mock and to <u>40\_MAT\_20\_19</u># And shall deliver him to the Gentiles to mock, and to scourge, and to crucify [him]: and the third day he shall rise again.

mock at her <u>25\_LAM\_01\_07</u> # Jerusalem remembered in the days of her affliction and of her miseries all her pleasant things that she had in the days of old, when her people fell into the hand of the enemy, and none did help her: the adversaries saw her, [and] did mock at her sabbaths.

mock at sin <u>20\_PRO\_14\_09</u># Fools make a mock at sin: but among the righteous [there is] favour.

mock him and <u>41\_MAR\_10\_34</u> # And they shall mock him, and shall scourge him, and shall spit upon him, and shall kill him: and the third day he shall rise again.

mock him <u>18\_JOB\_13\_09</u># Is it good that he should search you out? or as one man mocketh another, do ye [so] mock him?

mock him <u>42\_LUK\_14\_29</u> # Lest haply, after he hath laid the foundation, and is not able to finish [it], all that behold [it] begin to mock him,

mock me <u>01\_GEN\_39\_17</u> # And she spake unto him according to these words, saying, The Hebrew servant, which thou hast brought unto us, came in unto me to mock me:

mock me <u>24\_JER\_38\_19</u># And Zedekiah the king said unto Jeremiah, I am afraid of the Jews that are fallen to the Chaldeans, lest they deliver me into their hand, and they mock me.

mock on <u>18\_JOB\_21\_03</u> # Suffer me that I may speak; and after that I have spoken, mock on.

mock thee which <u>26\_EZE\_22\_05</u># [Those that be] near, and [those that be] far from thee, shall mock thee, [which art] infamous [and] much vexed.

mock us he <u>01\_GEN\_39\_14</u># That she called unto the men of her house, and spake unto them, saying, See, he hath brought in an Hebrew unto us to mock us; he came in unto me to lie with me, and I cried with a loud voice:

mock when your 20\_PRO\_01\_26 # I also will laugh at your calamity; I will mock when your fear cometh;

mocked and others <u>44\_ACT\_17\_32</u> # And when they heard of the resurrection of the dead, some mocked: and others said, We will hear thee again of this [matter].

mocked and spitefully <u>42\_LUK\_18\_32</u> # For he shall be delivered unto the Gentiles, and shall be mocked, and spitefully entreated, and spitted on:

mocked for whatsoever <u>48\_GAL\_06\_07</u> # Be not deceived; God is not mocked: for whatsoever a man soweth, that shall he also reap.

mocked him and <u>12\_2KI\_02\_23</u> # And he went up from thence unto Bethel: and as he was going up by the way, there came forth little children out of the city, and mocked him, and said unto him, Go up, thou bald head; go up, thou bald head.

mocked him and <u>42\_LUK\_22\_63</u># And the men that held Jesus mocked him, and smote [him].

mocked him and <u>42\_LUK\_23\_11</u># And Herod with his men of war set him at nought, and mocked [him], and arrayed him in a gorgeous robe, and sent him again to Pilate.

mocked him coming <u>42\_LUK\_23\_36</u># And the soldiers also mocked him, coming to him, and offering him vinegar,

mocked him saying <u>40\_MAT\_27\_29</u># And when they had platted a crown of thorns, they put [it] upon his head, and a reed in his right hand: and they bowed the knee before him, and mocked him, saying, Hail, King of the Jews!

mocked him they <u>41\_MAR\_15\_20</u> # And when they had mocked him, they took off the purple from him, and put his own clothes on him, and led him out to crucify him.

mocked him they <u>40\_MAT\_27\_31</u># And after that they had mocked him, they took the robe off from him, and put his own raiment on him, and led him away to crucify [him].

mocked me and <u>07\_JUD\_16\_10</u># And Delilah said unto Samson, Behold, thou hast mocked me, and told me lies: now tell me, I pray thee, wherewith thou mightest be bound.

mocked me and <u>07\_JUD\_16\_13</u> # And Delilah said unto Samson, Hitherto thou hast mocked me, and told me lies: tell me wherewith thou mightest be bound. And he said unto her, If thou weavest the seven locks of my head with the web.

