place, and hast made thee an high place in every street.

eminent place and <u>26\_EZE\_16\_39</u># And I will also give thee into their hand, and they shall throw down thine eminent place, and shall break down thy high places: they shall strip thee also of thy clothes, and shall take thy fair jewels, and leave thee naked and bare.

eminent place in <u>26\_EZE\_16\_31</u># In that thou buildest thine eminent place in the head of every way, and makest thine high place in every street; and hast not been as an harlot, in that thou scornest hire;

eminent <u>26\_EZE\_17\_22</u># Thus saith the Lord GOD; I will also take of the highest branch of the high cedar, and will set [it]; I will crop off from the top of his young twigs a tender one, and will plant [it] upon an high mountain and eminent:

examine himself and <u>46\_1CO\_11\_28</u># But let a man examine himself, and so let him eat of [that] bread, and drink of [that] cup.

examine me is <u>46\_1CO\_09\_03</u># Mine answer to them that do examine me is this,

Examine me O <u>19\_PSA\_26\_02</u> # Examine me, O LORD, and prove me; try my reins and my heart.

examine the matter <u>15\_EZR\_10\_16</u> # And the children of the captivity did so. And Ezra the priest, [with] certain chief of the fathers, after the house of their fathers, and all of them by [their] names, were separated, and sat down in the first day of the tenth month to examine the matter.

Examine yourselves whether <u>47\_2CO\_13\_05</u> # Examine yourselves, whether ye be in the faith; prove your own selves. Know ye not your own selves, how that Jesus Christ is in you, except ye be reprobates?

examined by scourging <u>44\_ACT\_22\_24</u># The chief captain commanded him to be brought into the castle, and bade that he should be examined by scourging; that he might know wherefore they cried so against him.

examined him and <u>44\_ACT\_22\_29</u> # Then straightway they departed from him which should have examined him: and the chief captain also was afraid, after he knew that he was a Roman, and because he had bound him.

examined him before <u>42\_LUK\_23\_14</u> # Said unto them, Ye have brought this man unto me, as one that perverteth the people: and, behold, I, having examined [him] before you, have found no fault in this man touching those things whereof ye accuse him:

examined me would <u>44\_ACT\_28\_18</u># Who, when they had examined me, would have let [me] go, because there was no cause of death in me.

examined of the <u>44\_ACT\_04\_09</u># If we this day be examined of the good deed done to the impotent man, by what means he is made whole;

examined the keepers <u>44\_ACT\_12\_19</u> # And when Herod had sought for him, and found him not, he examined the keepers, and commanded that [they] should be put to death. And he went down from Judaea to Caesarea, and [there] abode.

famine among the <u>26\_EZE\_36\_30</u># And I will multiply the fruit of the tree, and the increase of the field, that ye shall receive no more reproach of famine among the heathen.

famine and all <u>01\_GEN\_41\_30</u> # And there shall arise after them seven years of famine; and all the plenty shall be forgotten in the land of Egypt; and the famine shall consume the land;

famine and by <u>14\_2CH\_32\_11</u># Doth not Hezekiah persuade you to give over yourselves to die by famine and by thirst, saying, The LORD our God shall deliver us out of the hand of the king of Assyria?

famine and by <u>26\_EZE\_06\_11</u># Thus saith the Lord GOD; Smite with thine hand, and stamp with thy foot, and say, Alas for all the evil abominations of the house of Israel! for they shall fall by the sword, by the famine, and by the pestilence.

famine and by <u>24\_JER\_14\_12</u> # When they fast, I will not hear their cry; and when they offer burnt offering and an oblation, I will not accept them: but I will consume them by the sword, and by the famine, and by the pestilence.

famine and by <u>24\_JER\_21\_09</u># He that abideth in this city shall die by the sword, and by the famine, and by the pestilence: but he that goeth out, and falleth to the Chaldeans that besiege you, he shall live, and his life shall be unto him for a prey.

famine and by <u>24\_JER\_27\_13</u># Why will ye die, thou and thy people, by the sword, by the famine, and by the pestilence, as the LORD hath spoken against the nation that will not serve the king of Babylon?

famine and by <u>24\_JER\_32\_36</u># And now therefore thus saith the LORD, the God of Israel, concerning this city, whereof ye say, It shall be delivered into the hand of the king of Babylon by the sword, and by the famine, and by the pestilence;

famine and by <u>24\_JER\_38\_02</u> # Thus saith the LORD, He that remaineth in this city shall die by the sword, by the famine, and by the pestilence: but he that goeth forth to the Chaldeans shall live; for he shall have his life for a prey, and shall live.

famine and by <u>24\_JER\_42\_17</u># So shall it be with all the men that set their faces to go into Egypt to sojourn there; they shall die by the sword, by the famine, and by the pestilence: and none of them shall remain or escape from the evil that I will bring upon them.

famine and by <u>24\_JER\_42\_22</u> # Now therefore know certainly that ye shall die by the sword, by the famine, and by the pestilence, in the place whither ye desire to go [and] to sojourn.

