mocked and others 44 ACT 17 32 # And when they heard of the resurrection of the dead, some mocked: and others said, We will hear thee again of this [matter].

mocked and spitefully 42 LUK 18 32 # For he shall be delivered unto the Gentiles, and shall be mocked, and spitefully entreated, and spitted on:

mocked for whatsoever 48 GAL 06 07 # Be not deceived; God is not mocked: for whatsoever a man soweth, that shall he also reap.

mocked him and 12 2KI 02 23 # And he went up from thence unto Bethel: and as he was going up by the way, there came forth little children out of the city, and mocked him, and said unto him, Go up, thou bald head; go up, thou bald head.

mocked him and 42 LUK 22 63 # And the men that held Jesus mocked him, and smote [him].

mocked him and 42 LUK 23 11 # And Herod with his men of war set him at nought, and mocked [him], and arraved him in a gorgeous robe, and sent him again to Pilate.

mocked him coming 42 LUK 23 36 # And the soldiers also mocked him, coming to him, and offering him vinegar,

mocked him saying 40 MAT 27 29 # And when they had platted a crown of thorns, they put [it] upon his head, and a reed in his right hand: and they bowed the knee before him, and mocked him, saying, Hail, King of the Jews!

mocked him they 41 MAR 15 20 # And when they had mocked him, they took off the purple from him, and put his own clothes on him, and led him out to crucify him.

mocked him they 40 MAT 27 31# And after that they had mocked him, they took the robe off from him, and put his own raiment on him, and led him away to crucify [him].

mocked me and 07 JUD 16 10 # And Delilah said unto Samson, Behold, thou hast mocked me, and told me lies: now tell me, I pray thee, wherewith thou mightest be bound.

mocked me and 07 JUD 16 13 # And Delilah said unto Samson, Hitherto thou hast mocked me, and told me lies: tell me wherewith thou mightest be bound. And he said unto her, If thou weavest the seven locks of my head with the web.

mocked me I 04 NUM 22 29 # And Balaam said unto the ass, Because thou hast mocked me: I would there were a sword in mine hand, for now would I kill thee

mocked me these 07 JUD 16 15# And she said unto him, How canst thou say, I love thee, when thine heart [is] not with me? thou hast mocked me these three times, and hast not told me wherein thy great strength [lieth].

mocked of his 18 JOB 12 04 # I am [as] one mocked of his neighbour, who calleth upon God, and he answereth him: the just upright [man is] laughed to scorn.

mocked of the 40 MAT 02 16# Then Herod, when he saw that he was mocked of the wise men, was exceeding wroth, and sent forth, and slew all the children that were in Bethlehem, and in all the coasts thereof, from two years old and under, according to the time which he had diligently inquired of the wise men.

mocked the Jews 16 NEH 04 01 # But it came to pass, that when Sanballat heard that we builded the wall, he was wroth, and took great indignation, and mocked the Jews.

mocked the messengers 14 2CH 36 16# But they mocked the messengers of God, and despised his words, and misused his prophets, until the wrath of the LORD arose against his people, till [there was] no remedy.

mocked them and 11 1KI 18 27. # And it came to pass at noon, that Elijah mocked them, and said, Cry aloud: for he [is] a god; either he is talking, or he is pursuing, or he is in a journey, [or] peradventure he sleepeth, and must be awaked.

mocked them 14 2CH 30 10 # So the posts passed from city to city through the country of Ephraim and Manasseh even unto Zebulun: but they laughed them to scorn, and mocked them.

mocked unto his old GEN 19 14 # And Lot went out, and spake unto his sons in law, which married his daughters, and said, Up, get you out of this place; for the LORD will destroy this city. But he seemed as one that mocked unto his sons in law.