mocked me I <u>04\_NUM\_22\_29</u> # And Balaam said unto the ass, Because thou hast mocked me: I would there were a sword in mine hand, for now would I kill thee.

mocked me these <u>07\_JUD\_16\_15</u> # And she said unto him, How canst thou say, I love thee, when thine heart [is] not with me? thou hast mocked me these three times, and hast not told me wherein thy great strength [lieth].

mocked of his <u>18\_JOB\_12\_04</u> # I am [as] one mocked of his neighbour, who calleth upon God, and he answereth him: the just upright [man is] laughed to scorn.

mocked of the <u>40\_MAT\_02\_16</u># Then Herod, when he saw that he was mocked of the wise men, was exceeding wroth, and sent forth, and slew all the children that were in Bethlehem, and in all the coasts thereof, from two years old and under, according to the time which he had diligently inquired of the wise men.

mocked the Jews <u>16\_NEH\_04\_01</u> # But it came to pass, that when Sanballat heard that we builded the wall, he was wroth, and took great indignation, and mocked the Jews.

mocked the messengers <u>14\_2CH\_36\_16</u> # But they mocked the messengers of God, and despised his words, and misused his prophets, until the wrath of the LORD arose against his people, till [there was] no remedy.

mocked them and <u>11\_1KI\_18\_27</u># And it came to pass at noon, that Elijah mocked them, and said, Cry aloud: for he [is] a god; either he is talking, or he is pursuing, or he is in a journey, [or] peradventure he sleepeth, and must be awaked.

mockers in feasts <u>19\_PSA\_35\_16</u># With hypocritical mockers in feasts, they gnashed upon me with their teeth.

mockers in the <u>65\_JDE\_01\_18</u># How that they told you there should be mockers in the last time, who should walk after their own ungodly lusts.

mockers lest your <u>23\_ISA\_28\_22</u> # Now therefore be ye not mockers, lest your bands be made strong: for I have heard from the Lord GOD of hosts a consumption, even determined upon the whole earth.

mockers nor rejoiced <u>24\_JER\_15\_17</u> # I sat not in the assembly of the mockers, nor rejoiced; I sat alone because of thy hand: for thou hast filled me with indignation.

mockers with me <u>18\_JOB\_17\_02</u> # [Are there] not mockers with me? and doth not mine eye continue in their provocation?

mockest shall no <u>18\_JOB\_11\_03</u># Should thy lies make men hold their peace? and when thou mockest, shall no man make thee ashamed?

mocketh another do <u>18\_JOB\_13\_09</u># Is it good that he should search you out? or as one man mocketh another, do ye [so] mock him?

mocketh at fear <u>18\_JOB\_39\_22</u> # He mocketh at fear, and is not affrighted; neither turneth he back from the sword.

mocketh at his <u>20\_PRO\_30\_17</u># The eye [that] mocketh at [his] father, and despiseth to obey [his] mother, the ravens of the valley shall pick it out, and the young eagles shall eat it.

mocketh me <u>24\_JER\_20\_07</u># O LORD, thou hast deceived me, and I was deceived: thou art stronger than I, and hast prevailed: I am in derision daily, every one mocketh me.

mocketh the poor <u>20\_PRO\_17\_05</u># Whoso mocketh the poor reproacheth his Maker: [and] he that is glad at calamities shall not be unpunished.

mocking him with <u>40\_MAT\_27\_41</u># Likewise also the chief priests mocking [him], with the scribes and elders, said,

mocking said among <u>41\_MAR\_15\_31</u> # Likewise also the chief priests mocking said among themselves with the scribes, He saved others; himself he cannot save.

mocking said These <u>44\_ACT\_02\_13</u> # Others mocking said, These men are full of new wine.

mocking to all <u>26\_EZE\_22\_04</u> # Thou art become guilty in thy blood that thou hast shed; and hast defiled thyself in thine idols which thou hast made; and thou hast caused thy days to draw near, and art come [even] unto thy years: therefore have I made thee a reproach unto the heathen, and a mocking to all countries.

mocking <u>01\_GEN\_21\_09</u># And Sarah saw the son of Hagar the Egyptian, which she had born unto Abraham, mocking.

mockings and scourgings <u>58\_HEB\_11\_36</u># And others had trial of [cruel] mockings and scourgings, yea,