famine and by <u>24\_JER\_44\_13</u># For I will punish them that dwell in the land of Egypt, as I have punished Jerusalem, by the sword, by the famine, and by the pestilence:

famine and such 24\_JER\_15\_02 # And it shall come to pass, if they say unto thee, Whither shall we go forth? then thou shalt tell them, Thus saith the LORD; Such as [are] for death, to death; and such as [are] for the sword, to the sword; and such as [are] for the famine, to the famine; and such as [are] for the captivity, to the captivity.

famine and the <u>26\_EZE\_14\_21</u># For thus saith the Lord GOD; How much more when I send my four sore judgments upon Jerusalem, the sword, and the famine, and the noisome beast, and the pestilence, to cut off from it man and beast?

famine and the <u>23\_ISA\_51\_19</u># These two [things] are come unto thee; who shall be sorry for thee? desolation, and destruction, and the famine, and the sword: by whom shall I comfort thee?

famine and the <u>24\_JER\_14\_16</u> # And the people to whom they prophesy shall be cast out in the streets of Jerusalem because of the famine and the sword; and they shall have none to bury them, them, their wives, nor their sons, nor their daughters: for I will pour their wickedness upon them.

famine and they 24 JER 44 12 # And I will take the remnant of Judah, that have set their faces to go into the land of Egypt to sojourn there, and they shall all be consumed, [and] fall in the land of Egypt; they shall [even] be consumed by the sword [and] by the famine: they shall die, from the least even unto the greatest, by the sword and by the famine: and they shall be an execration, [and] an astonishment, and a curse, and a reproach.

famine and with <u>24\_JER\_27\_08</u># And it shall come to pass, [that] the nation and kingdom which will not serve the same Nebuchadnezzar the king of Babylon, and that will not put their neck under the yoke of the king of Babylon, that nation will I punish, saith the LORD, with the sword, and with the famine, and with the pestilence, until I have consumed them by his hand.

famine and with <u>24\_JER\_29\_18</u># And I will persecute them with the sword, with the famine, and with the pestilence, and will deliver them to be removed to all the kingdoms of the earth, to be a curse, and an astonishment, and an hissing, and a reproach, among all the nations whither I have driven them:

famine been in <u>01\_GEN\_45\_06</u># For these two years [hath] the famine [been] in the land: and yet [there are] five years, in the which [there shall] neither [be] earing nor harvest.

famine but I <u>24\_JER\_14\_13</u># Then said I, Ah, Lord GOD! behold, the prophets say unto them, Ye shall not see the sword, neither shall ye have famine; but I will give you assured peace in this place.

famine came which <u>01\_GEN\_41\_50</u> # And unto Joseph were born two sons before the years of famine came, which Asenath the daughter of Potipherah priest of On bare unto him.

famine come unto <u>10\_2SA\_24\_13</u> # So Gad came to David, and told him, and said unto him, Shall seven years of famine come unto thee in thy land? or wilt thou flee three months before thine enemies, while they pursue thee? or that there be three days' pestilence in thy land? now advise, and see what answer I shall return to him that sent me.

famine following for <u>01\_GEN\_41\_31</u># And the plenty shall not be known in the land by reason of that famine following; for it [shall be] very grievous.

famine he shall <u>18\_JOB\_05\_20</u># In famine he shall redeem thee from death: and in war from the power of the sword.

famine if there <u>11\_1KI\_08\_37</u># If there be in the land famine, if there be pestilence, blasting, mildew, locust, [or] if there be caterpillar; if their enemy besiege them in the land of their cities; whatsoever plague, whatsoever sickness [there be];

famine in Samaria <u>11\_1KI\_18\_02</u># And Elijah went to show himself unto Ahab. And [there was] a sore famine in Samaria.

famine in Samaria <u>12\_2KI\_06\_25</u> # And there was a great famine in Samaria: and, behold, they besieged it, until an ass's head was [sold] for fourscore [pieces] of silver, and the fourth part of a cab of dove's dung for five [pieces] of silver.

famine in that <u>42\_LUK\_15\_14</u># And when he had spent all, there arose a mighty famine in that land; and he began to be in want.

famine in the <u>10\_2SA\_21\_01</u> # Then there was a famine in the days of David three years, year after year; and David inquired of the LORD. And the LORD answered, [It is] for Saul, and for [his] bloody house, because he slew the Gibeonites.

famine in the <u>30\_AMO\_08\_11</u># Behold, the days come, saith the Lord GOD, that I will send a famine in the land, not a famine of bread, nor a thirst for water, but of hearing the words of the LORD:

famine in the <u>01\_GEN\_12\_10</u># And there was a famine in the land: and Abram went down into Egypt to sojourn there; for the famine [was] grievous in the land.

