mist and a <u>44\_ACT\_13\_11</u># And now, behold, the hand of the Lord [is] upon thee, and thou shalt be blind, not seeing the sun for a season. And immediately there fell on him a mist and a darkness; and he went about seeking some to lead him by the hand.

mist from the <u>01\_GEN\_02\_06</u># But there went up a mist from the earth, and watered the whole face of the ground.

mist of darkness <u>61\_2PE\_02\_17</u> # These are wells without water, clouds that are carried with a tempest; to whom the mist of darkness is reserved for ever.

mistress and submit <u>01\_GEN\_16\_09</u># And the angel of the LORD said unto her, Return to thy mistress, and submit thyself under her hands.

mistress as with <u>23 ISA 24\_02</u> # And it shall be, as with the people, so with the priest; as with the servant, so with his master; as with the maid, so with her mistress; as with the buyer, so with the seller; as with the lender, so with the borrower; as with the taker of usury, so with the giver of usury to him.

mistress of the <u>11\_1KI\_17\_17</u># And it came to pass after these things, [that] the son of the woman, the mistress of the house, fell sick; and his sickness was so sore, that there was no breath left in him.

mistress of witchcrafts <u>34\_NAH\_03\_04</u># Because of the multitude of the whoredoms of the wellfavoured harlot, the mistress of witchcrafts, that selleth nations through her whoredoms, and families through her witchcrafts.

mistress Sarai <u>01\_GEN\_16\_08</u> # And he said, Hagar, Sarai's maid, whence camest thou? and whither wilt thou go? And she said, I flee from the face of my mistress Sarai.

mistress so our <u>19\_PSA\_123\_02</u> # Behold, as the eyes of servants [look] unto the hand of their masters, [and] as the eyes of a maiden unto the hand of her mistress; so our eyes [wait] upon the LORD our God, until that he have mercy upon us.

mistress was despised <u>01\_GEN\_16\_04</u> # And he went in unto Hagar, and she conceived: and when she saw that she had conceived, her mistress was despised in her eyes.

mistress Would God <u>12\_2KI\_05\_03</u> # And she said unto her mistress, Would God my lord [were] with the prophet that [is] in Samaria! for he would recover him of his leprosy.

mistress <u>20\_PRO\_30\_23</u> # For an odious [woman] when she is married; and an handmaid that is heir to her mistress.

psalmist of Israel <u>10\_2SA\_23\_01</u> # Now these [be] the last words of David. David the son of Jesse said, and the man [who was] raised up on high, the anointed of the God of Jacob, and the sweet psalmist of Israel, said,