famine into the <u>24\_JER\_21\_07</u> # And afterward, saith the LORD, I will deliver Zedekiah king of Judah, and his servants, and the people, and such as are left in this city from the pestilence, from the sword, and from the famine, into the hand of Nebuchadrezzar king of Babylon, and into the hand of their enemies, and into the hand of those that seek their life: and he shall smite them with the edge of the sword; he shall not spare them, neither have pity, nor have mercy.

famine is in <u>12\_2KI\_07\_04</u># If we say, We will enter into the city, then the famine [is] in the city, and we shall die there: and if we sit still here, we die also. famine is sore <u>01\_GEN\_47\_04</u># They said moreover unto Pharaoh, For to sojourn in the land are we come; for thy servants have no pasture for their flocks; for the famine [is] sore in the land of Canaan: now therefore, we pray thee, let thy servants dwell in the land of Goshen.

famine lest thou <u>01\_GEN\_45\_11</u># And there will I nourish thee; for yet [there are] five years of famine; lest thou, and thy household, and all that thou hast, come to poverty.

famine of bread <u>30\_AMO\_08\_11</u># Behold, the days come, saith the Lord GOD, that I will send a famine in the land, not a famine of bread, nor a thirst for water, but of hearing the words of the LORD:

famine of your <u>01\_GEN\_42\_19</u># If ye [be] true [men], let one of your brethren be bound in the house of your prison: go ye, carry corn for the famine of your houses:

famine of your <u>01\_GEN\_42\_33</u># And the man, the lord of the country, said unto us, Hereby shall I know that ye [are] true [men]; leave one of your brethren [here] with me, and take [food for] the famine of your households, and be gone:

famine or nakedness <u>45\_ROM\_08\_35</u> # Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? [shall] tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or peril, or sword?

famine or three <u>13\_1CH\_21\_12</u> # Either three years' famine; or three months to be destroyed before thy foes, while that the sword of thine enemies overtaketh [thee]; or else three days the sword of the LORD, even the pestilence, in the land, and the angel of the LORD destroying throughout all the coasts of Israel. Now therefore advise thyself what word I shall bring again to him that sent me.

famine prevailed in <u>12\_2KI\_25\_03</u> # And on the ninth [day] of the [fourth] month the famine prevailed in the city, and there was no bread for the people of the land.

famine prevailed over <u>01\_GEN\_47\_20</u># And Joseph bought all the land of Egypt for Pharaoh; for the Egyptians sold every man his field, because the famine prevailed over them: so the land became Pharaoh's.

famine shall consume <u>01\_GEN\_41\_30</u># And there shall arise after them seven years of famine; and all the plenty shall be forgotten in the land of Egypt; and the famine shall consume the land;

famine shall not 24\_JER\_14\_15 # Therefore thus saith the LORD concerning the prophets that prophesy in my name, and I sent them not, yet they say, Sword and famine shall not be in this land; By sword and famine shall those prophets be consumed.

famine shall they <u>26\_EZE\_05\_12</u># A third part of thee shall die with the pestilence, and with famine shall they be consumed in the midst of thee: and a third part shall fall by the sword round about thee; and I will

scatter a third part into all the winds, and I will draw out a sword after them.

famine shall those <u>24\_JER\_14\_15</u># Therefore thus saith the LORD concerning the prophets that prophesy in my name, and I sent them not, yet they say, Sword and famine shall not be in this land; By sword and famine shall those prophets be consumed.

famine thou shalt <u>18\_JOB\_05\_22</u> # At destruction and famine thou shalt laugh: neither shalt thou be afraid of the beasts of the earth.

famine thus will <u>26\_EZE\_06\_12</u># He that is far off shall die of the pestilence; and he that is near shall fall by the sword; and he that remaineth and is besieged shall die by the famine: thus will I accomplish my fury upon them.

famine to the <u>24\_JER\_15\_02</u> # And it shall come to pass, if they say unto thee, Whither shall we go forth? then thou shalt tell them, Thus saith the LORD; Such as [are] for death, to death; and such as [are] for the sword, to the sword; and such as [are] for the famine, to the famine; and such as [are] for the captivity, to the captivity.

famine until there 24\_JER\_44\_27 # Behold, I will watch over them for evil, and not for good: and all the men of Judah that [are] in the land of Egypt shall be consumed by the sword and by the famine, until there be an end of them.

famine upon it <u>26\_EZE\_14\_13</u> # Son of man, when the land sinneth against me by trespassing grievously, then will I stretch out mine hand upon it, and will break the staff of the bread thereof, and will send famine upon it, and will cut off man and beast from it:

famine upon the <u>19\_PSA\_105\_16</u># Moreover he called for a famine upon the land: he brake the whole staff of bread.

famine upon you <u>26\_EZE\_05\_16</u># When I shall send upon them the evil arrows of famine, which shall be for [their] destruction, [and] which I will send to destroy you: and I will increase the famine upon you, and will break your staff of bread:

famine upon you <u>26\_EZE\_36\_29</u># I will also save you from all your uncleannesses: and I will call for the corn, and will increase it, and lay no famine upon you.
